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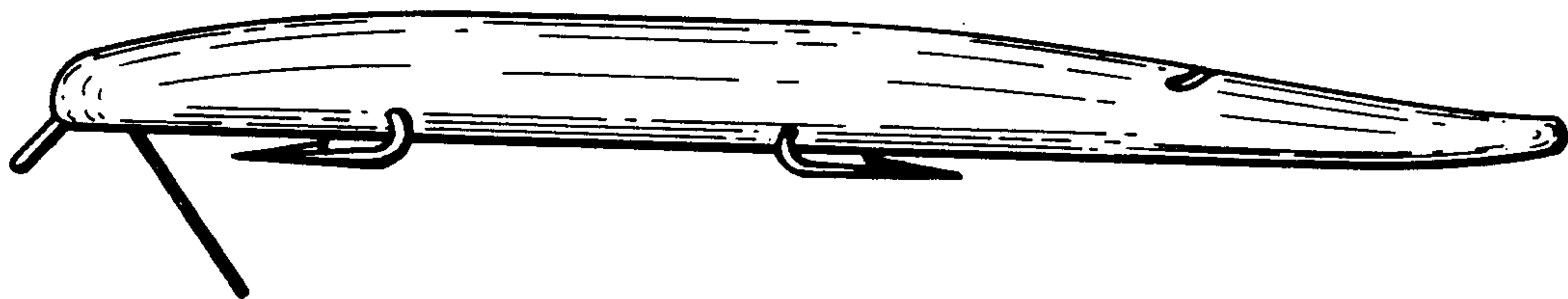
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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a fish lure, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of the fishing lure embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a side elevation view of the fishing lure embodying my new design, but rotated 180° from FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a front elevation view looking from the left hand end of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 6 is an end elevation view looking from the right hand end of FIG. 1.



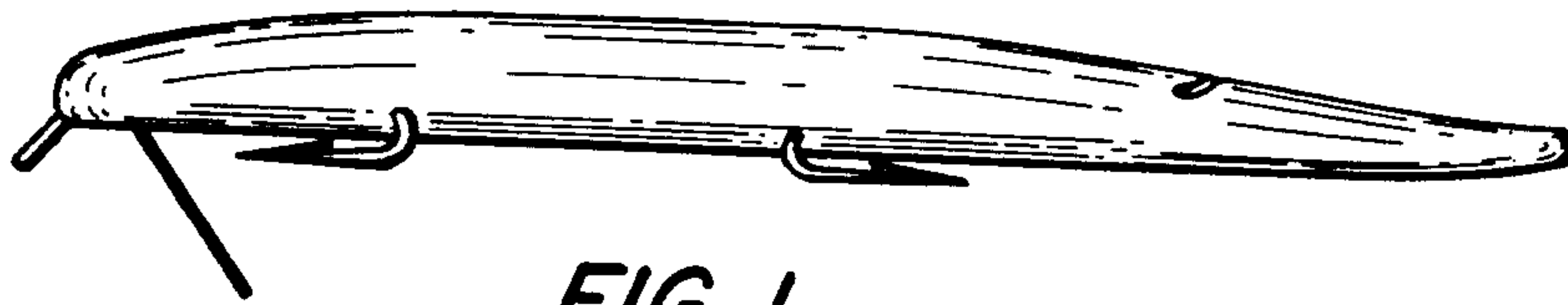

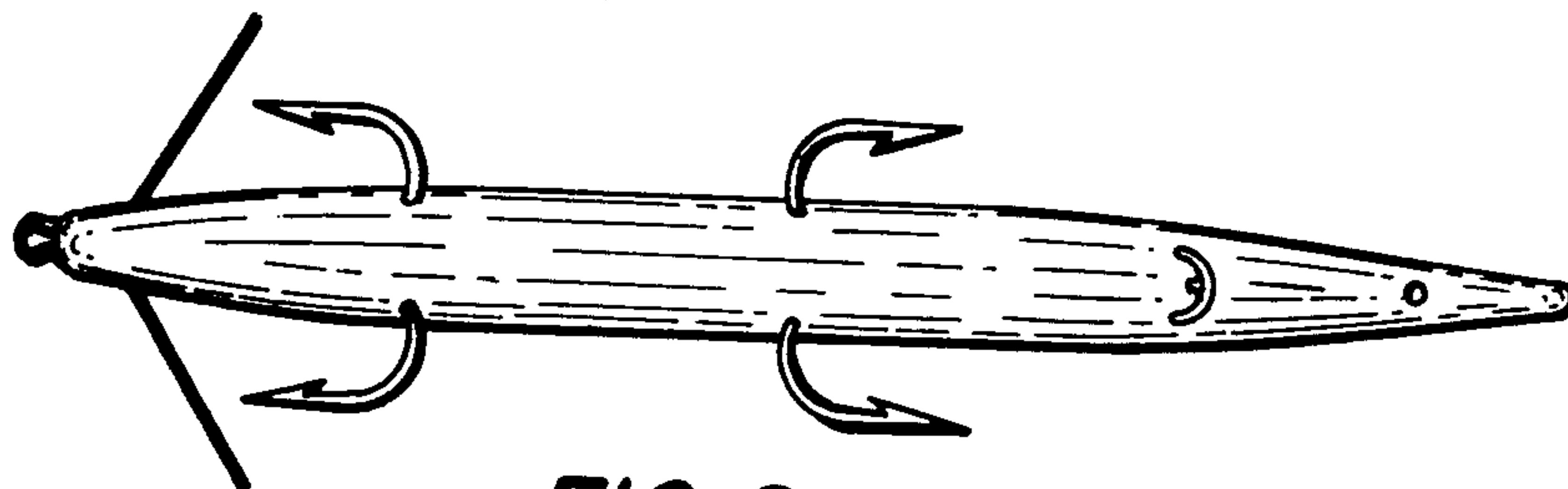

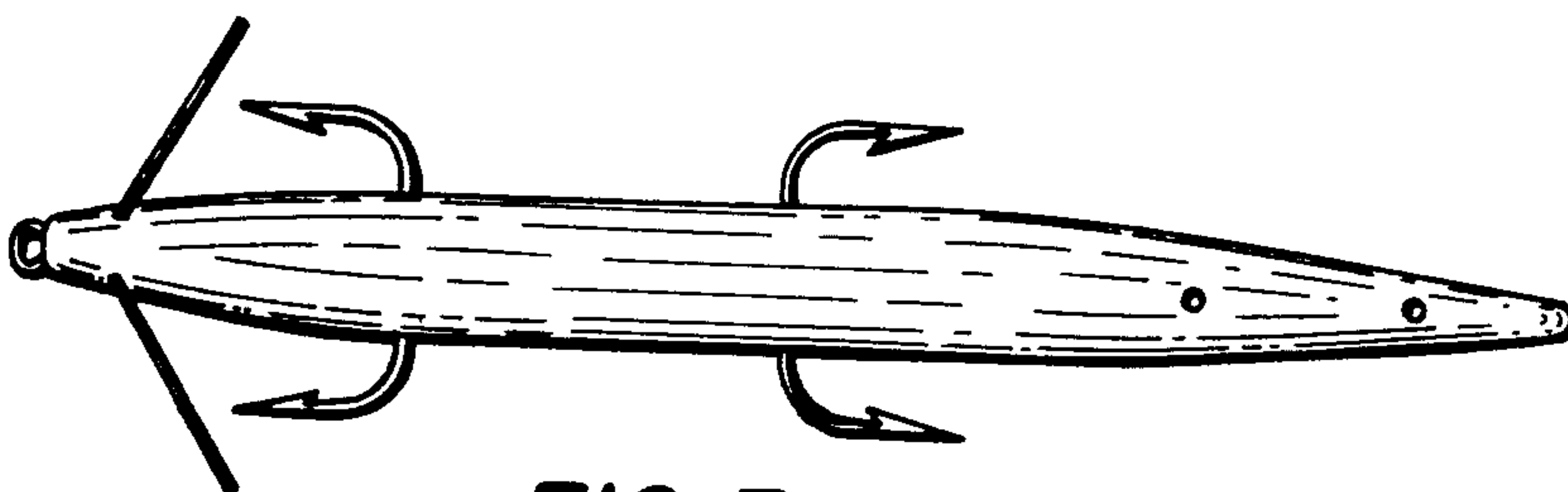

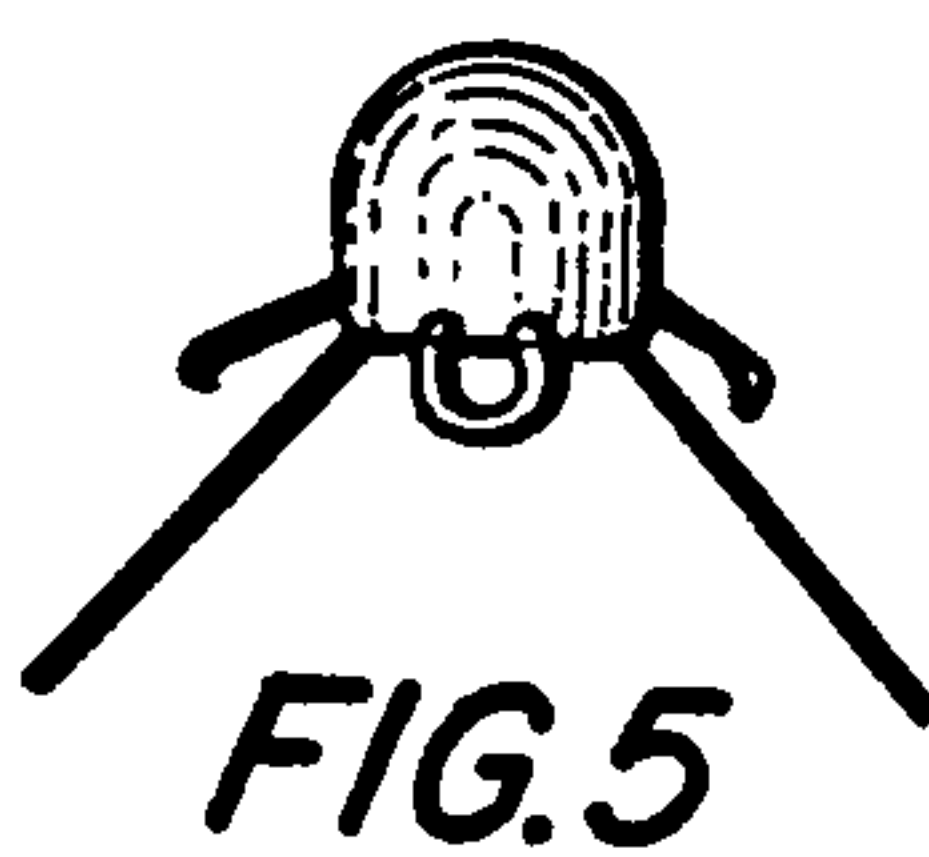

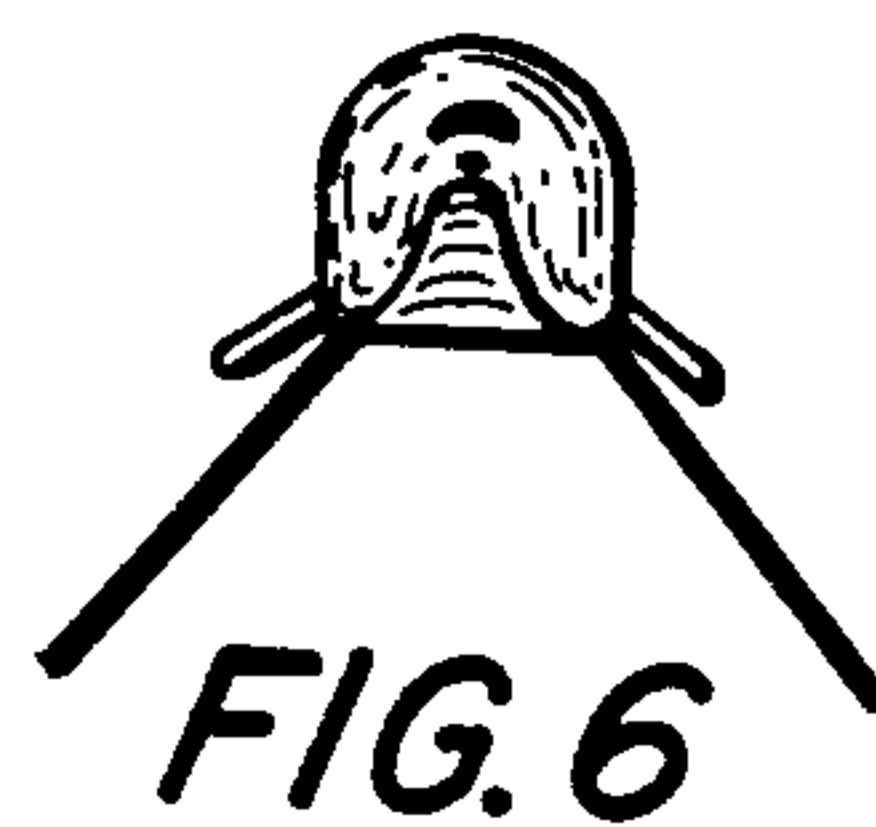
