The ornamental design for a tire, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a perspective view of a tire showing our new design, it being understood that the tread design is repeated throughout the circumference of the tire as shown schematically by solid lines, the opposite side being substantially the same as that shown.
