FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;

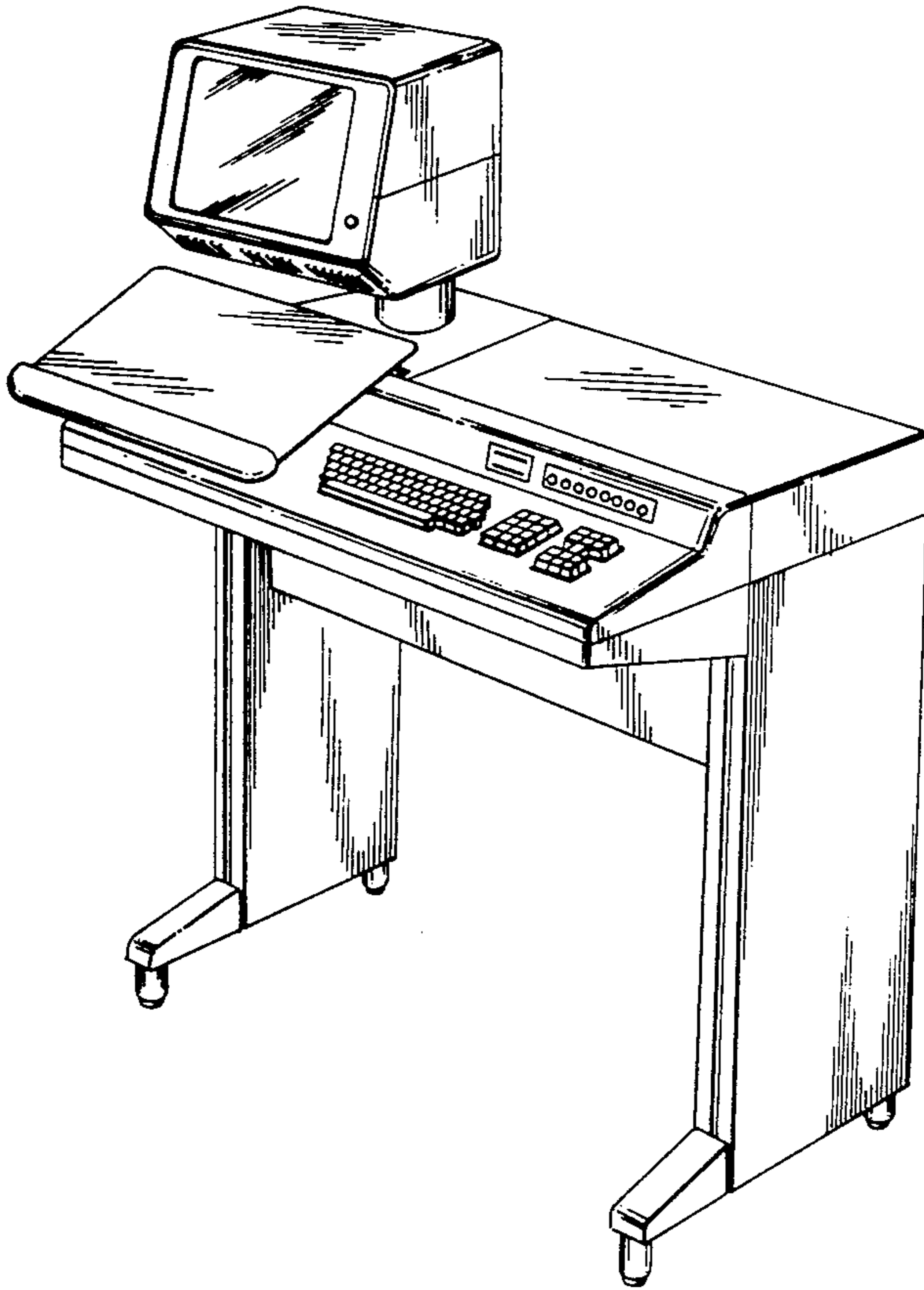
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view.



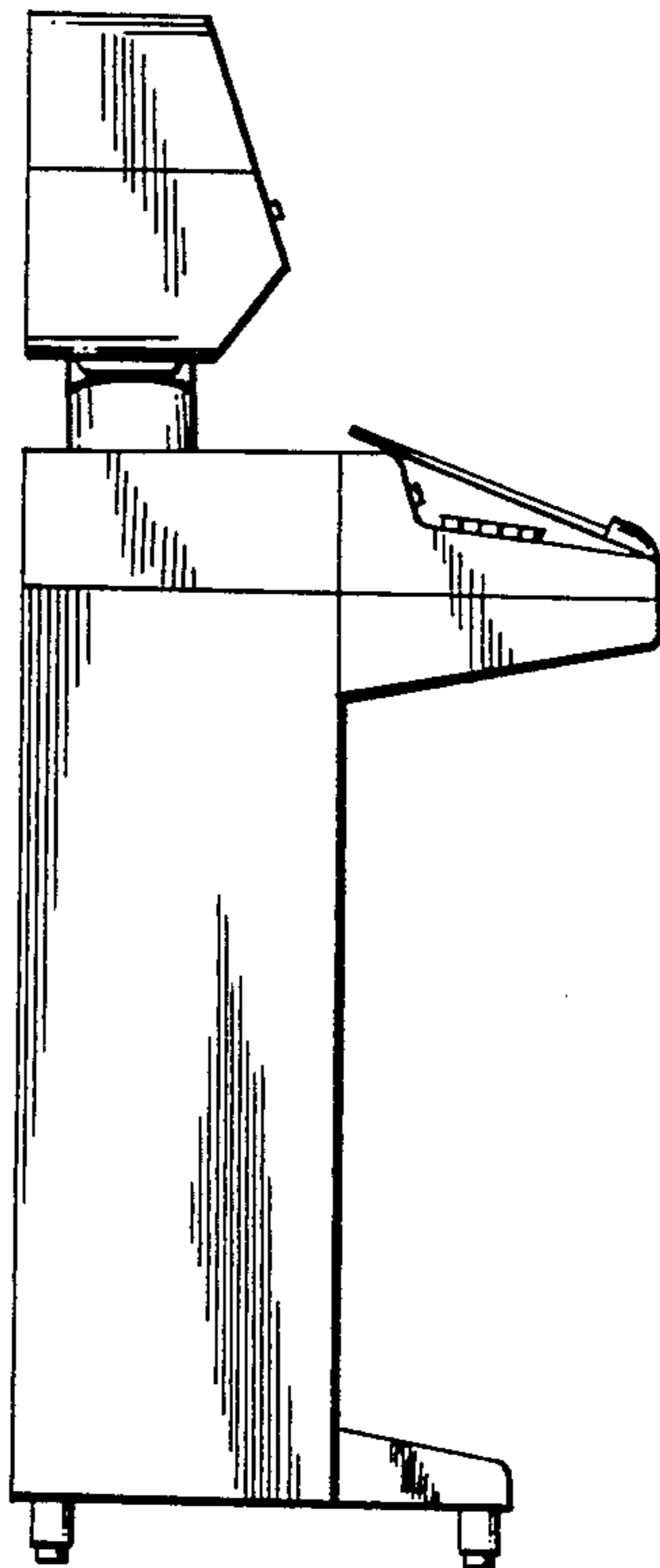
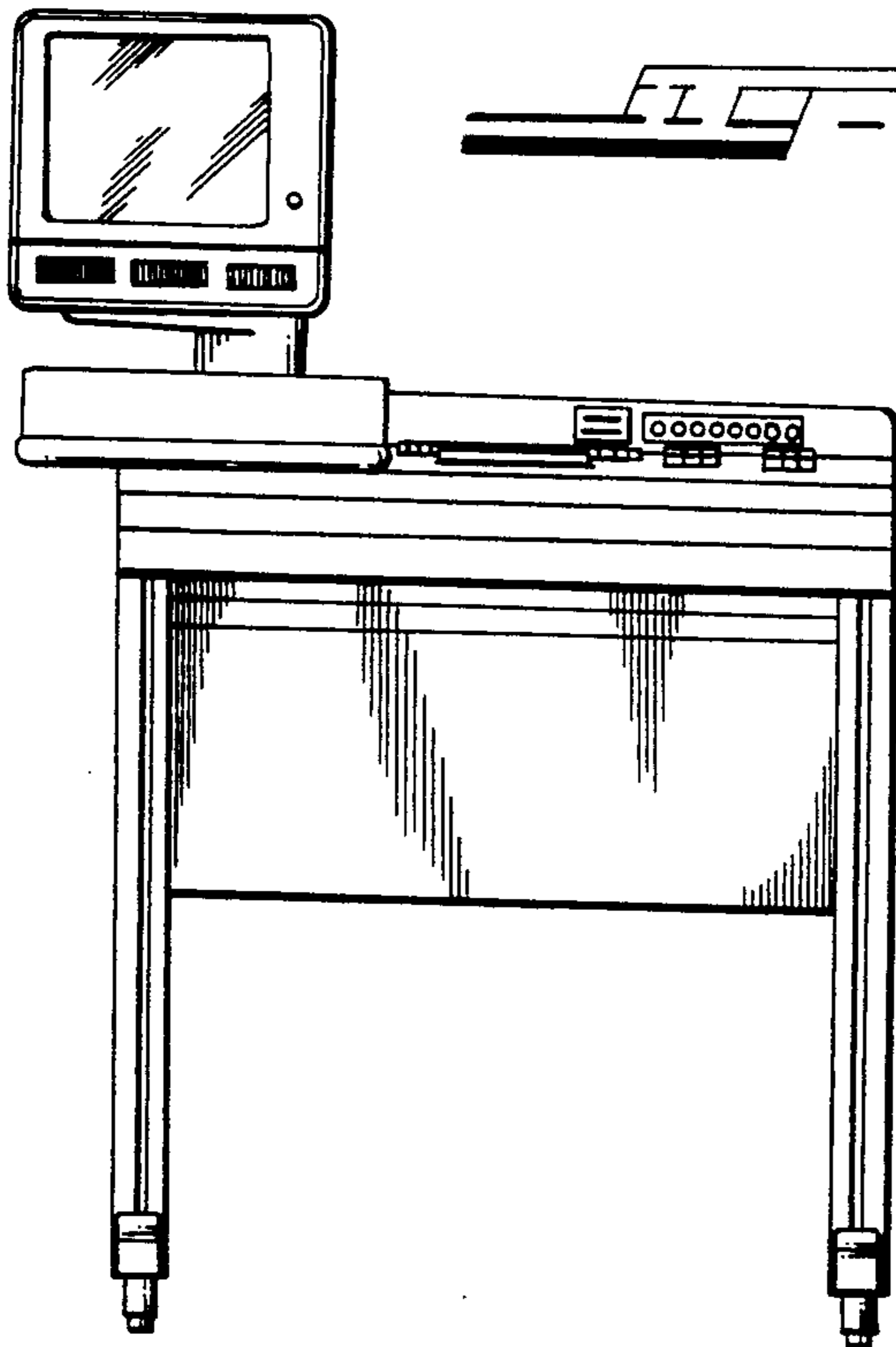
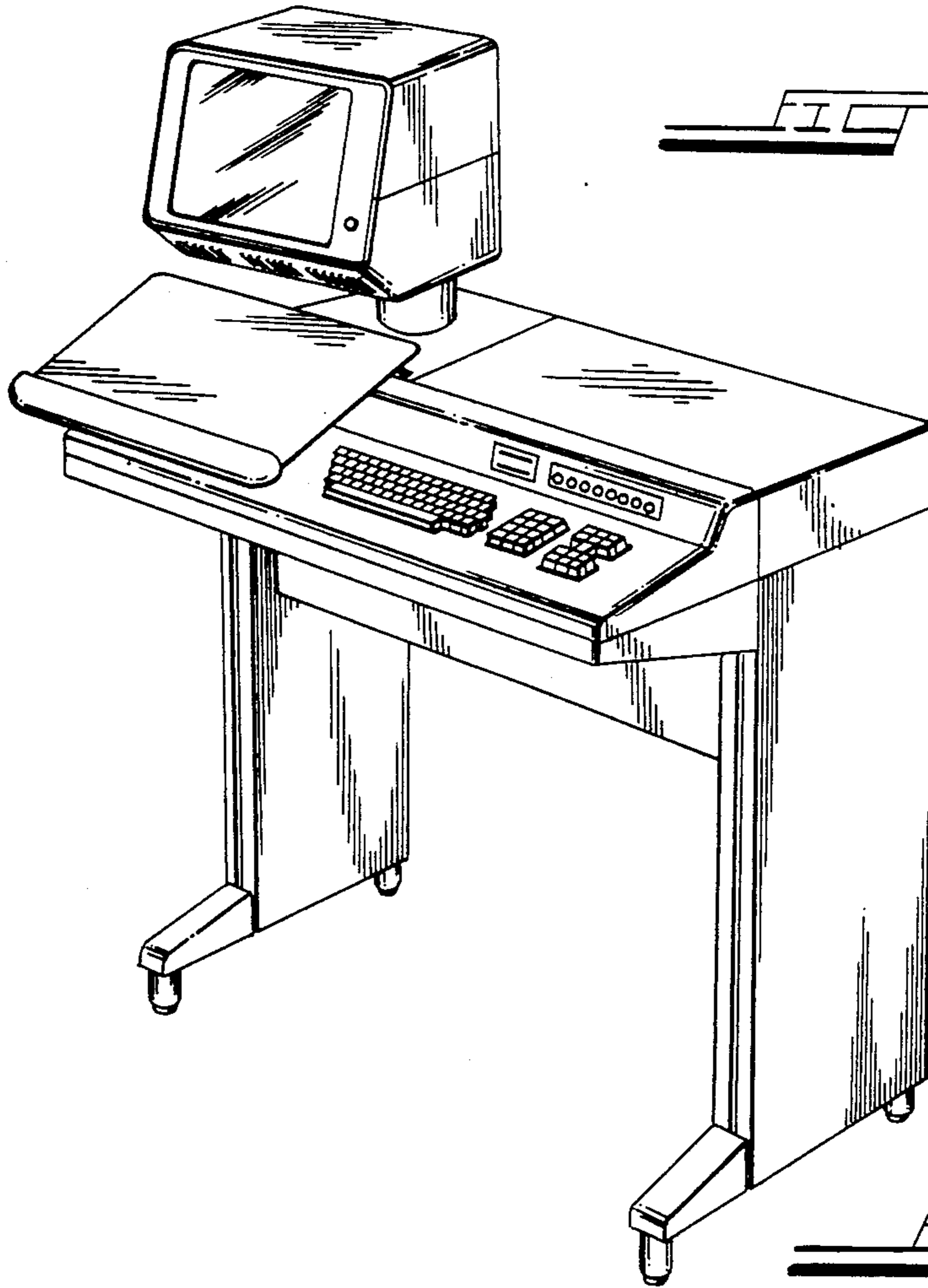

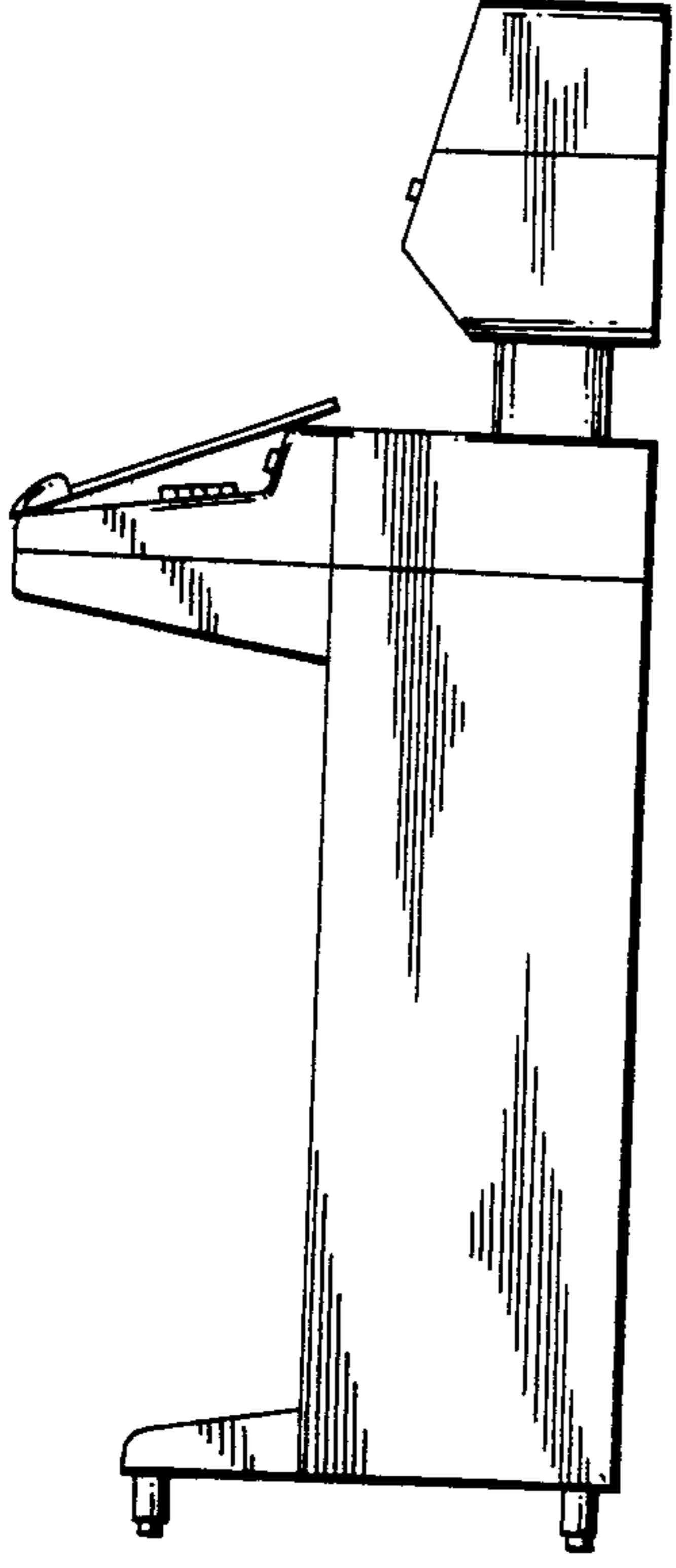

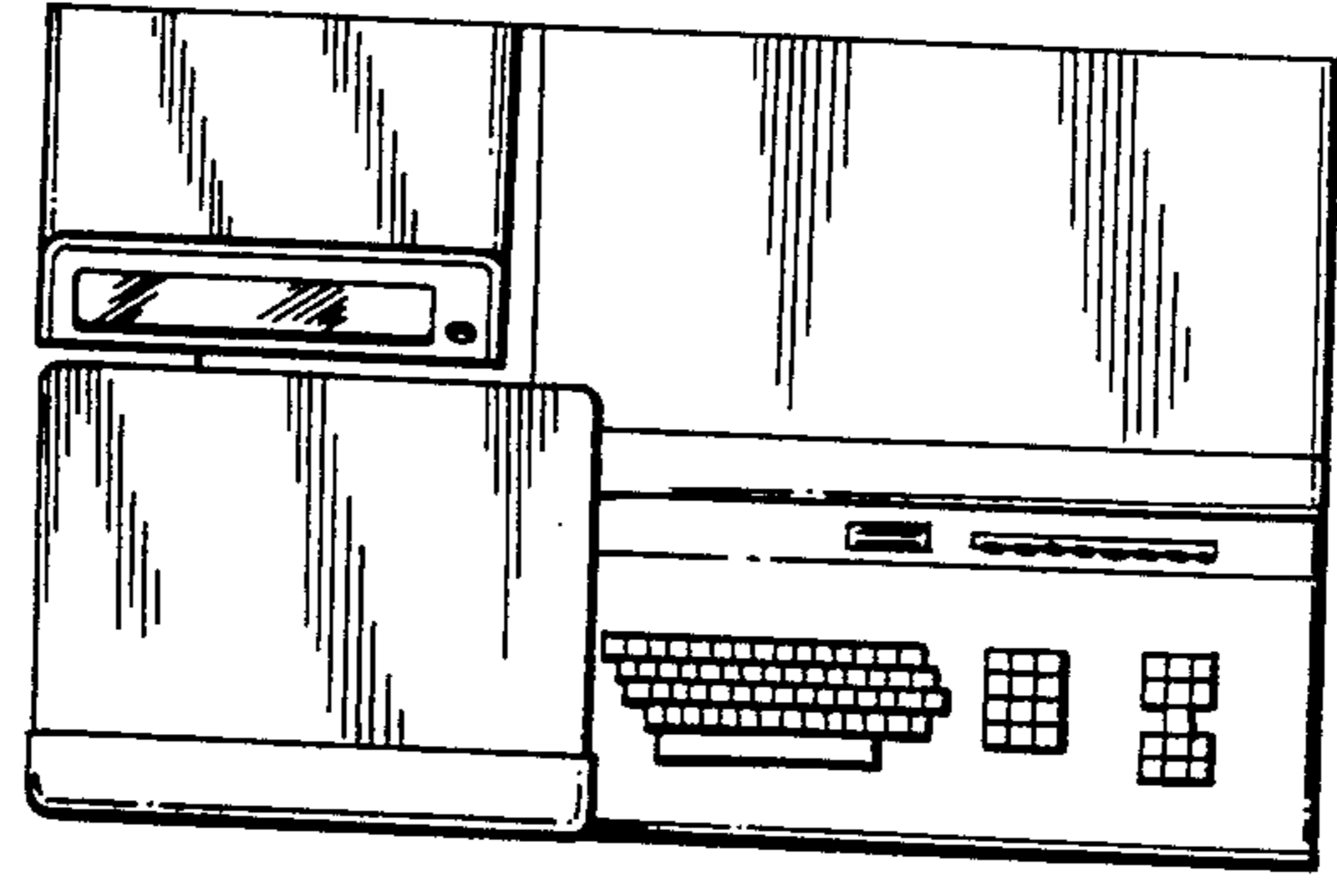

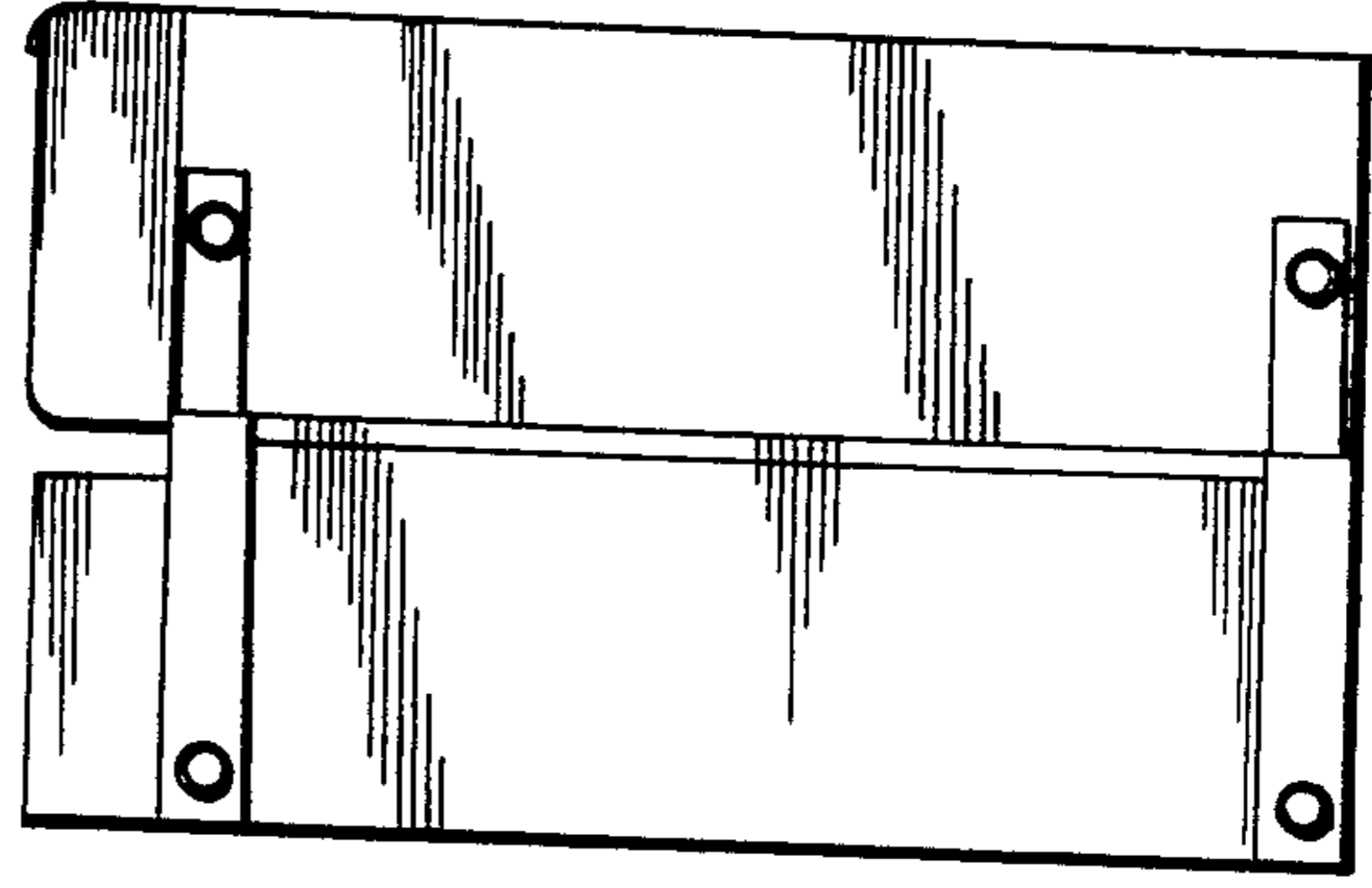
