The ornamental design for a teleprinter console, substantially as shown and described.

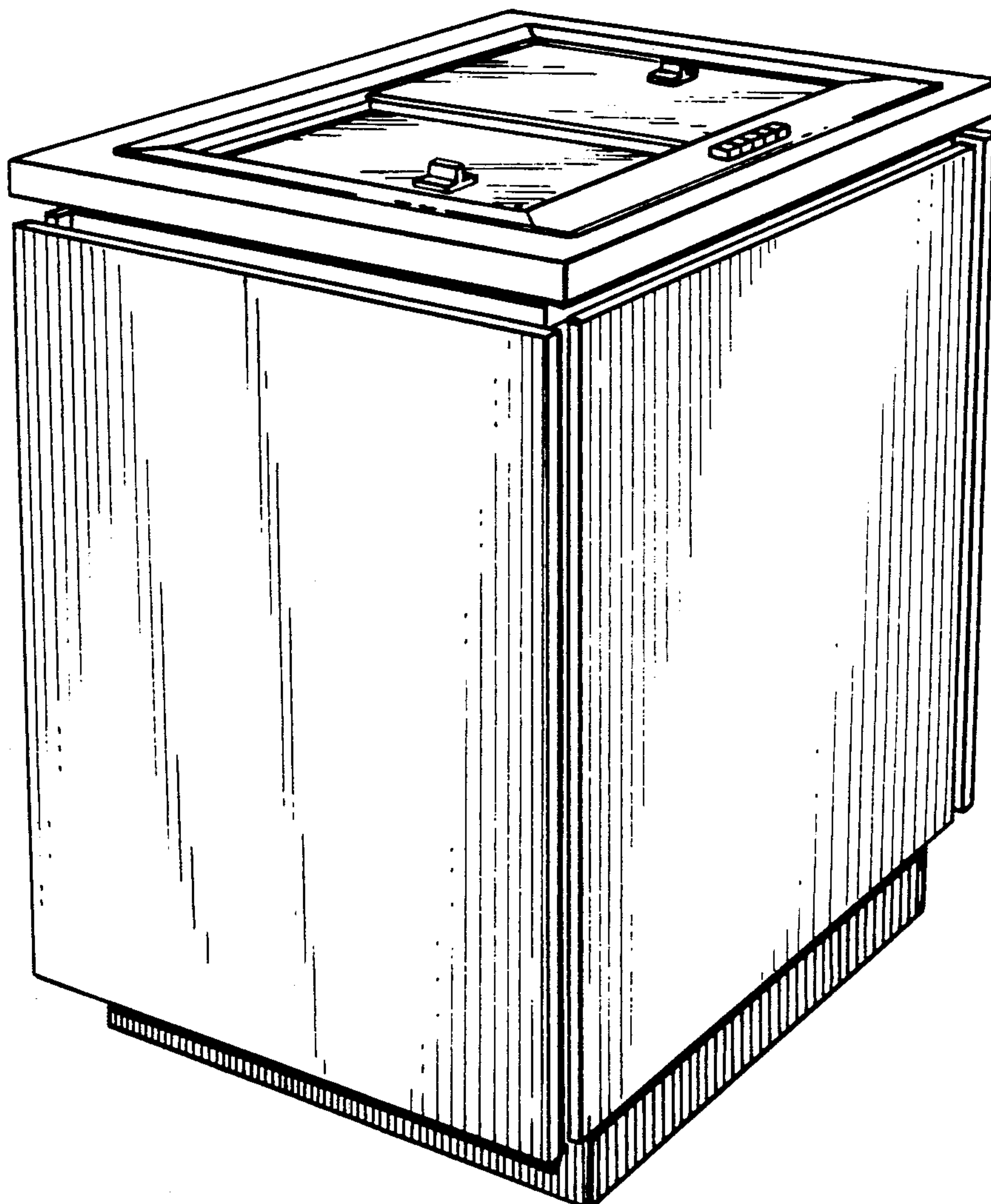
## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a teleprinter console showing our new design;

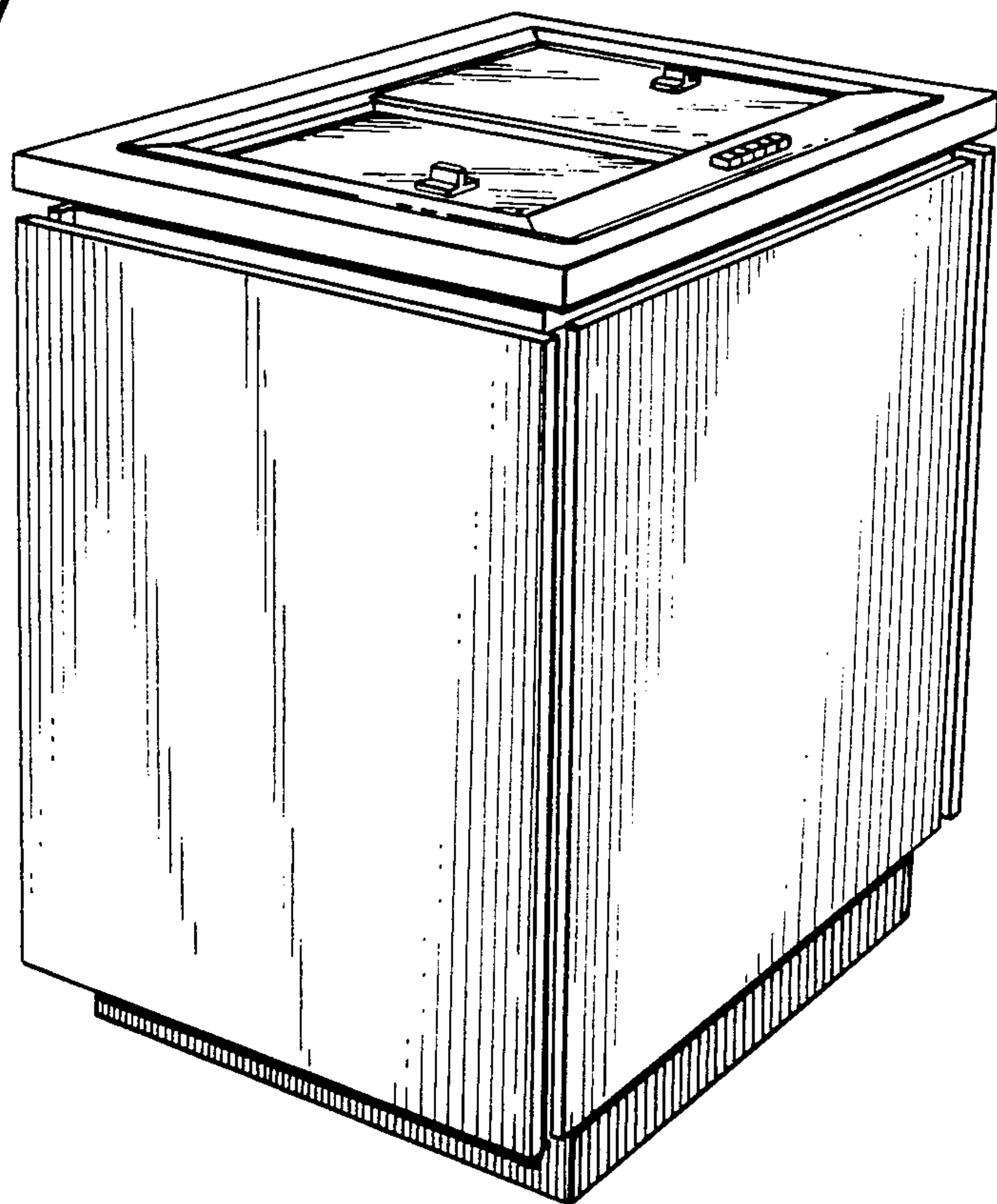
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof.

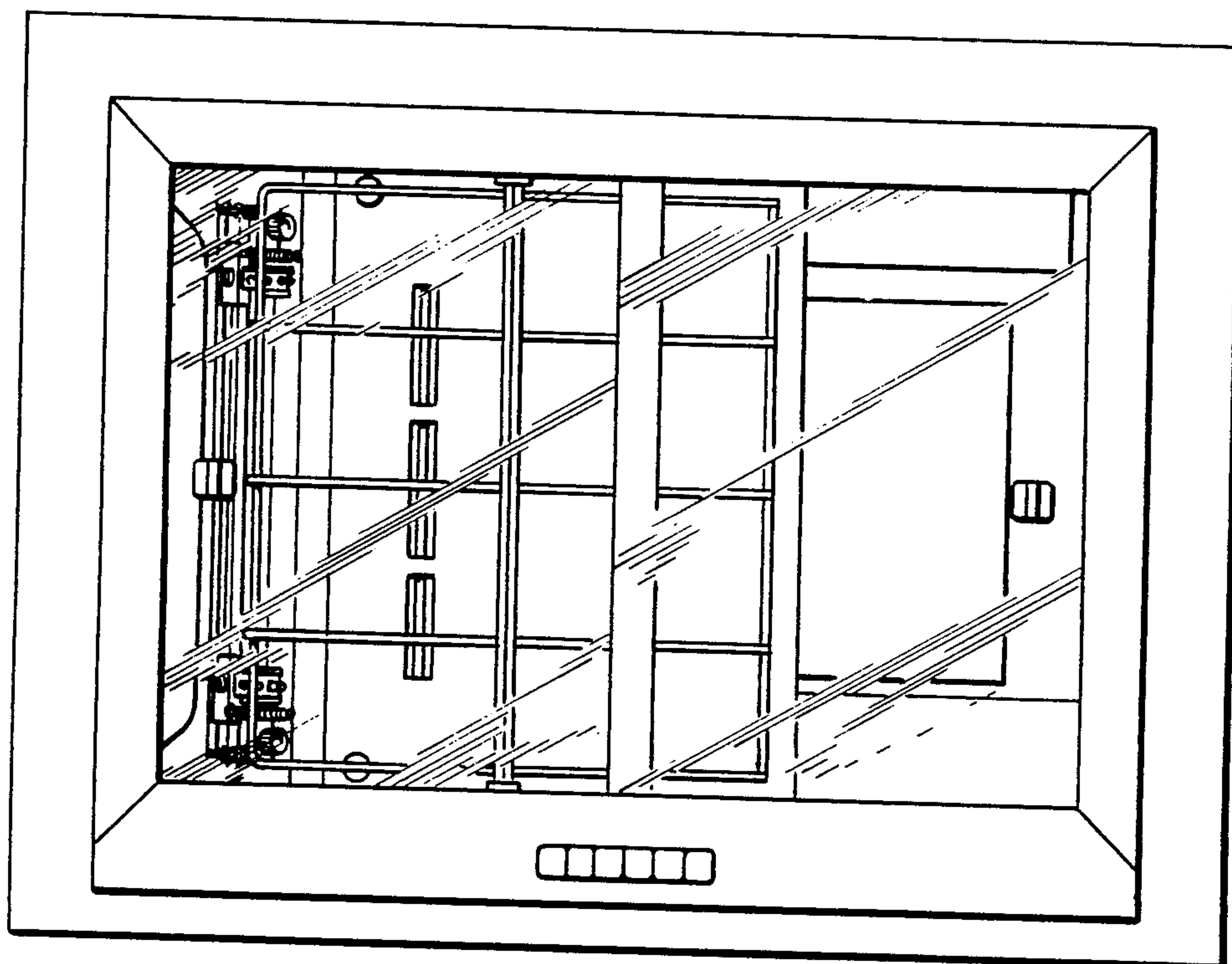
The characteristic feature of our design resides in the framing of the top opening.
