[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a molded glove, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a molded glove showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is an elevational view from one side of the glove of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the glove of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view from the other side of the glove of FIG. 1.

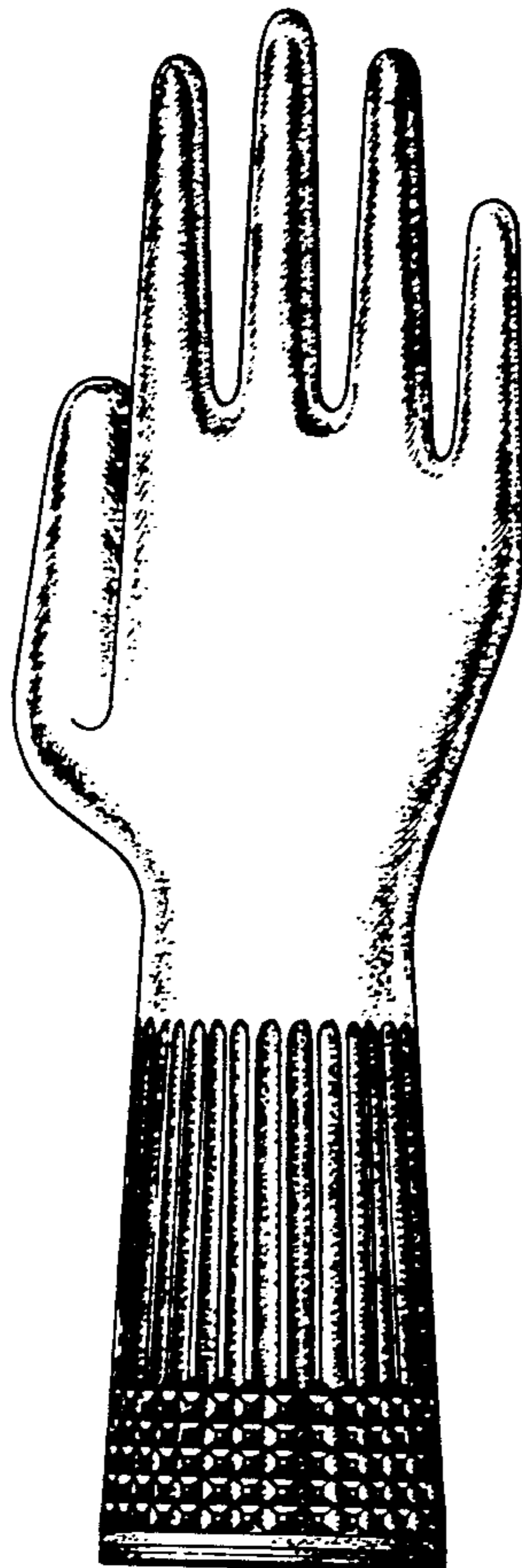

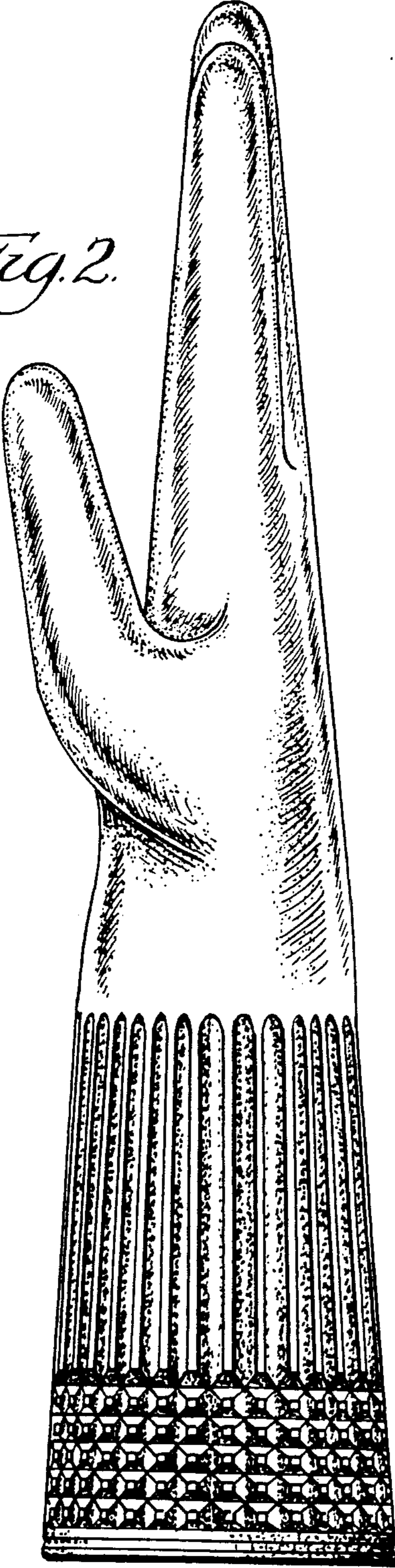

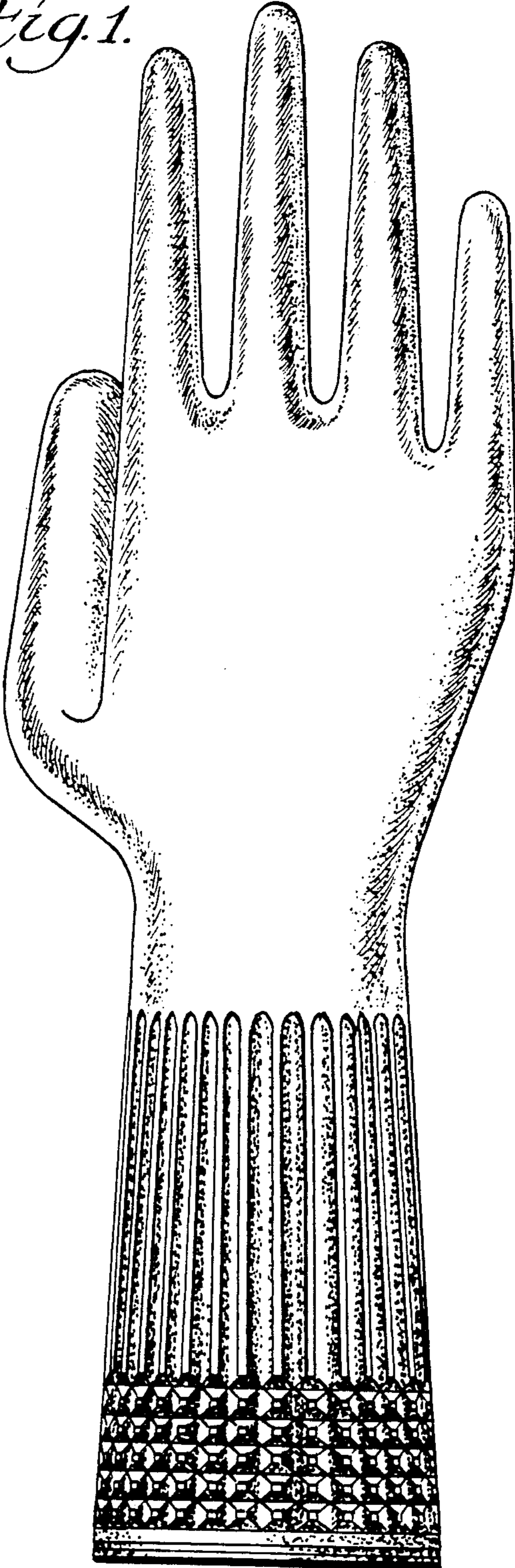

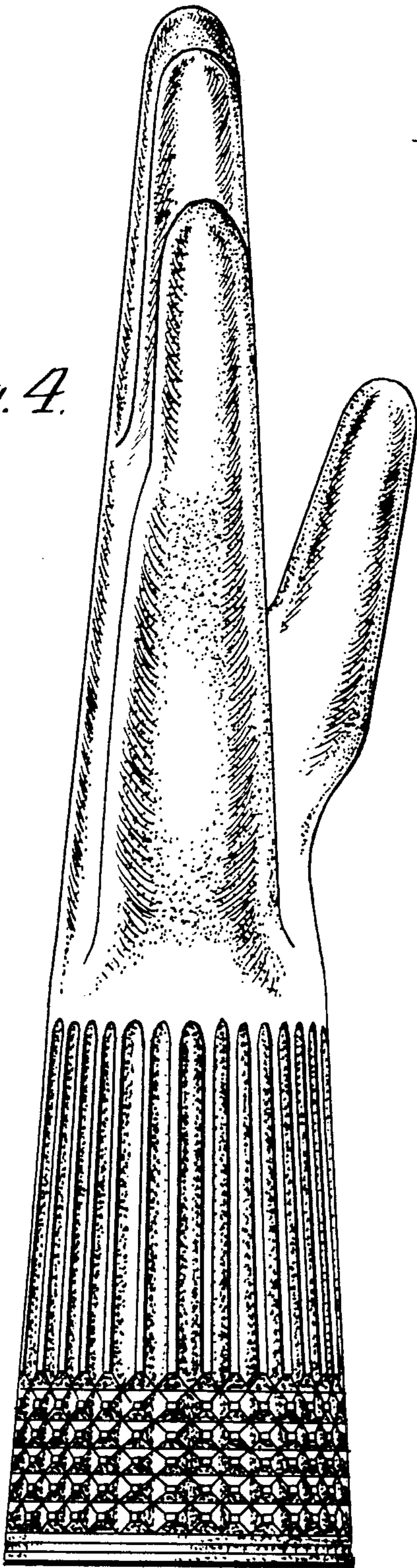
