FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a handgun grip showing my new design;

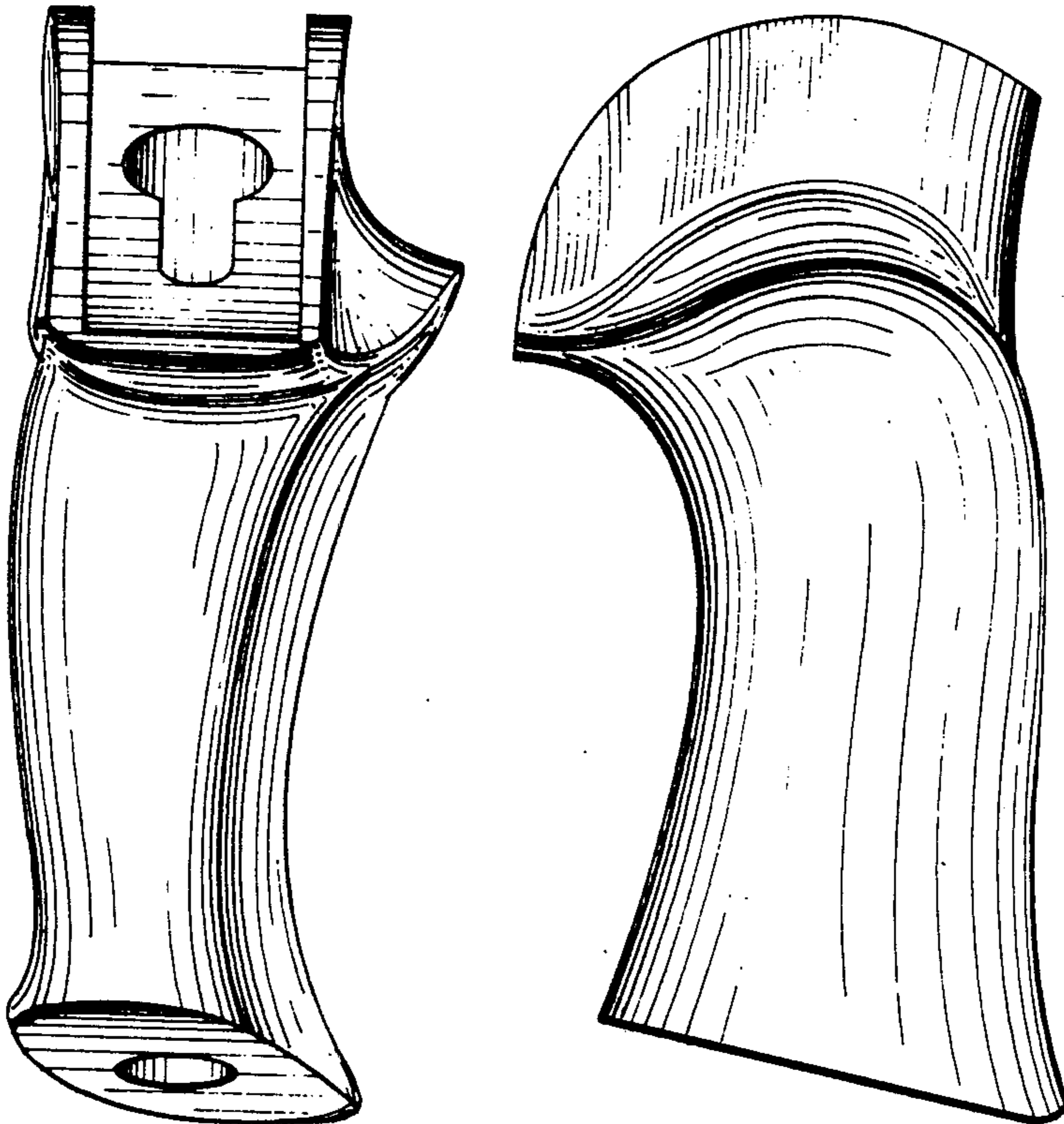
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.



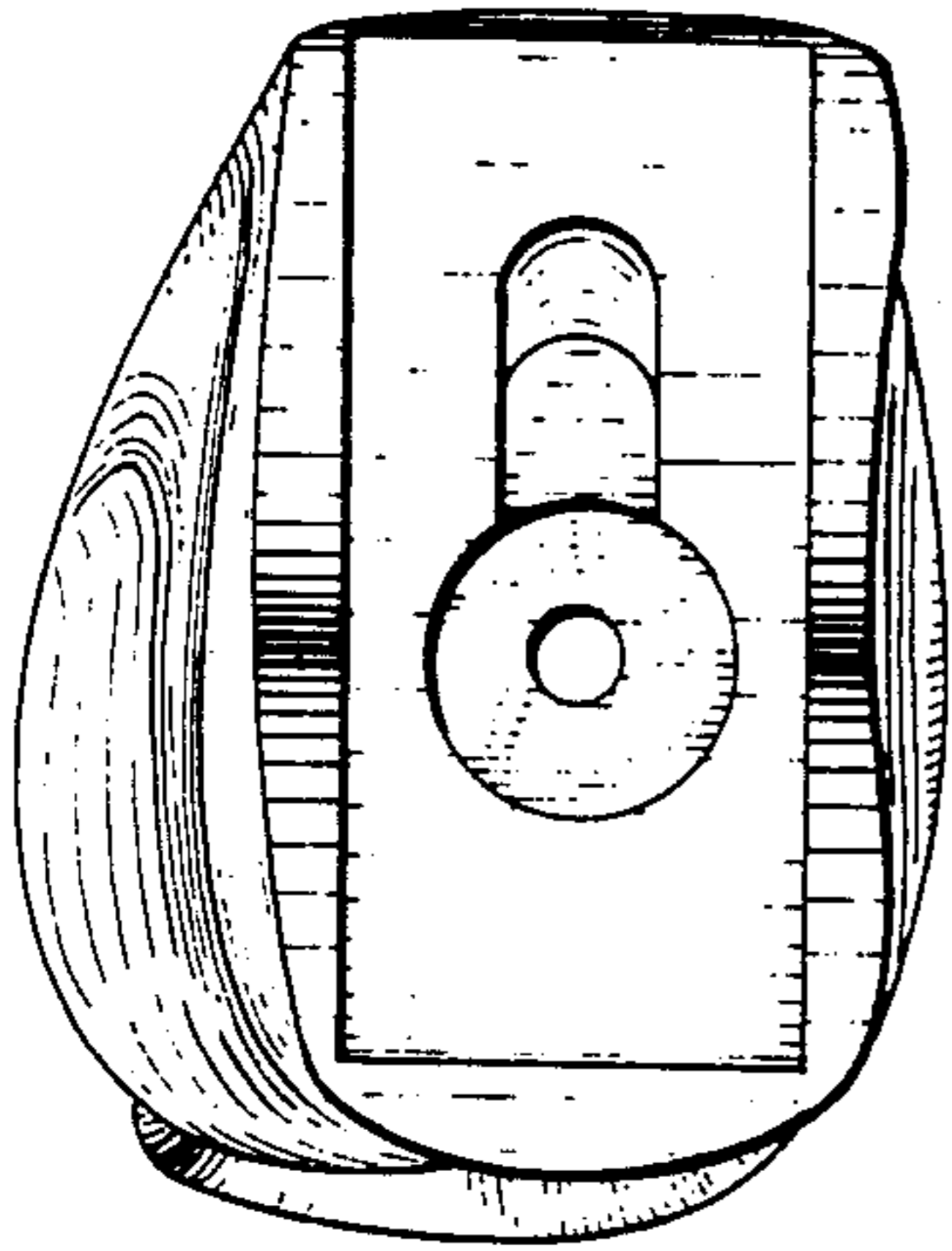

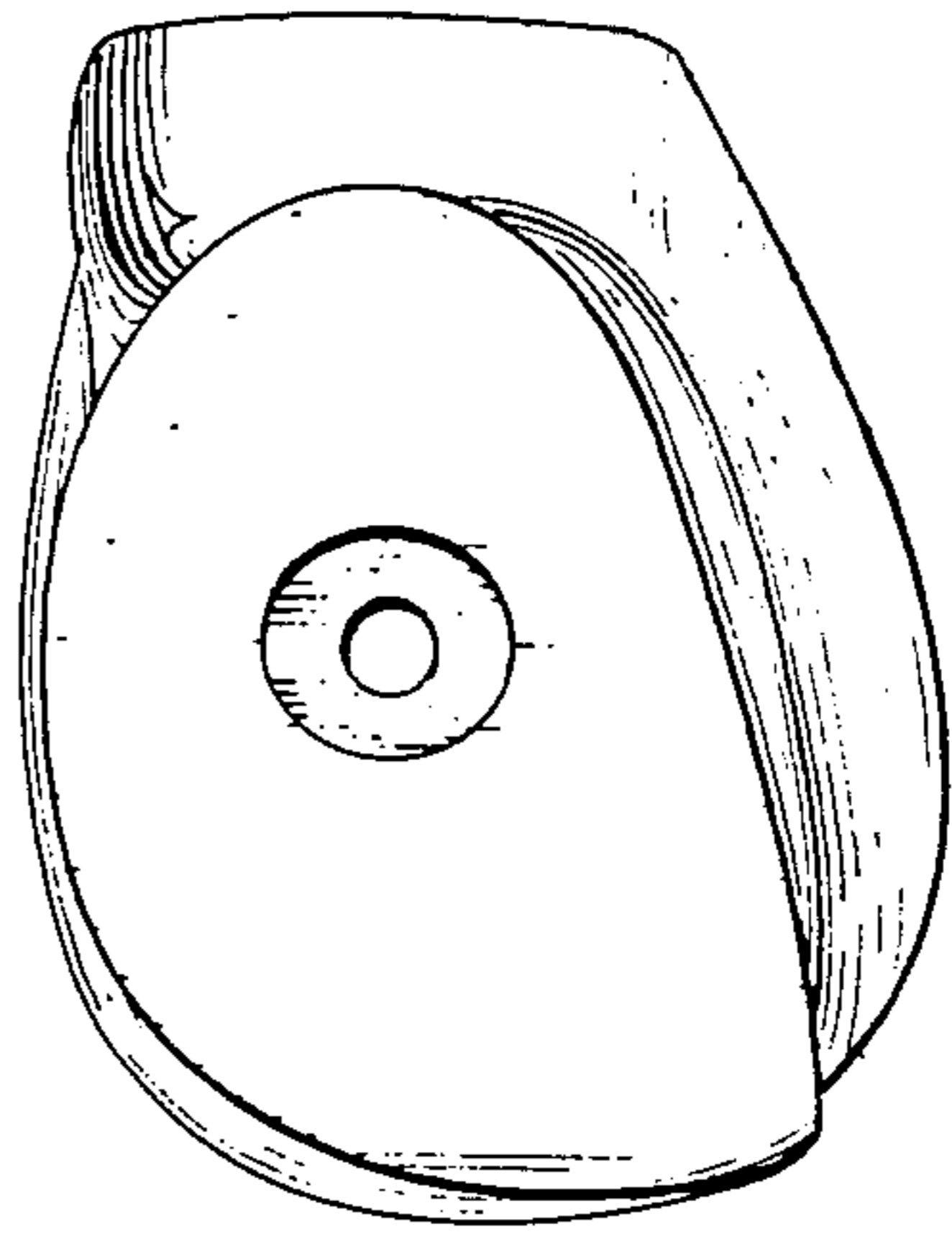

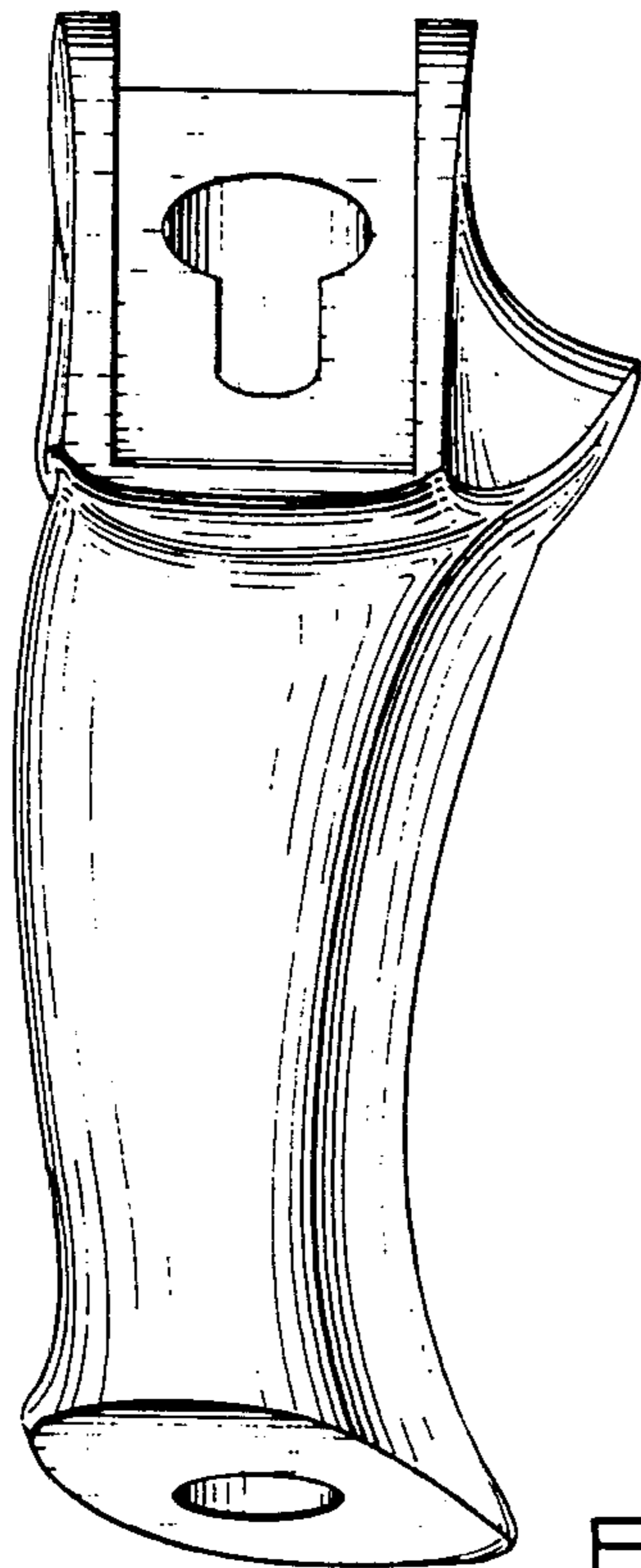

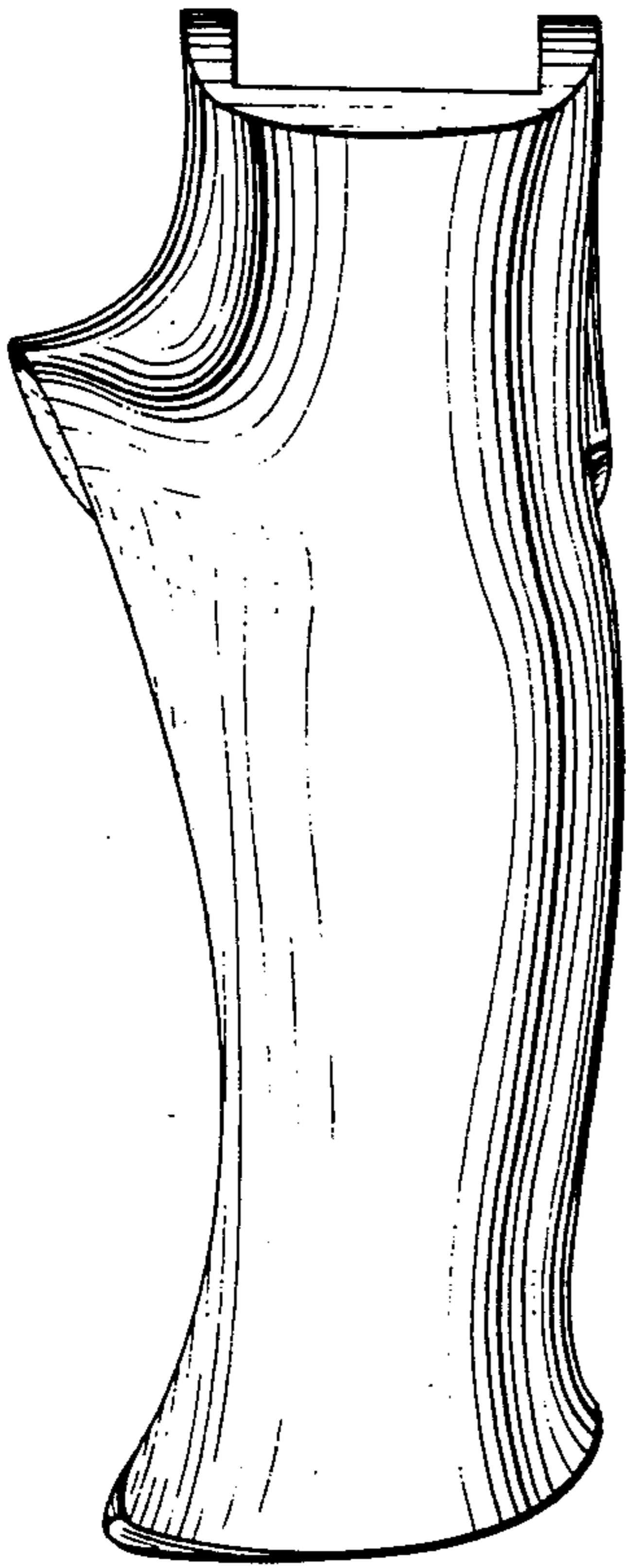

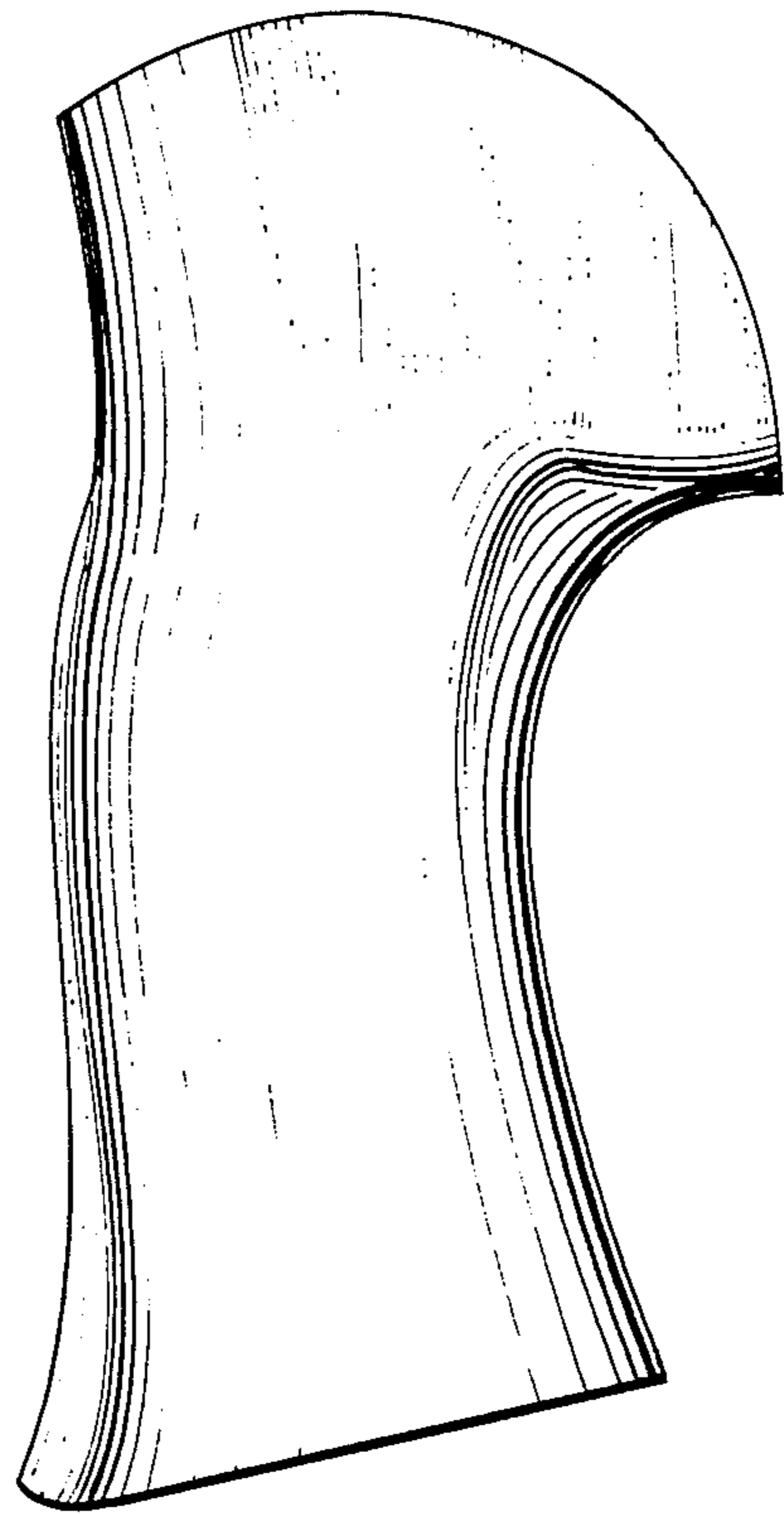

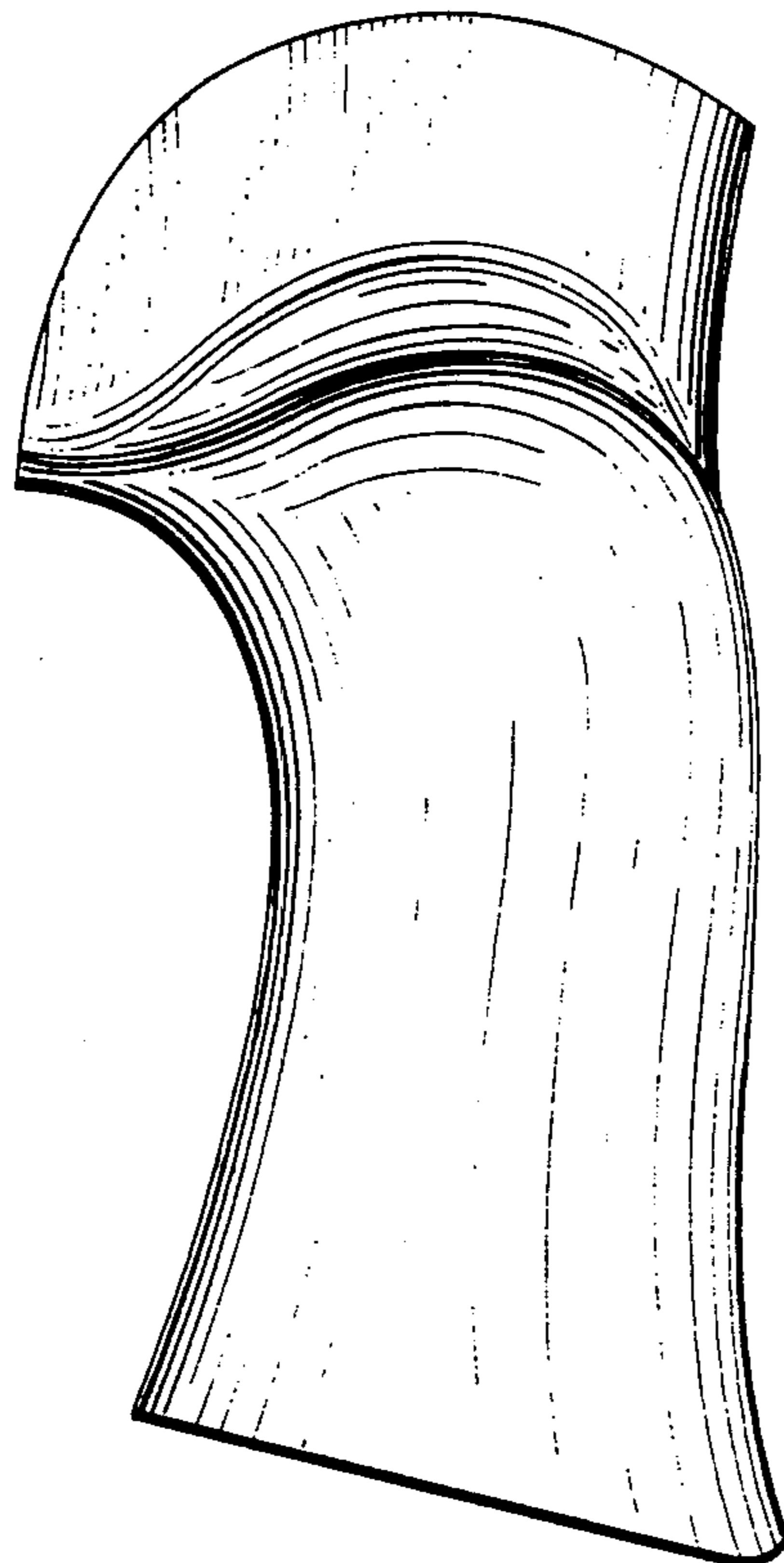
