FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a housing for audio-visual entertainment system or similar article showing my new design;

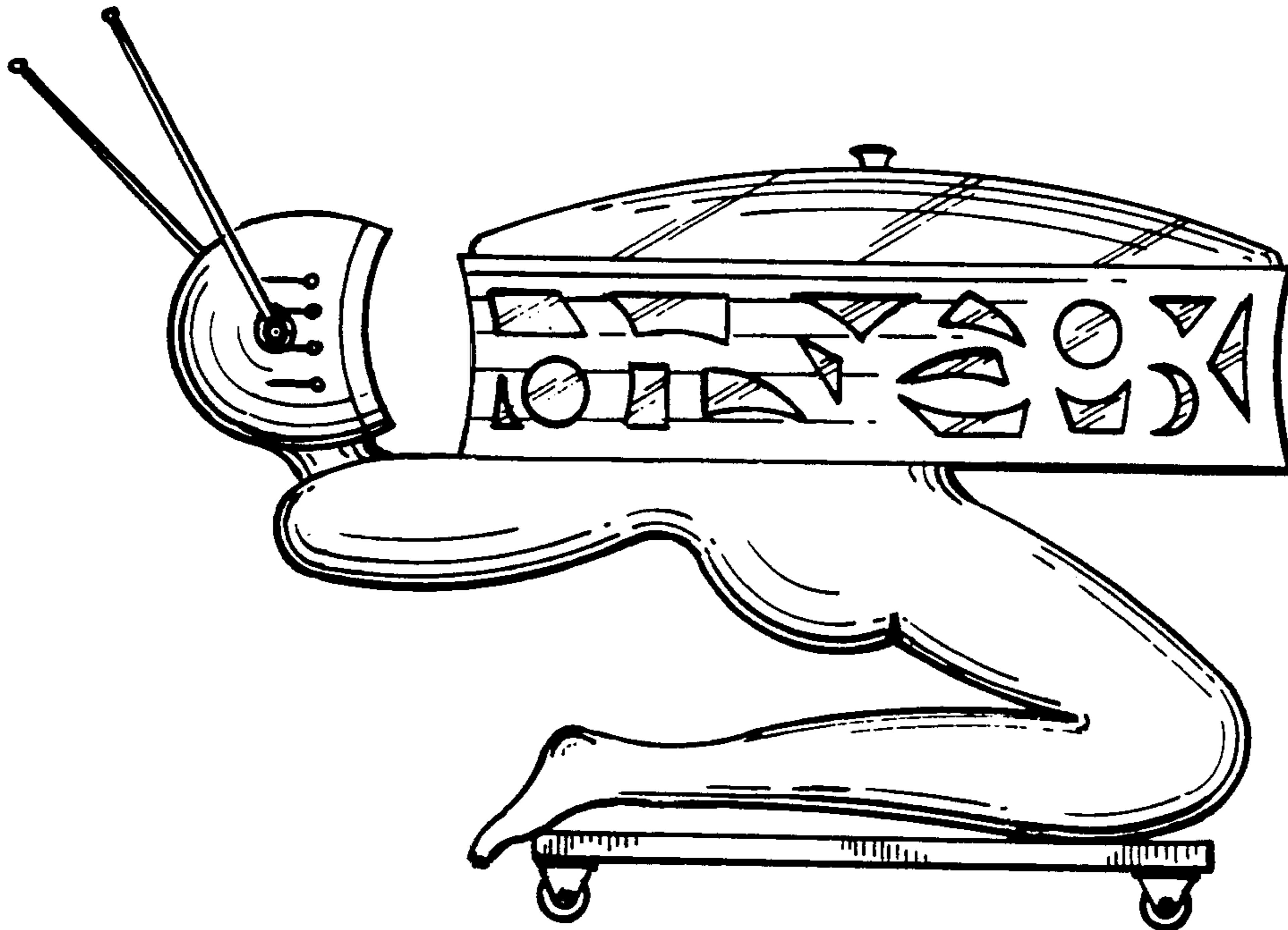
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 1.



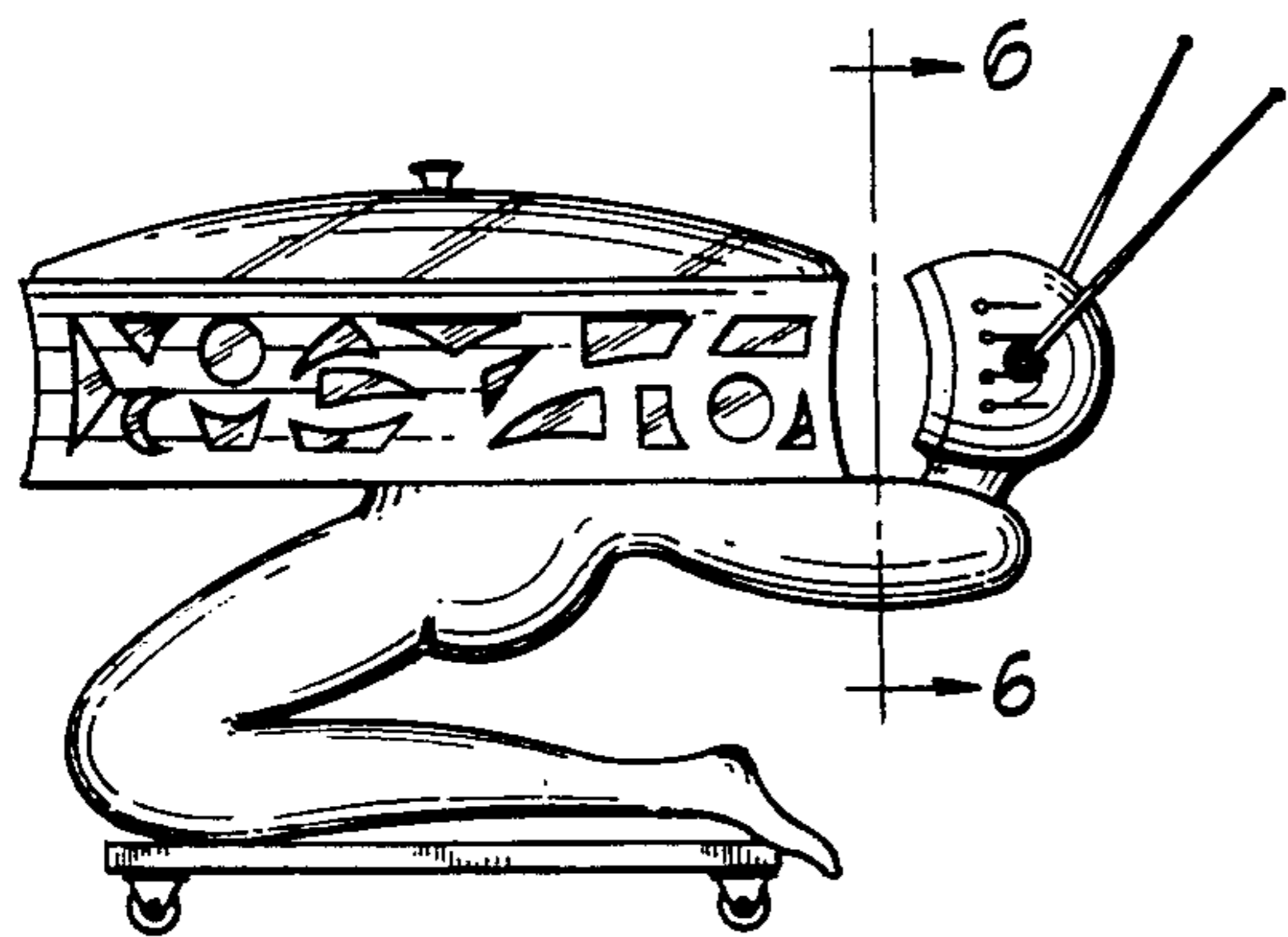

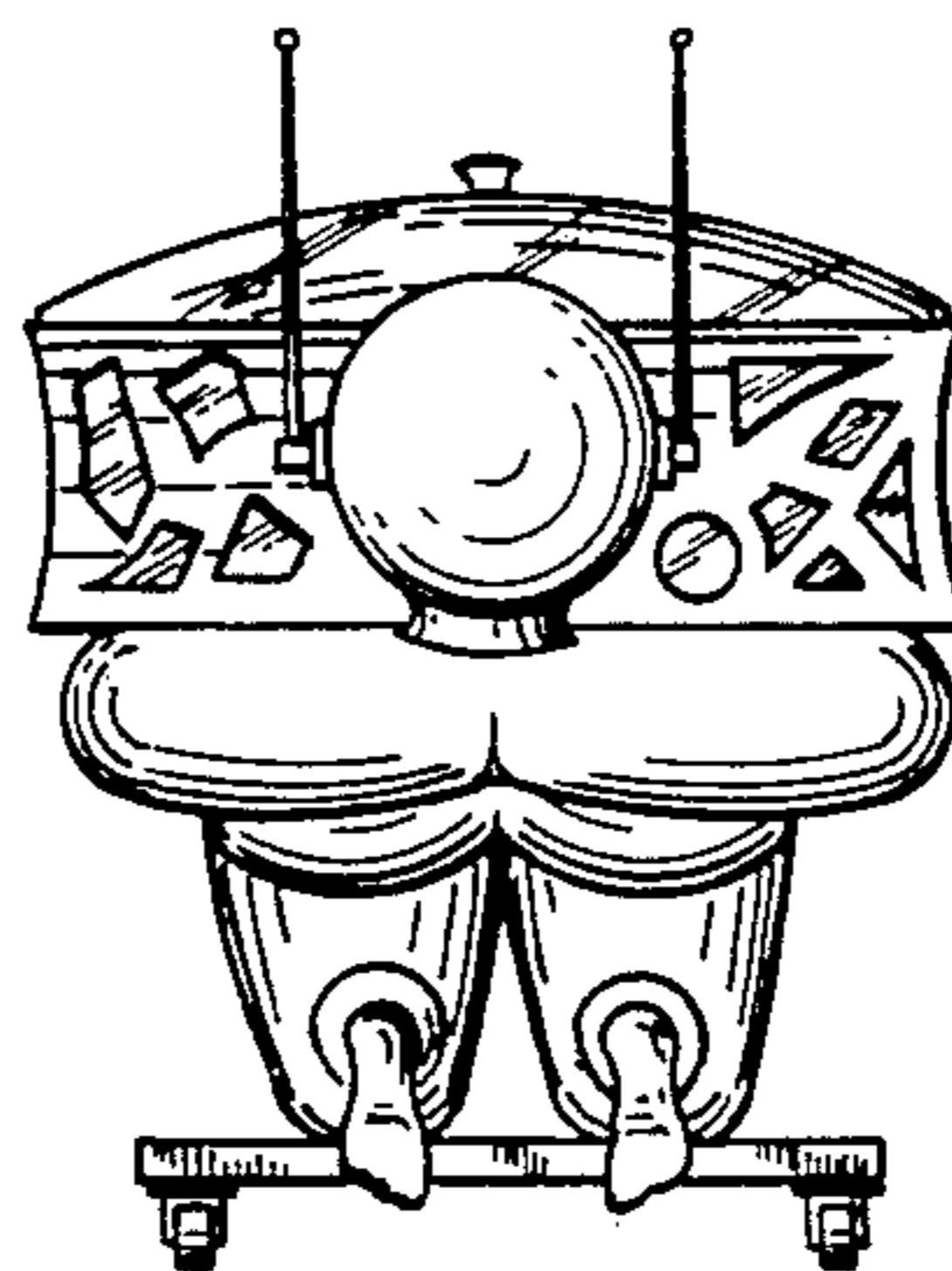

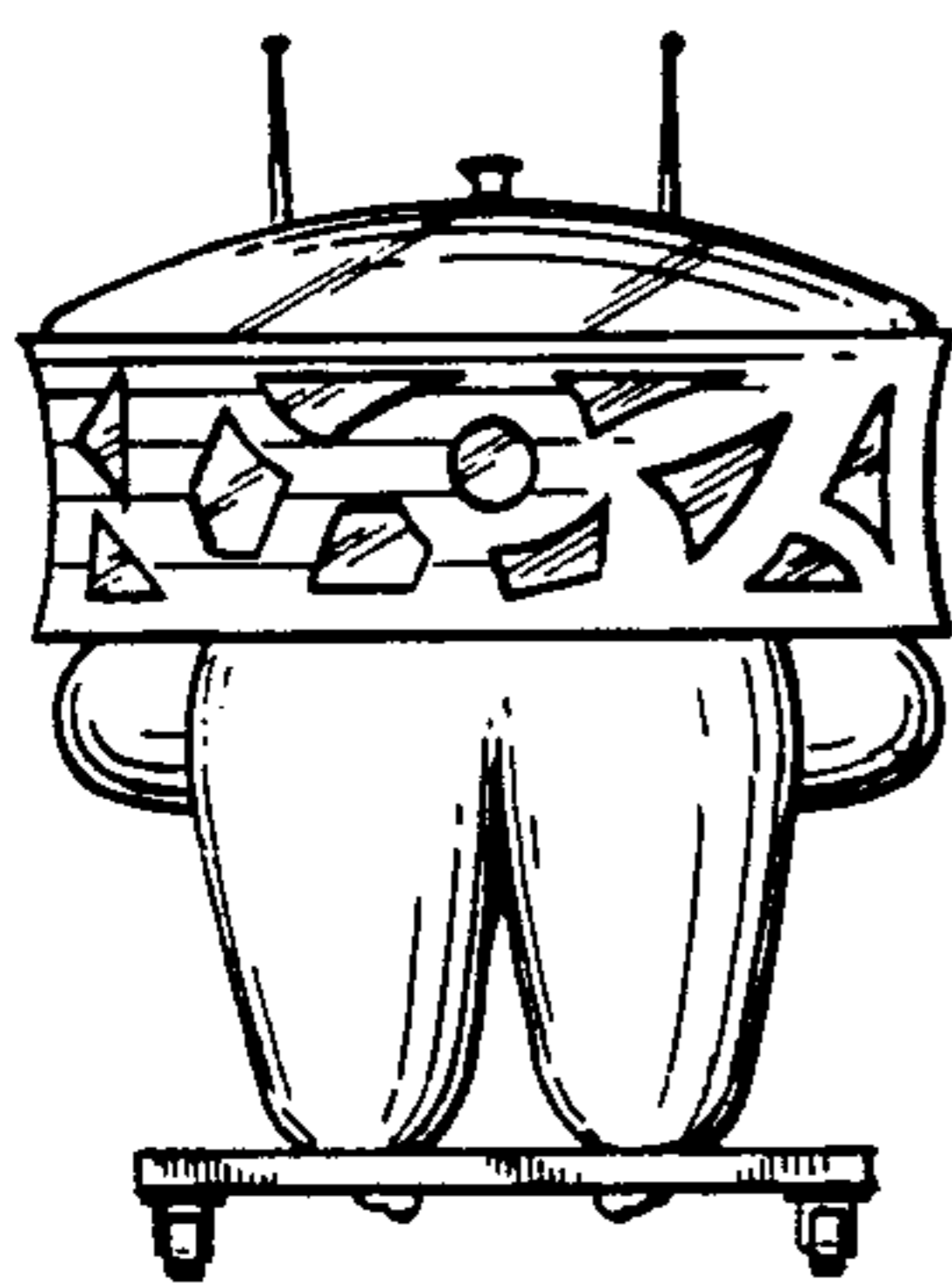

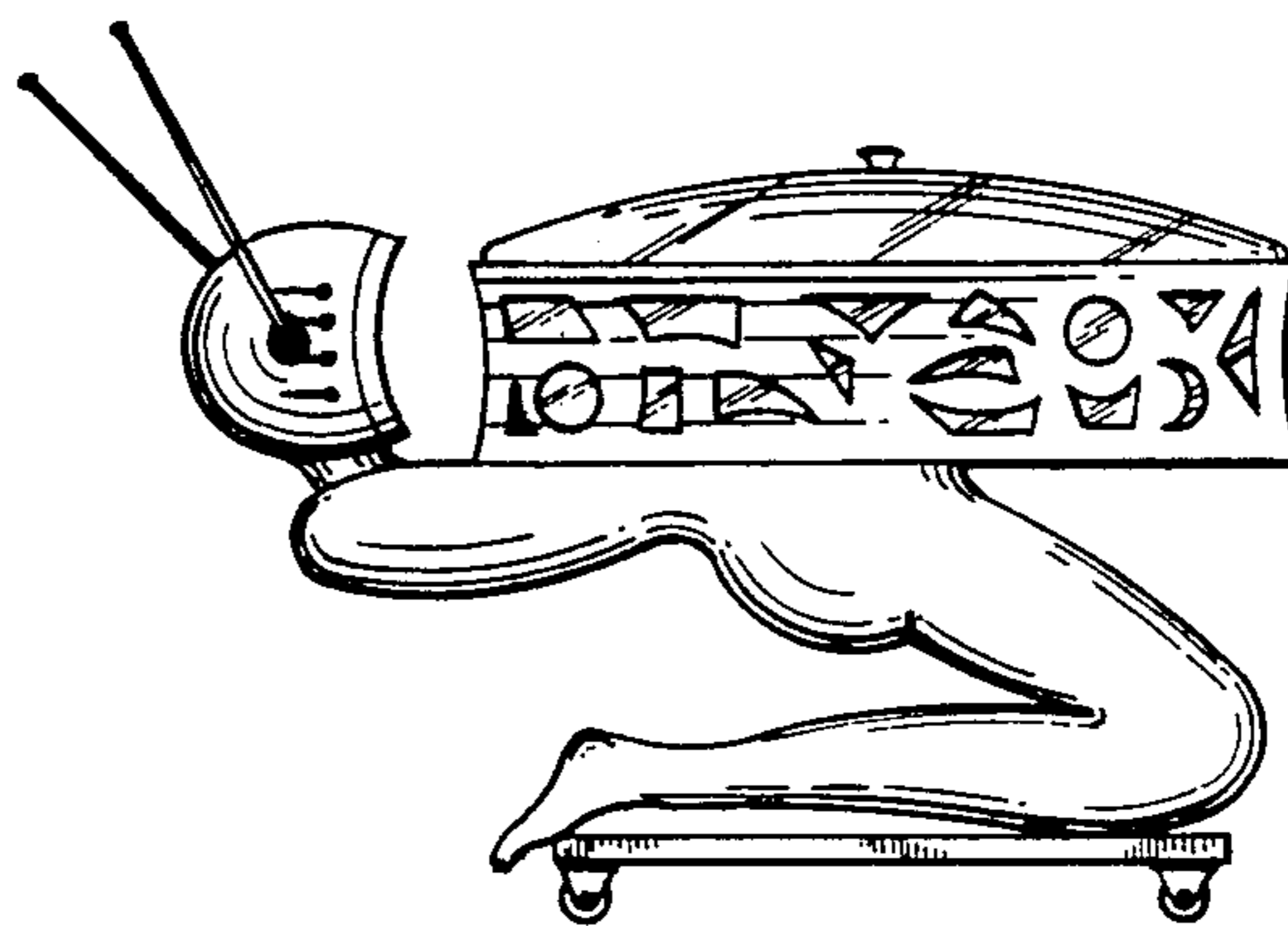

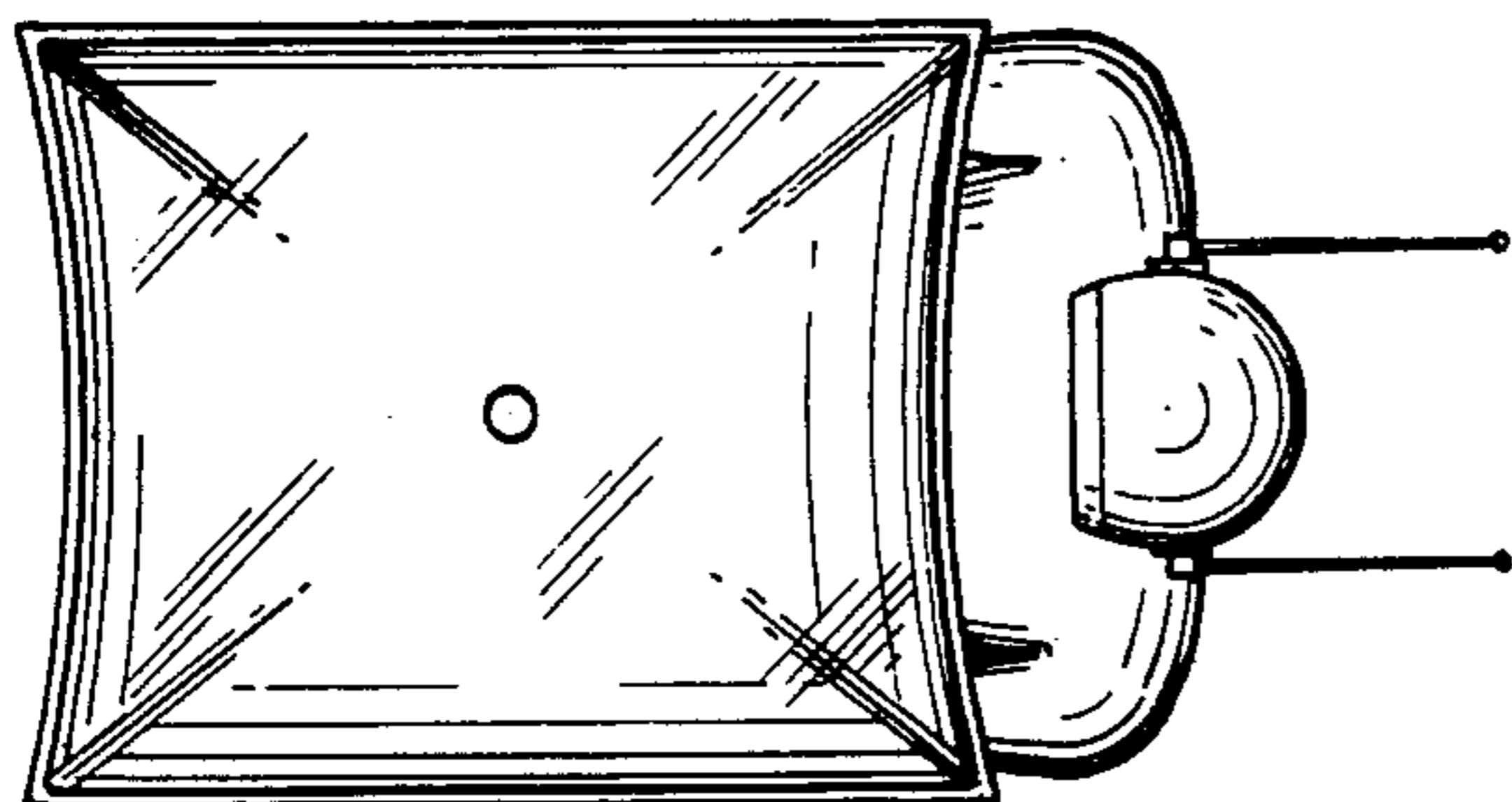

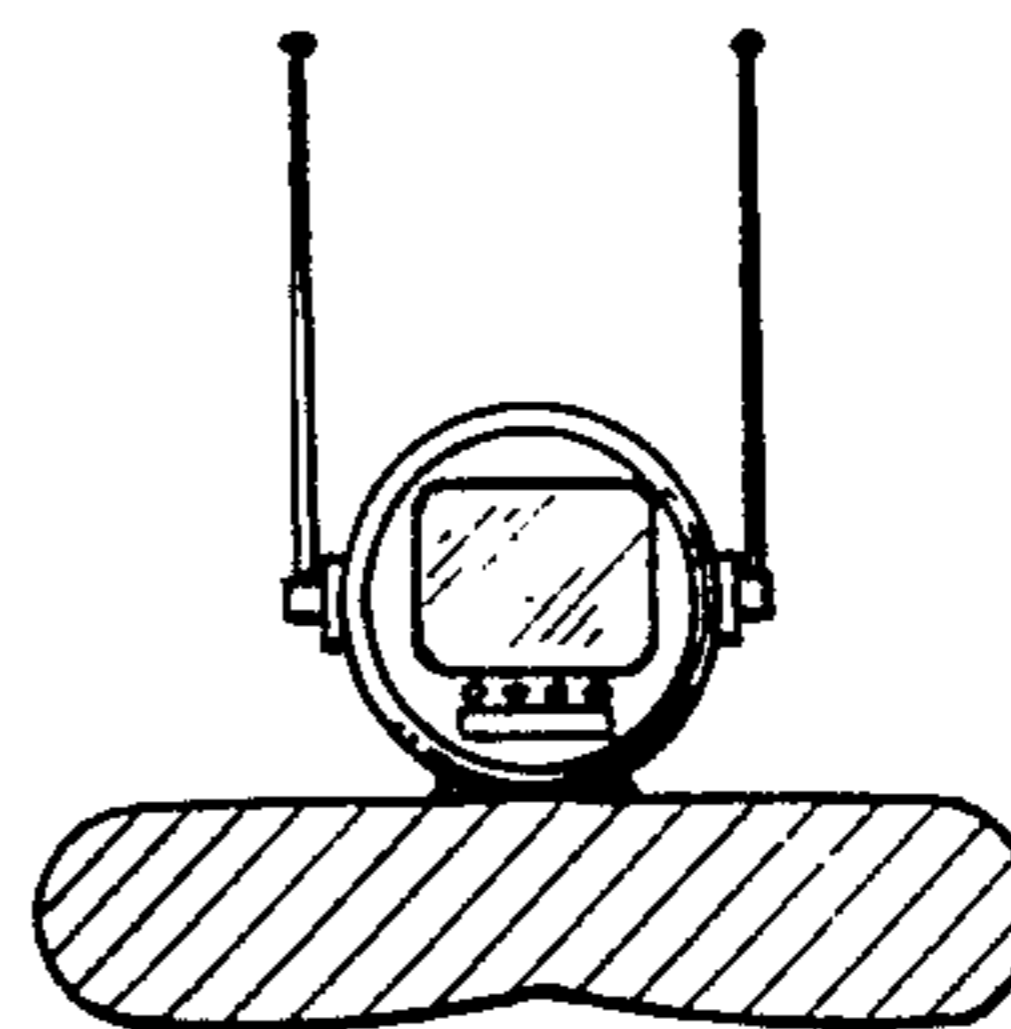
