The ornamental design for a crab trap, substantially as shown and described.

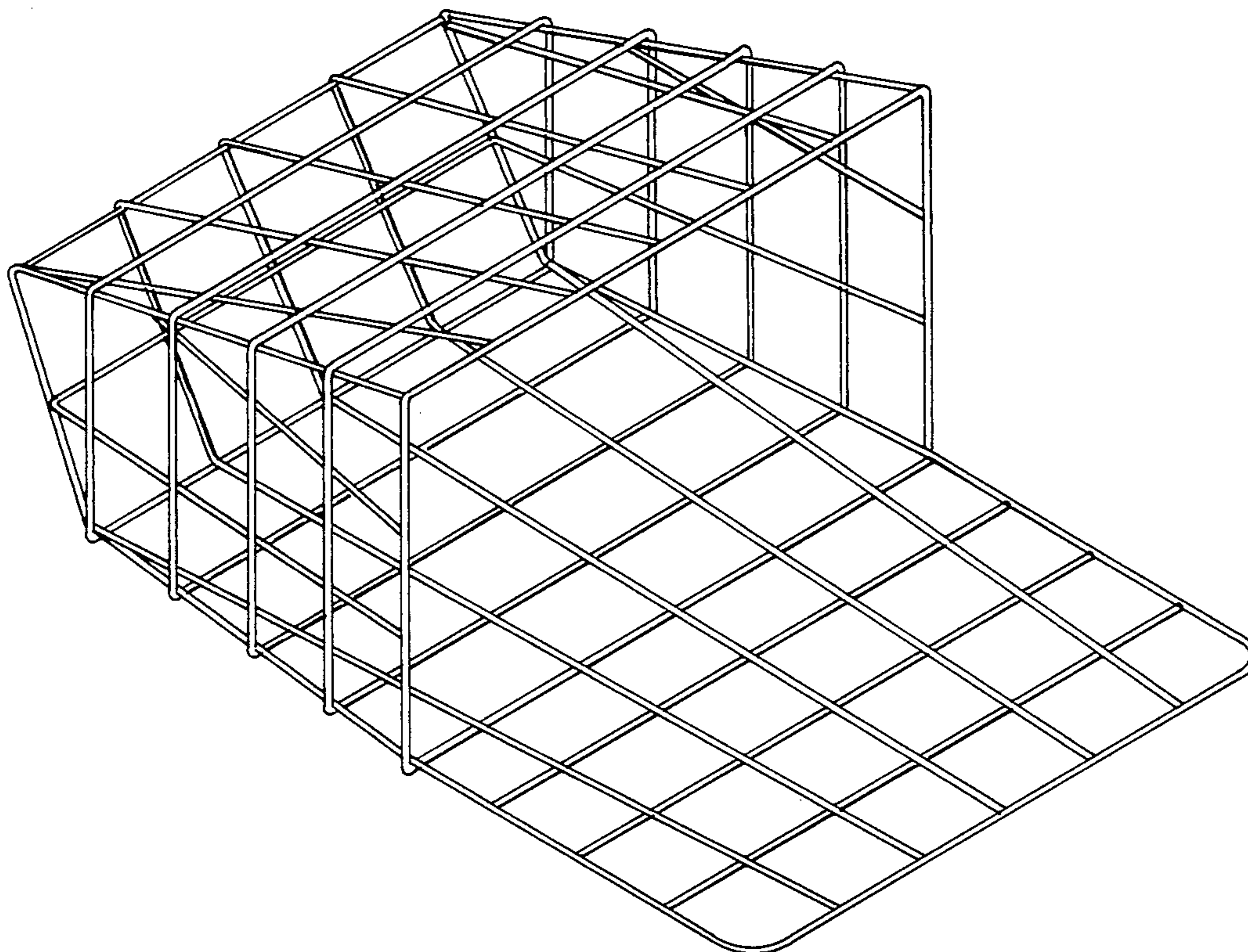
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



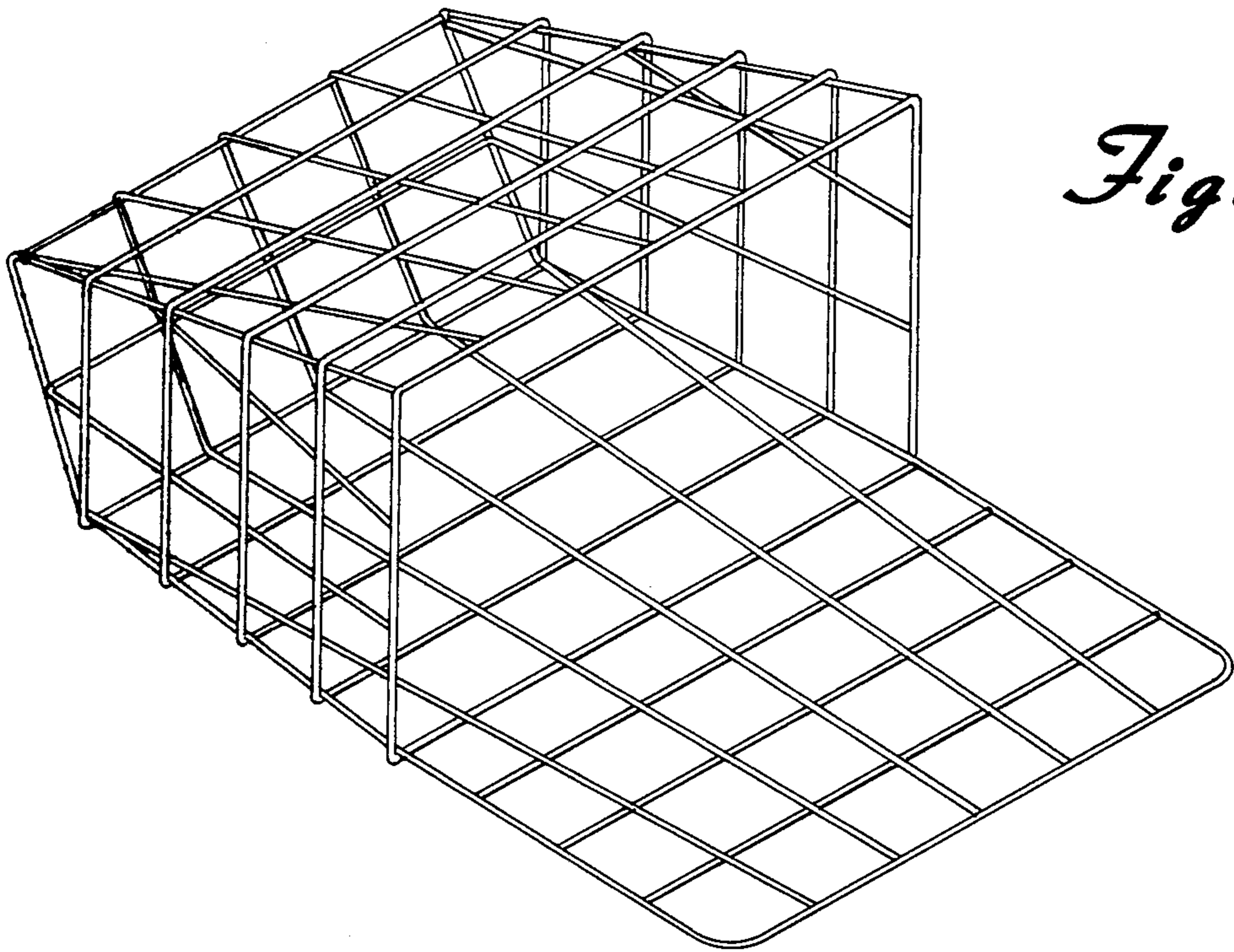

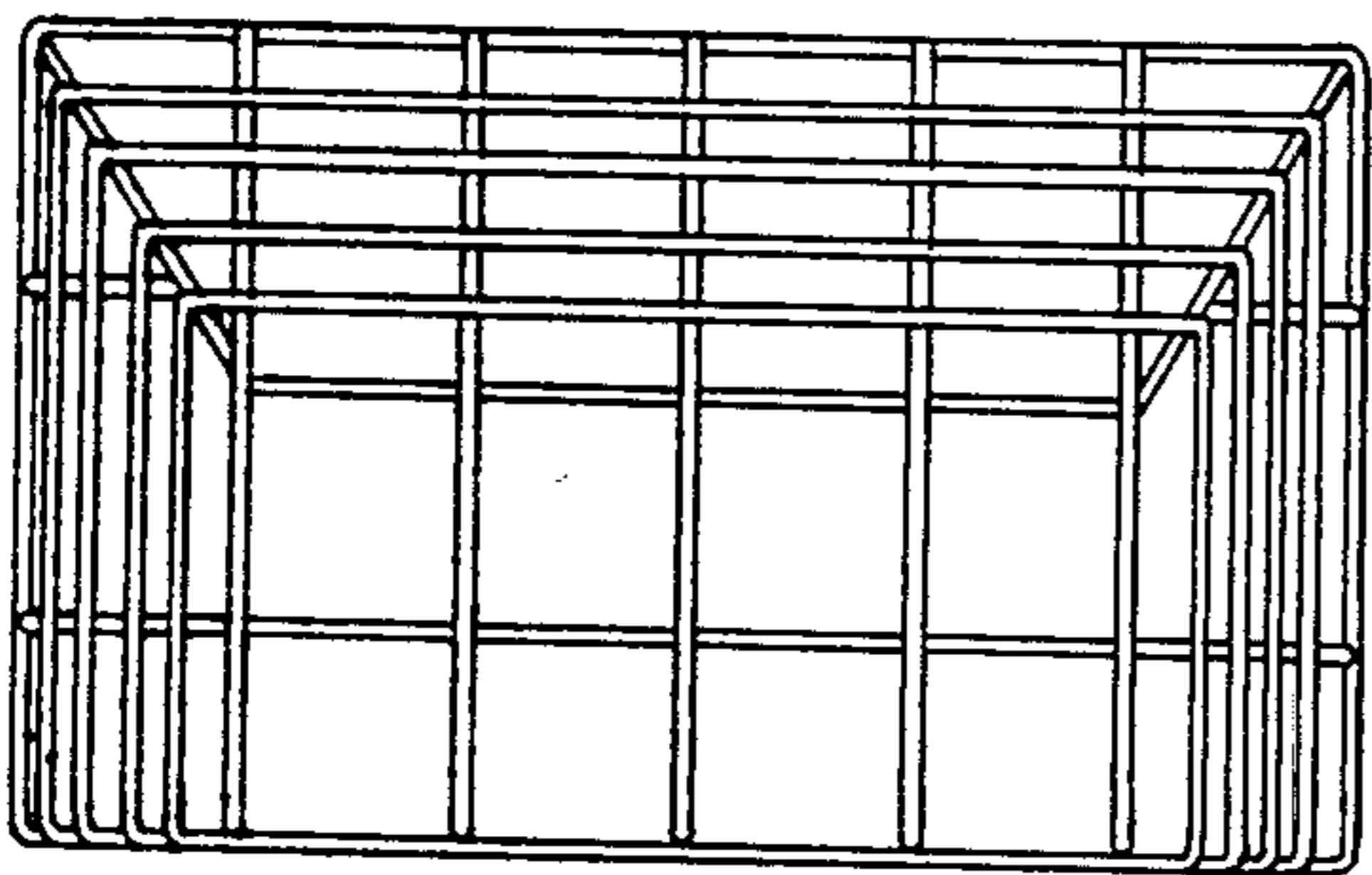

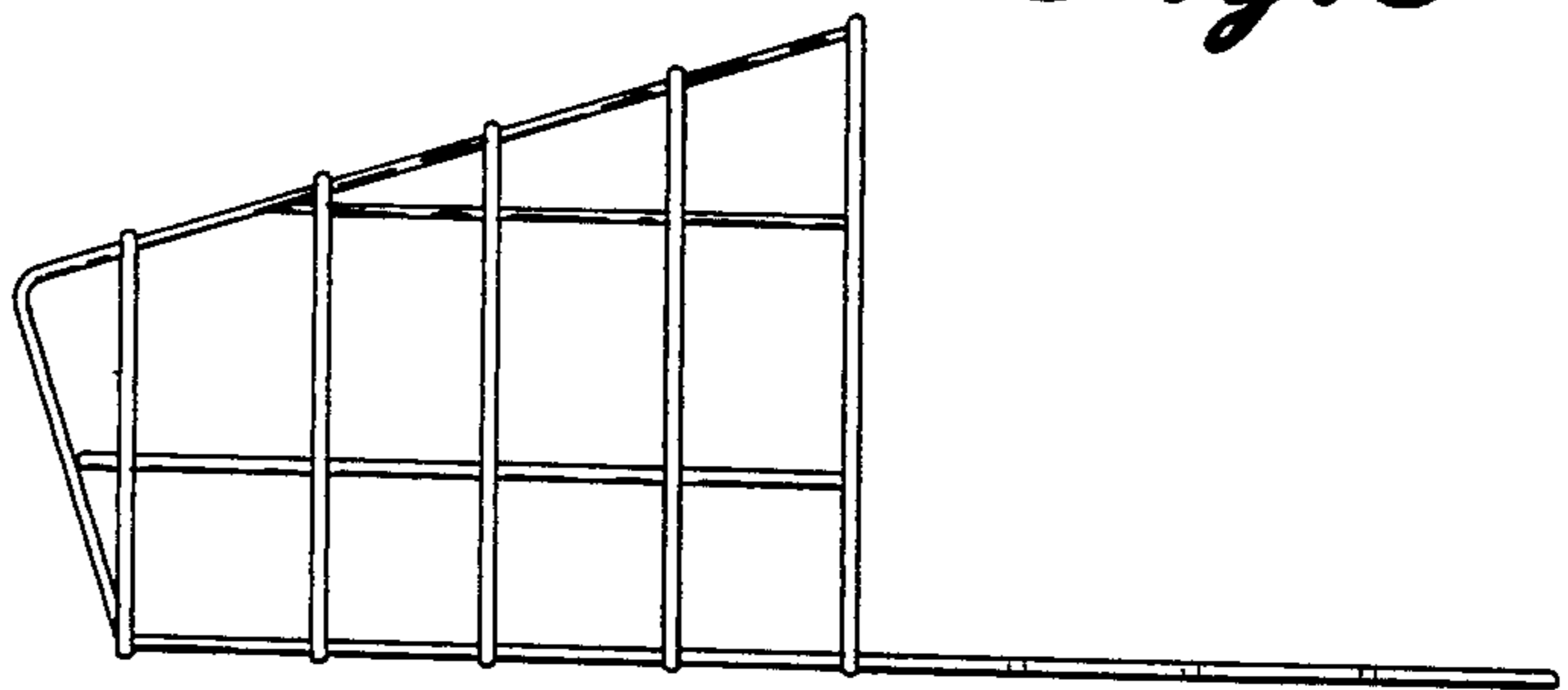
