[57] CLAIM

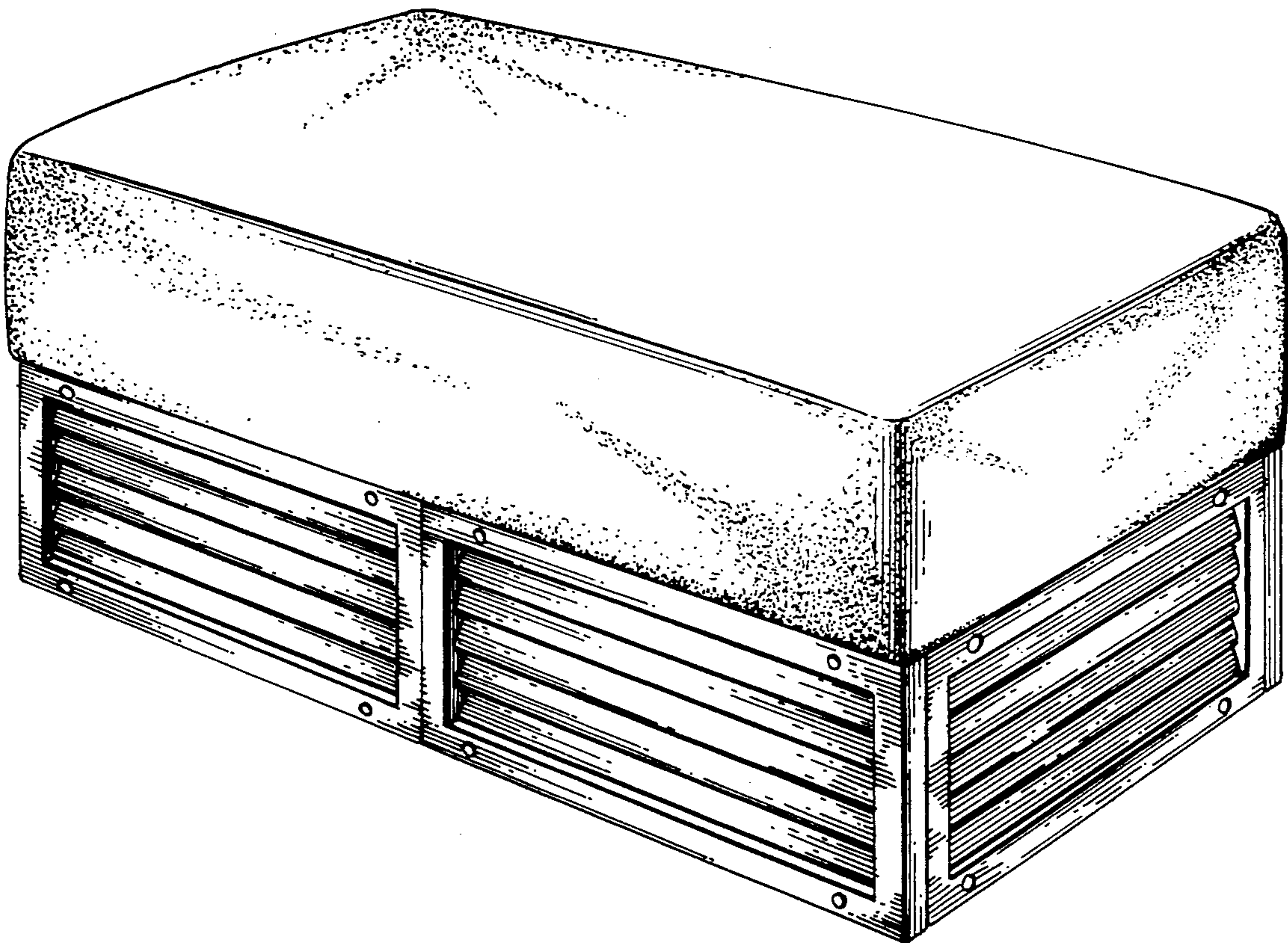
The ornamental design for a footstool, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a footstool incorporating the present invention;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view showing one of the two identical ends of the footstool of FIG. 1 but on a reduced scale;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view showing the undisclosed side of FIG. 1 on a reduced scale.



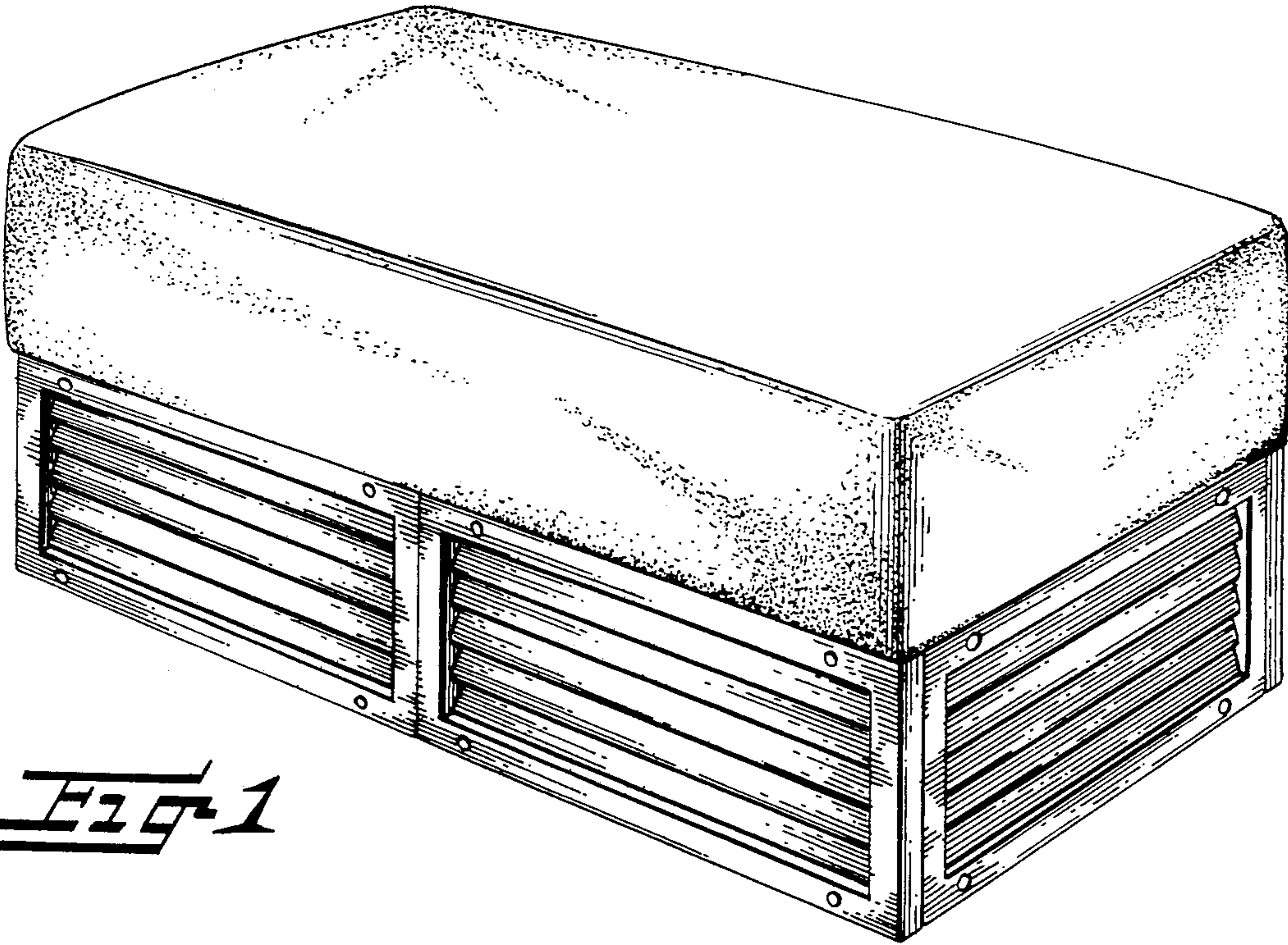

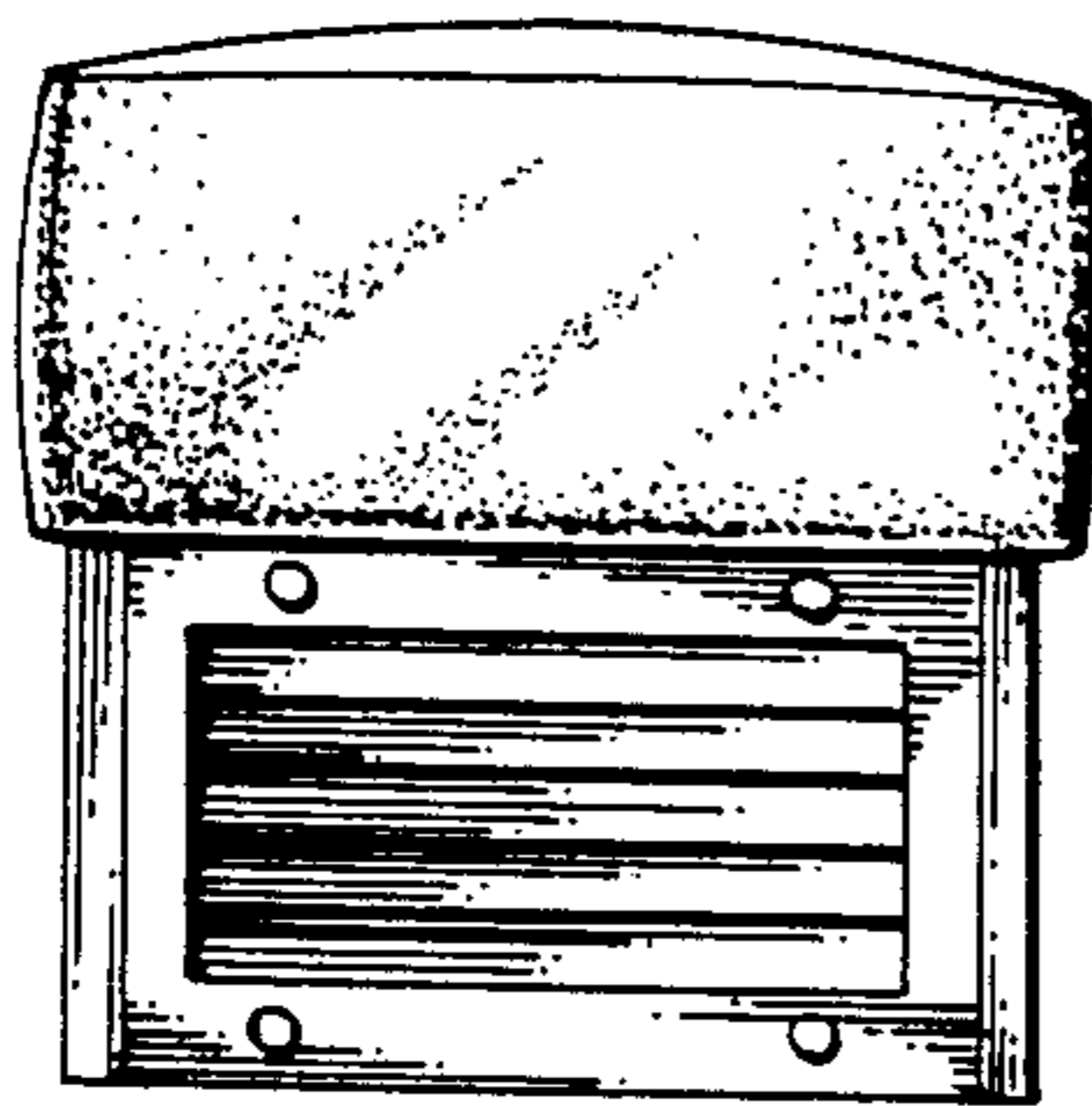

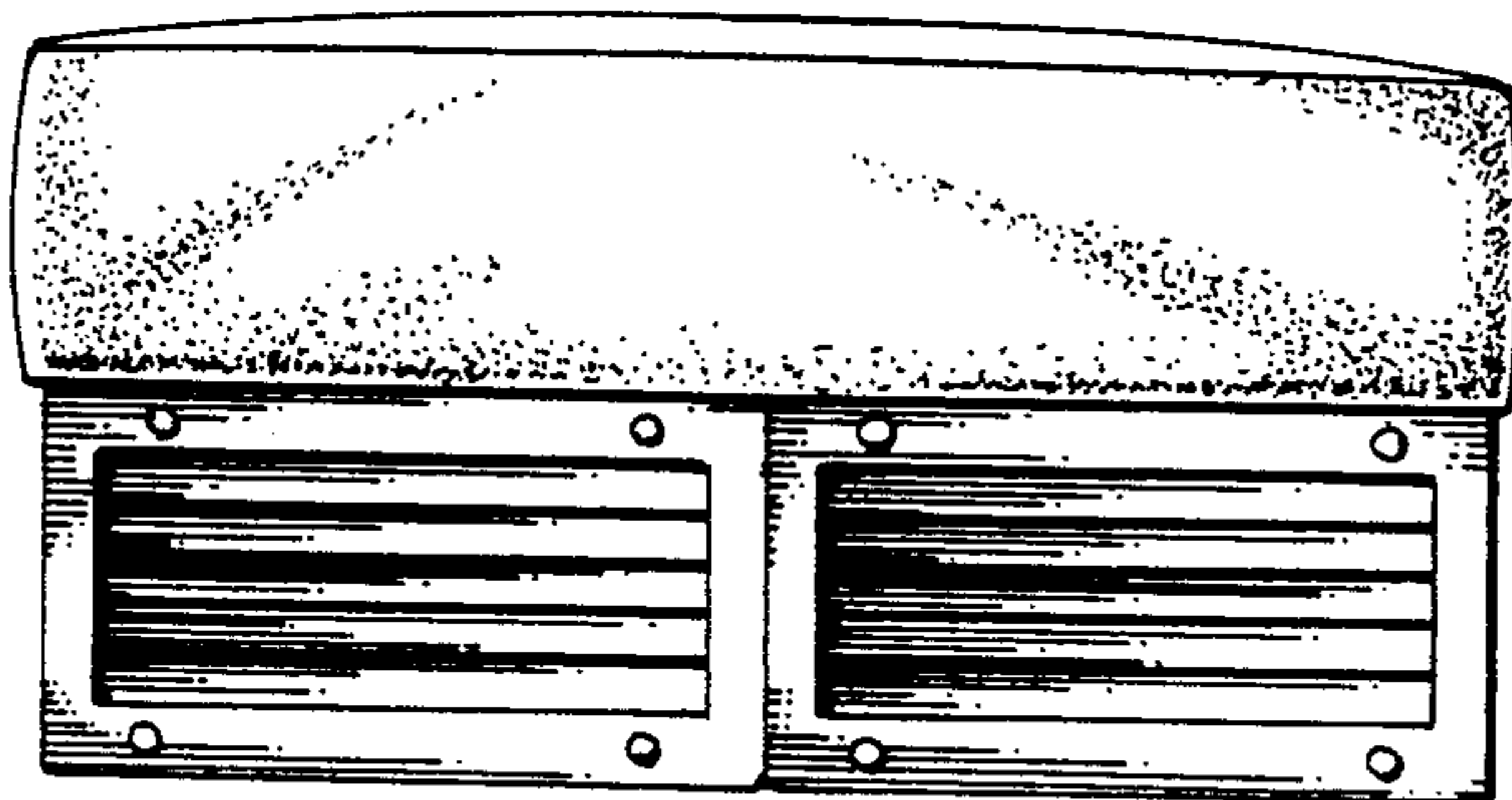
