[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wind-up audible toy, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a "wind-up audible toy" showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

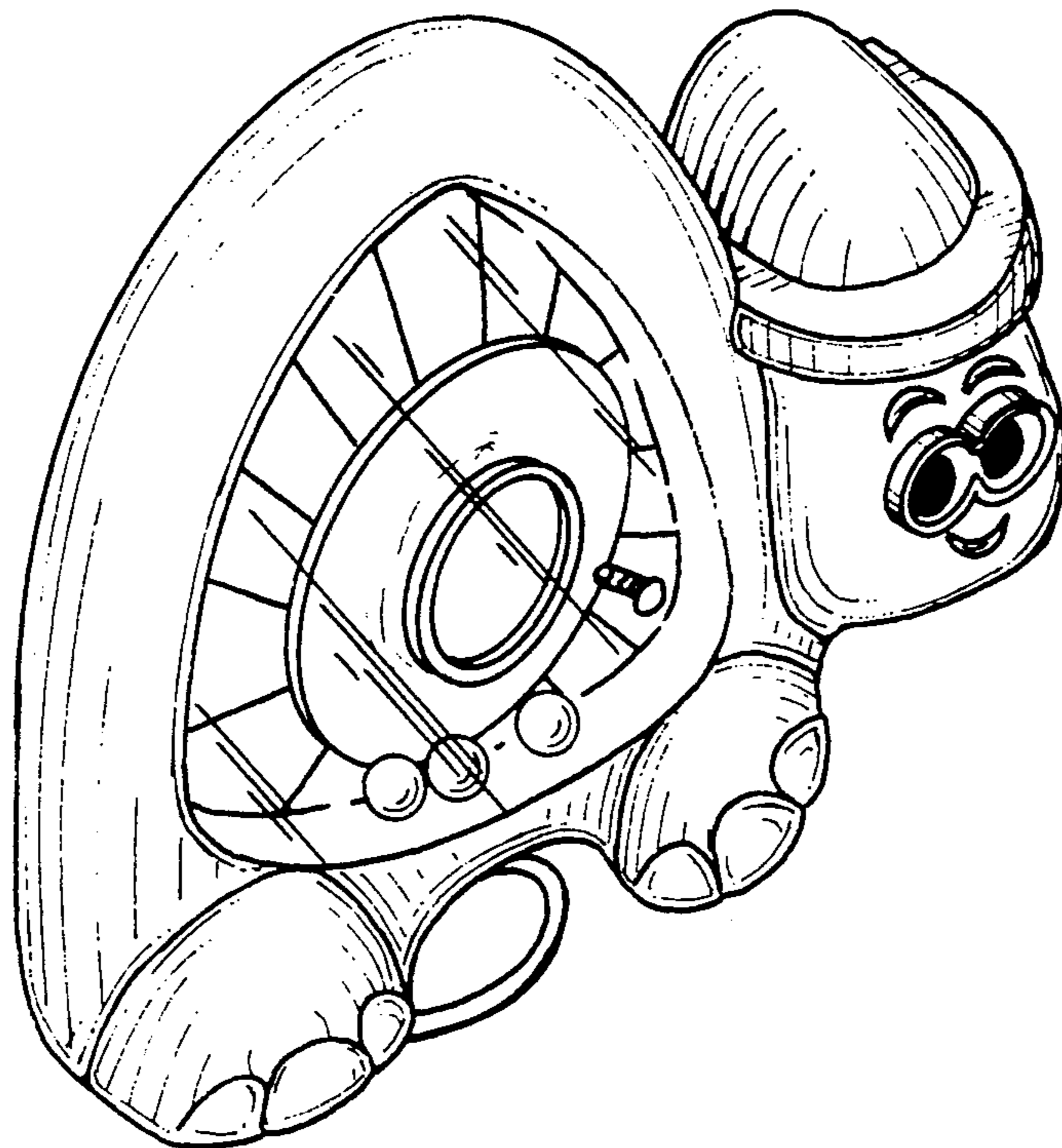

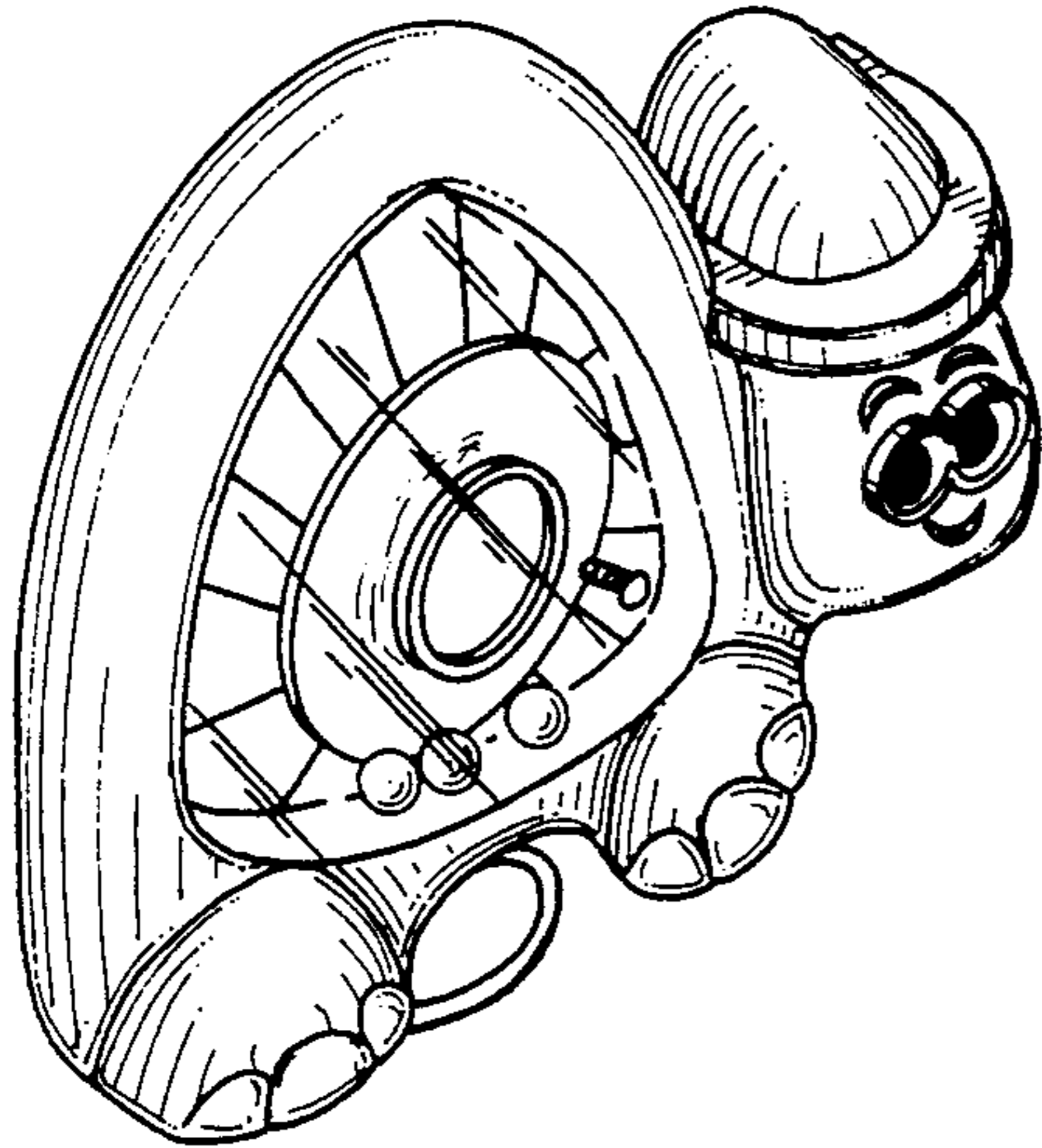

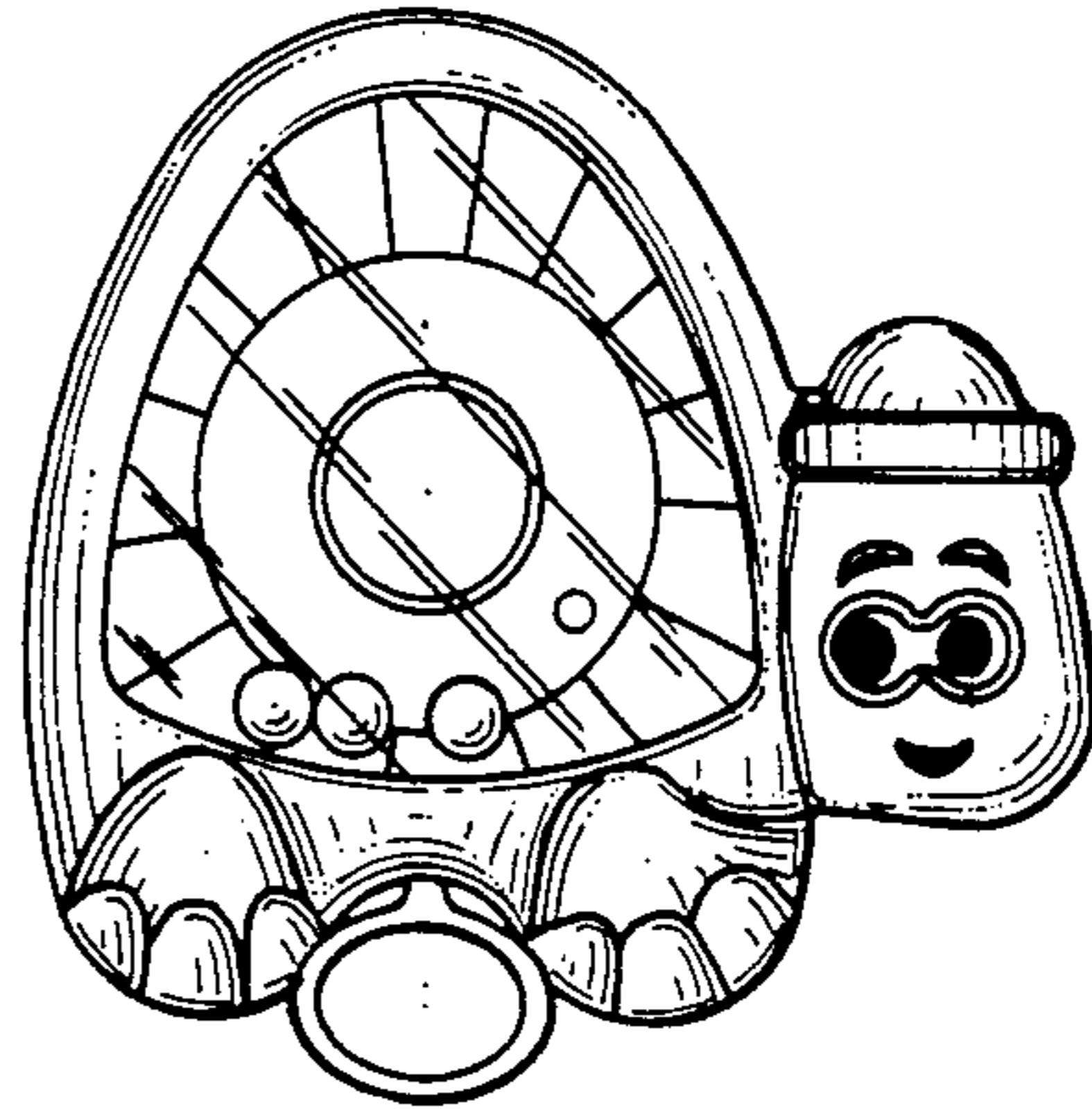

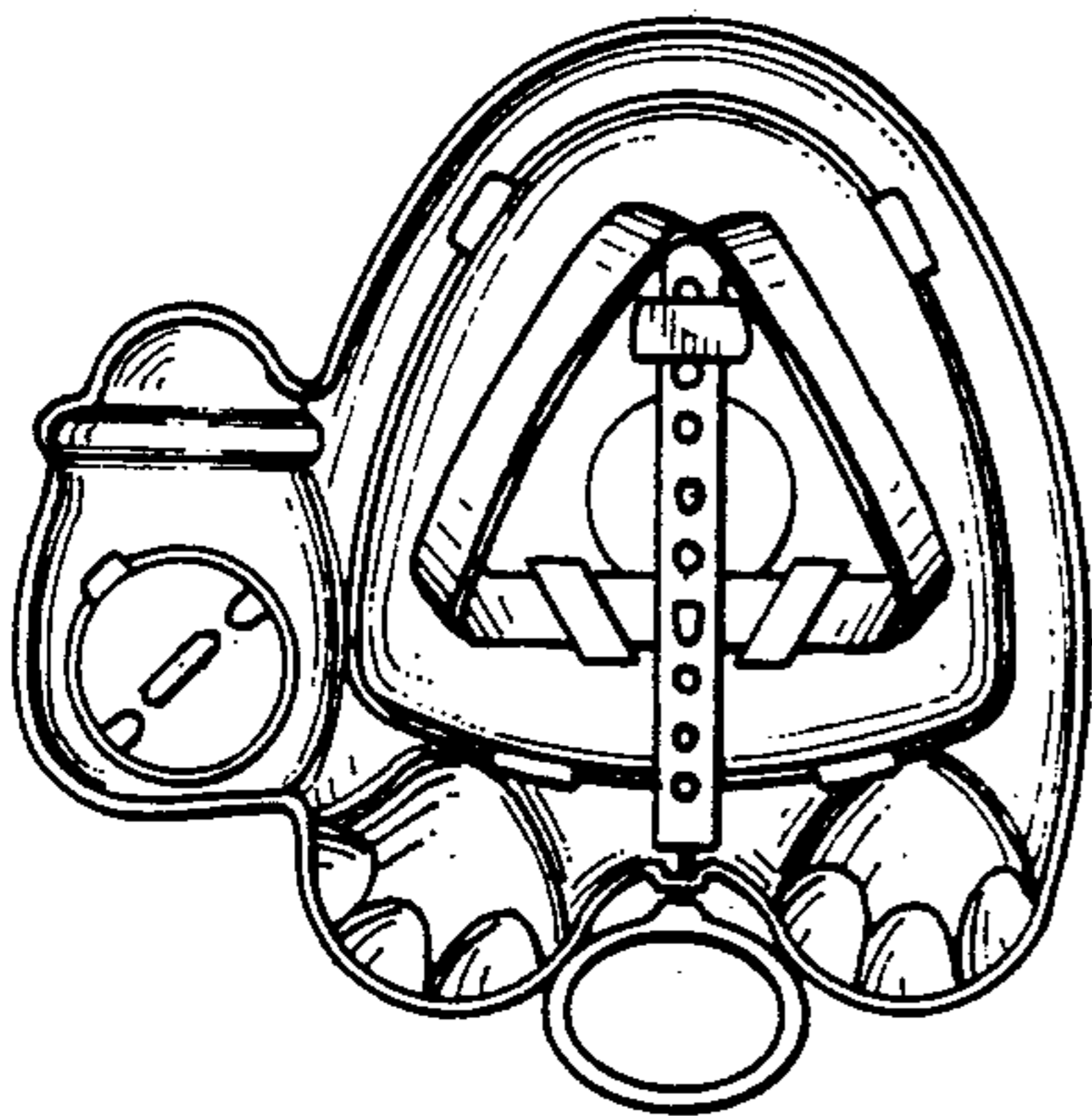

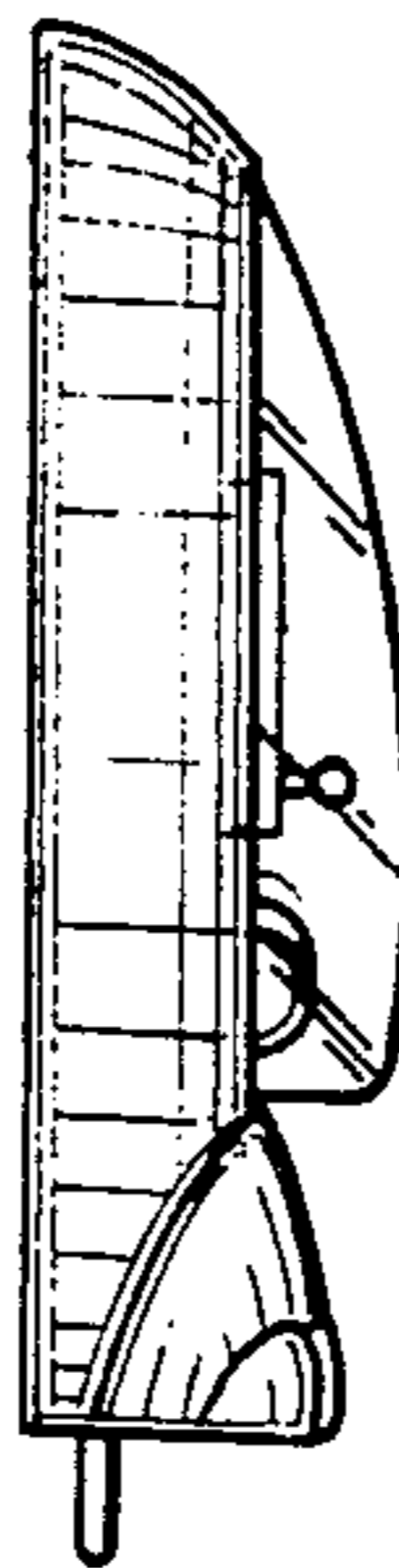

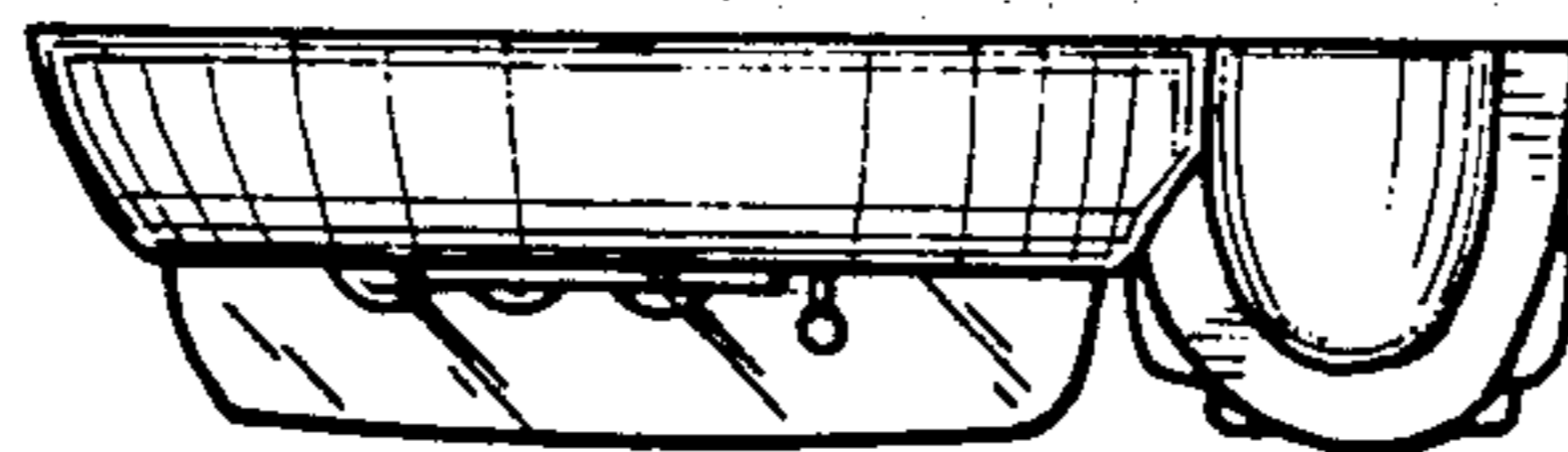
