[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a golf club head, substan-  
tially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a golf club head.  
FIG. 2 is a rear view of our new and ornamental design  
for a golf club head on a No. 3 iron.  
FIG. 3 is a section view through line 3—3 of FIG. 2.  
FIG. 4 is an end view of a golf club head having our  
new ornamental design on a No. 6 iron.  
FIG. 5 is a rear view showing our new and ornamental  
design on a No. 9 iron.  
FIG. 6 is a section view of FIG. 5 through line 6—6.  
The dominant feature of our design resides in the ap-  
pearance of the rear portion of the club head.

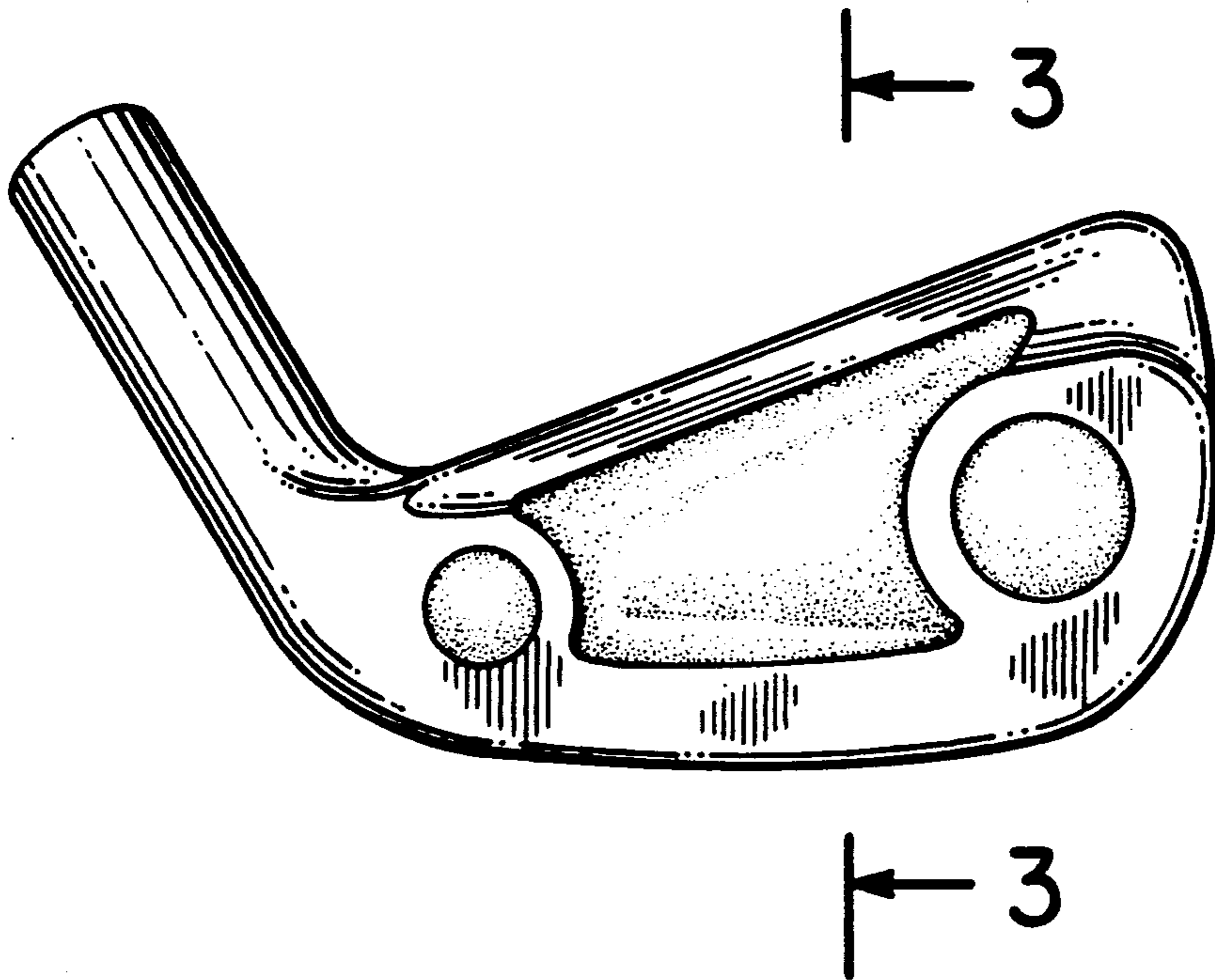

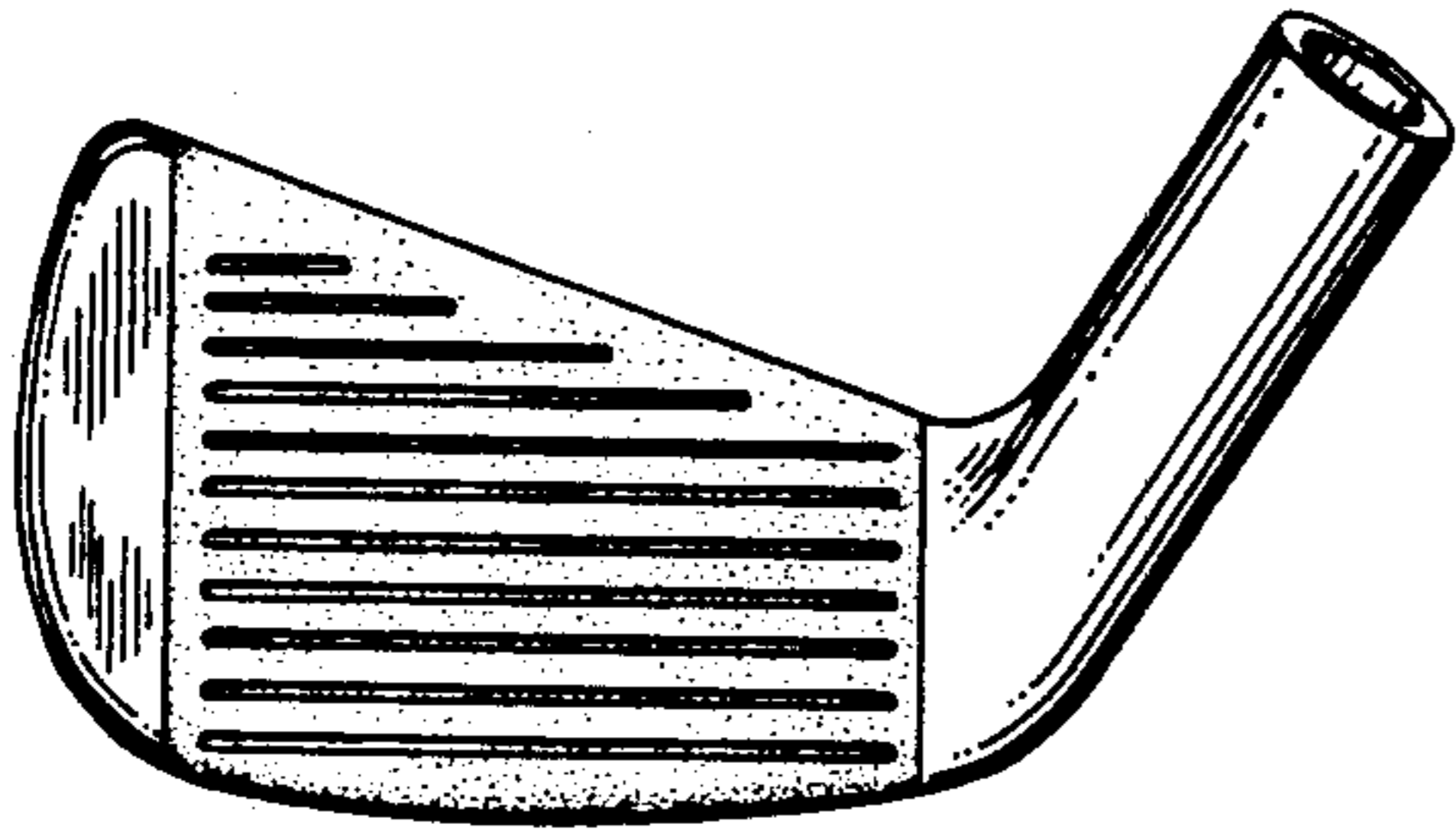

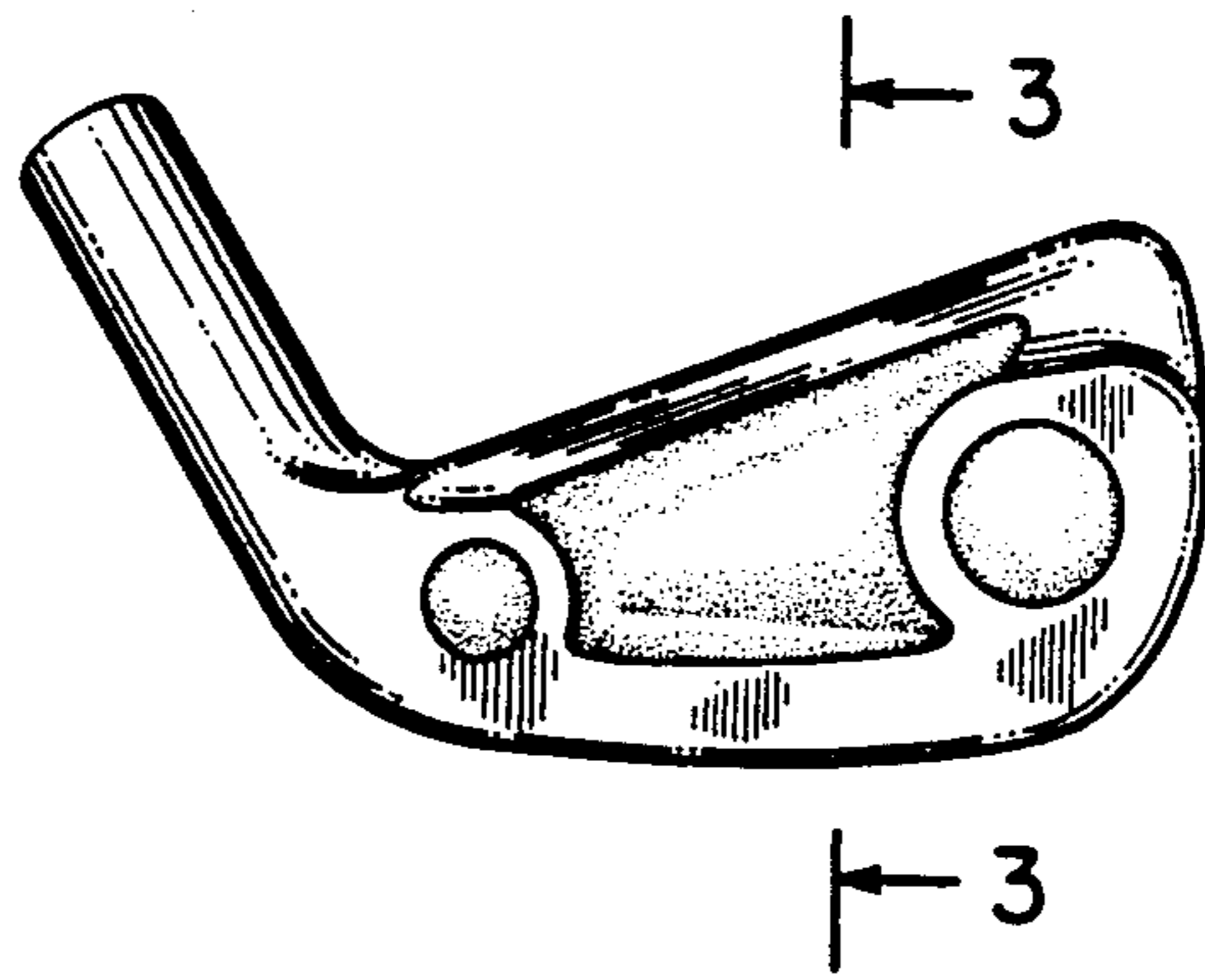

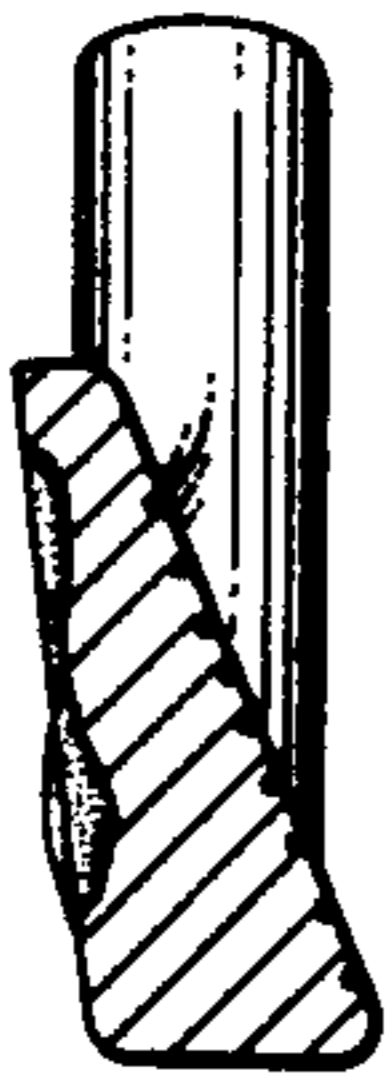

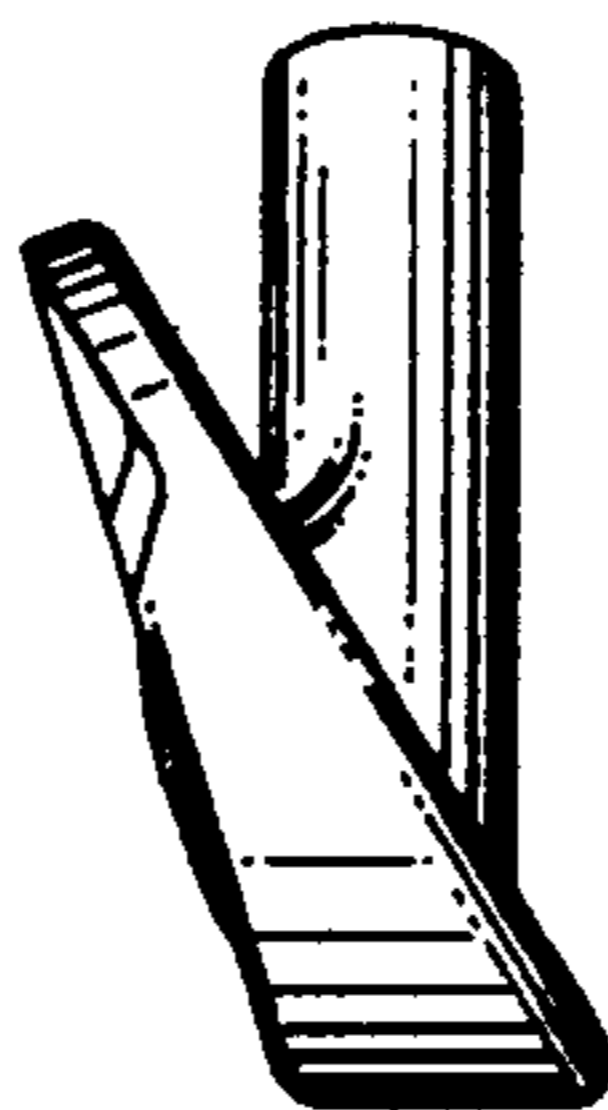

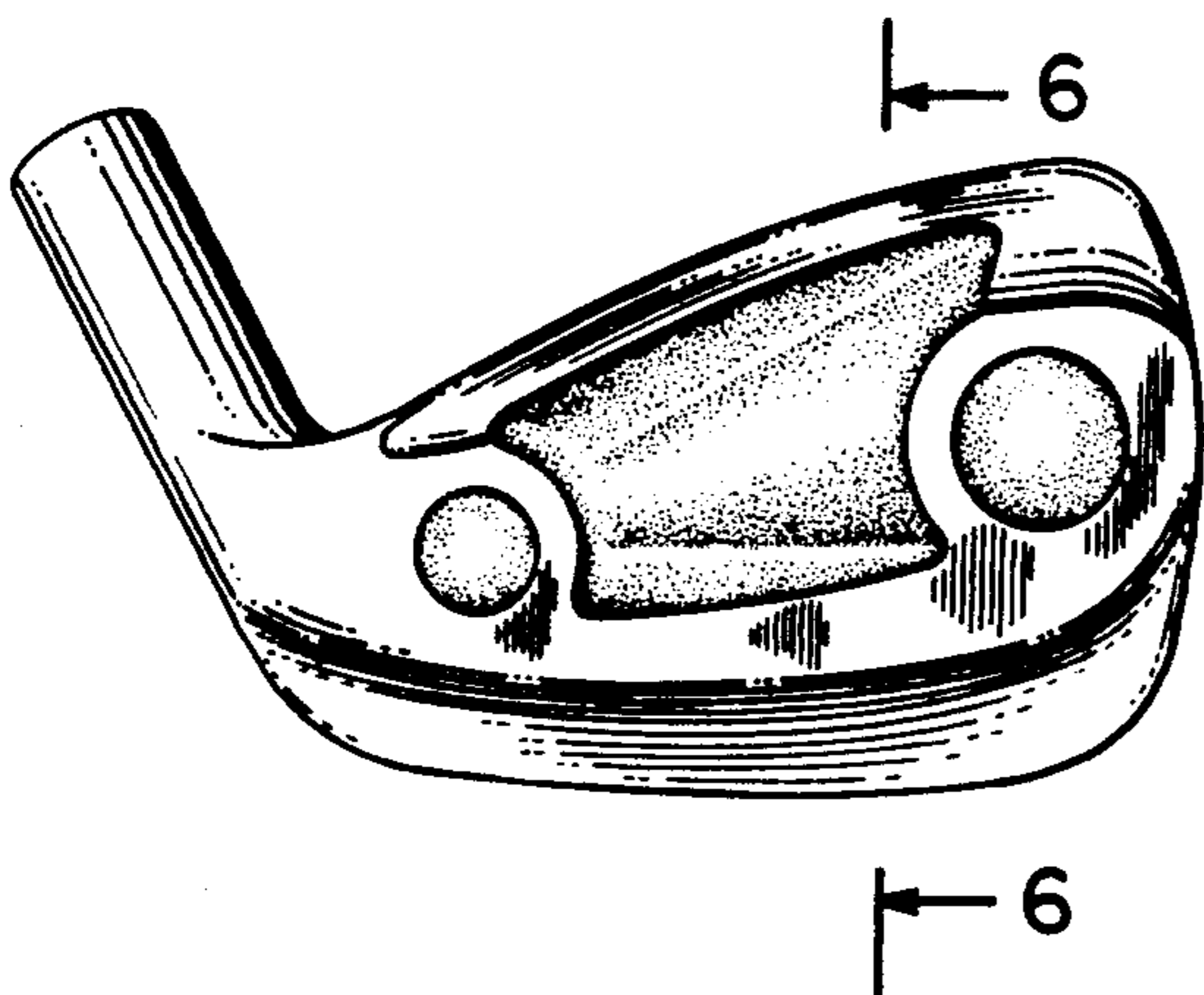
