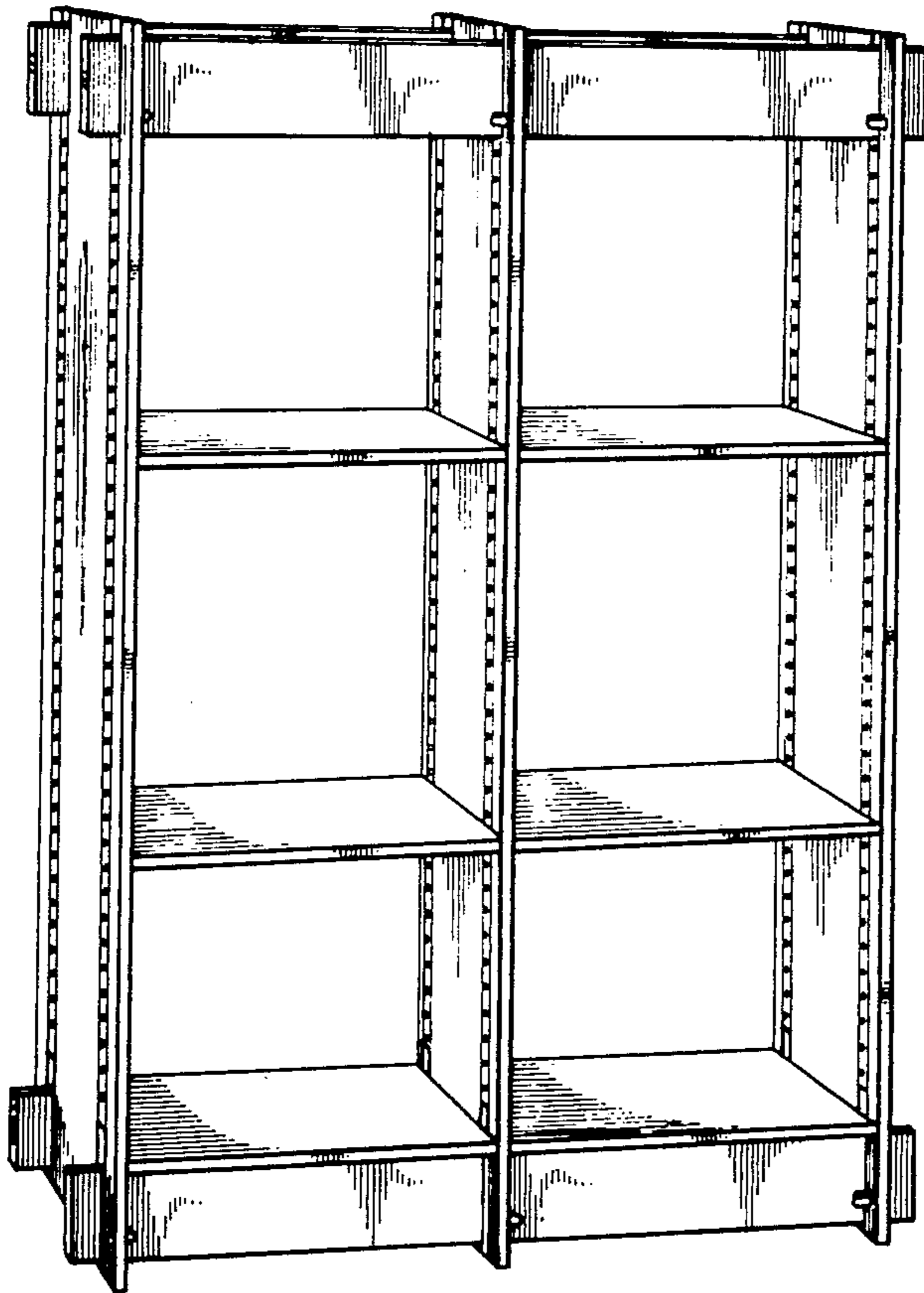

 FIG. 10 is an underside plan of FIG. 6.



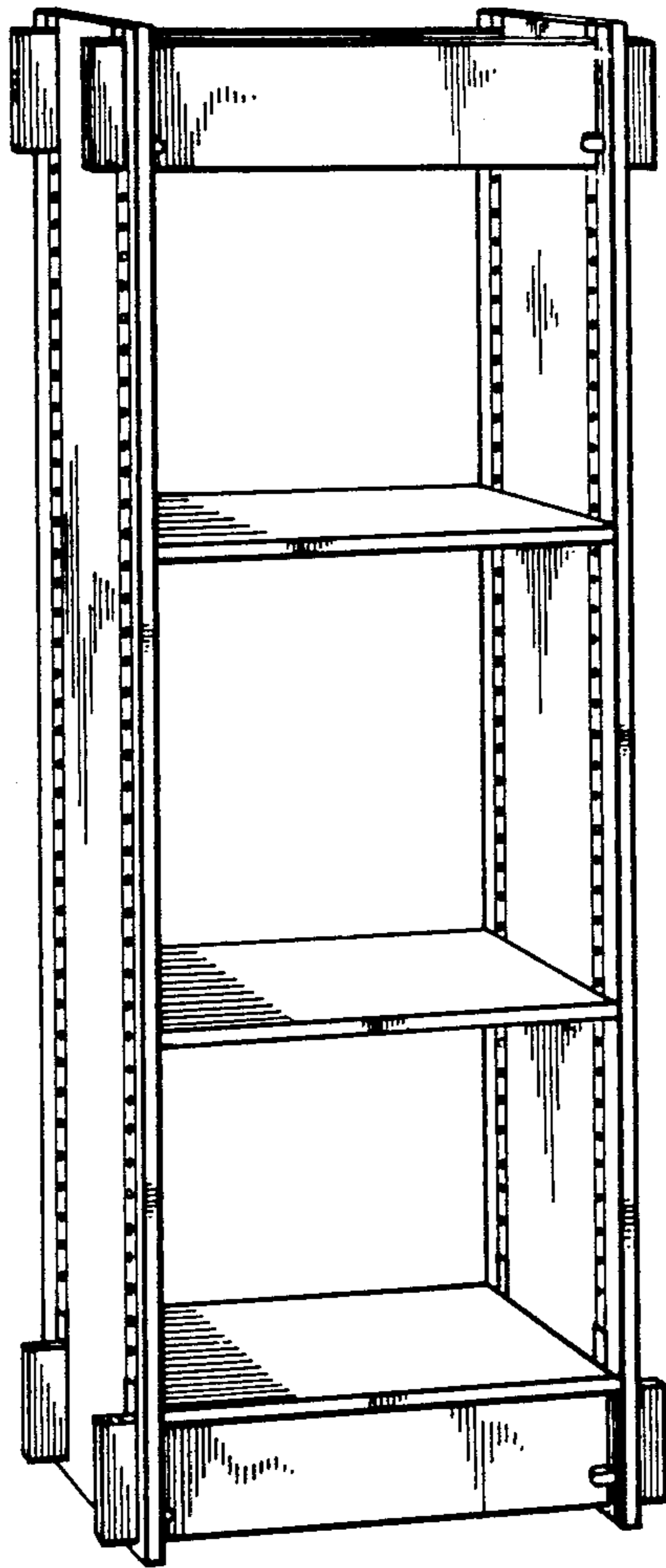

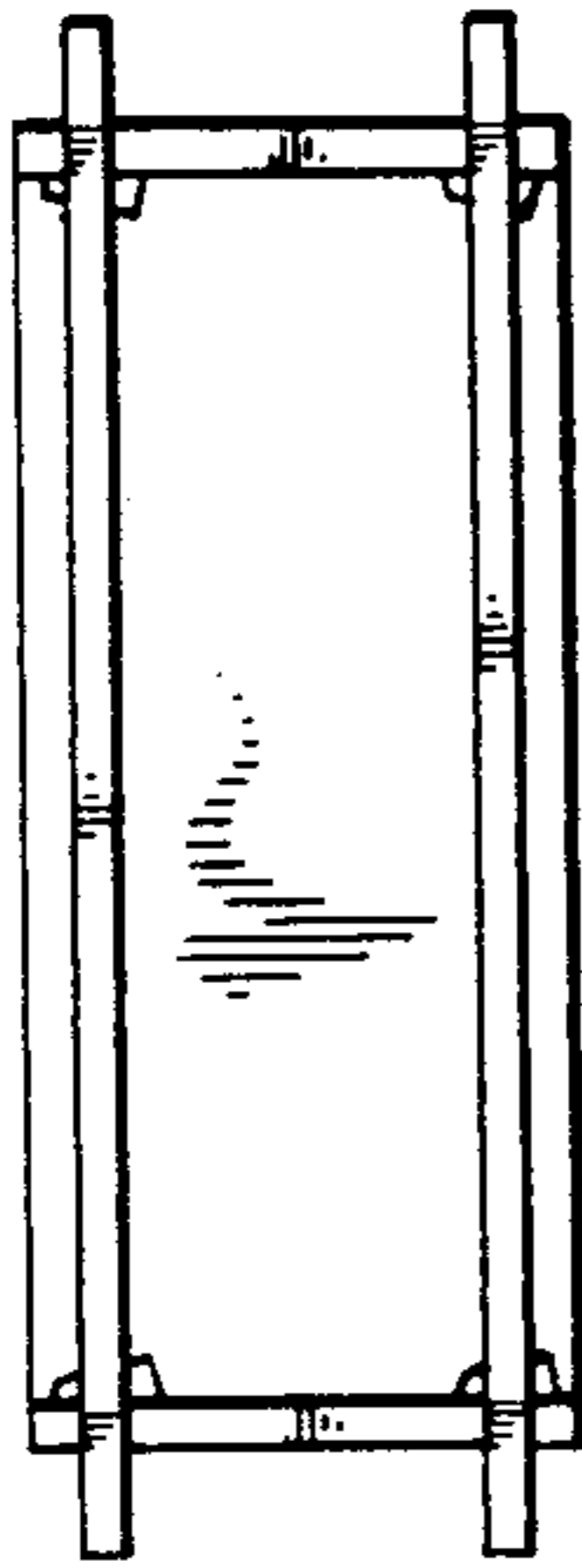

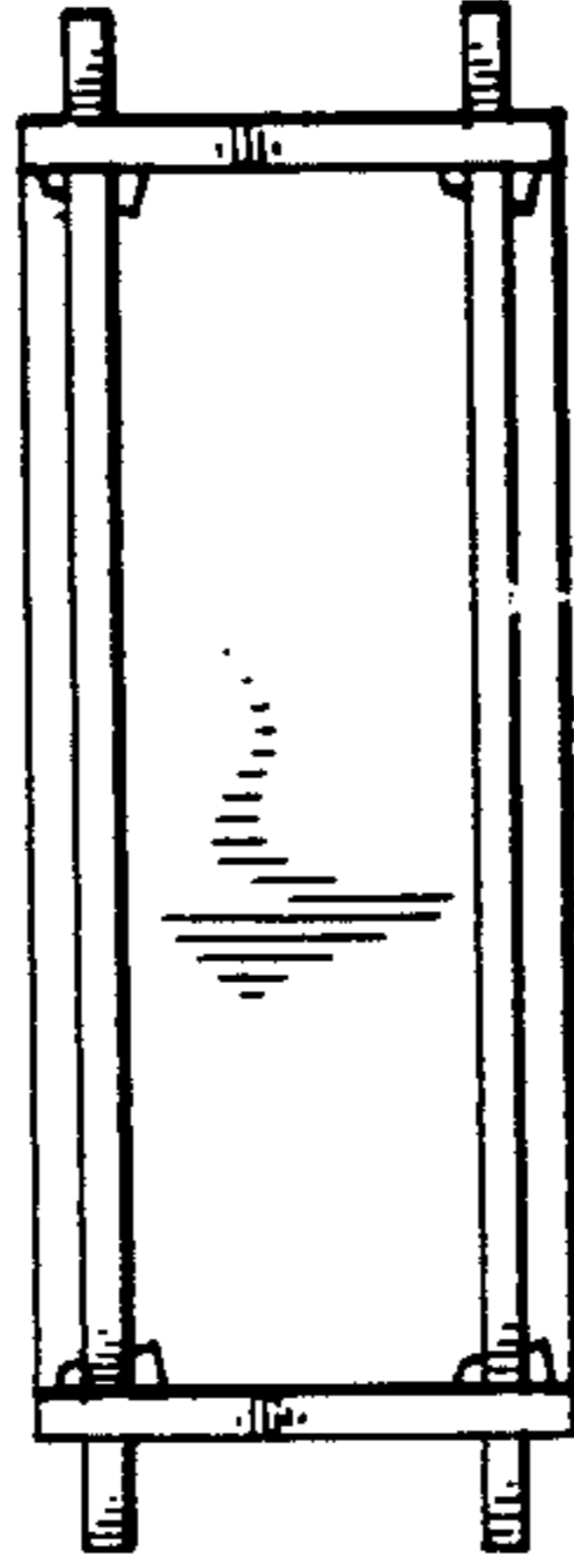

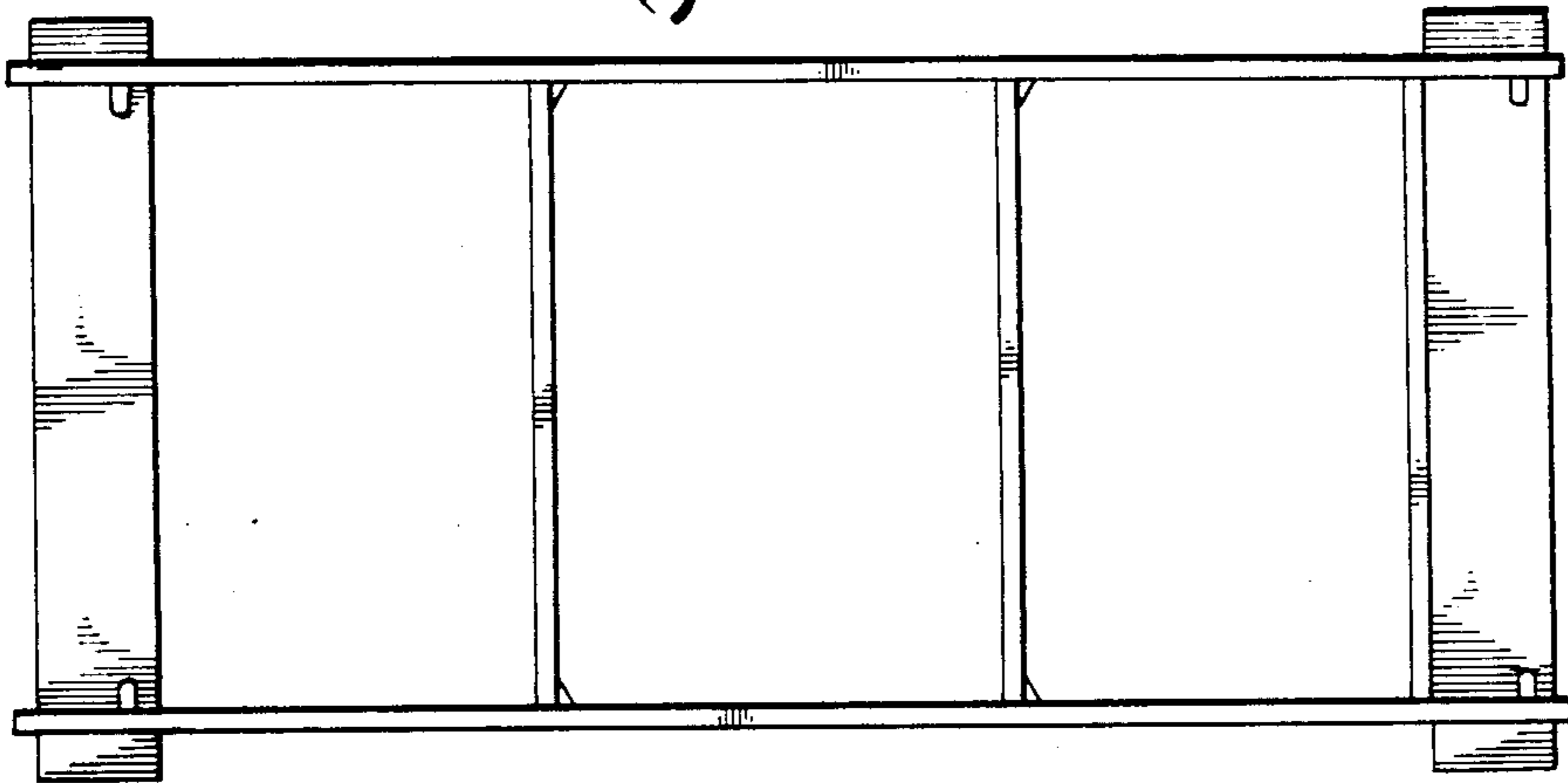
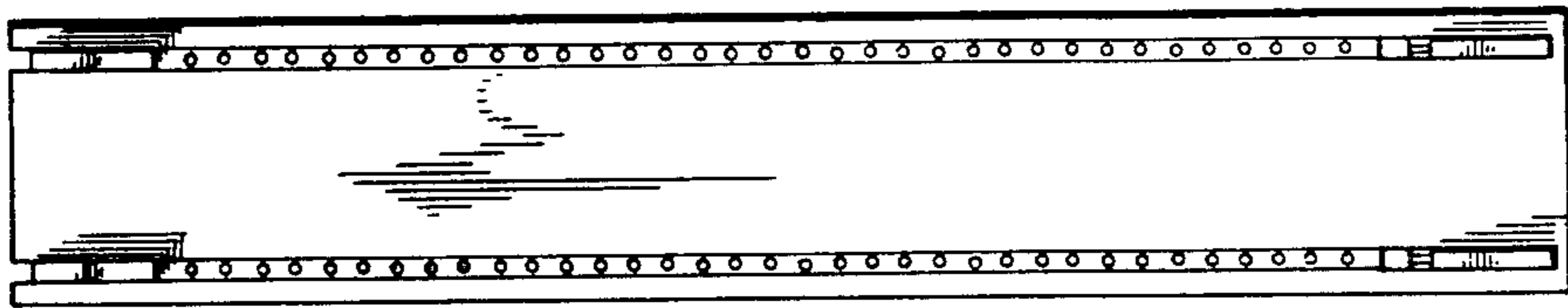
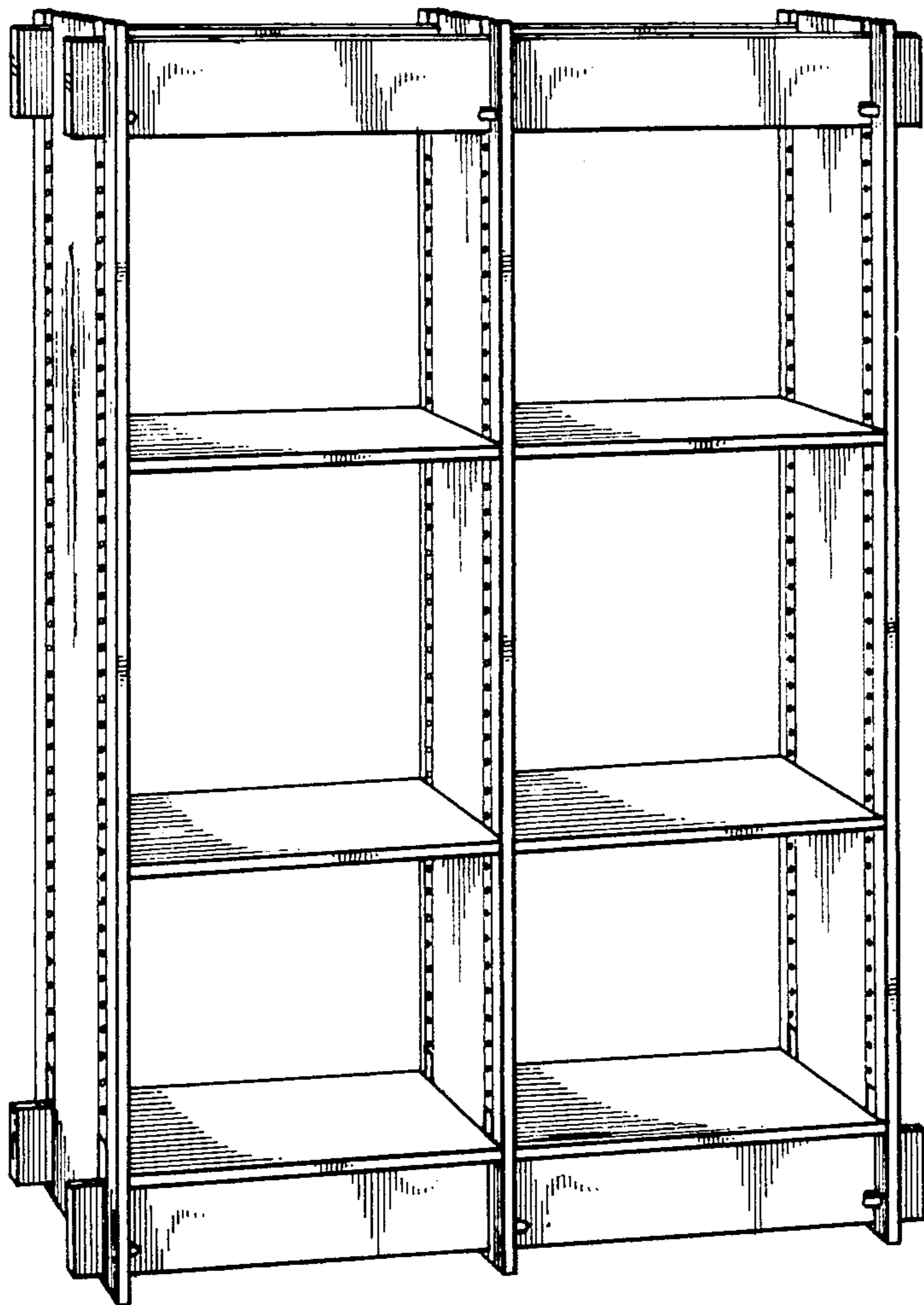

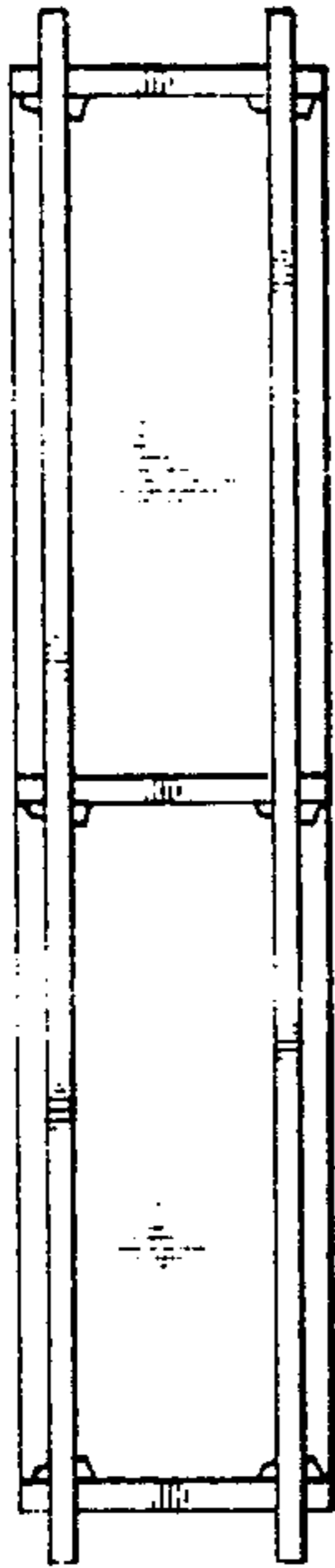

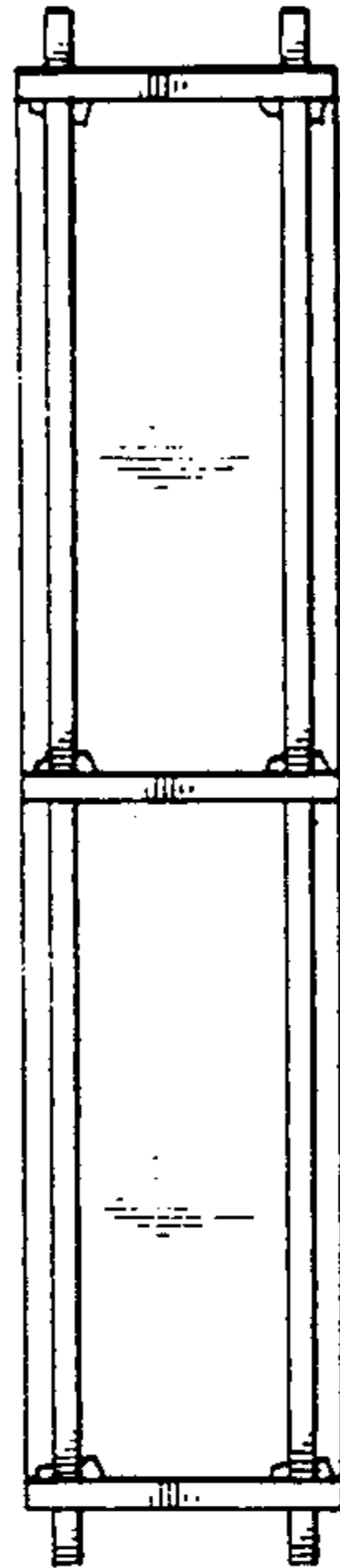

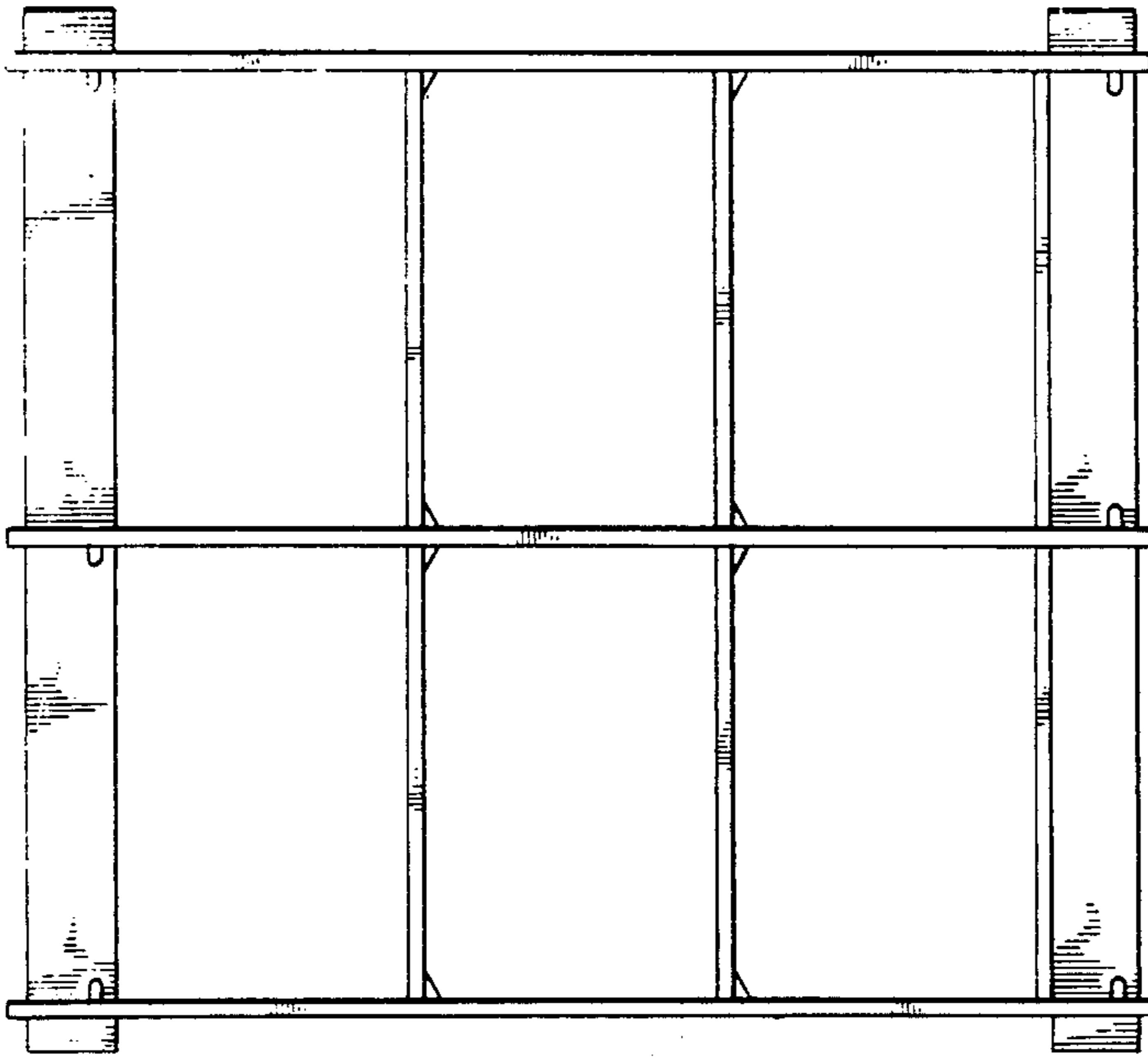

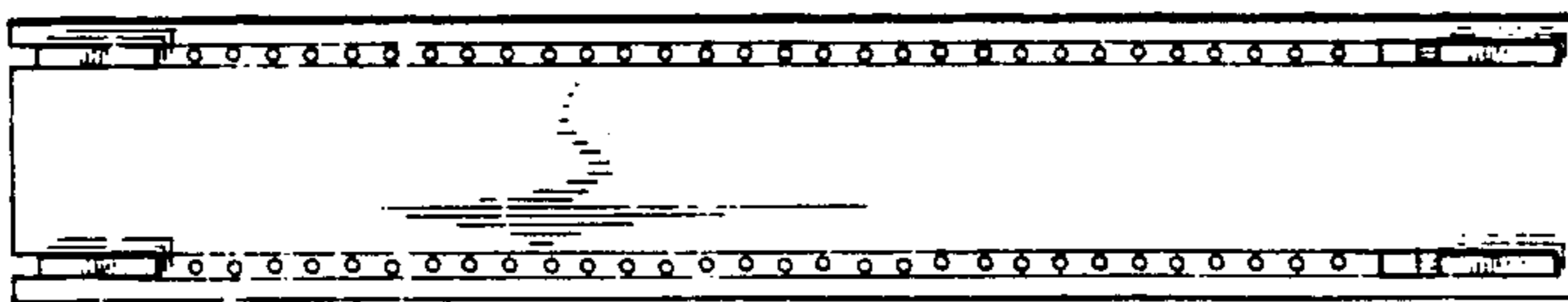
