the direction of the arrow IV in FIG. 1.

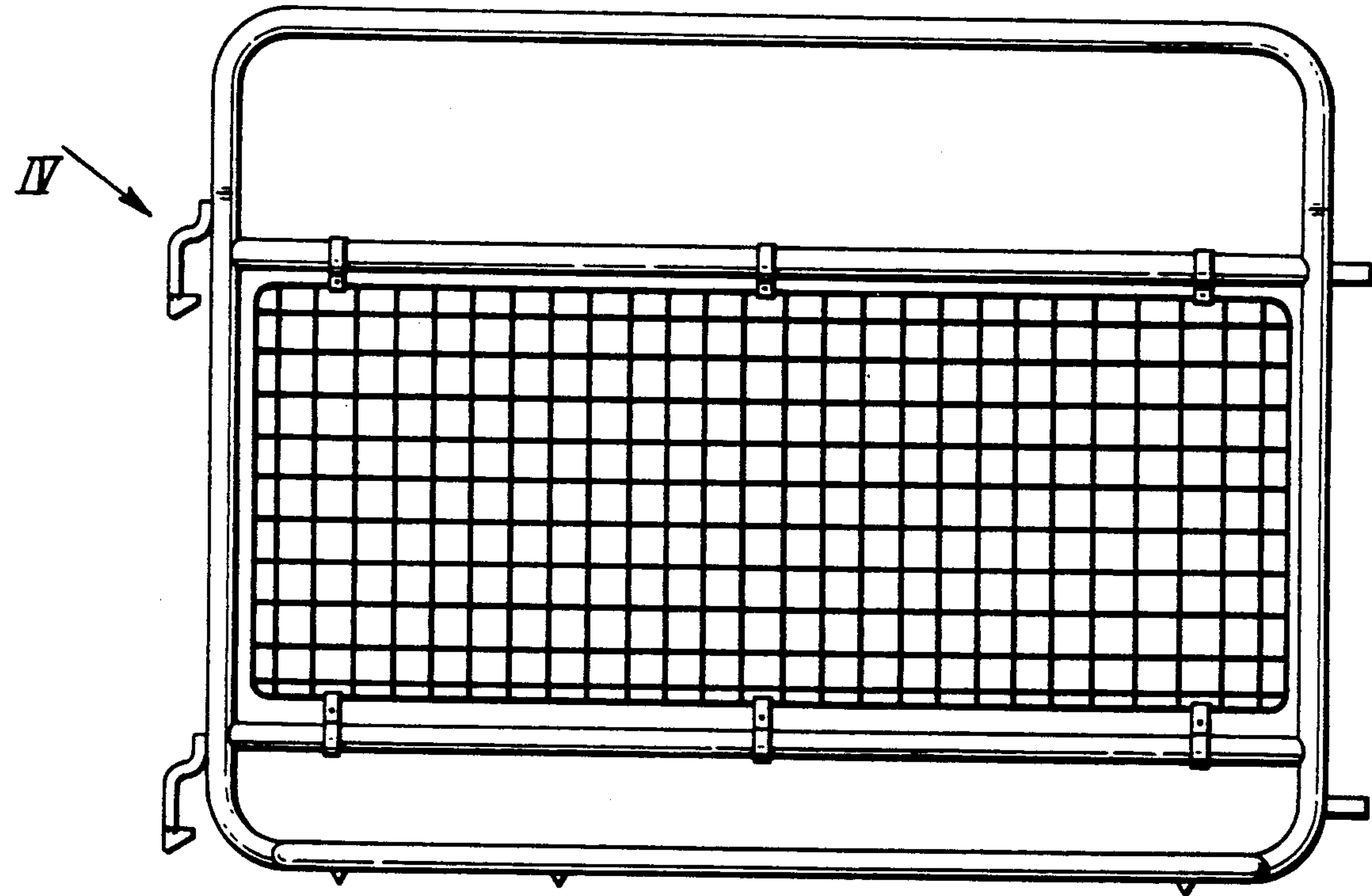

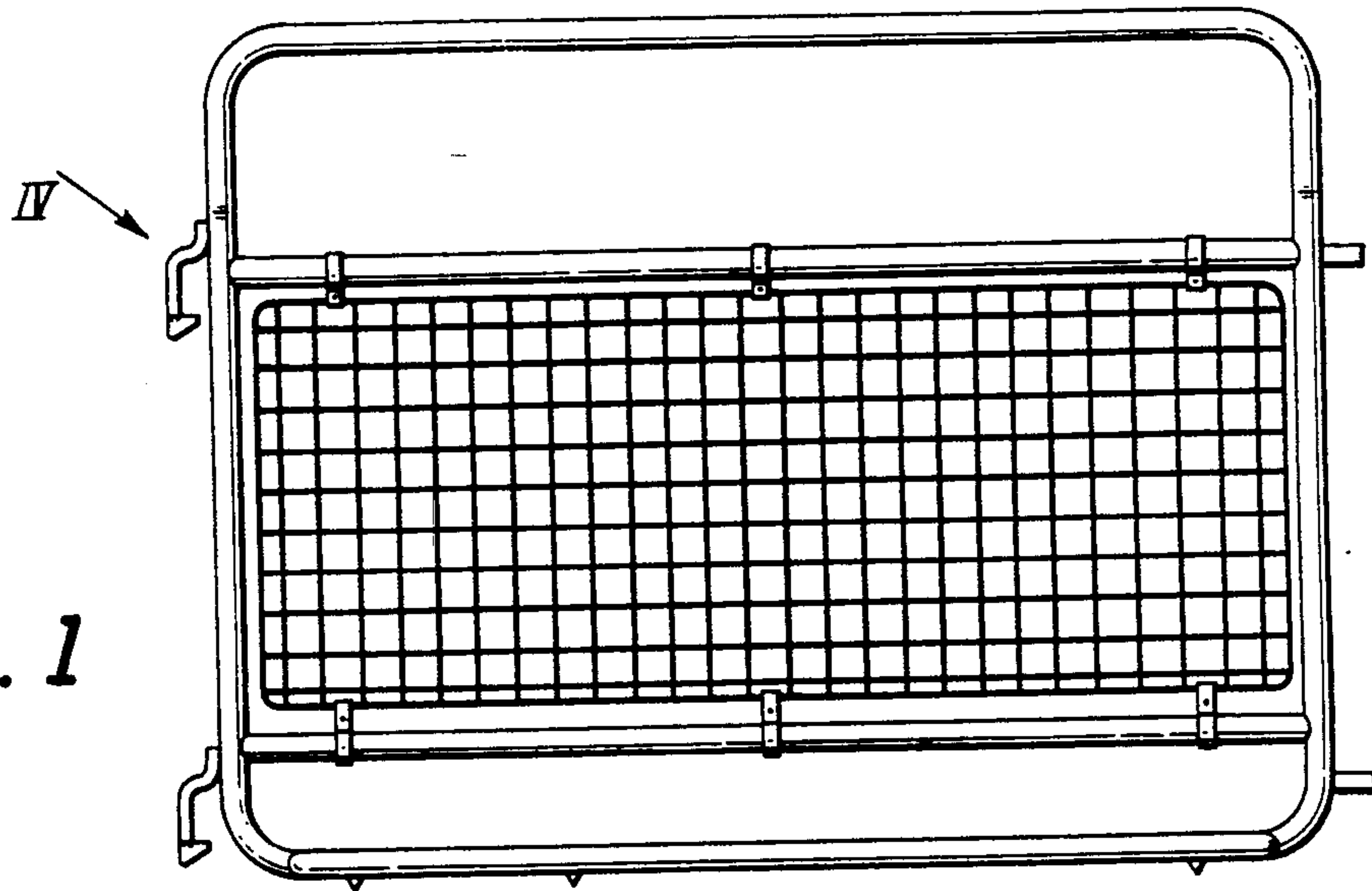

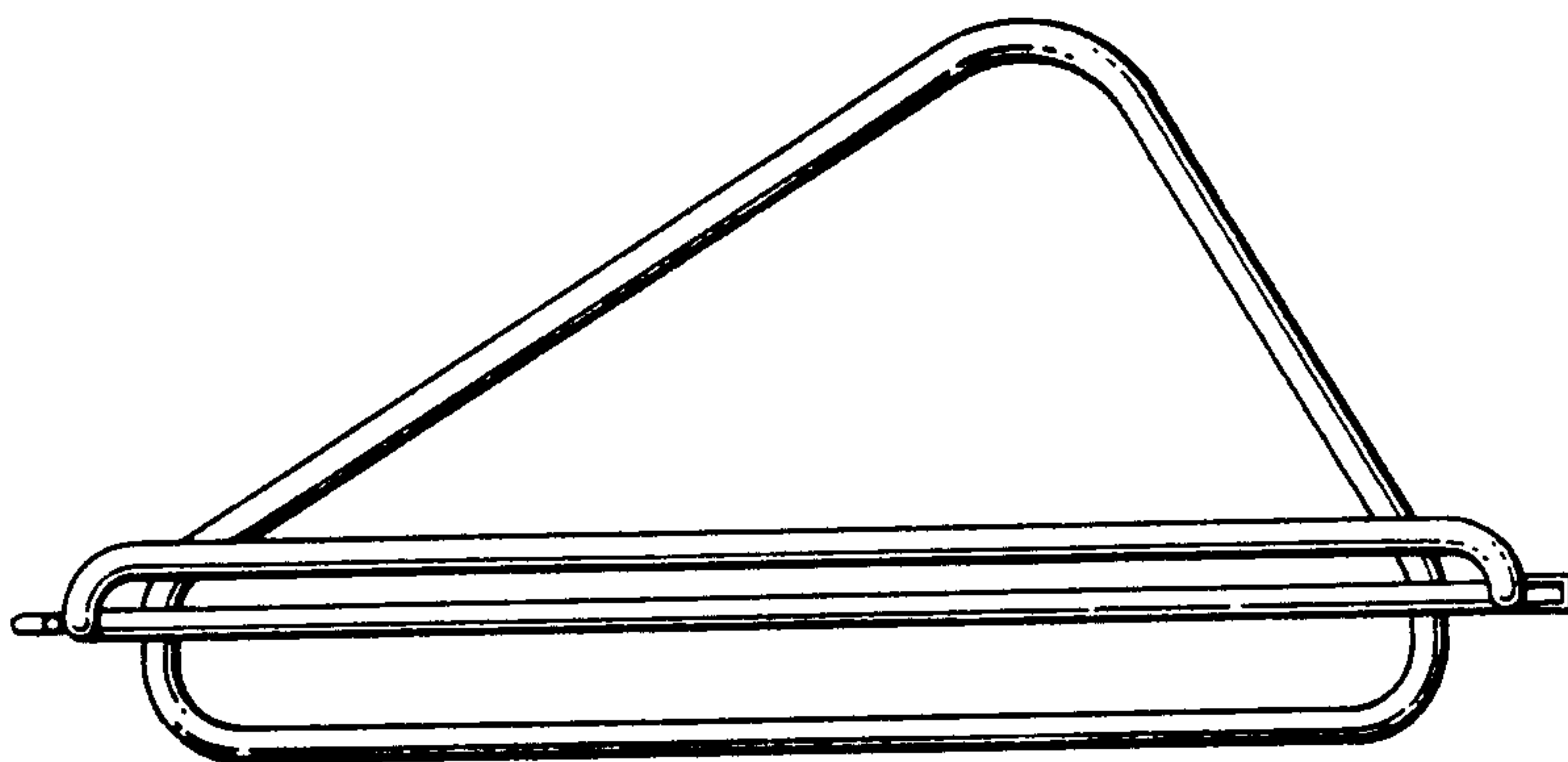

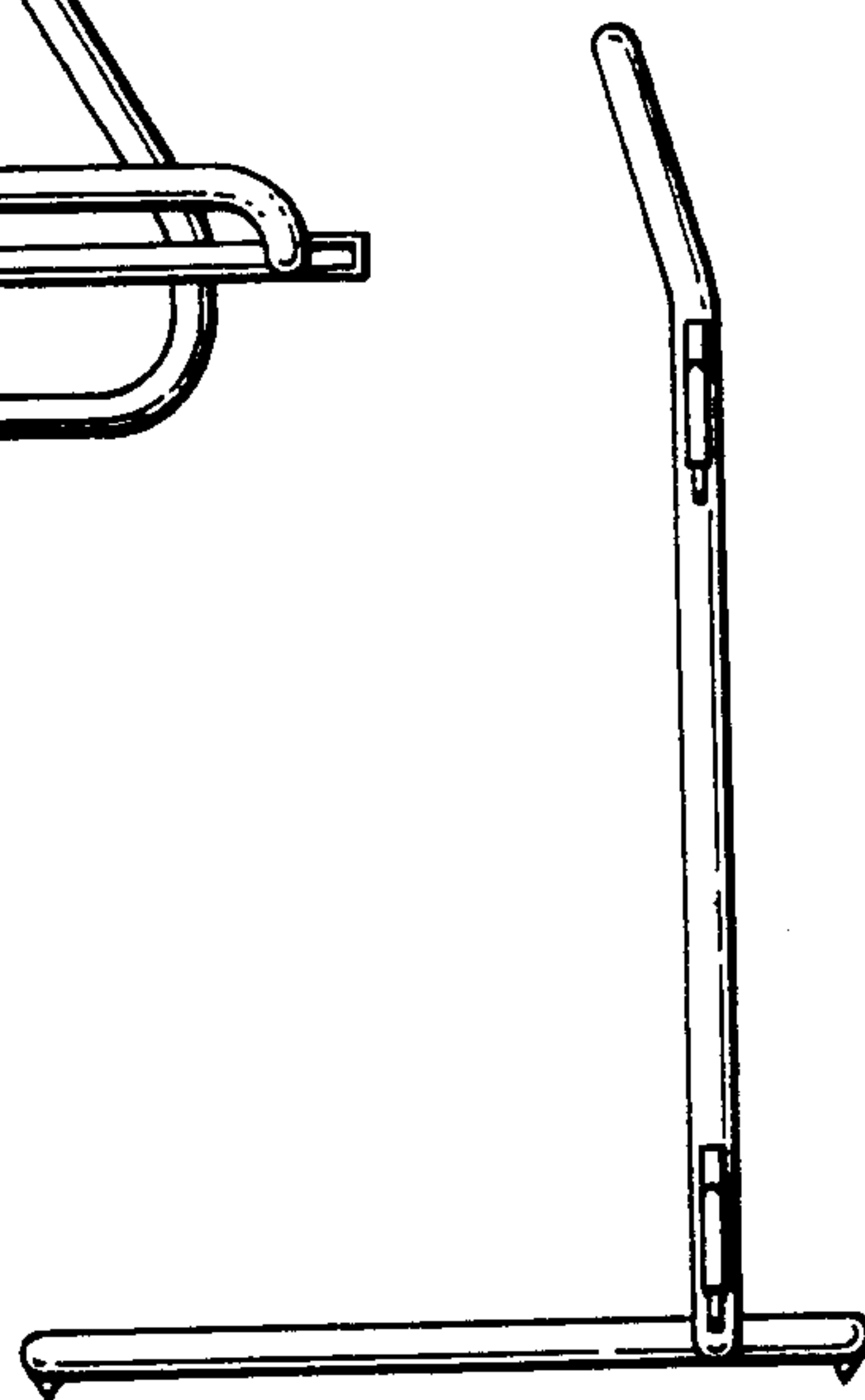
