The ornamental design for a rotary stand for potted plants, as shown and described.

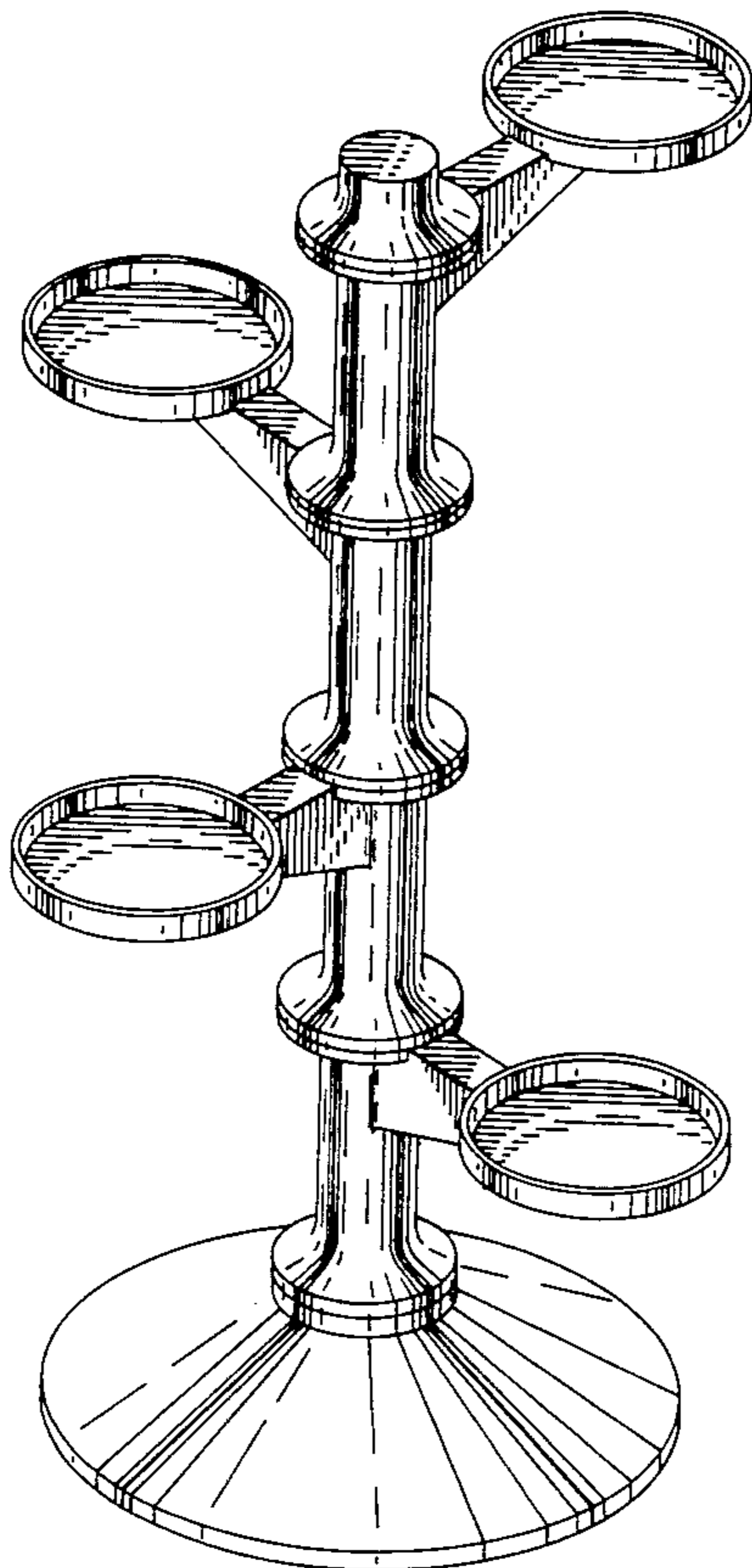
DESCRIPTION

The bottom of the stand is a plane surface.



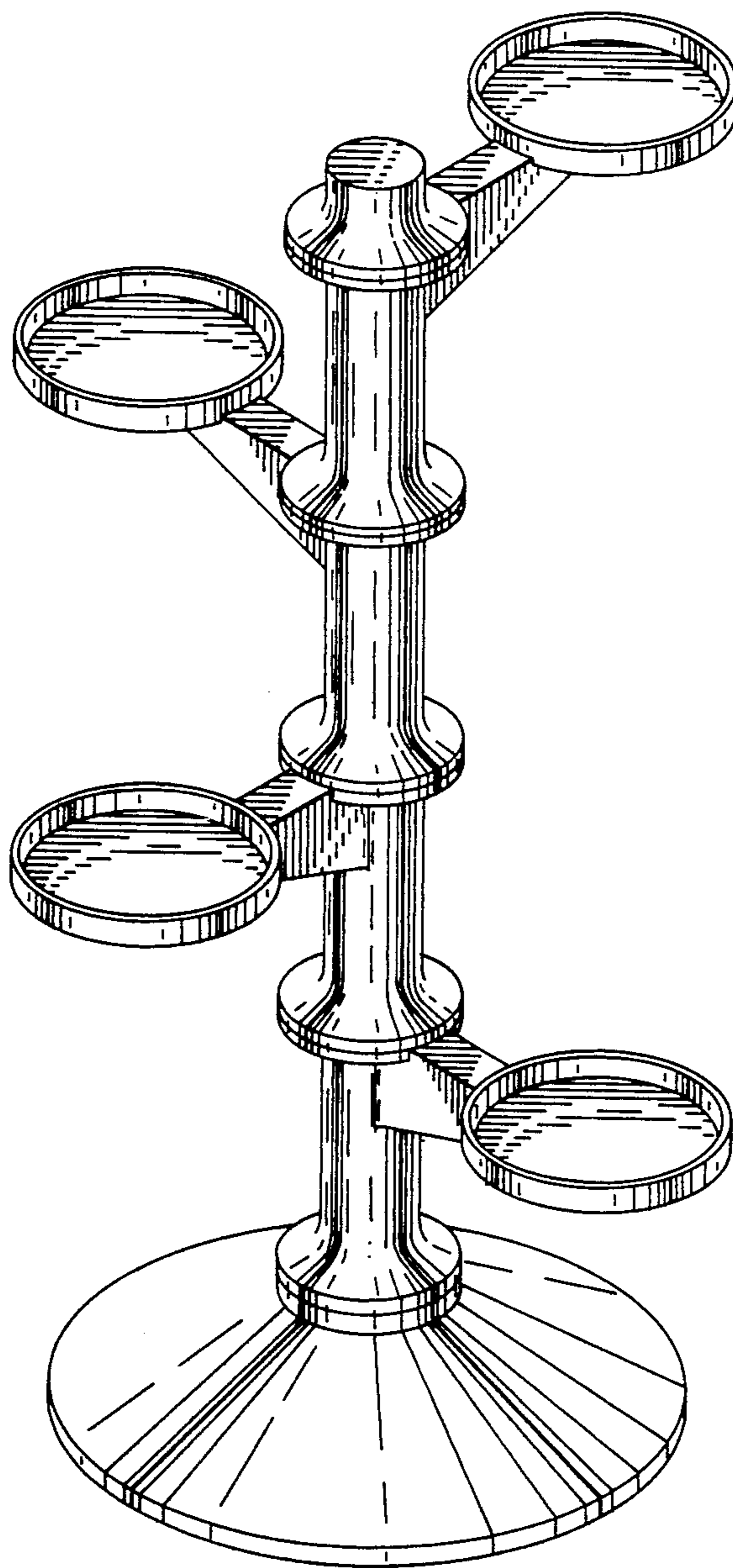

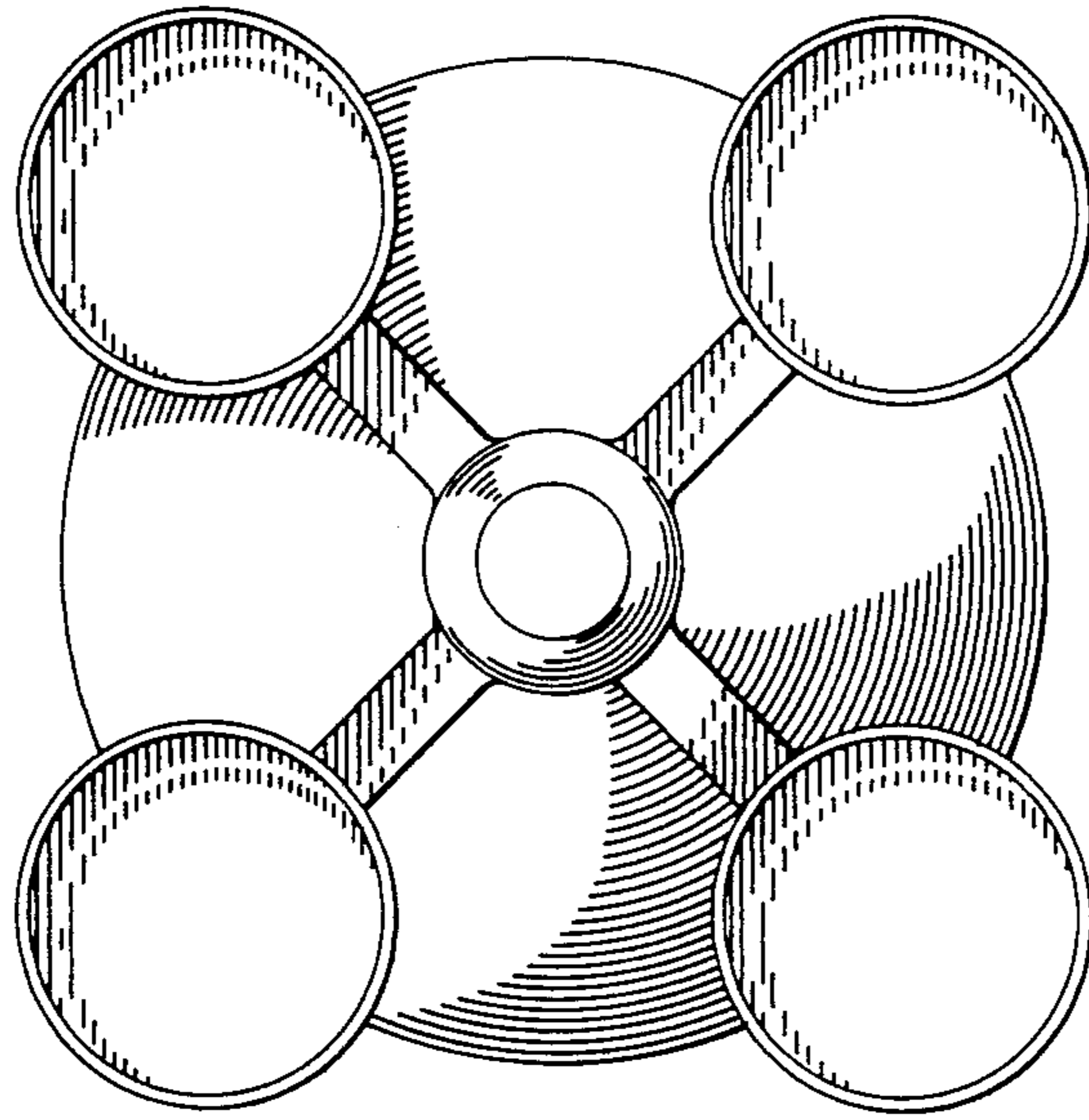

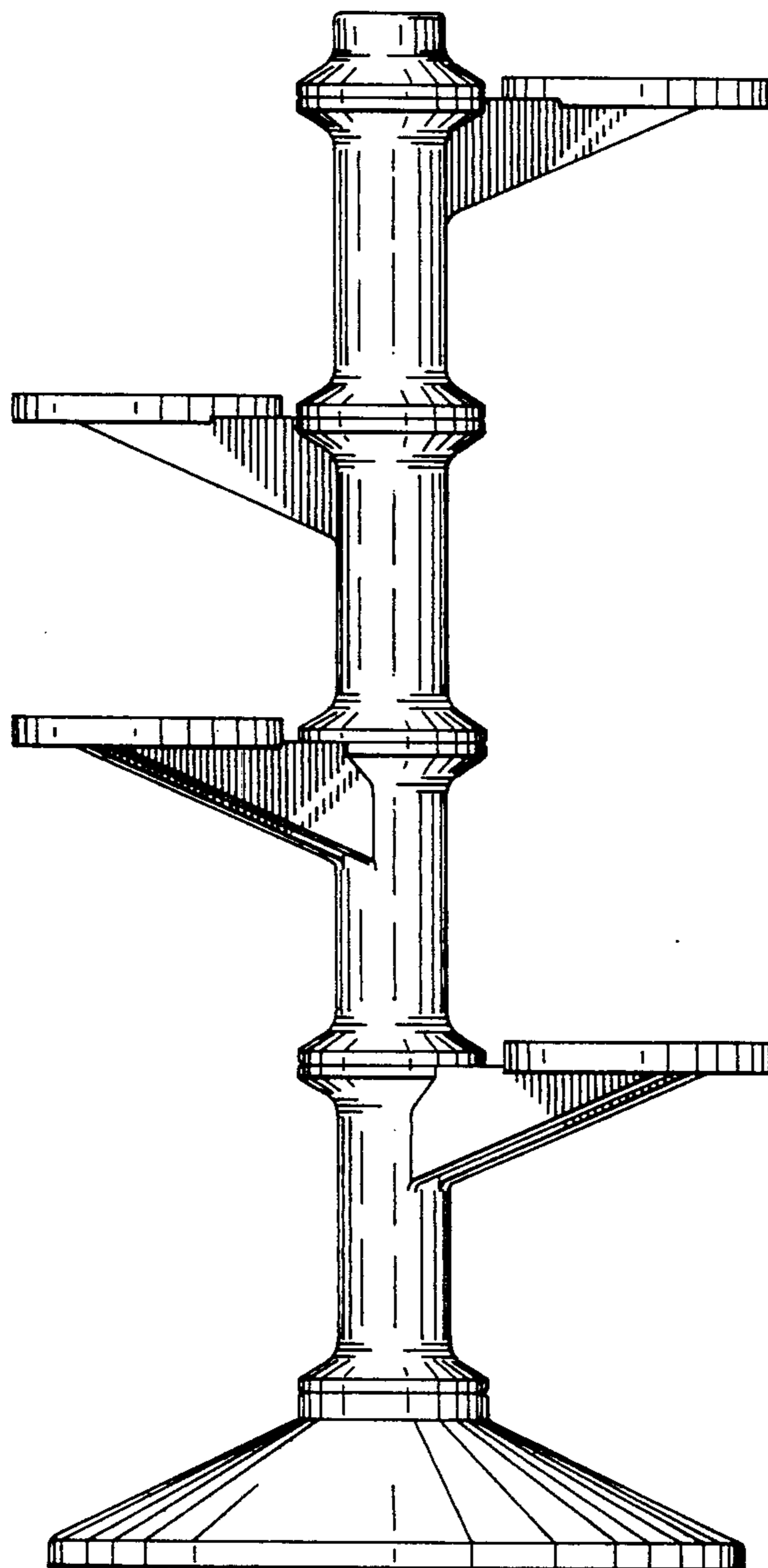
