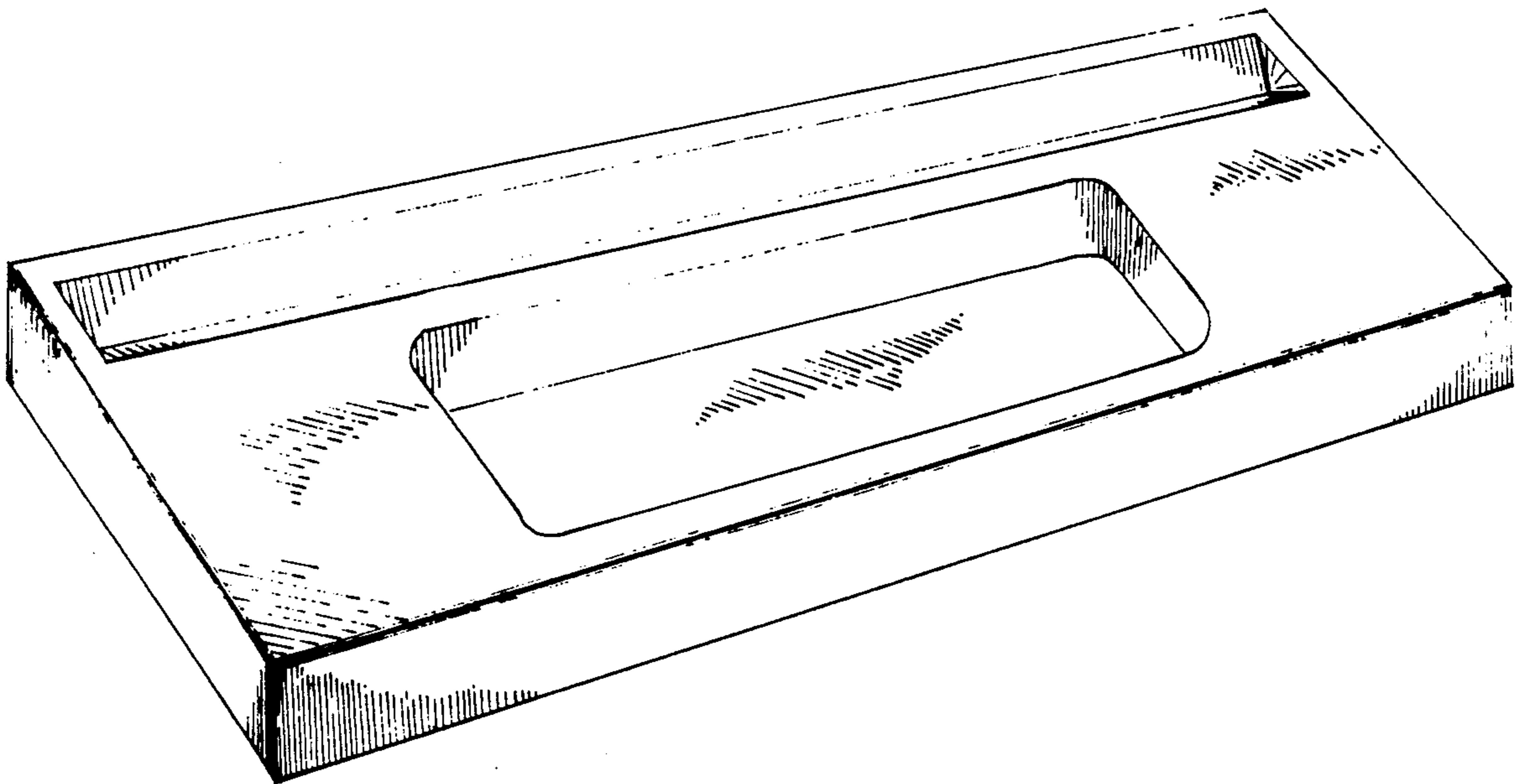

The ornamental design for a tray for designing beaded jewelry, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tray for designing beaded jewelry showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being identical thereto;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 5 is an end elevational view; and
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 2.



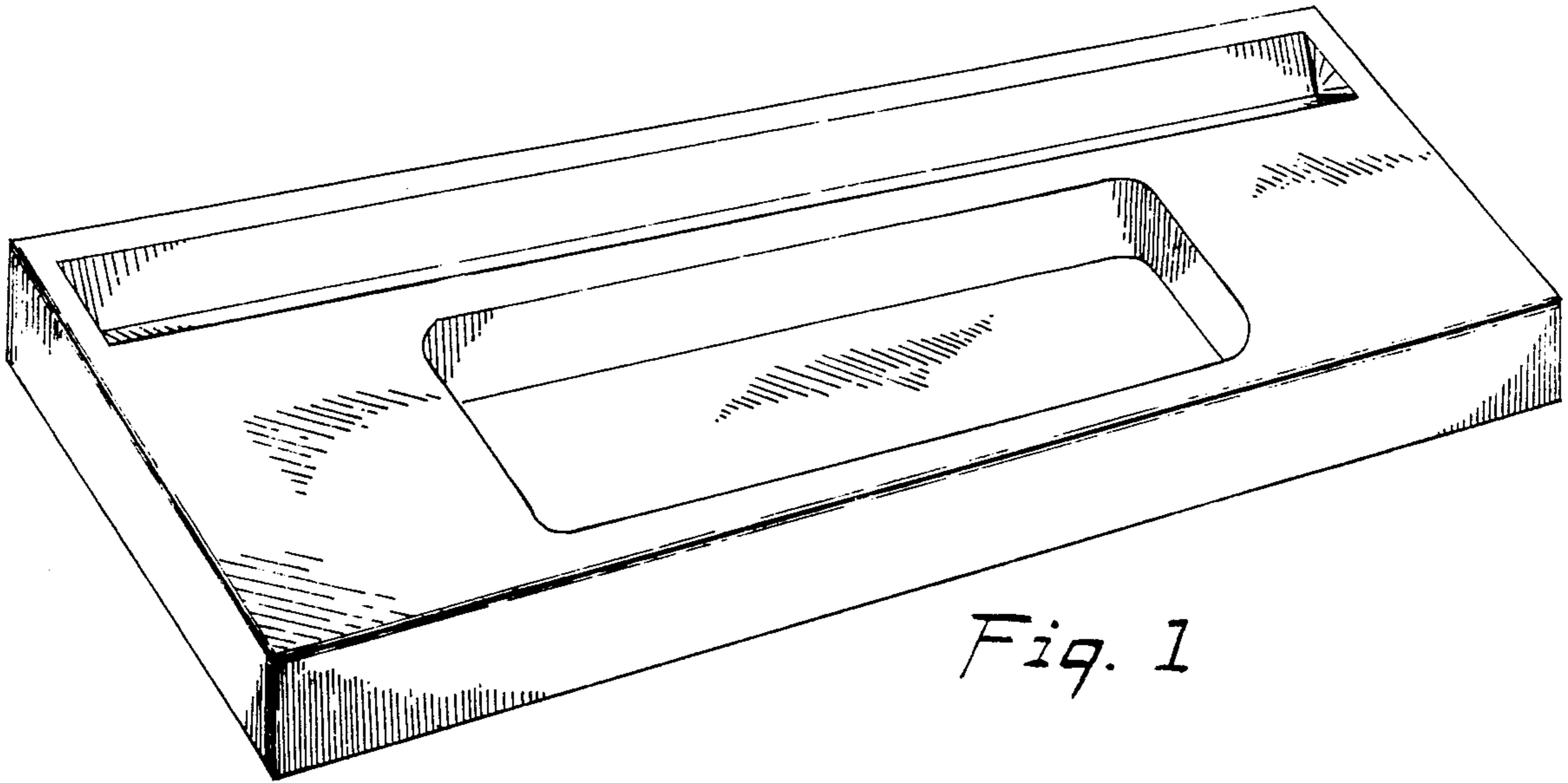

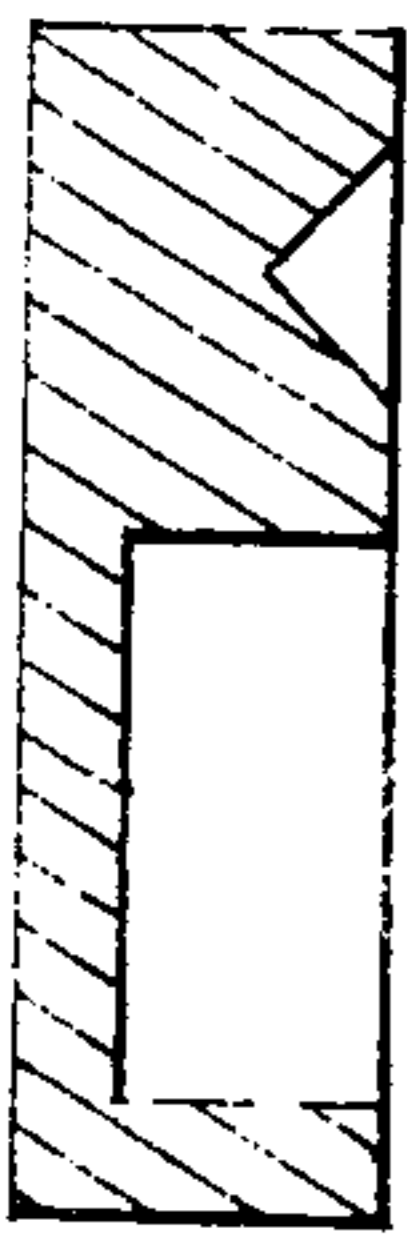

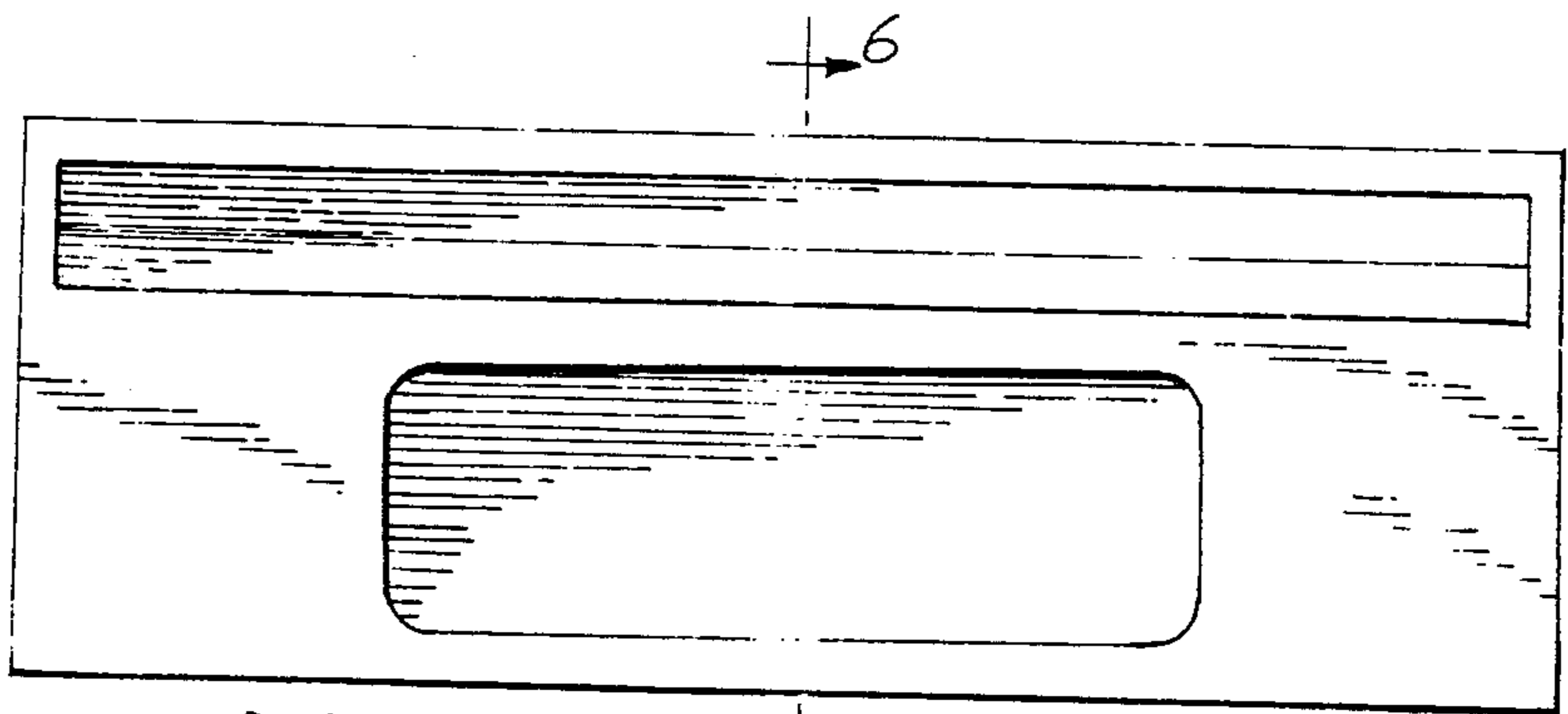

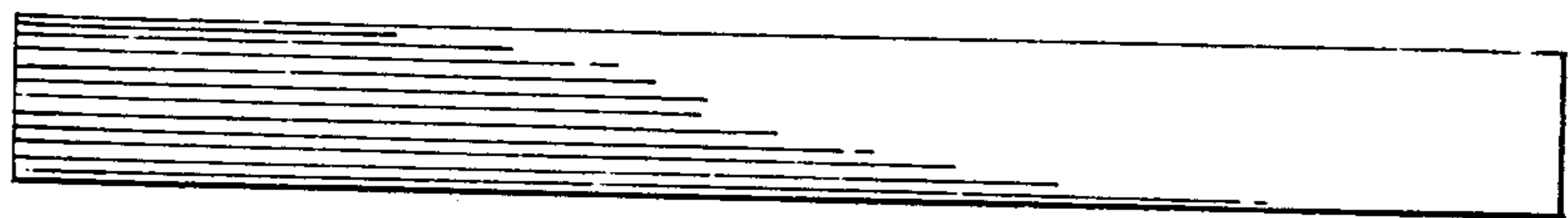

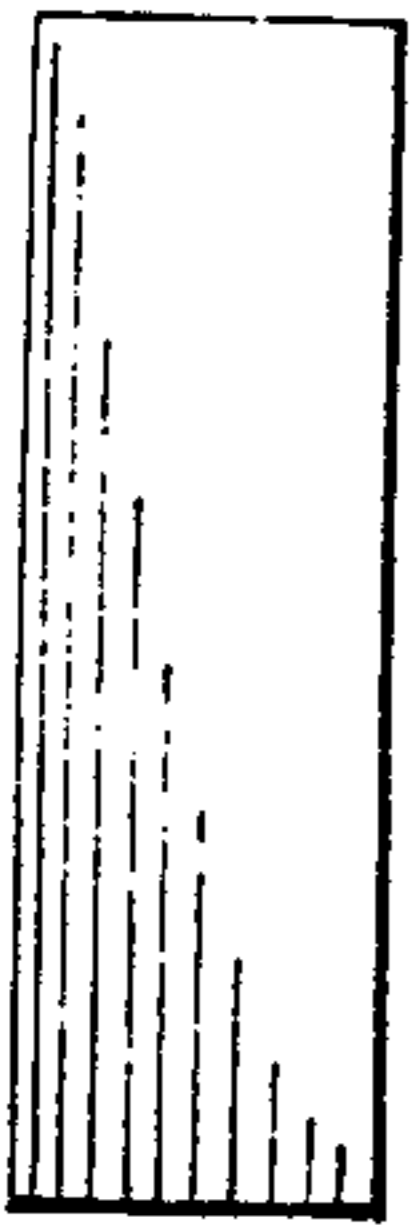

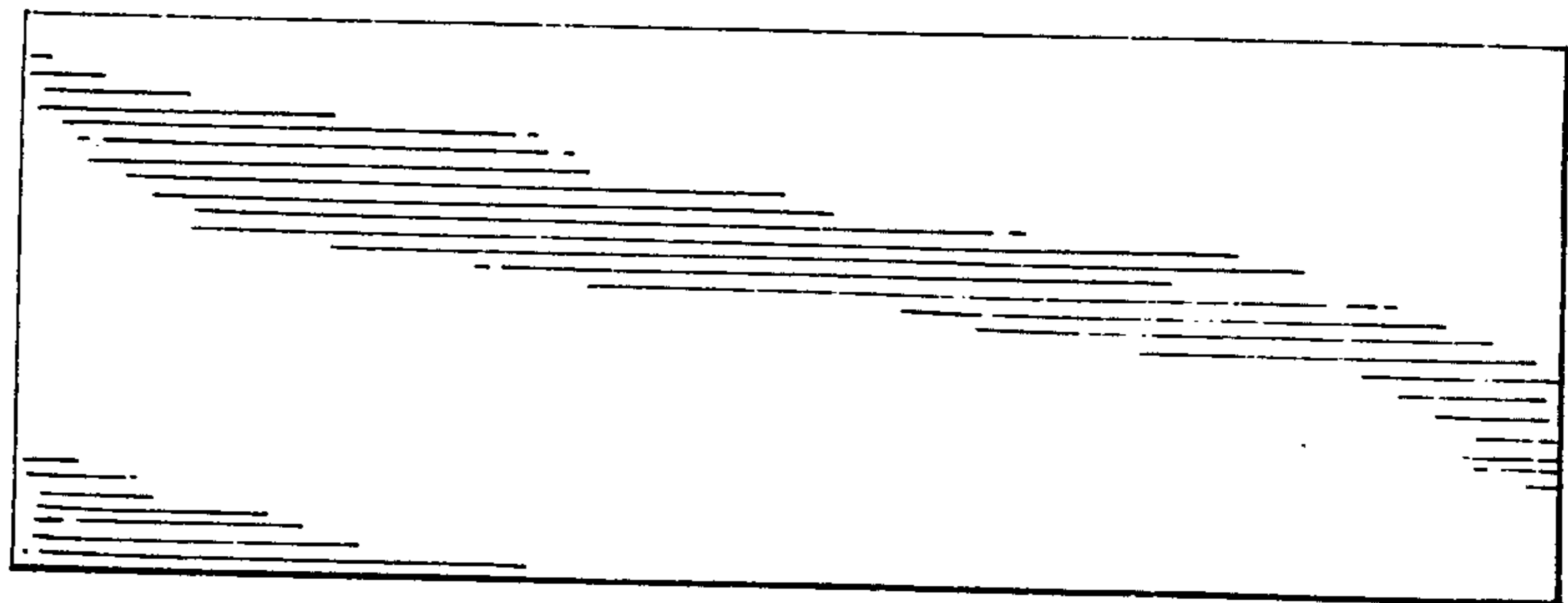
