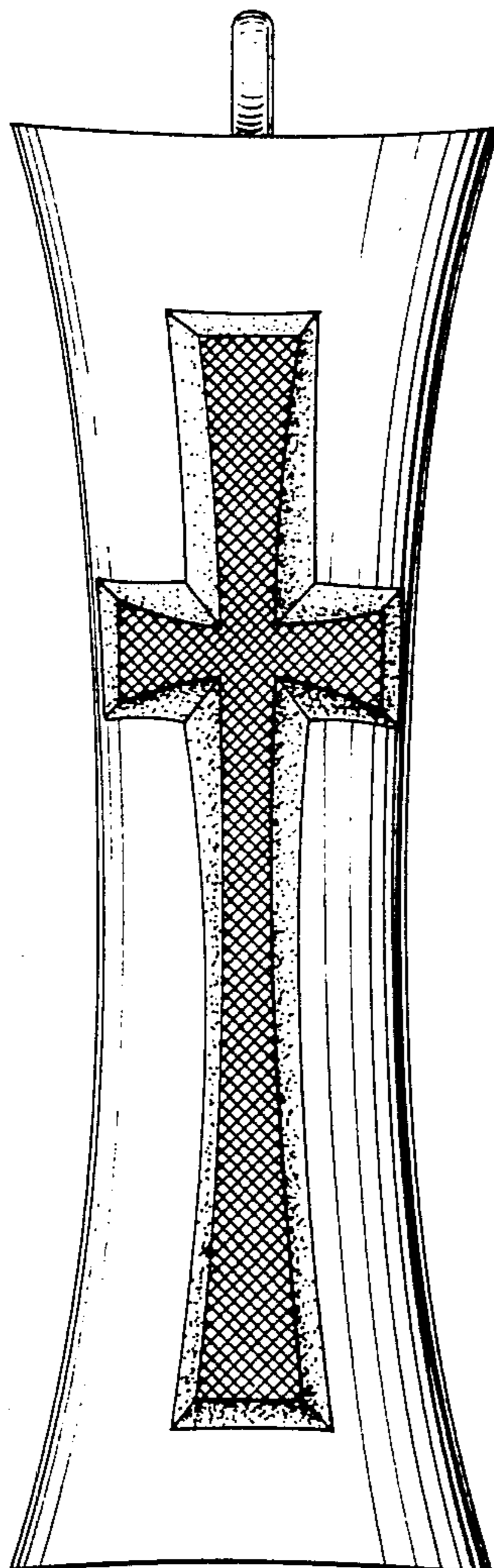
The ornamental design for a medallion, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a medallion showing my new design, the bottom view being identical to the top with the exception of the eyelet.

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of a medallion showing my new design, the left side being a mirror image of the right side.

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of a medallion showing my new design.



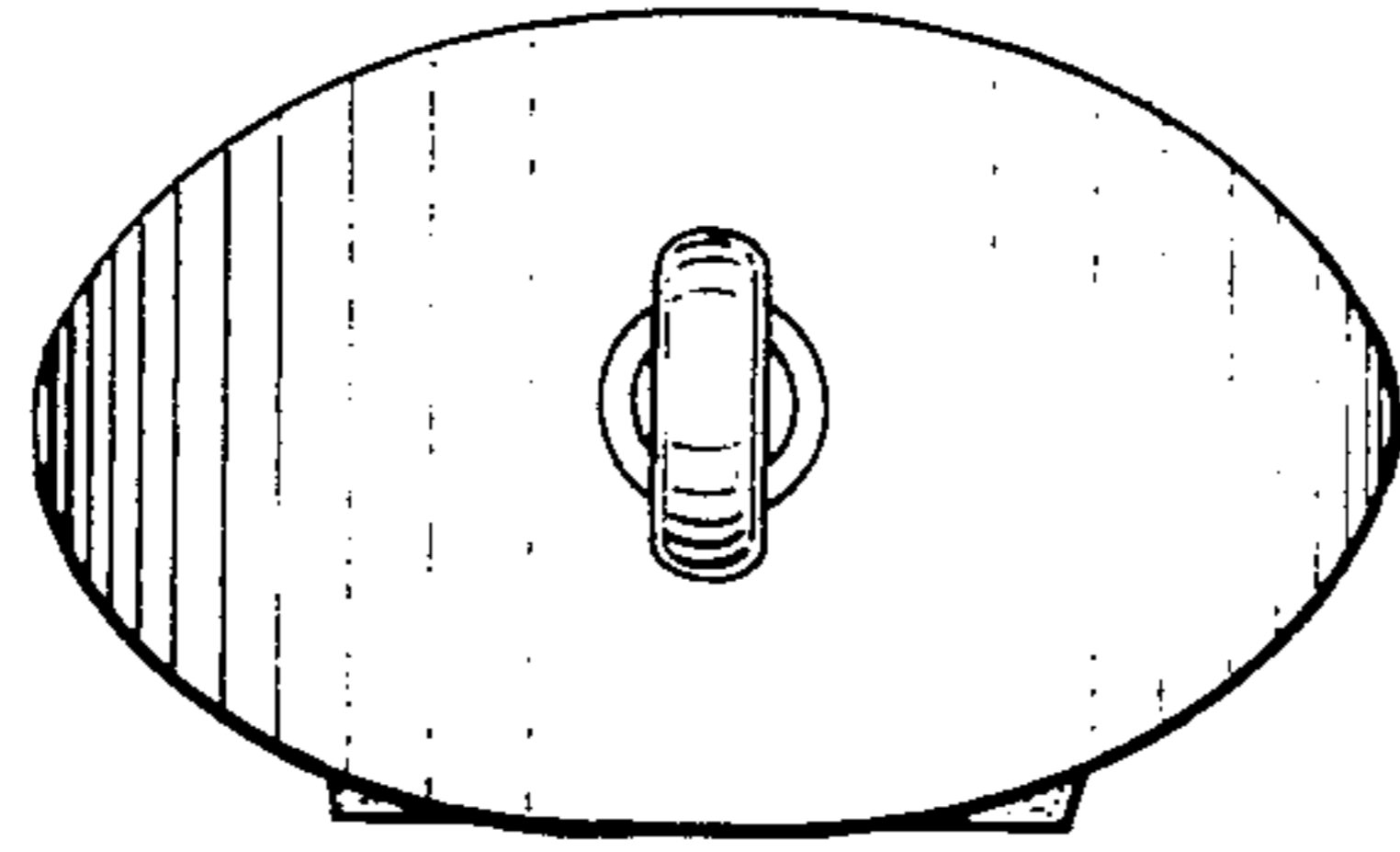

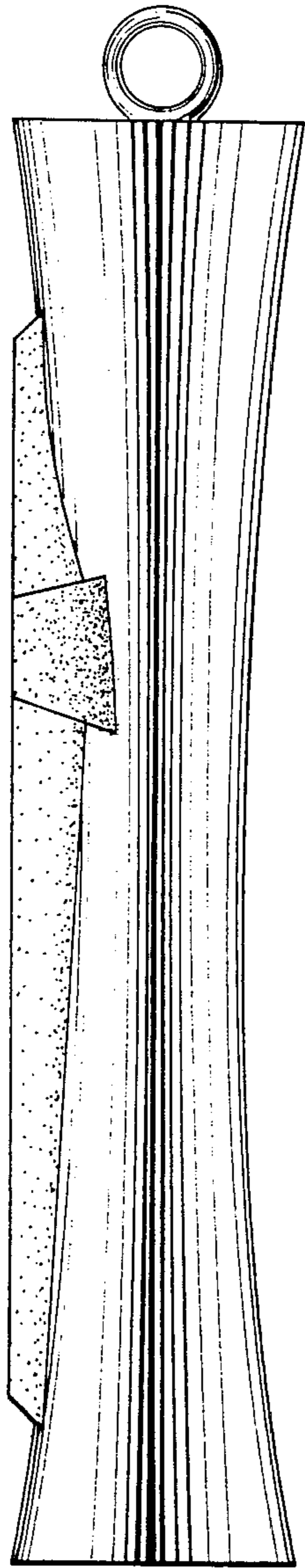

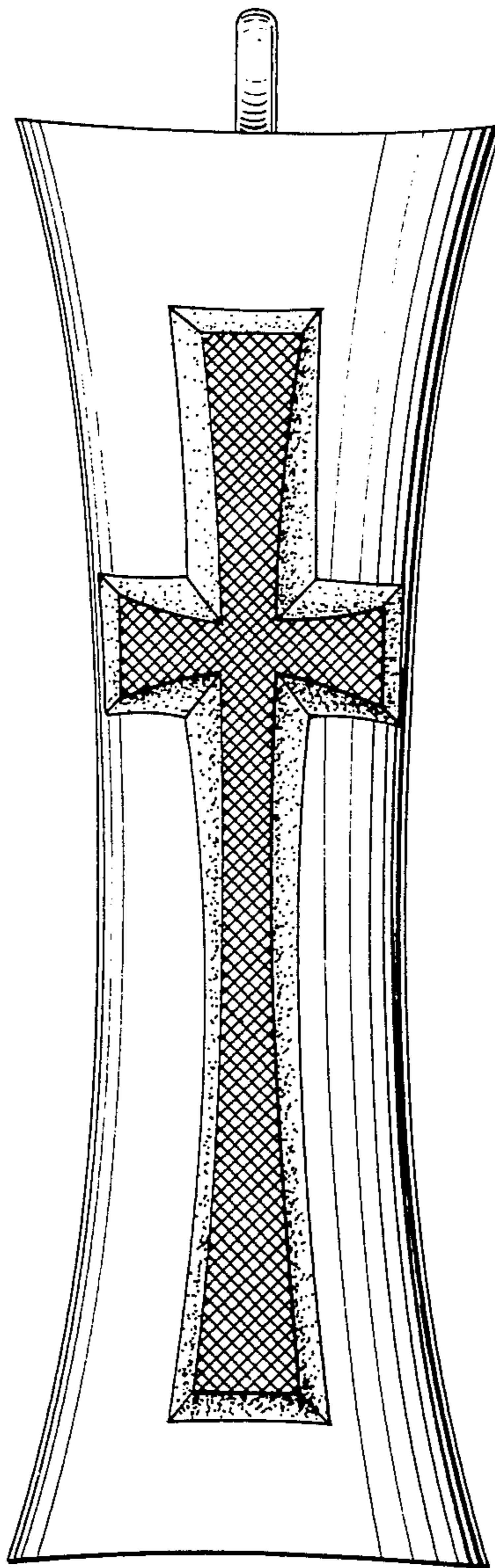
