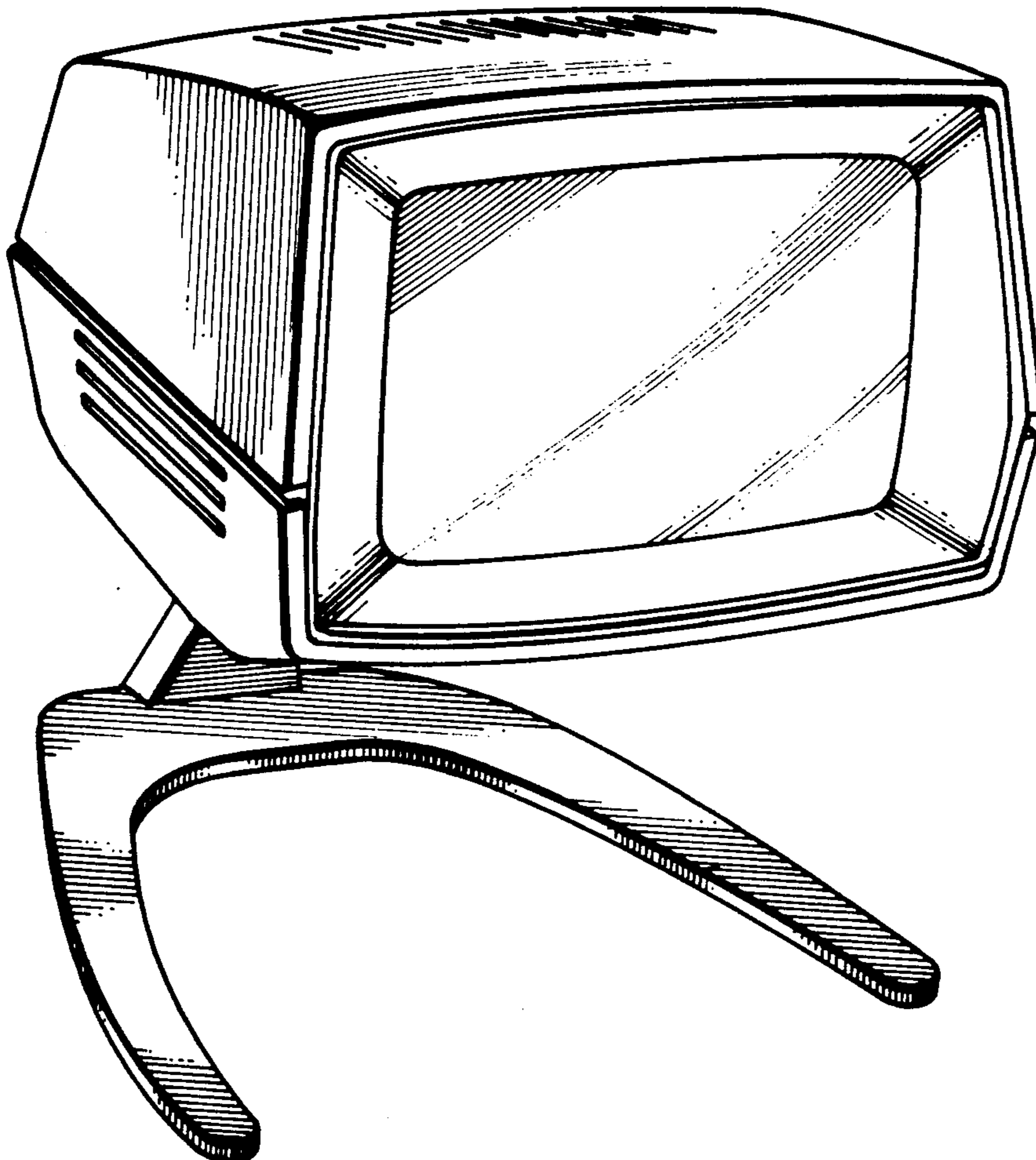

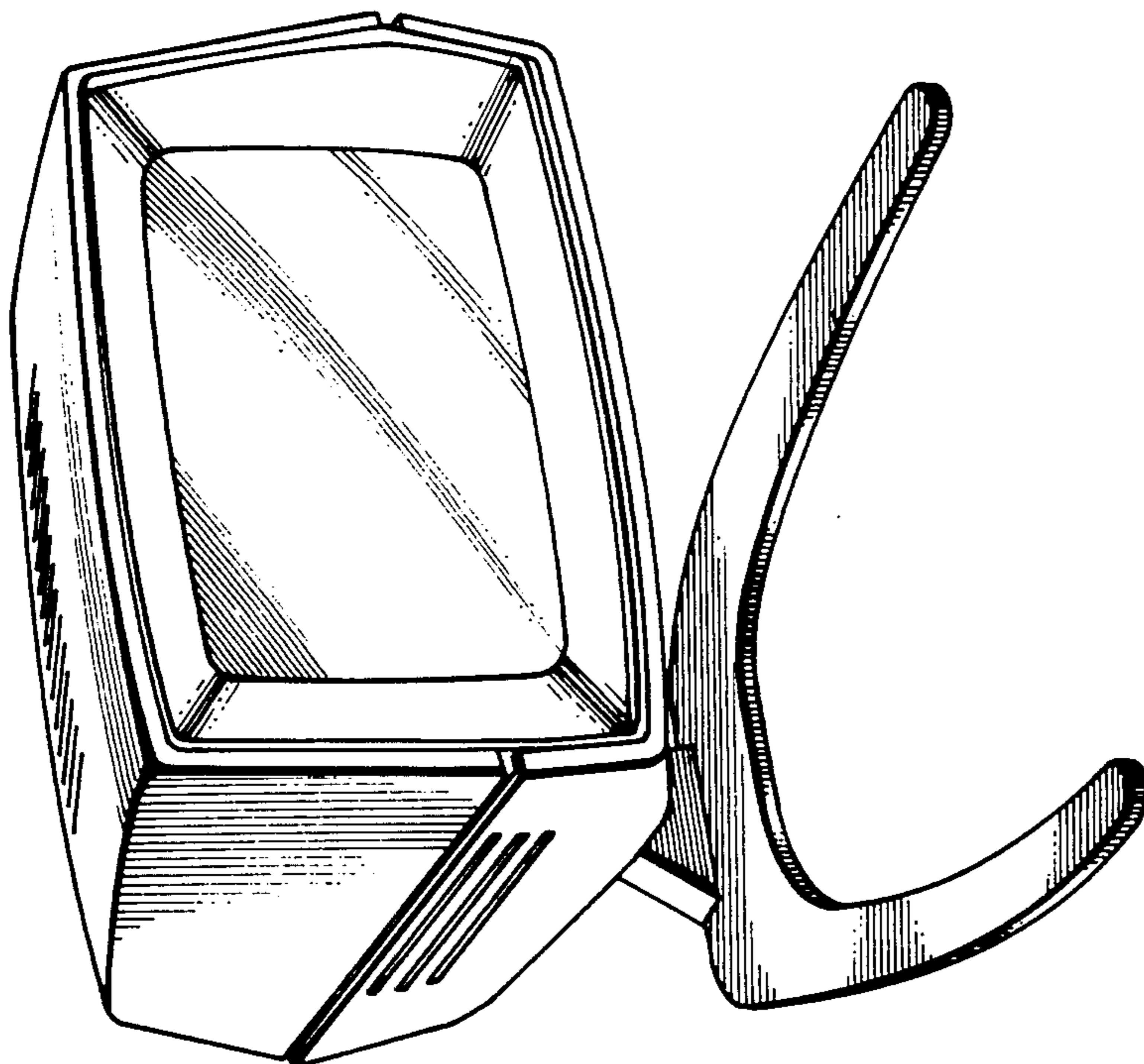
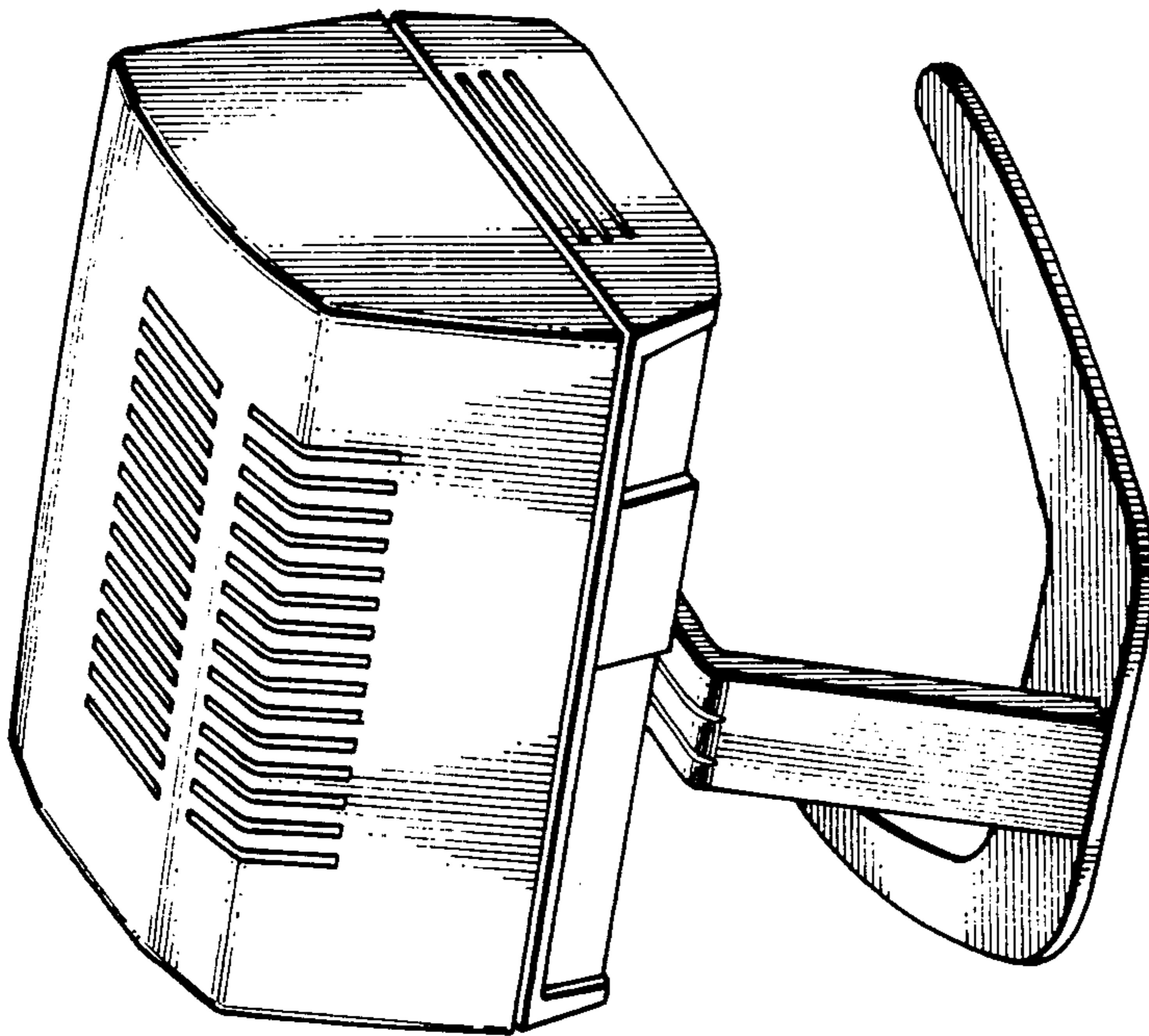
CLAIM

FIG. 3 is a side, elevational view thereof.





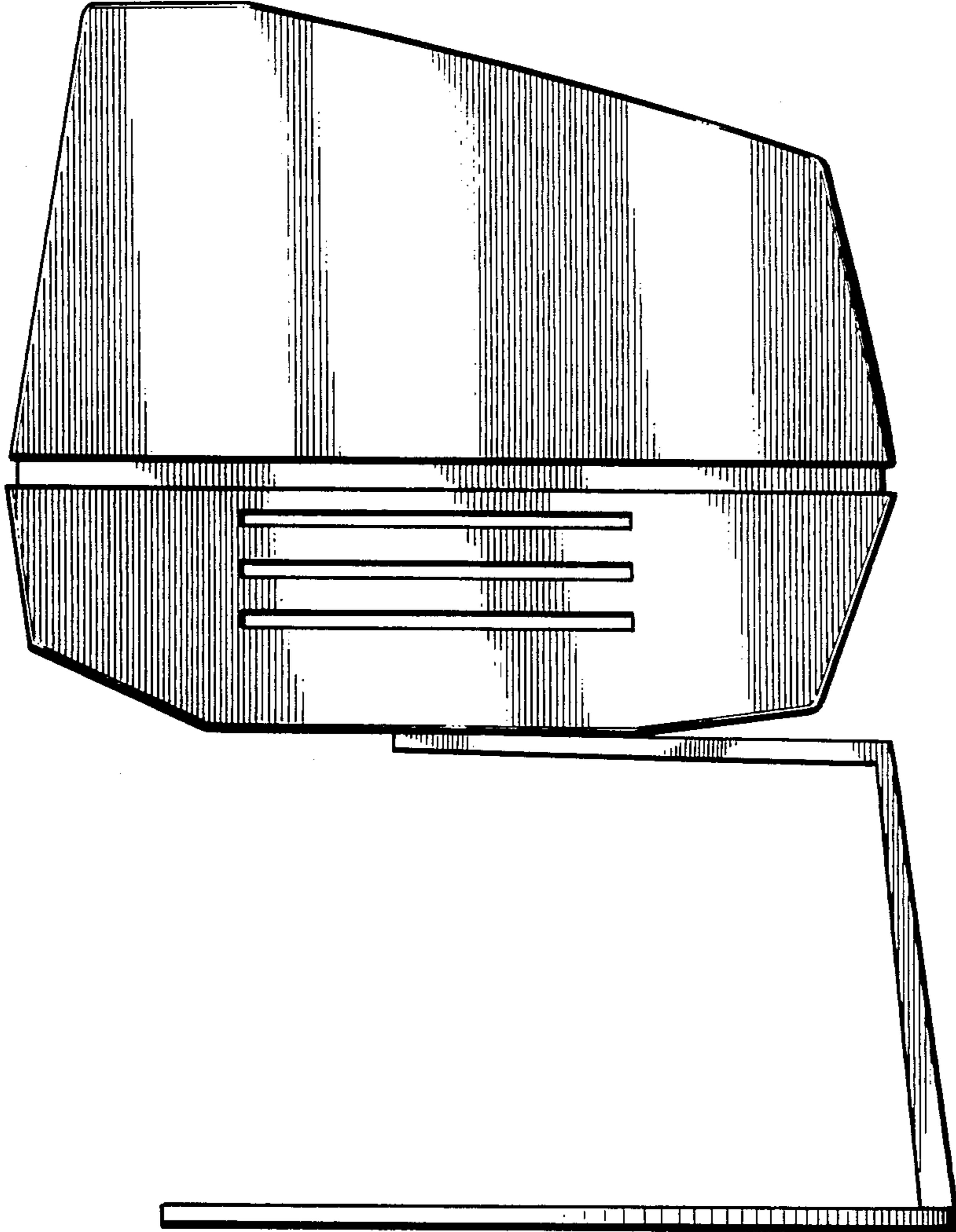
