DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of an arm chair showing my design;

 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the arm chair of FIG. 1.

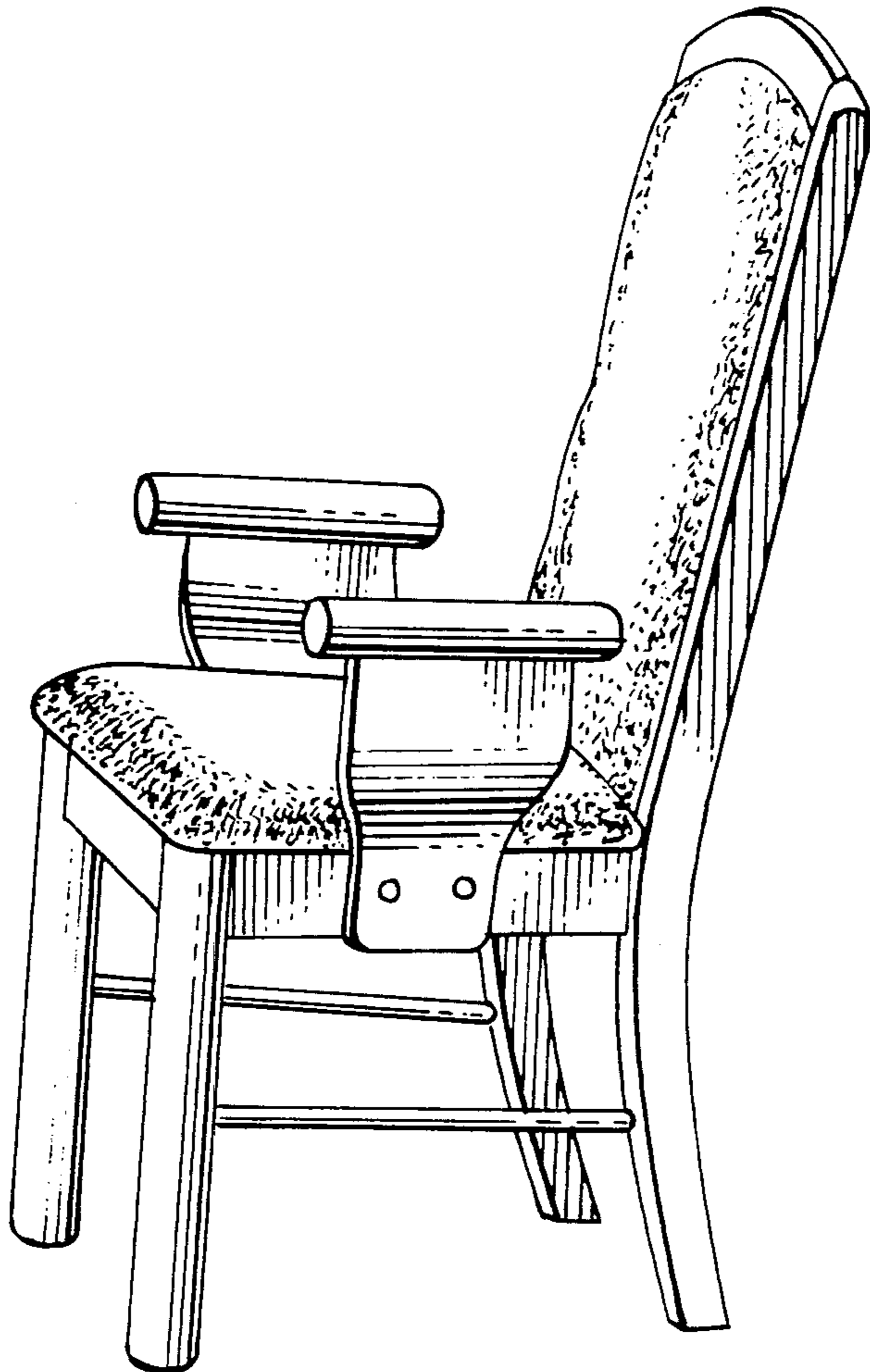

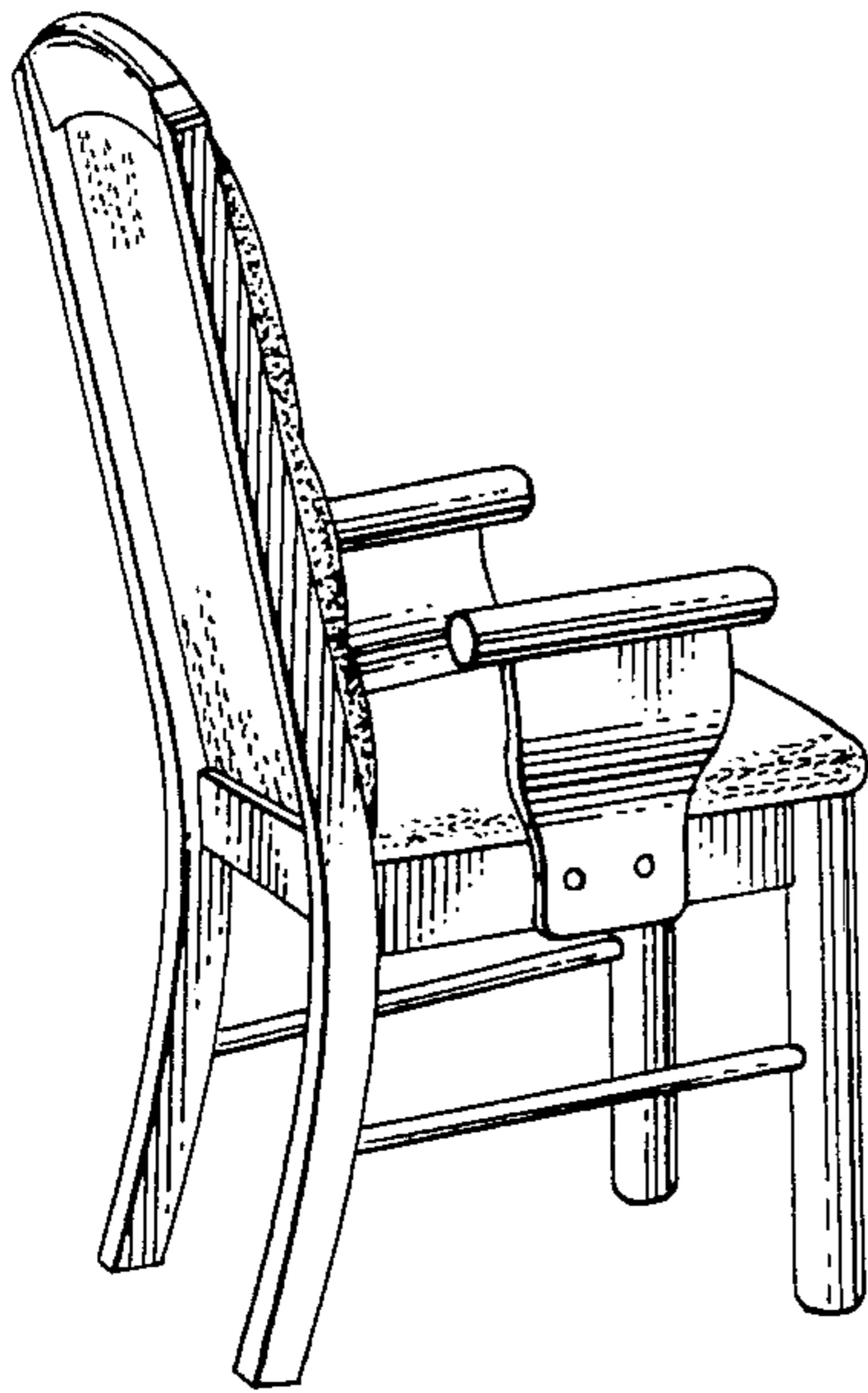

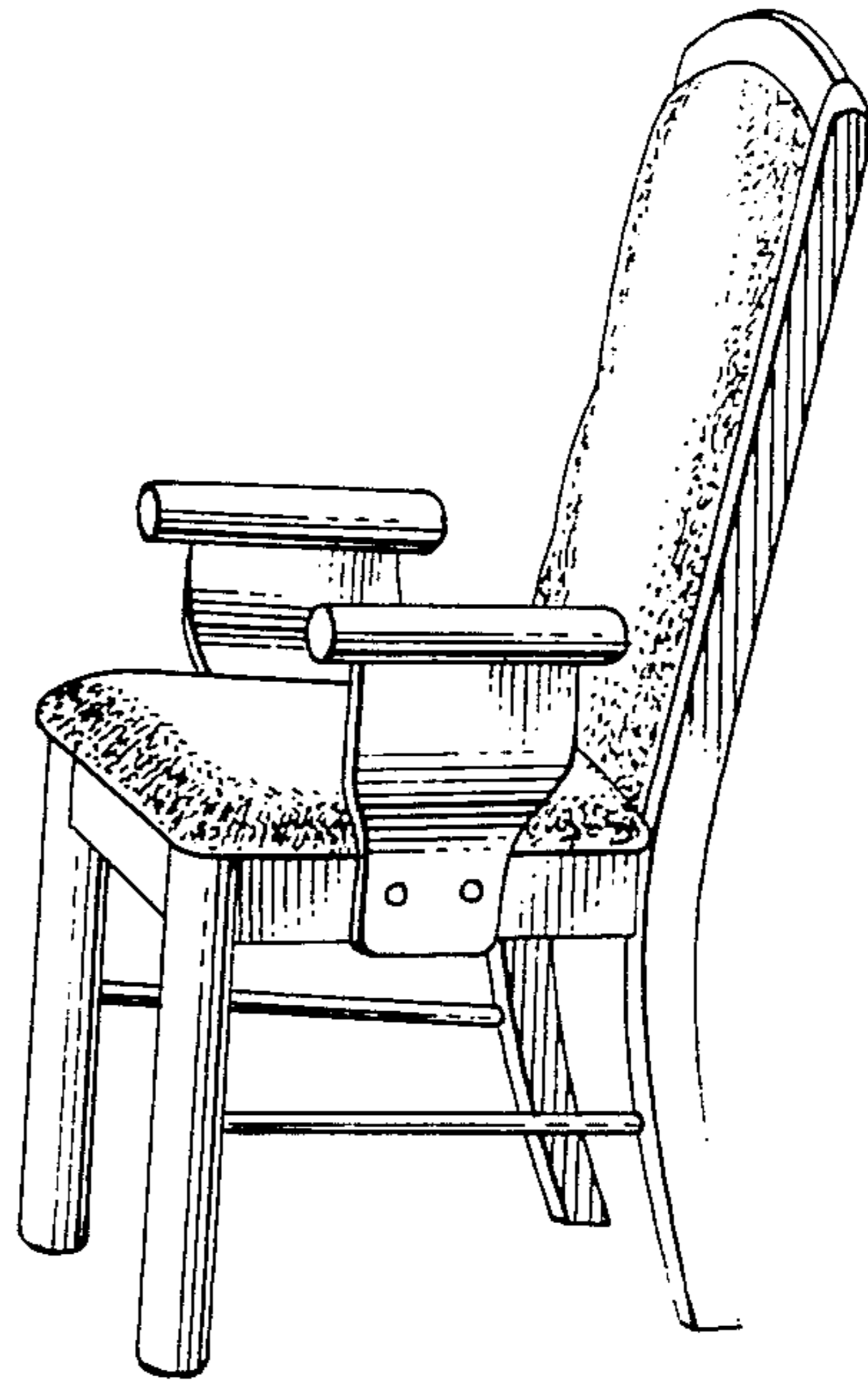

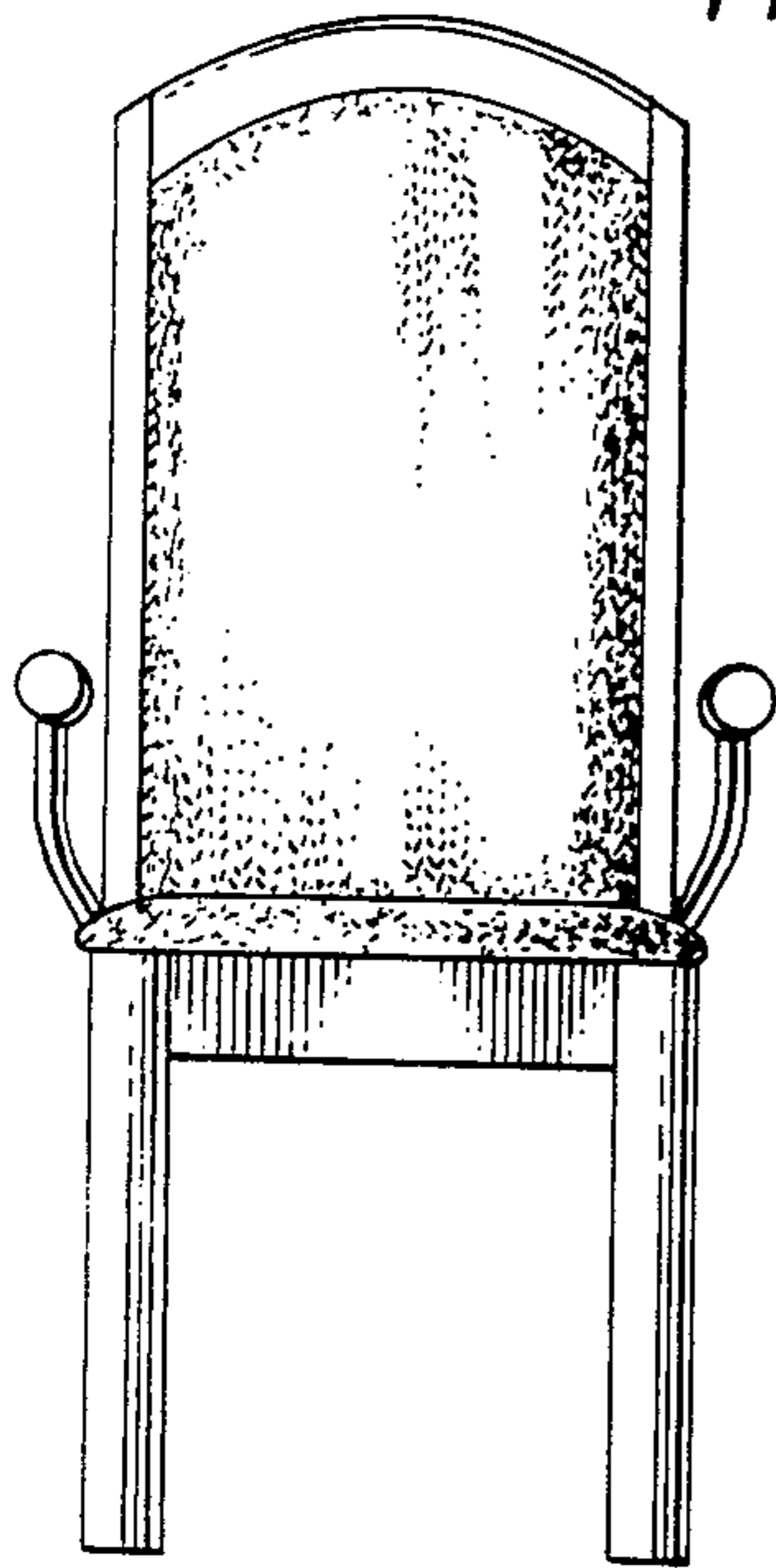

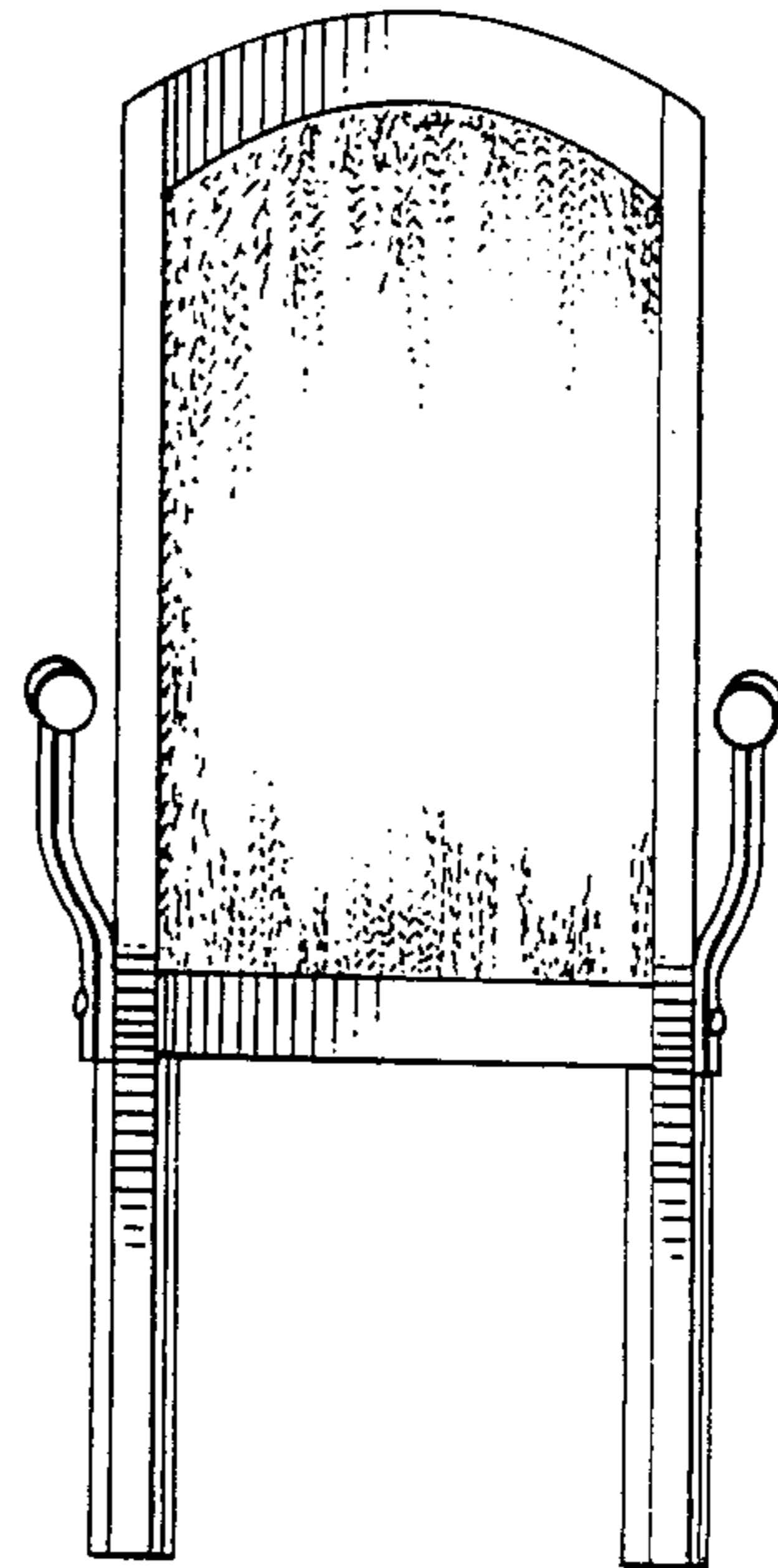
