FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the claimed cigarette
lighter pouch;

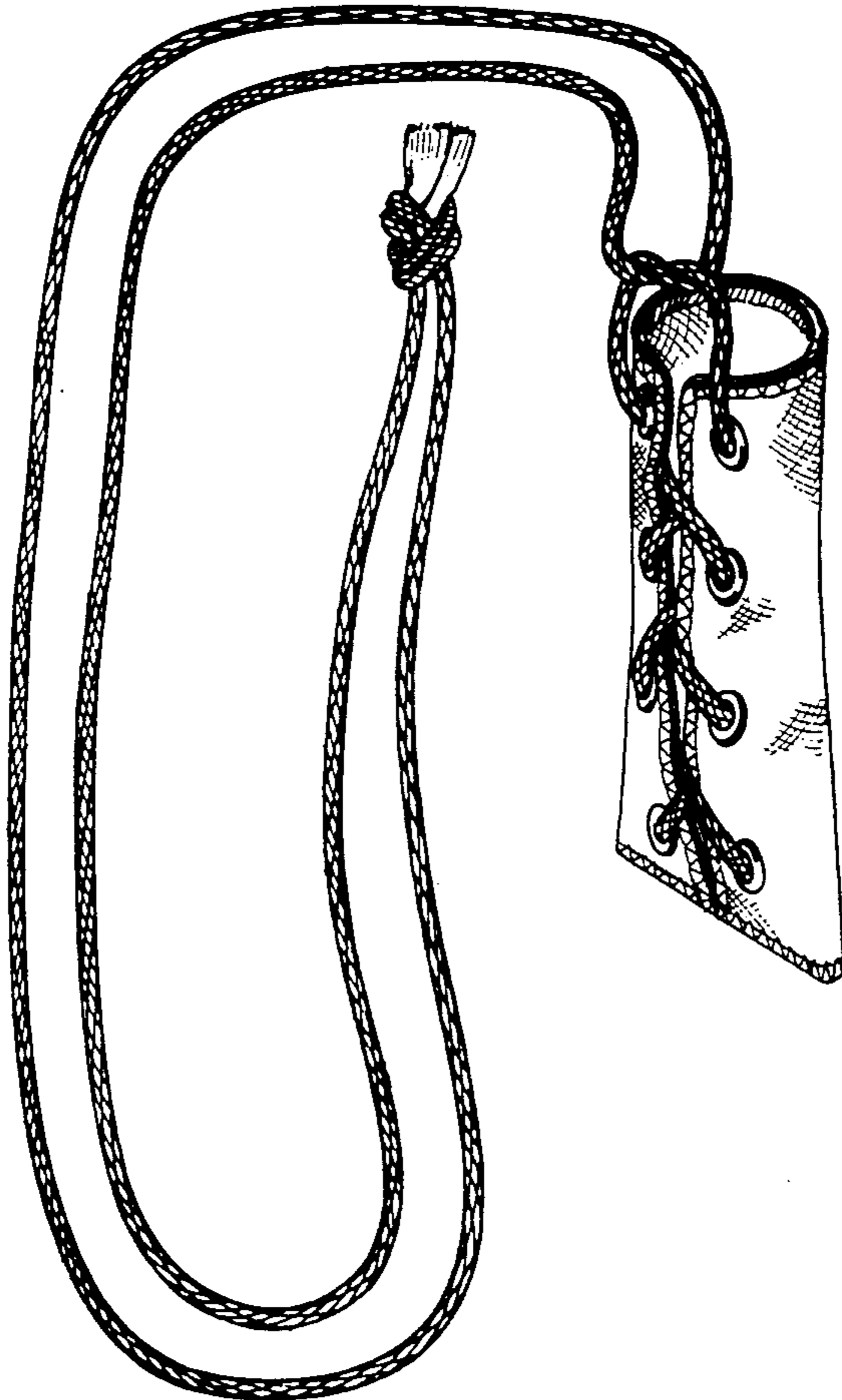
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front view of a second embodiment of the
cigarette lighter pouch, the two embodiments differing
only in the front lacing.

mentarily shown in FIG. 5 for convenience of illustra-
tion.



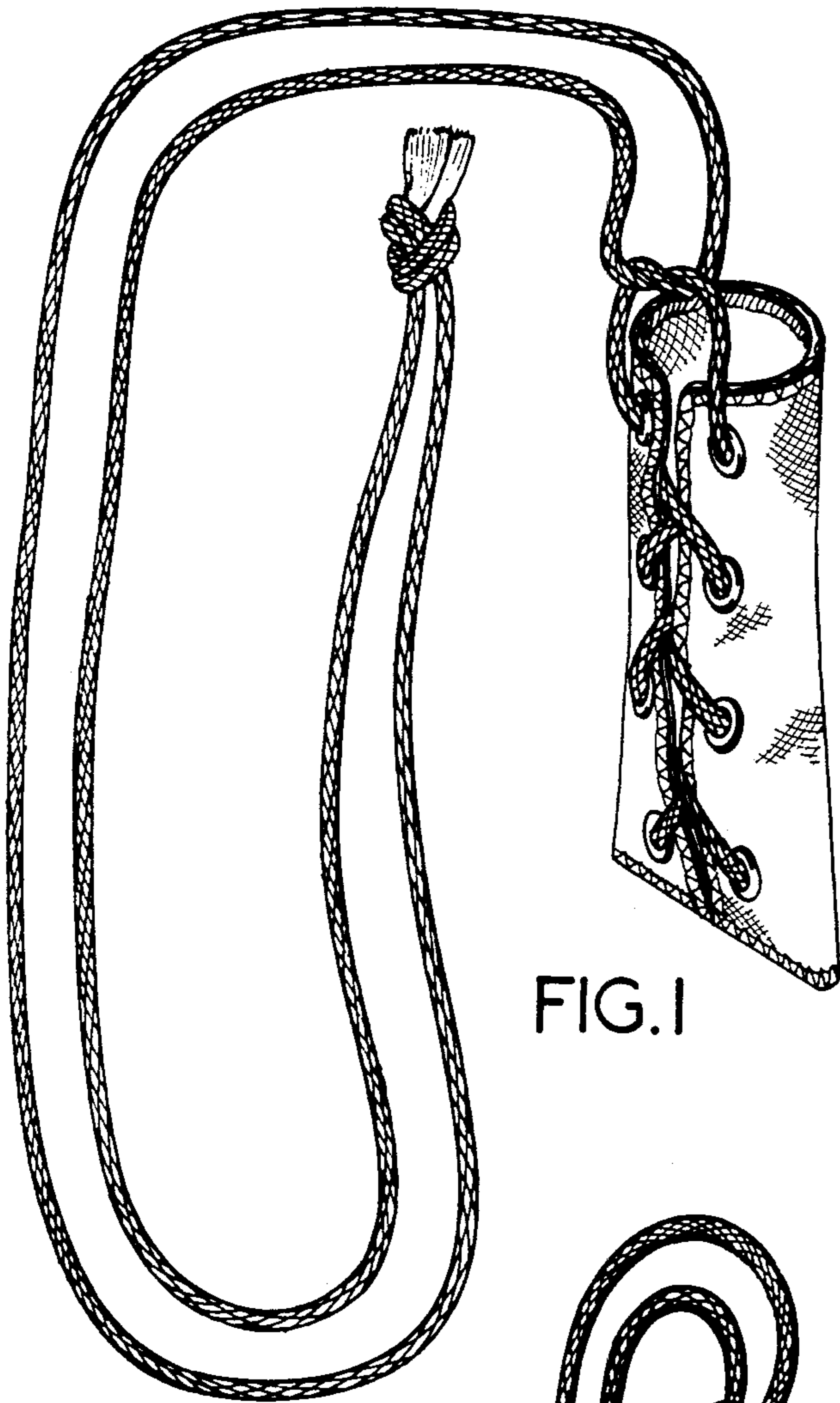

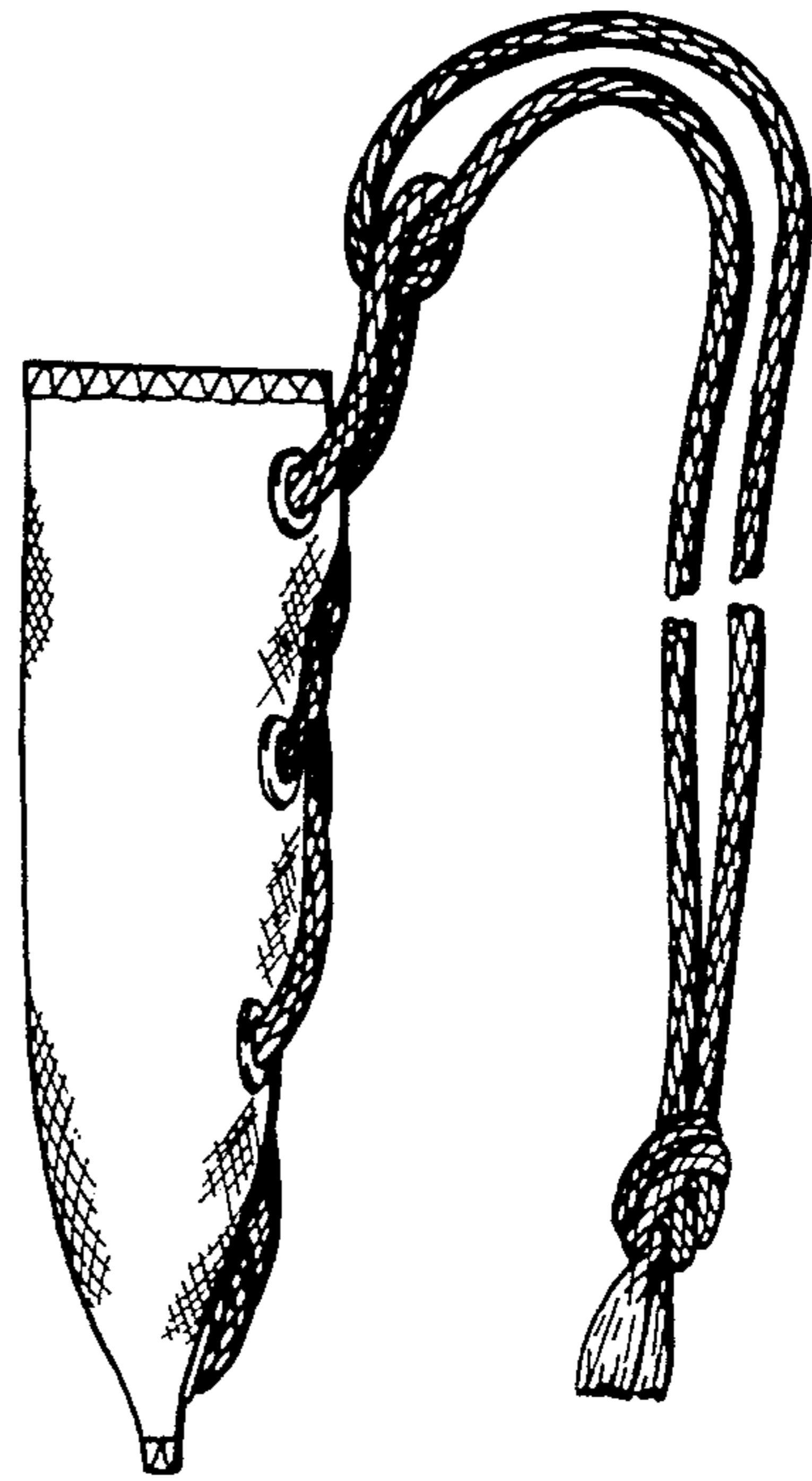

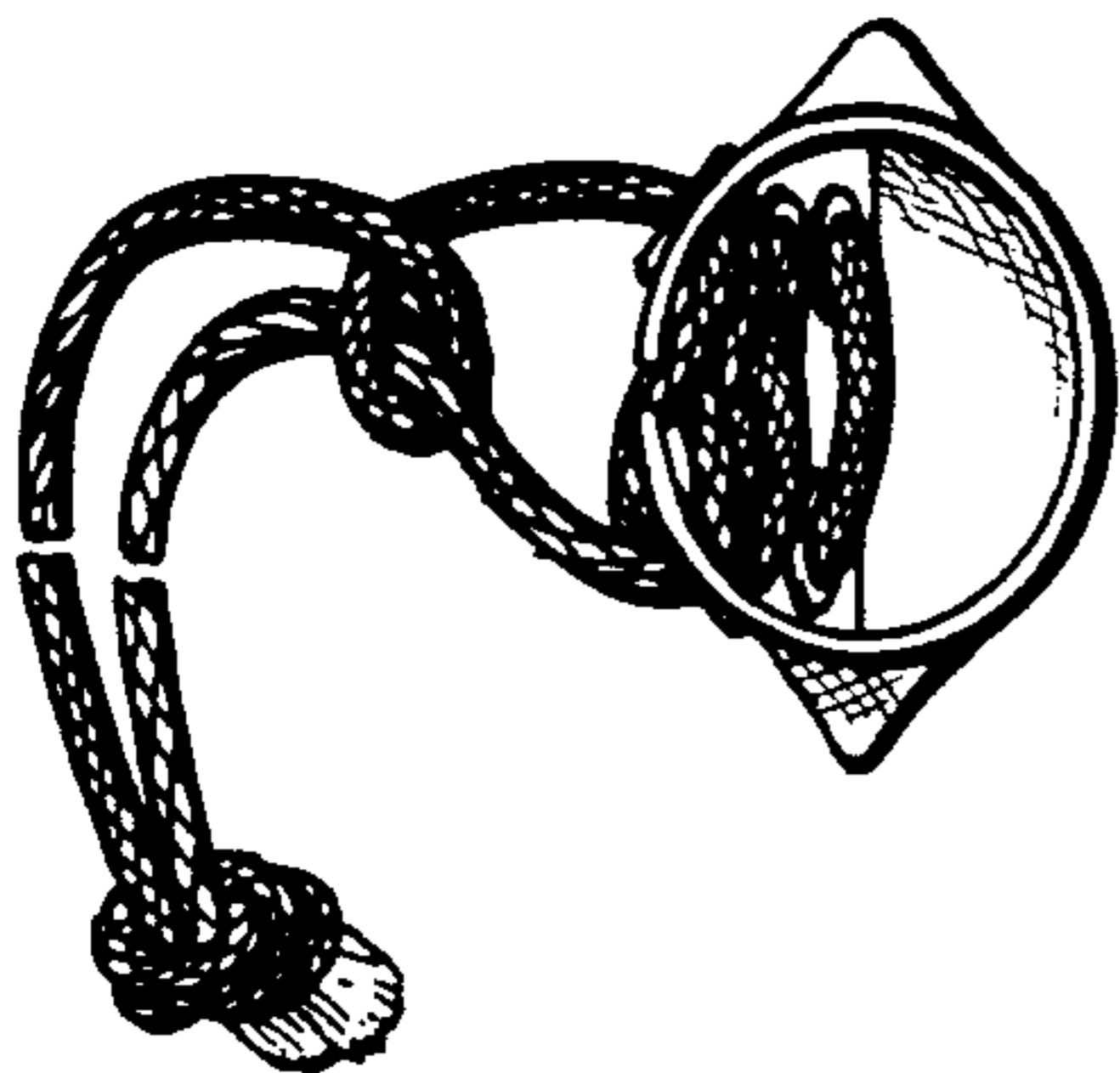

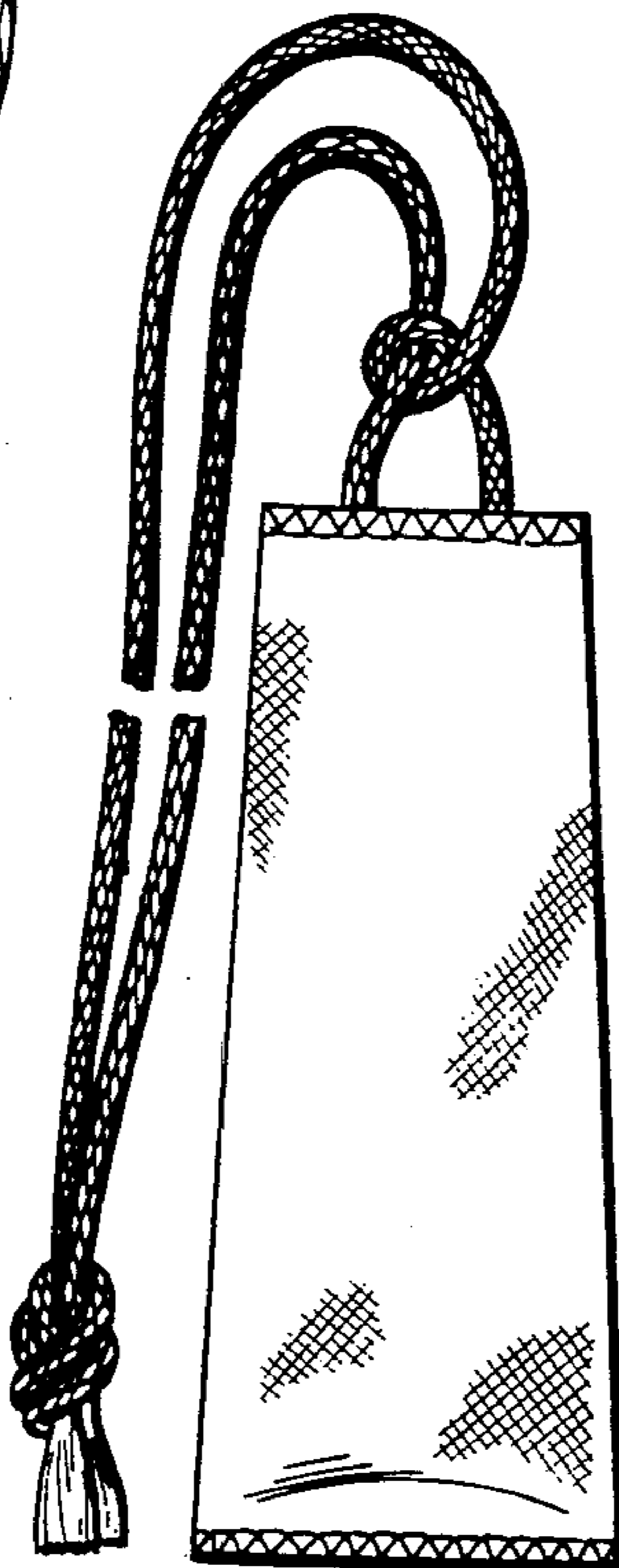

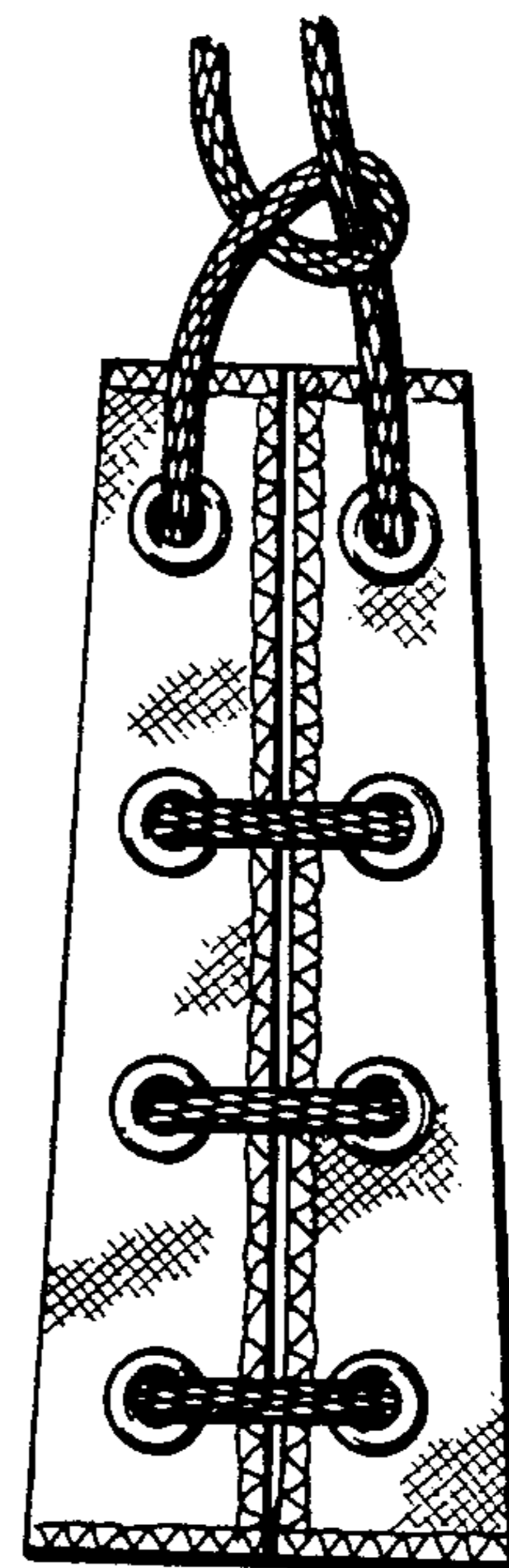
