[57] CLAIM

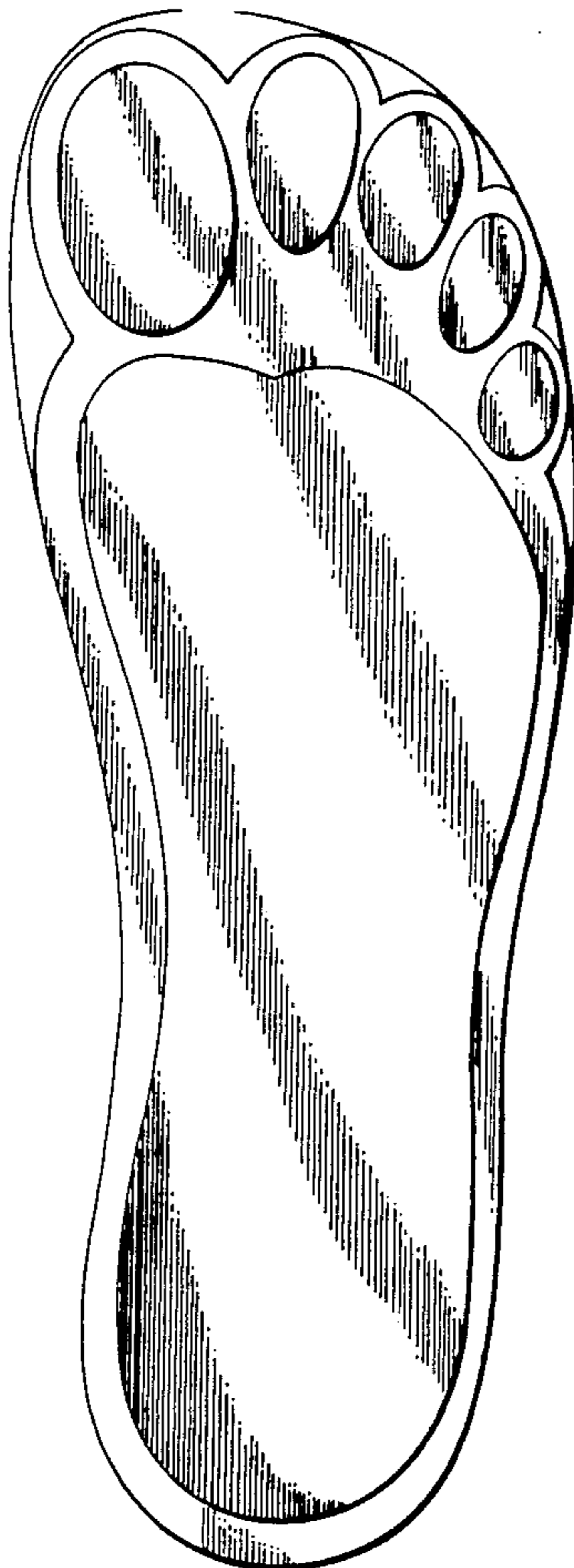
The ornamental design for a shoe bottom unit, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof.



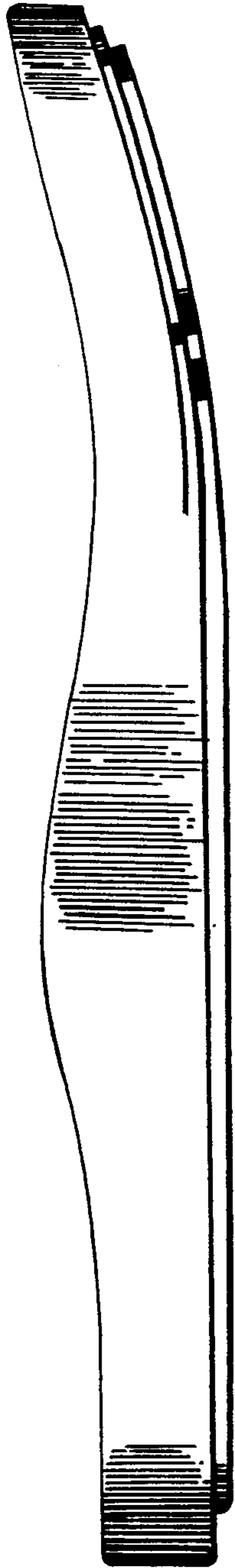

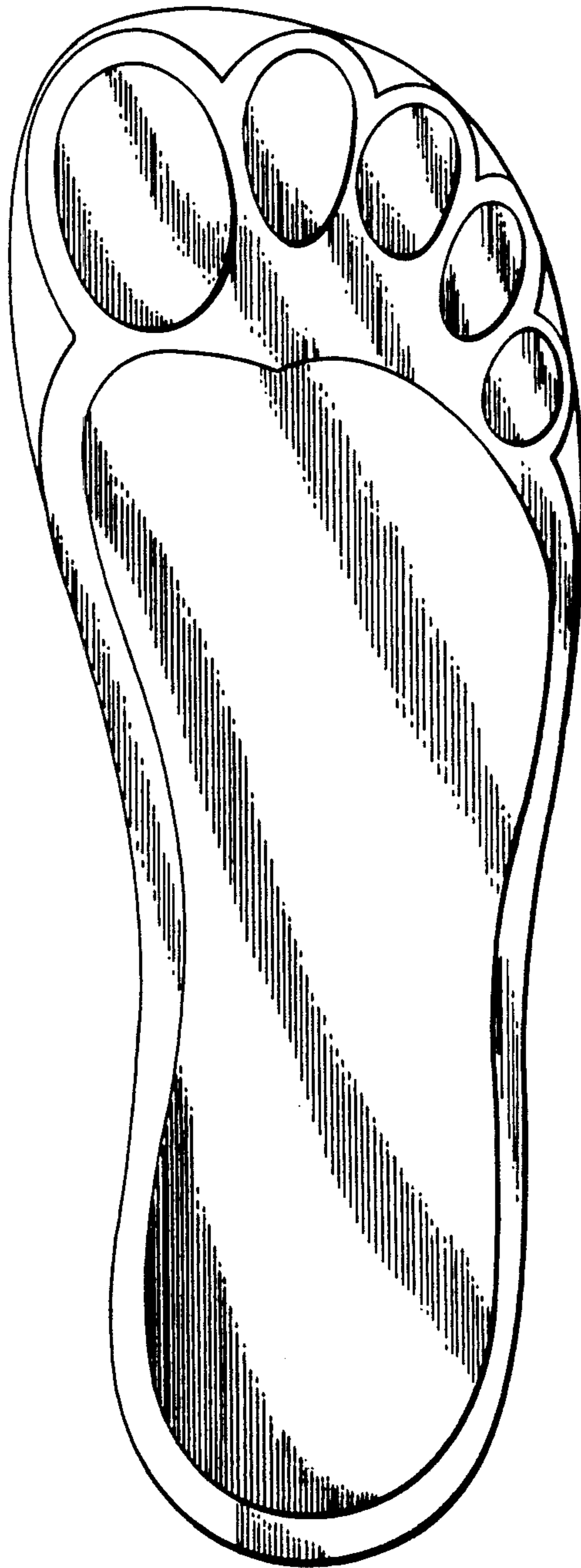

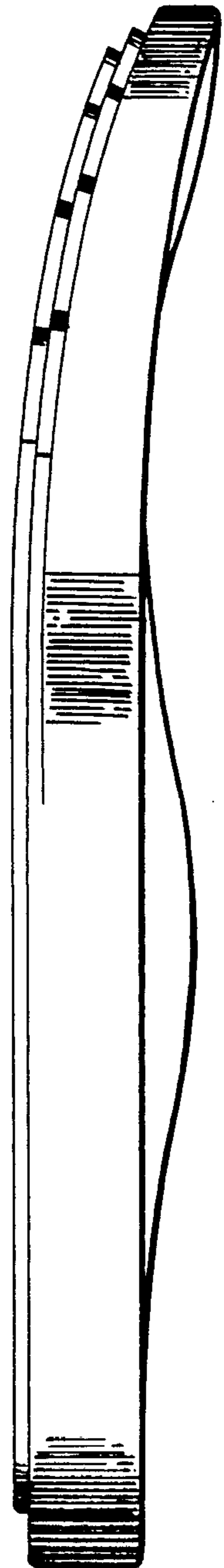
