[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an attachable support bracket for the ends of horizontal shelves, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing an attachable support bracket for the ends of horizontal shelves, with a fragmentary portion of one shelf being illustrated in phantom for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a perspective view on a slightly enlarged scale of the design; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the design; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the design; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the design; FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the design; and FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the design.

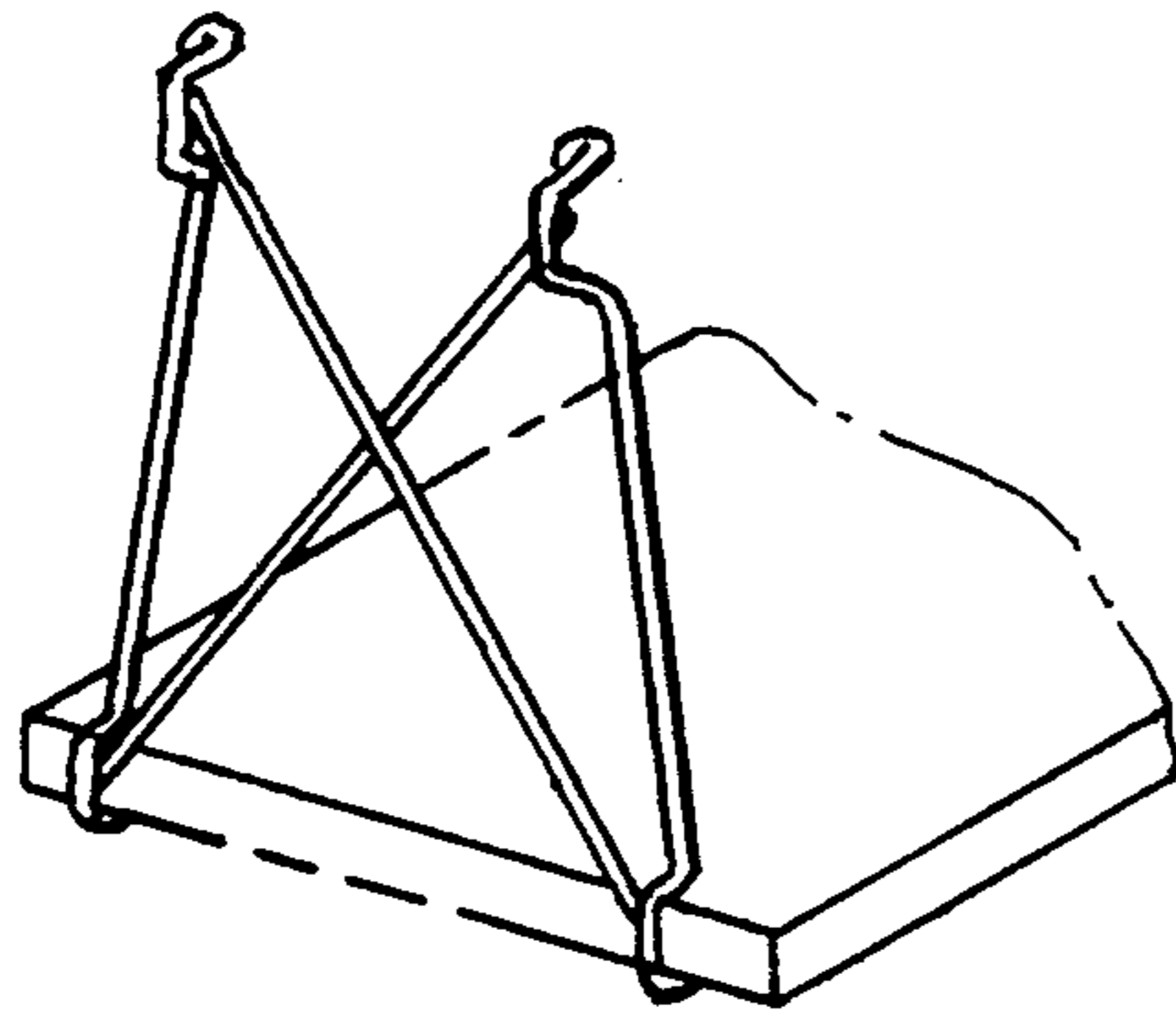

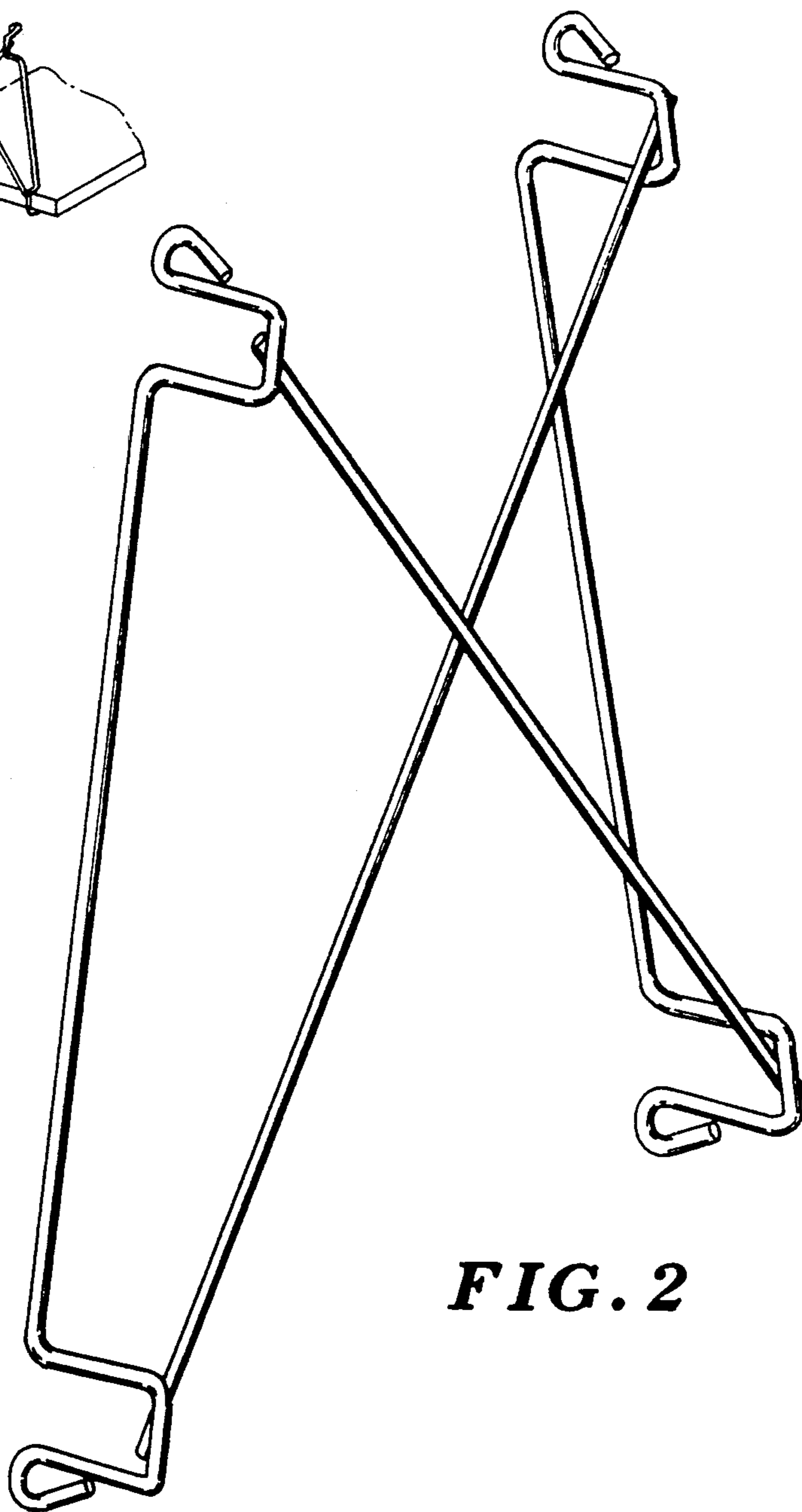
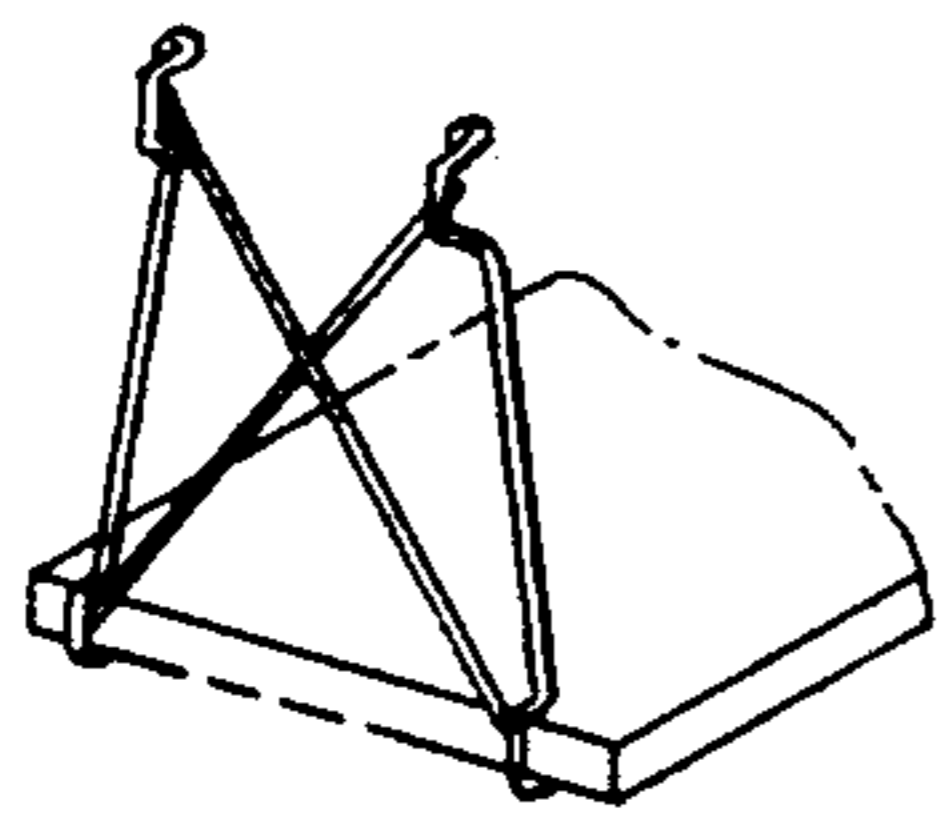

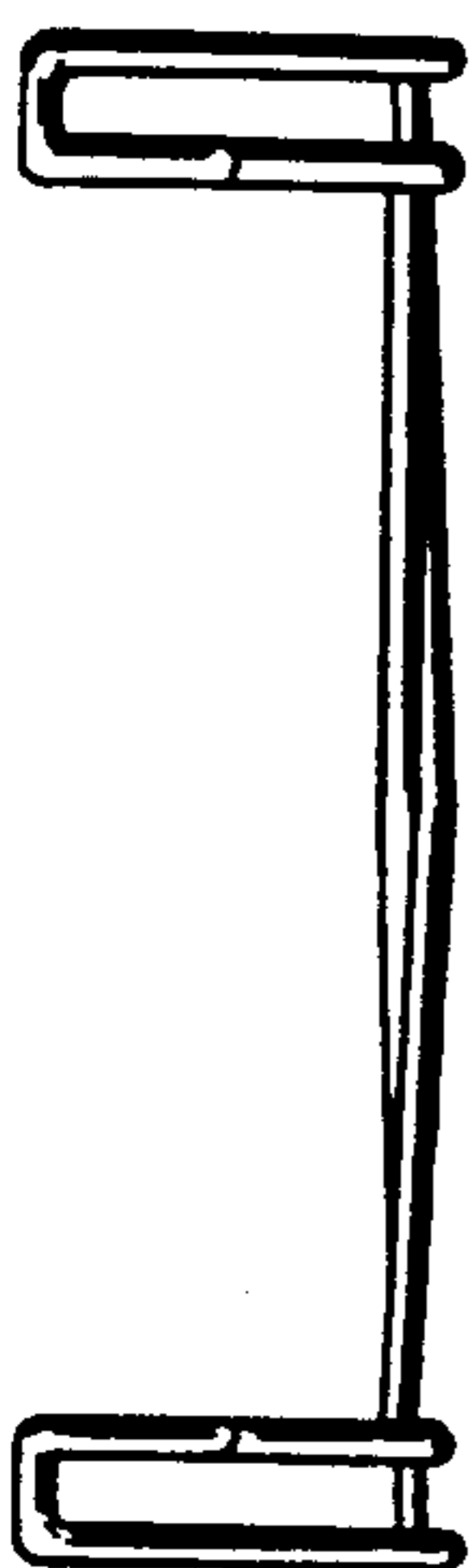

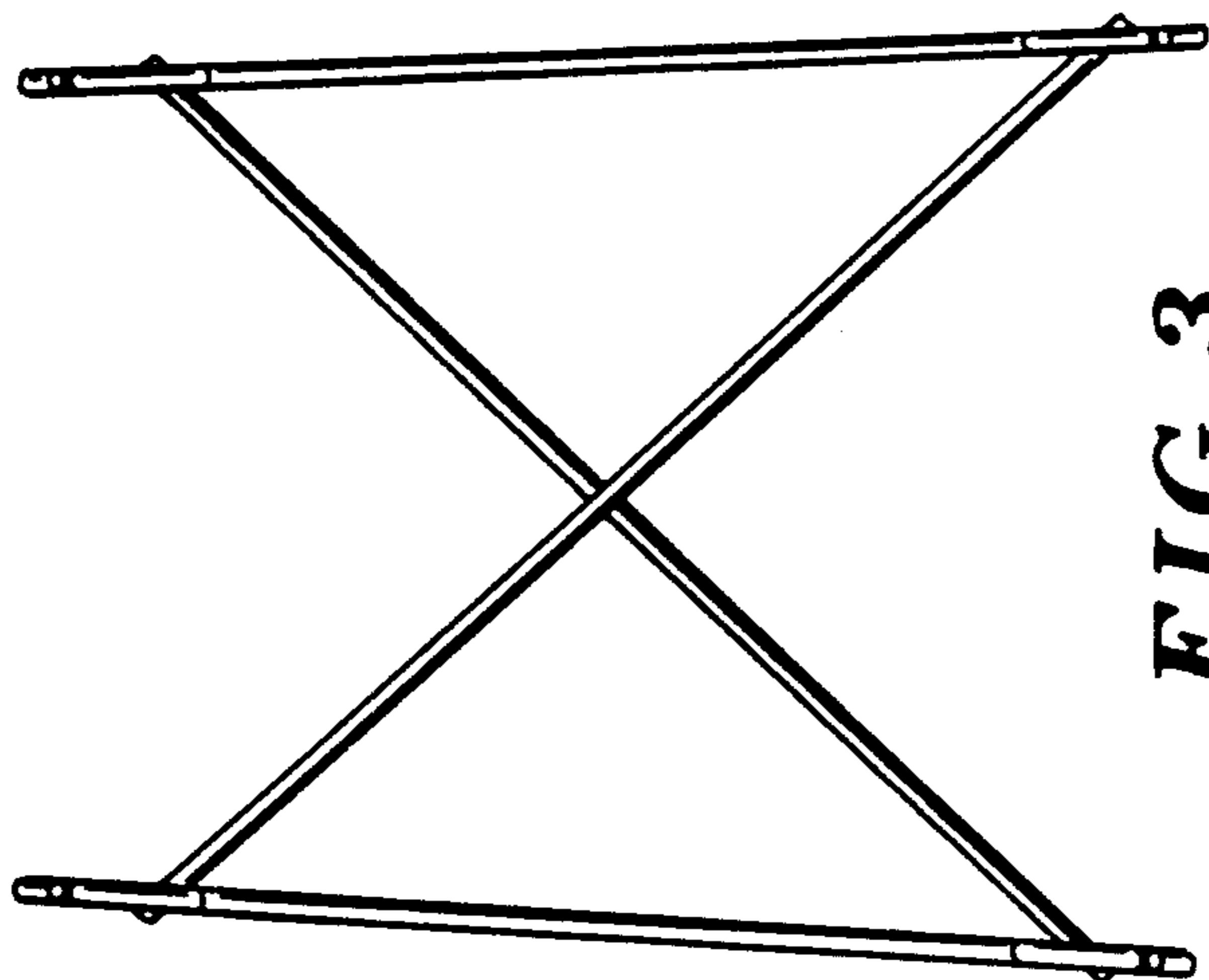

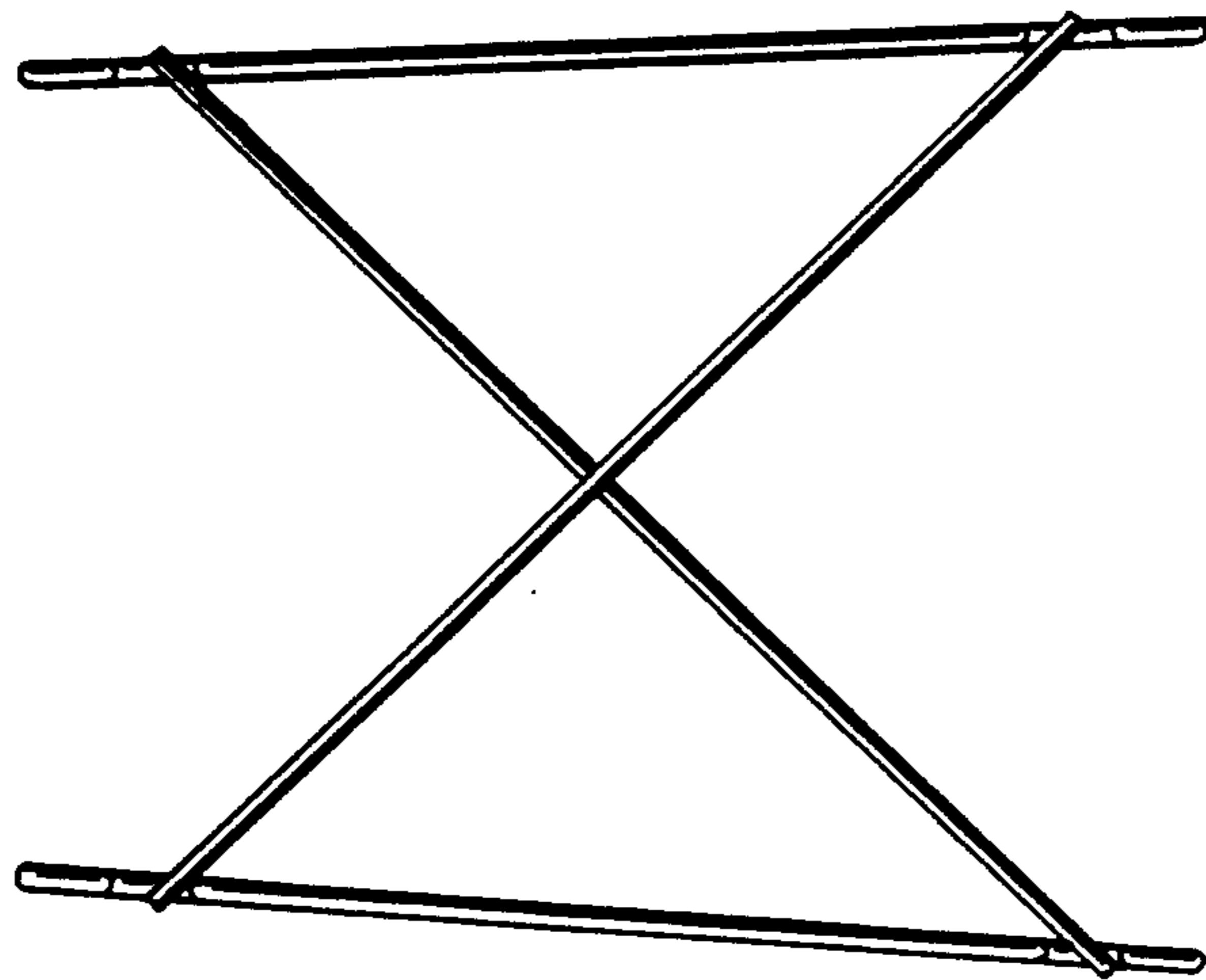

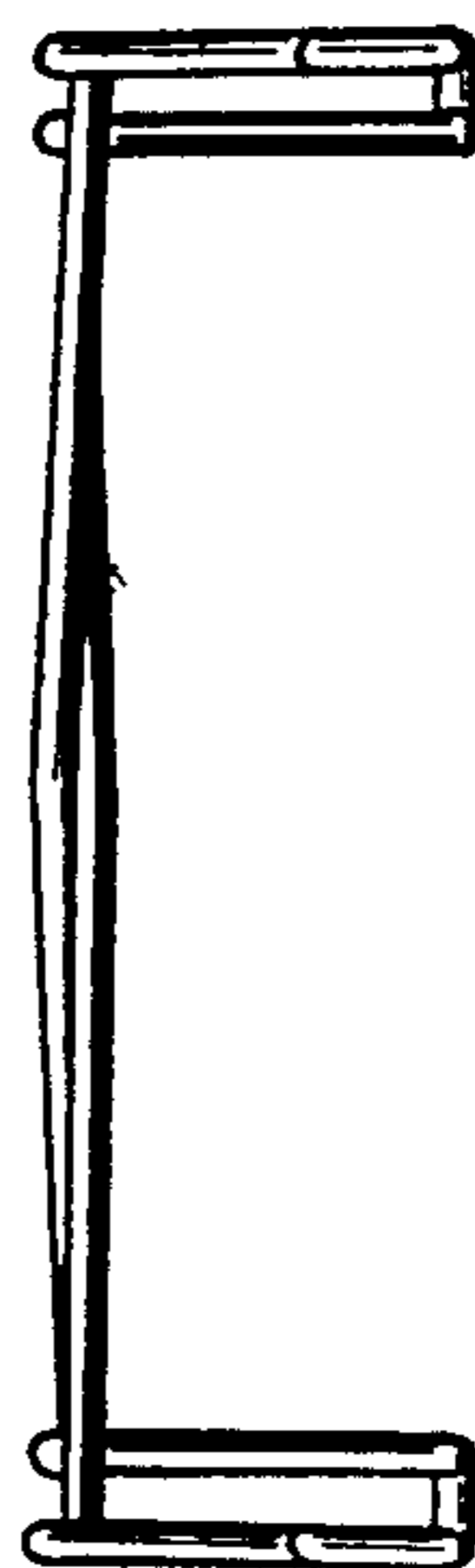
