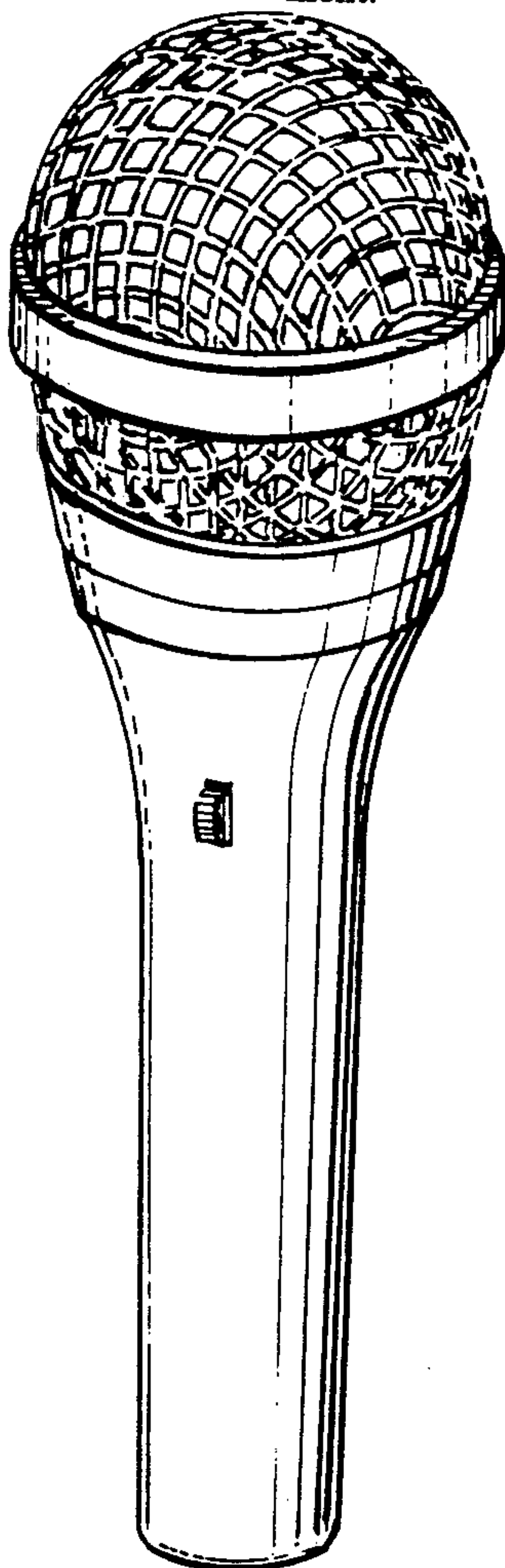

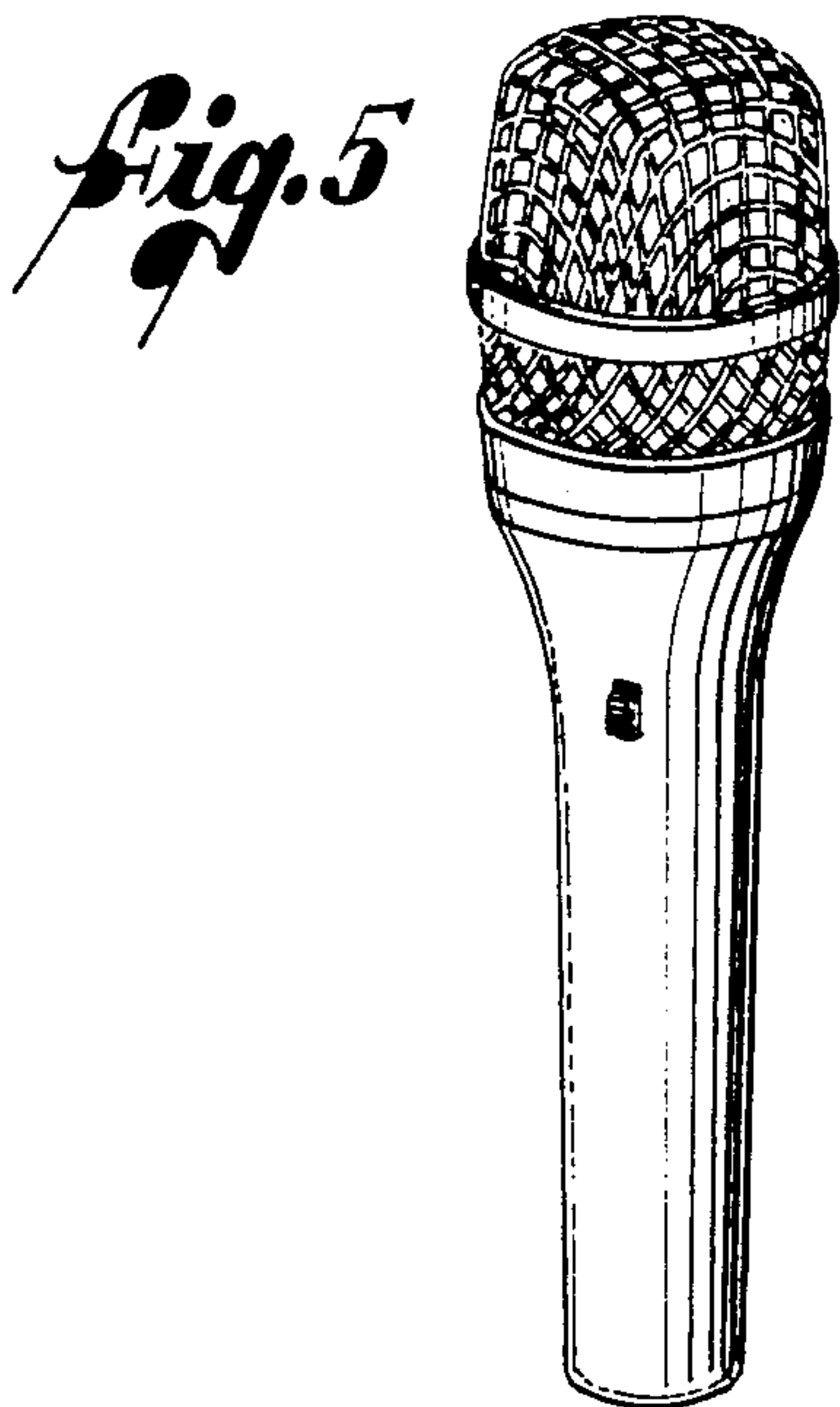
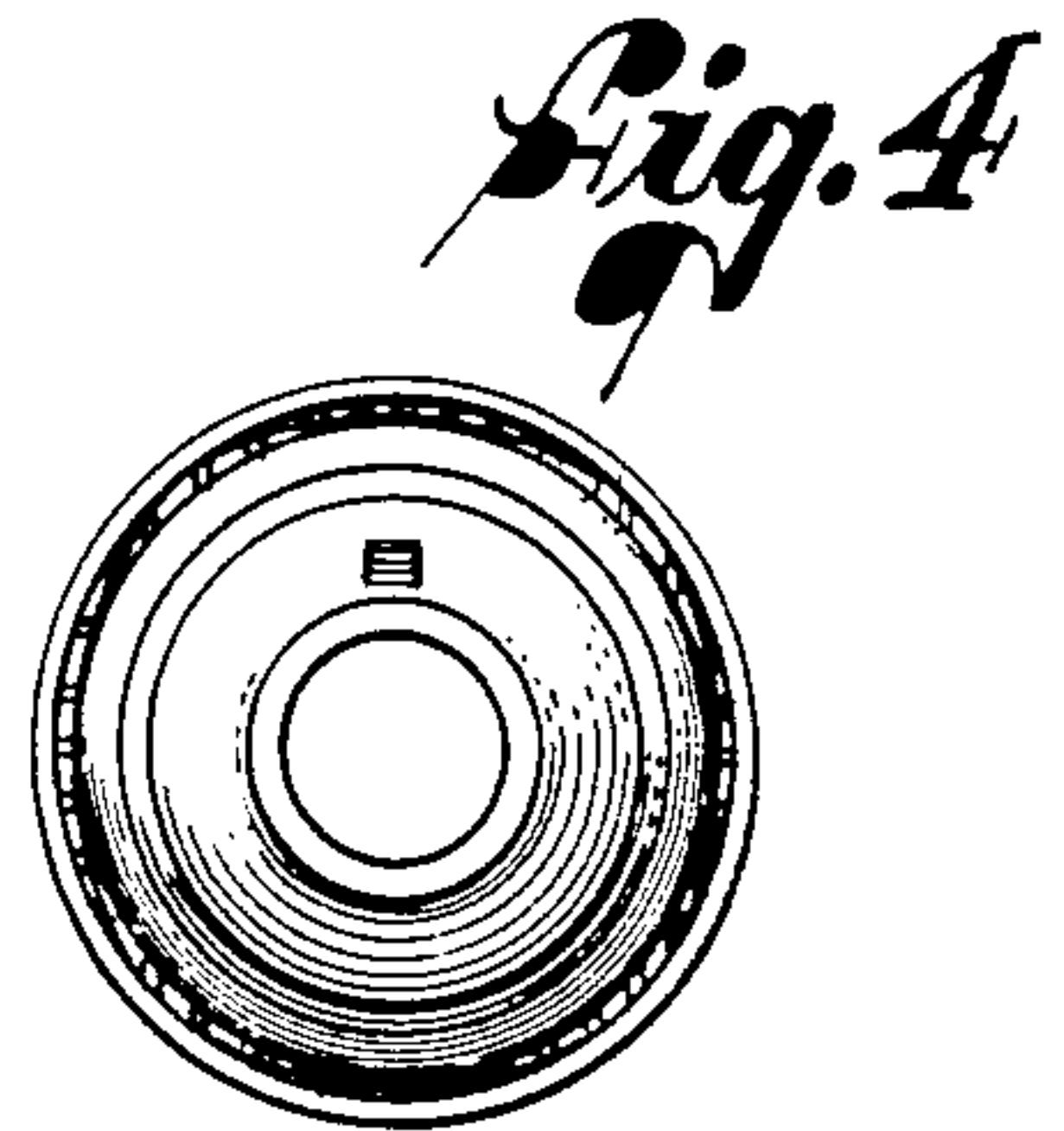
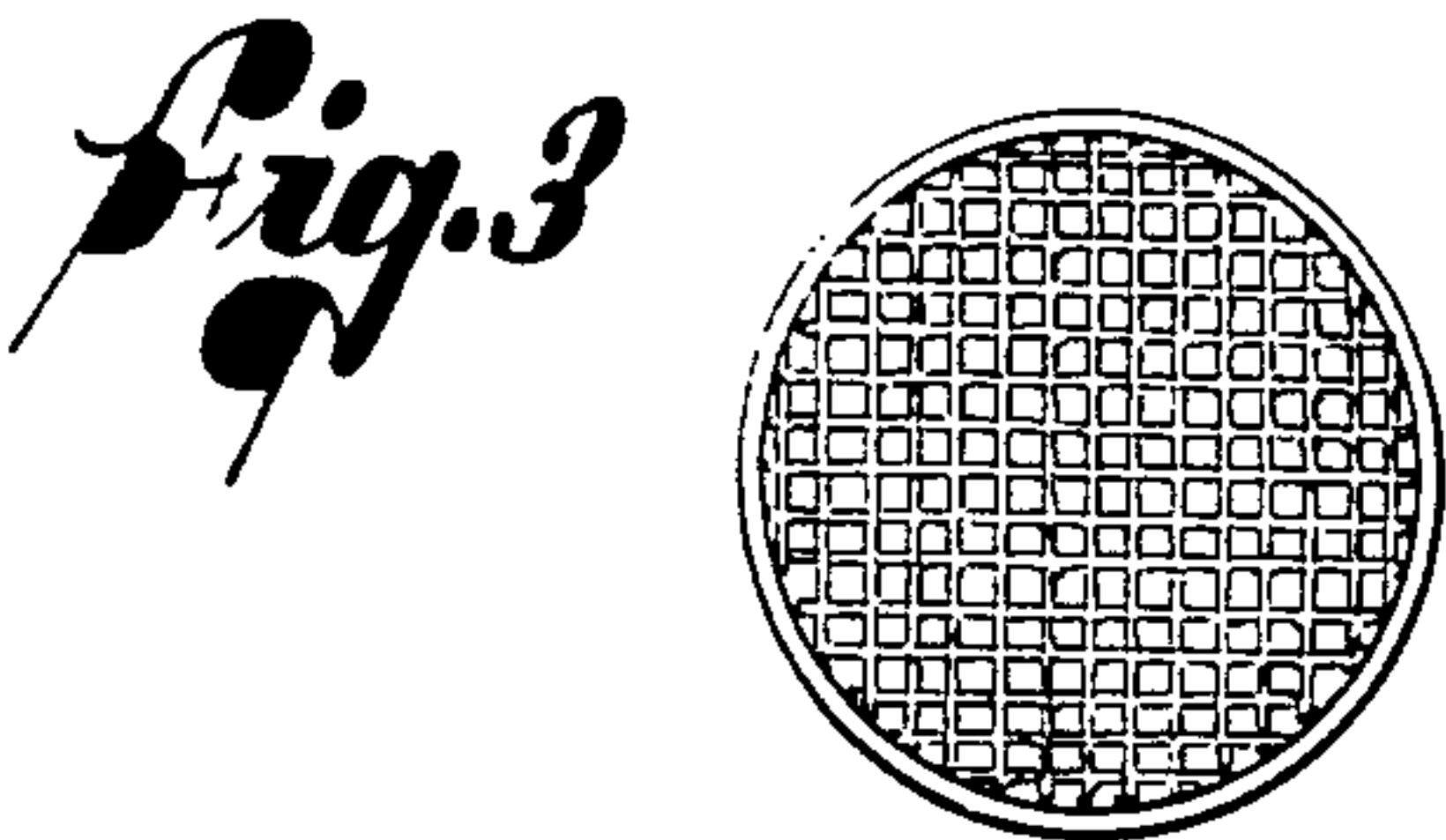
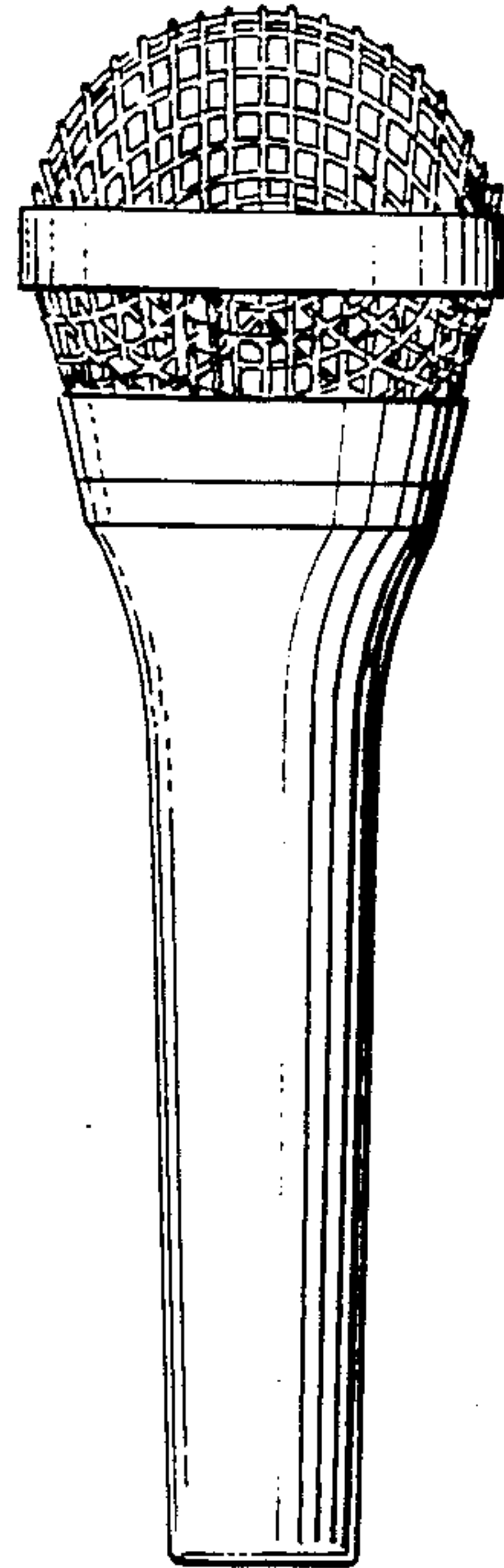
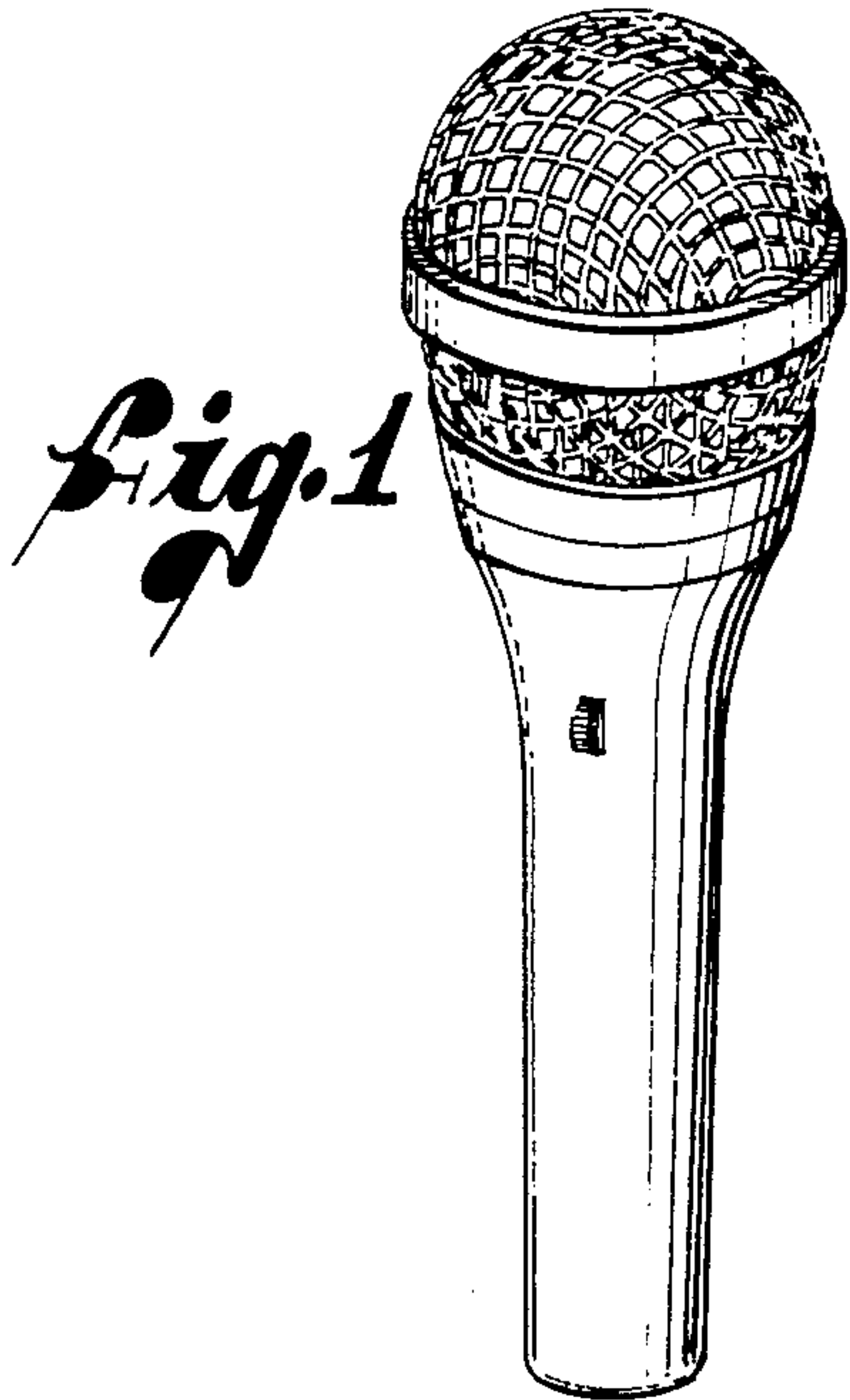
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a microphone showing my new design;

 FIG. 15 is a bottom plan view of the fourth embodiment.





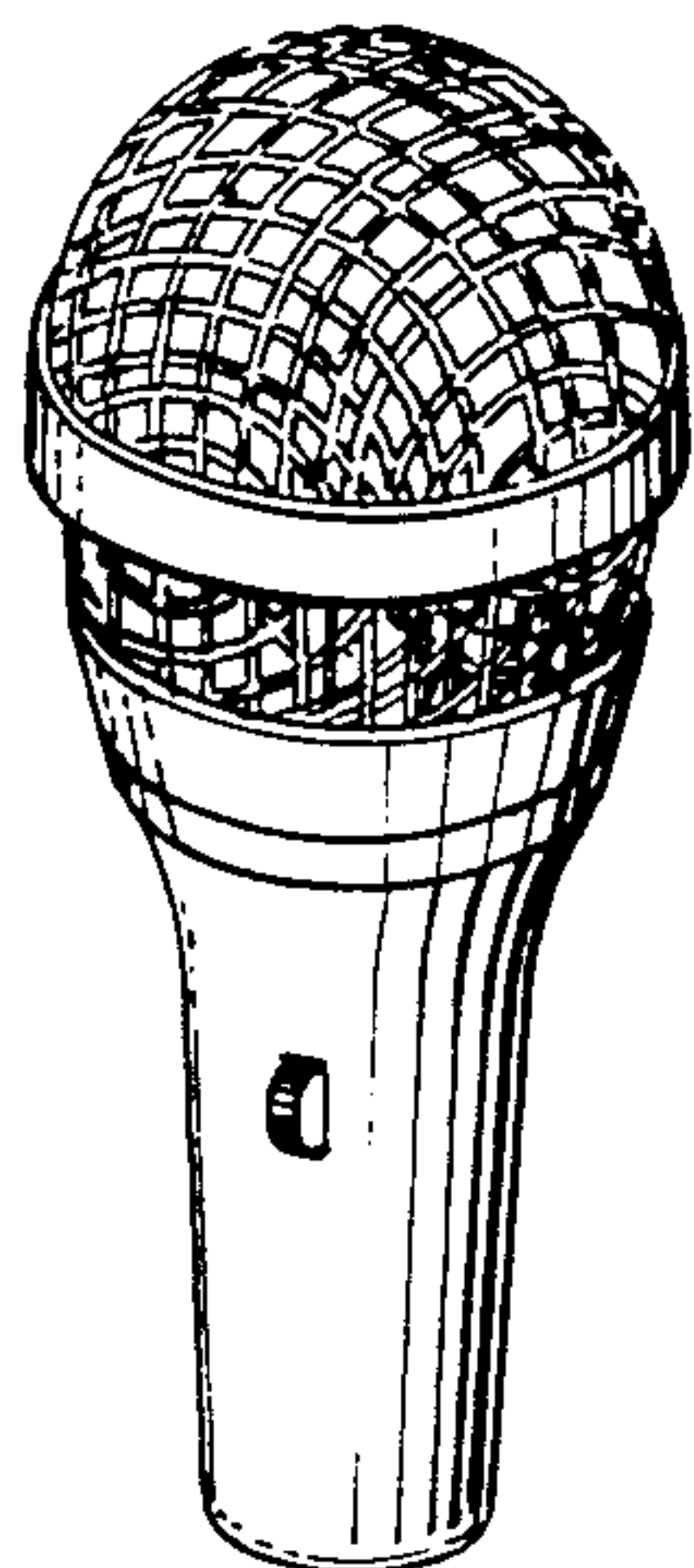

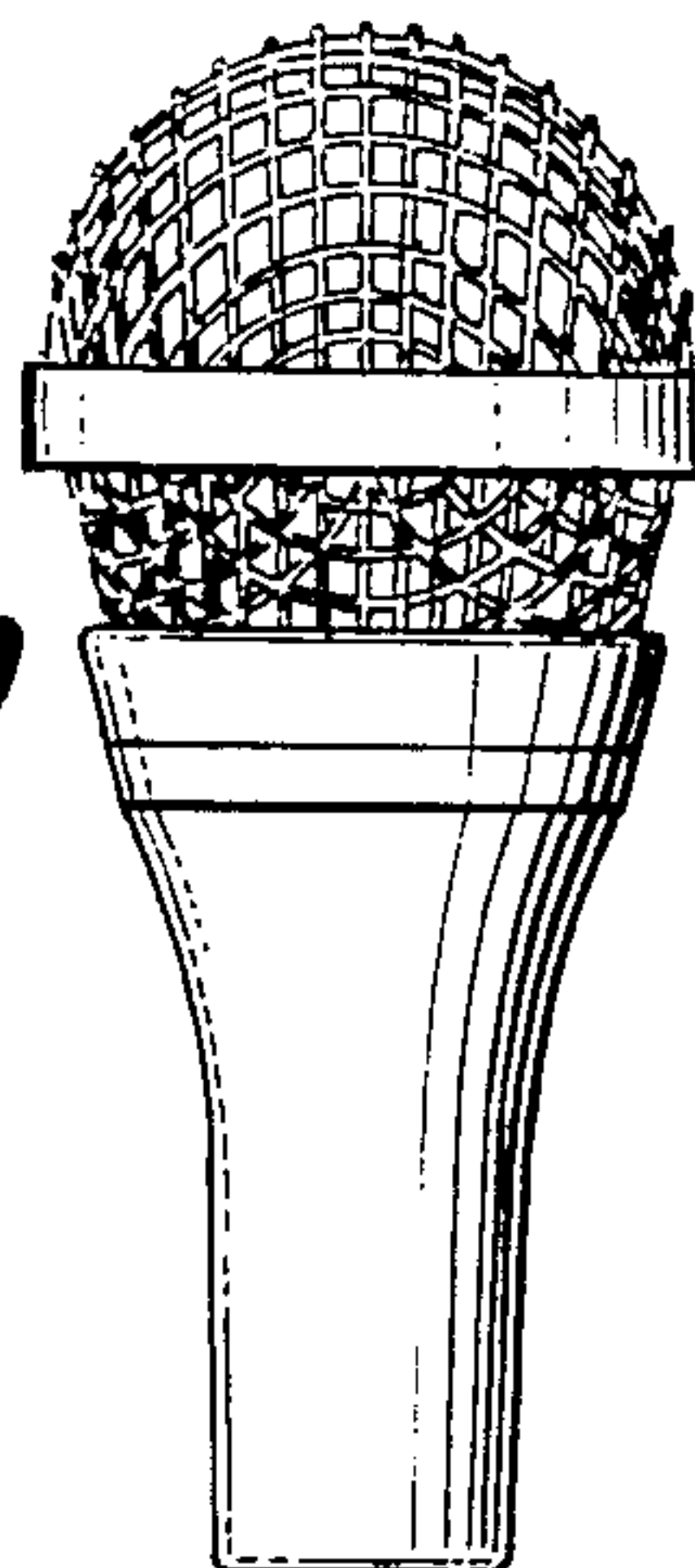

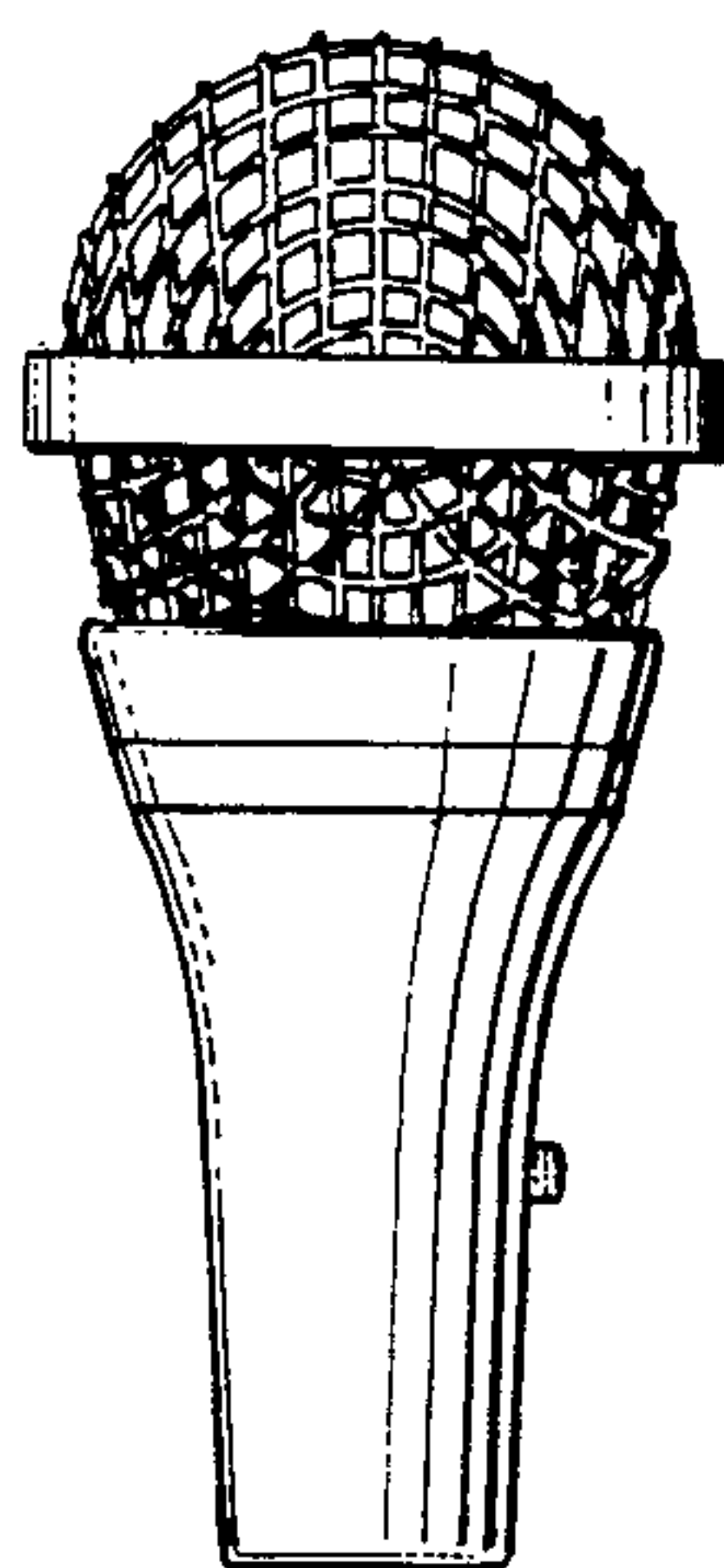

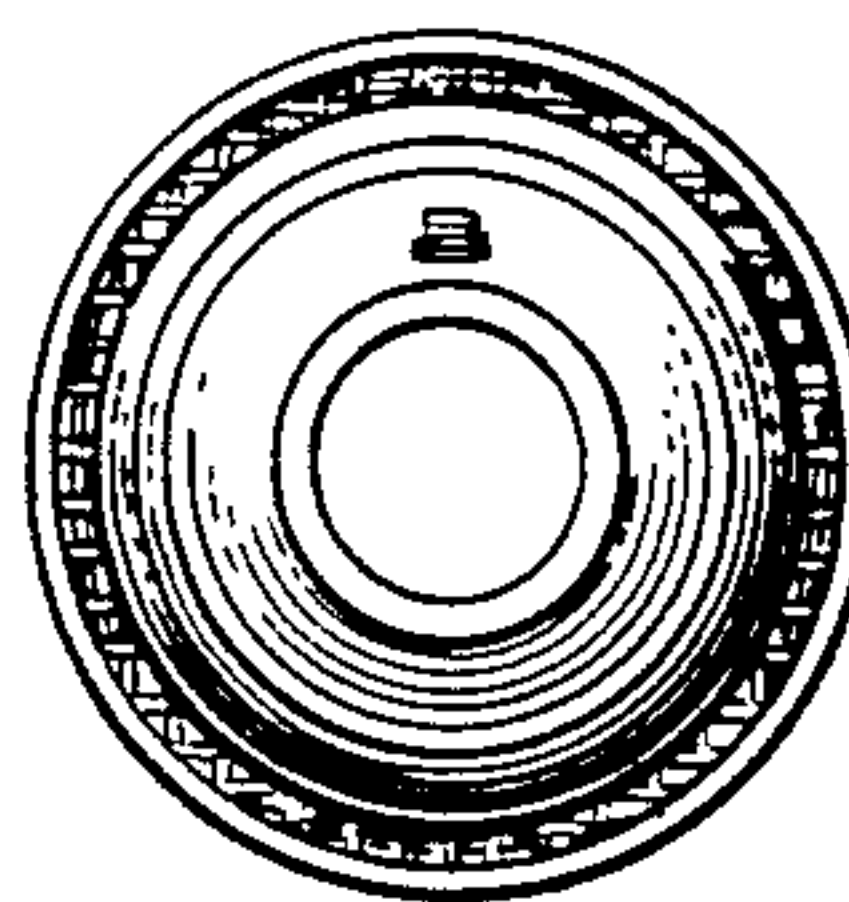

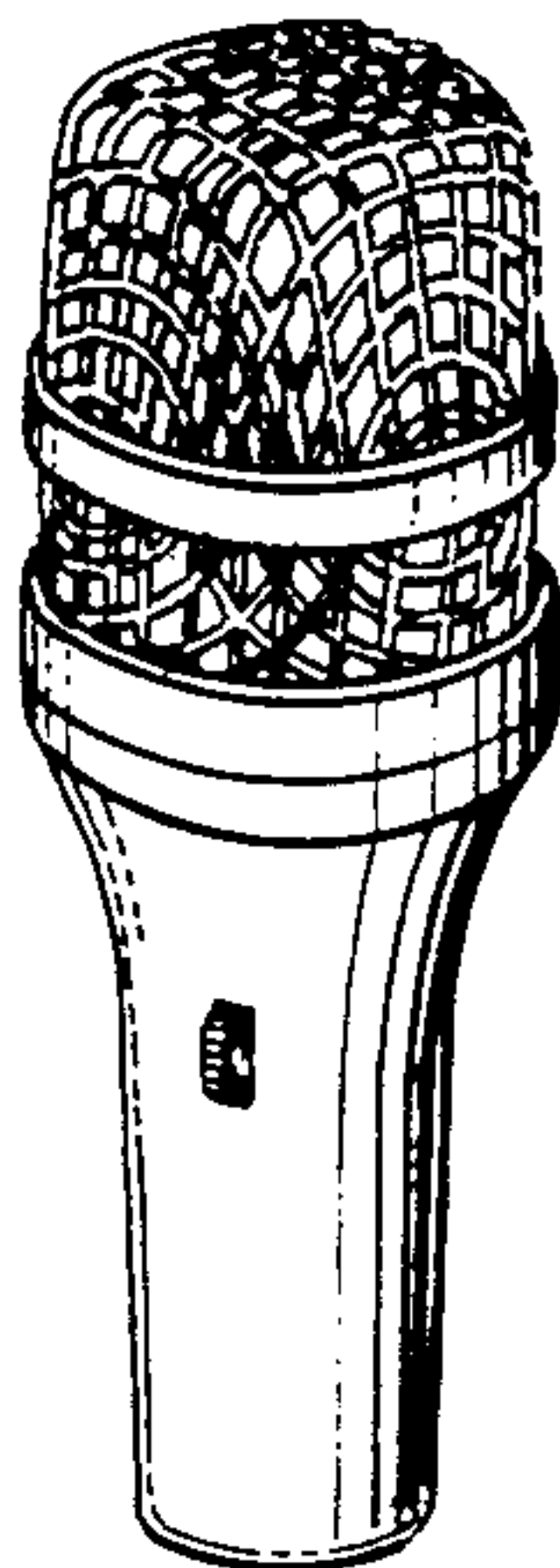

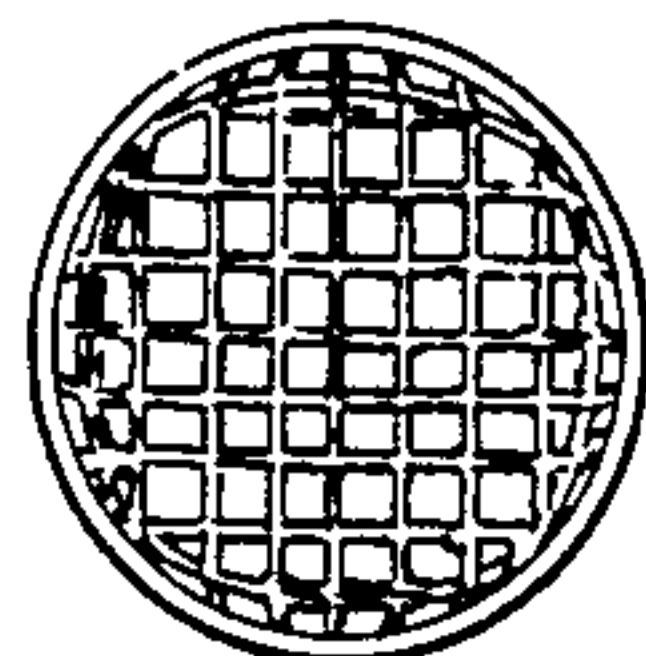
