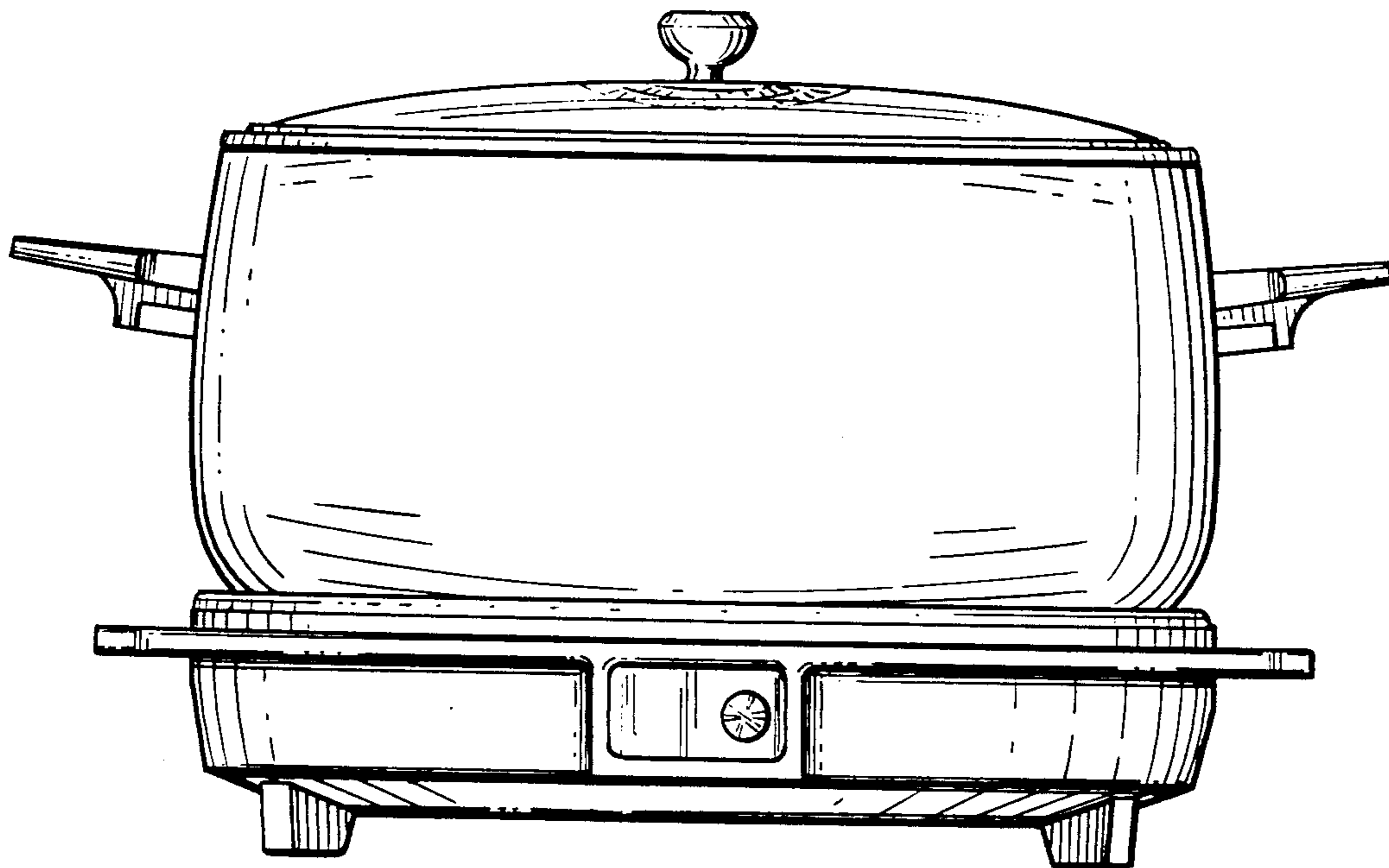

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for electric cooking base and vessel, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of an electric cooking base and vessel showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left end perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right end elevational view of FIG. 1; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



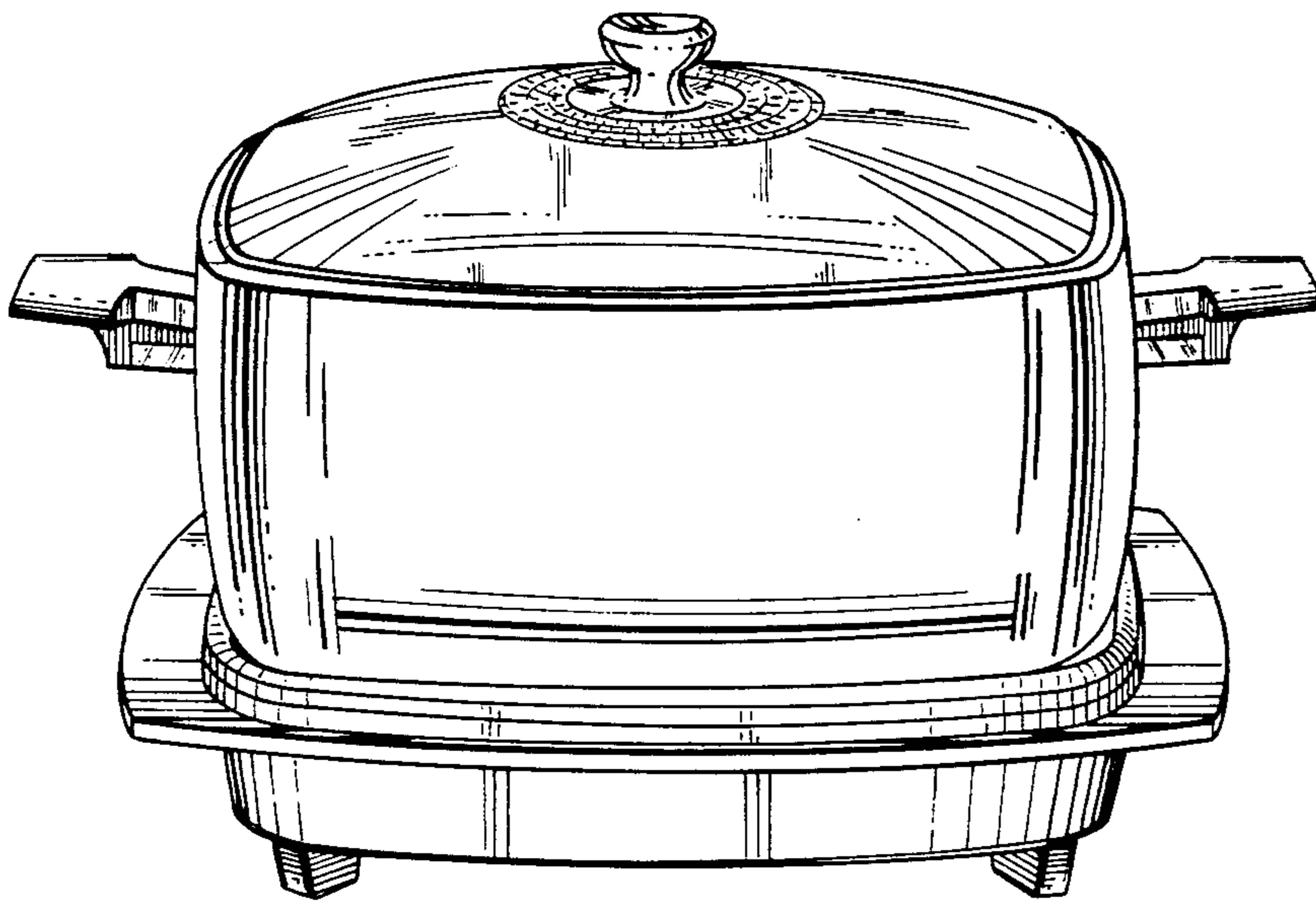

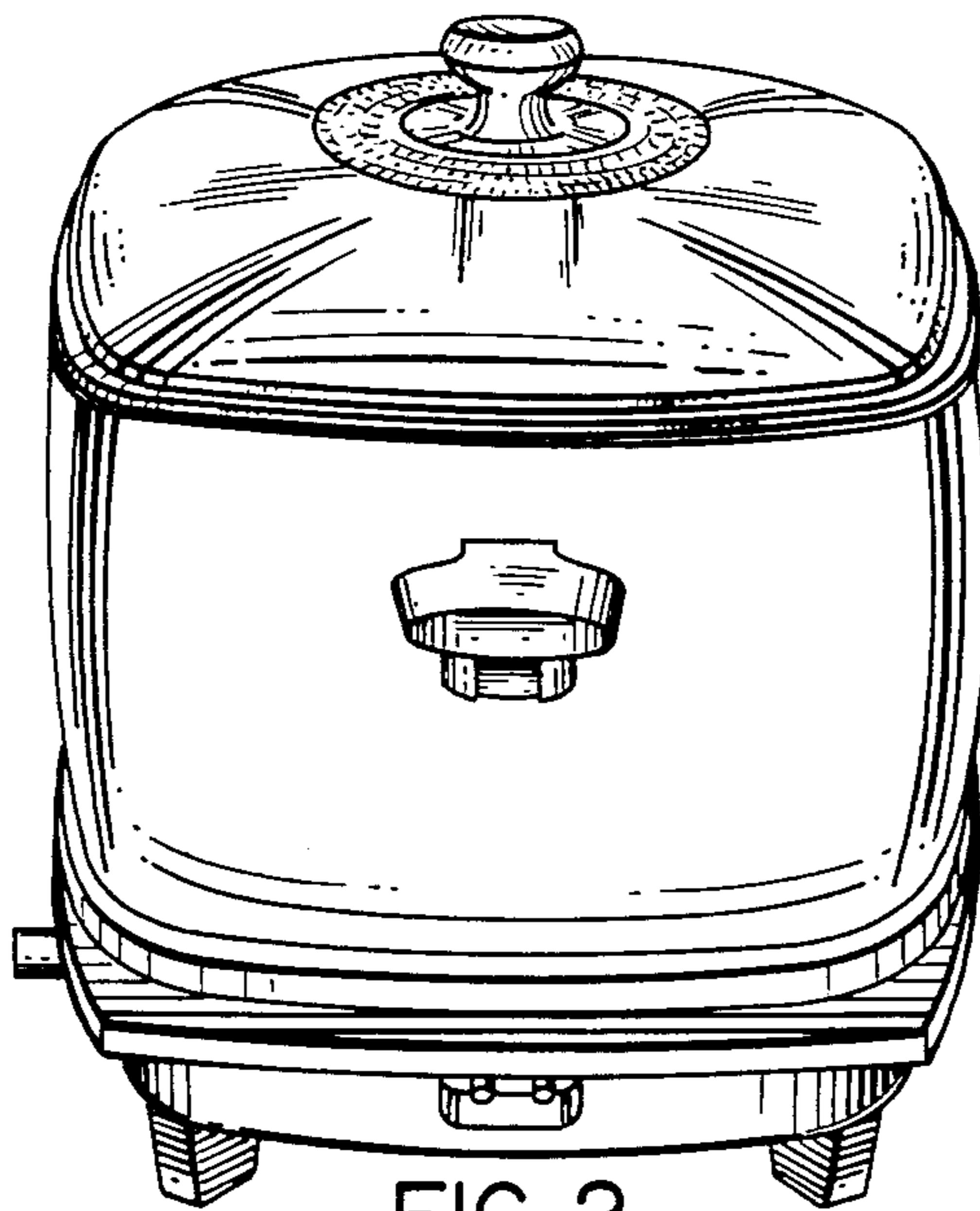

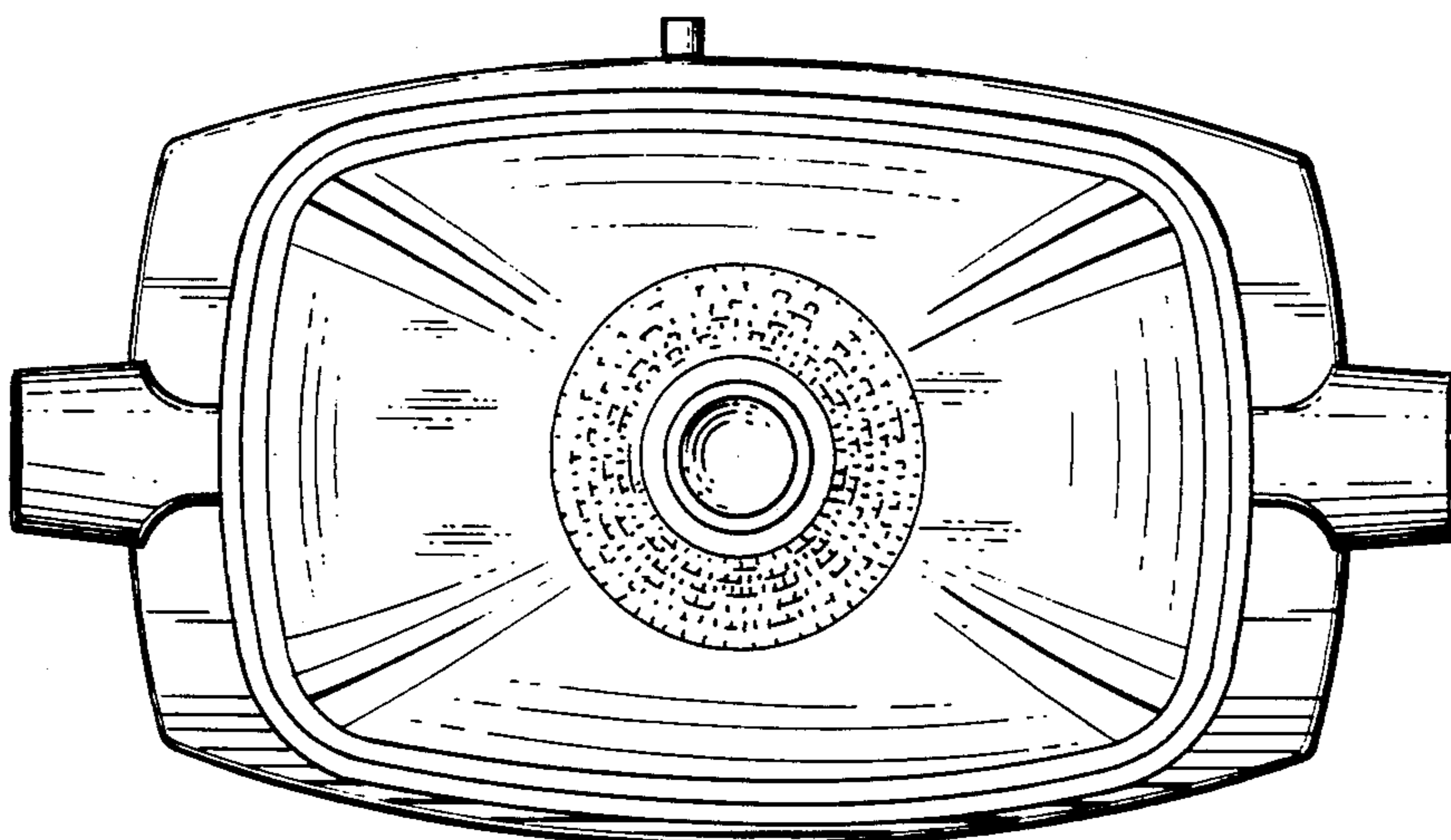

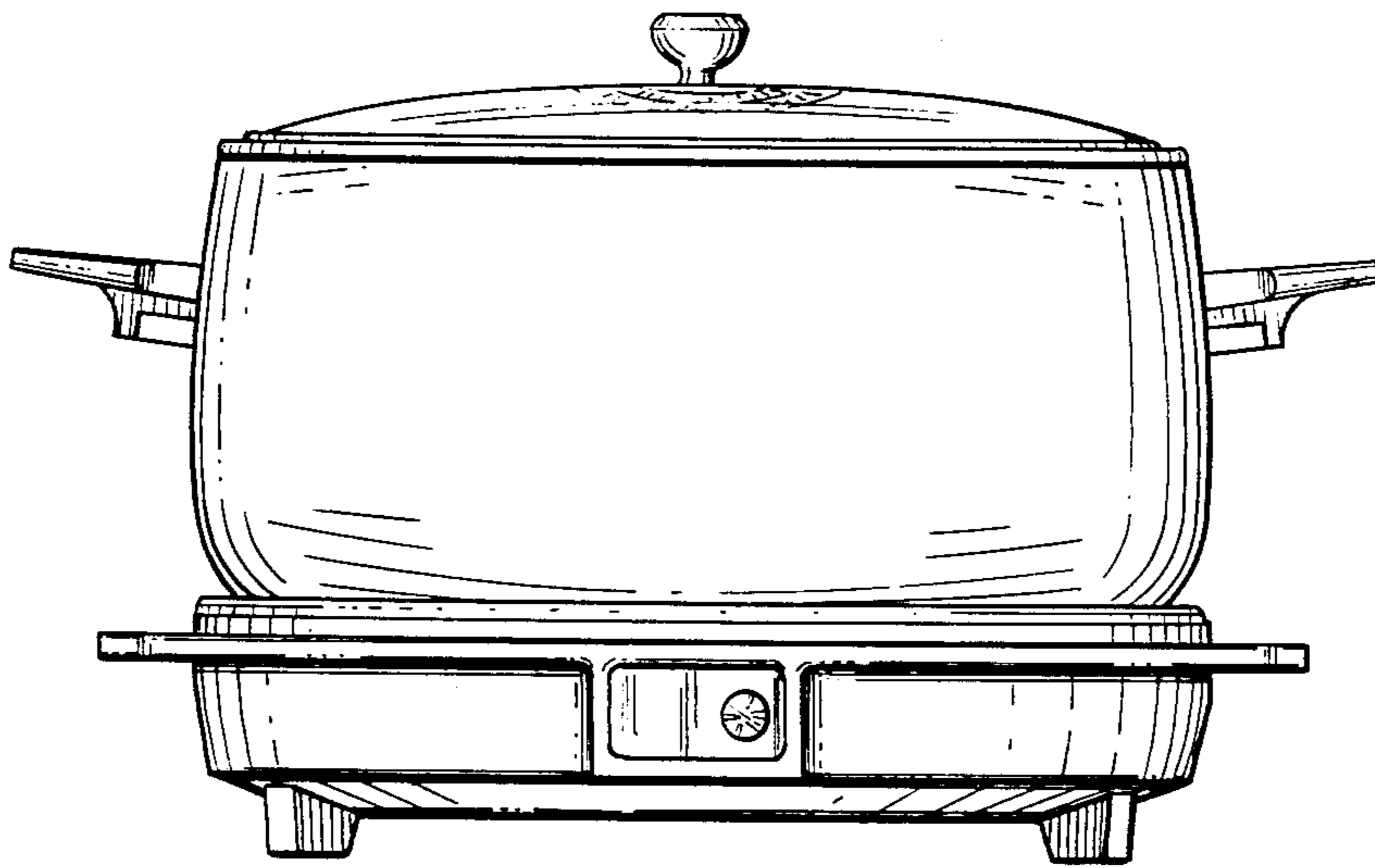

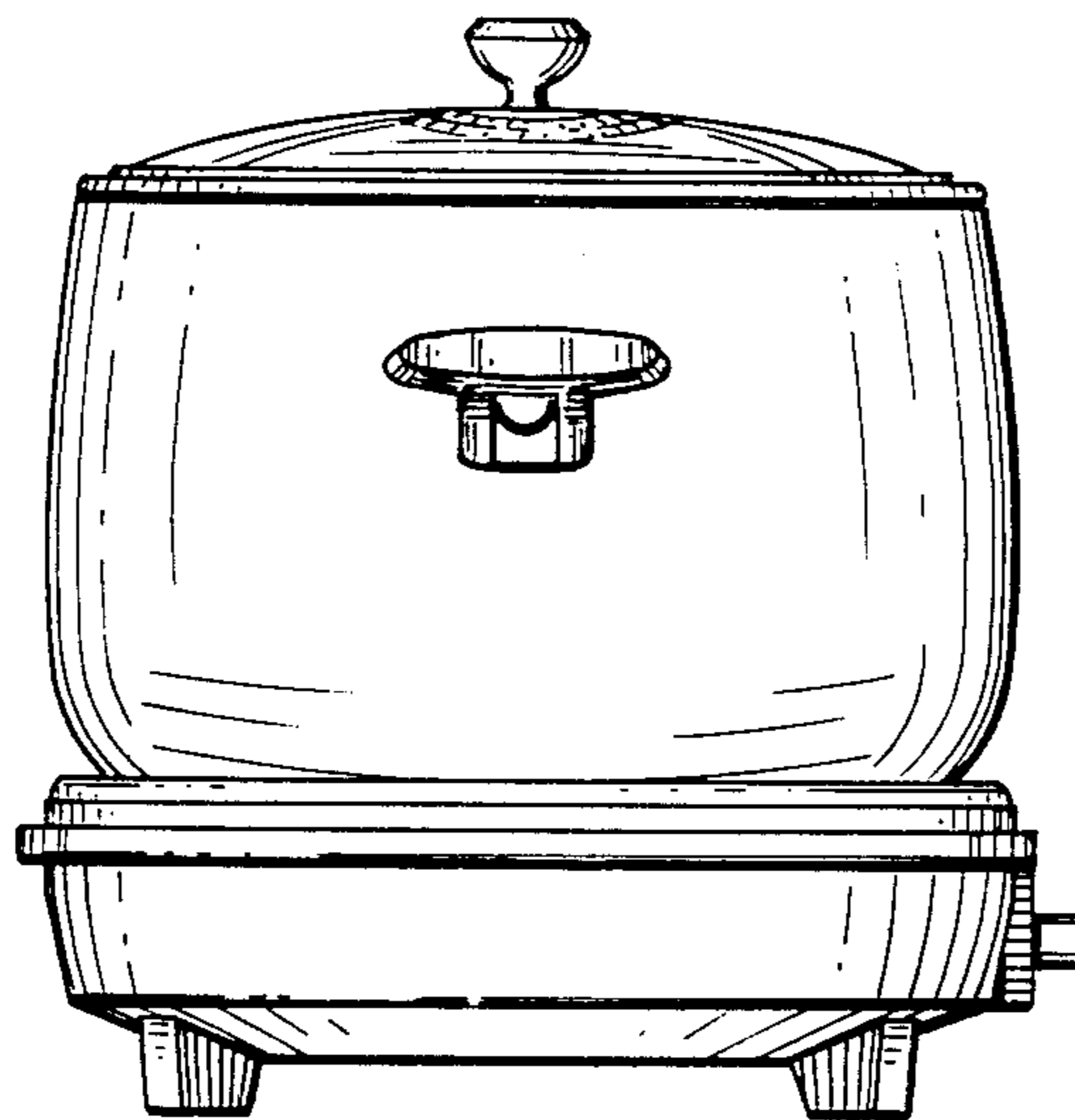

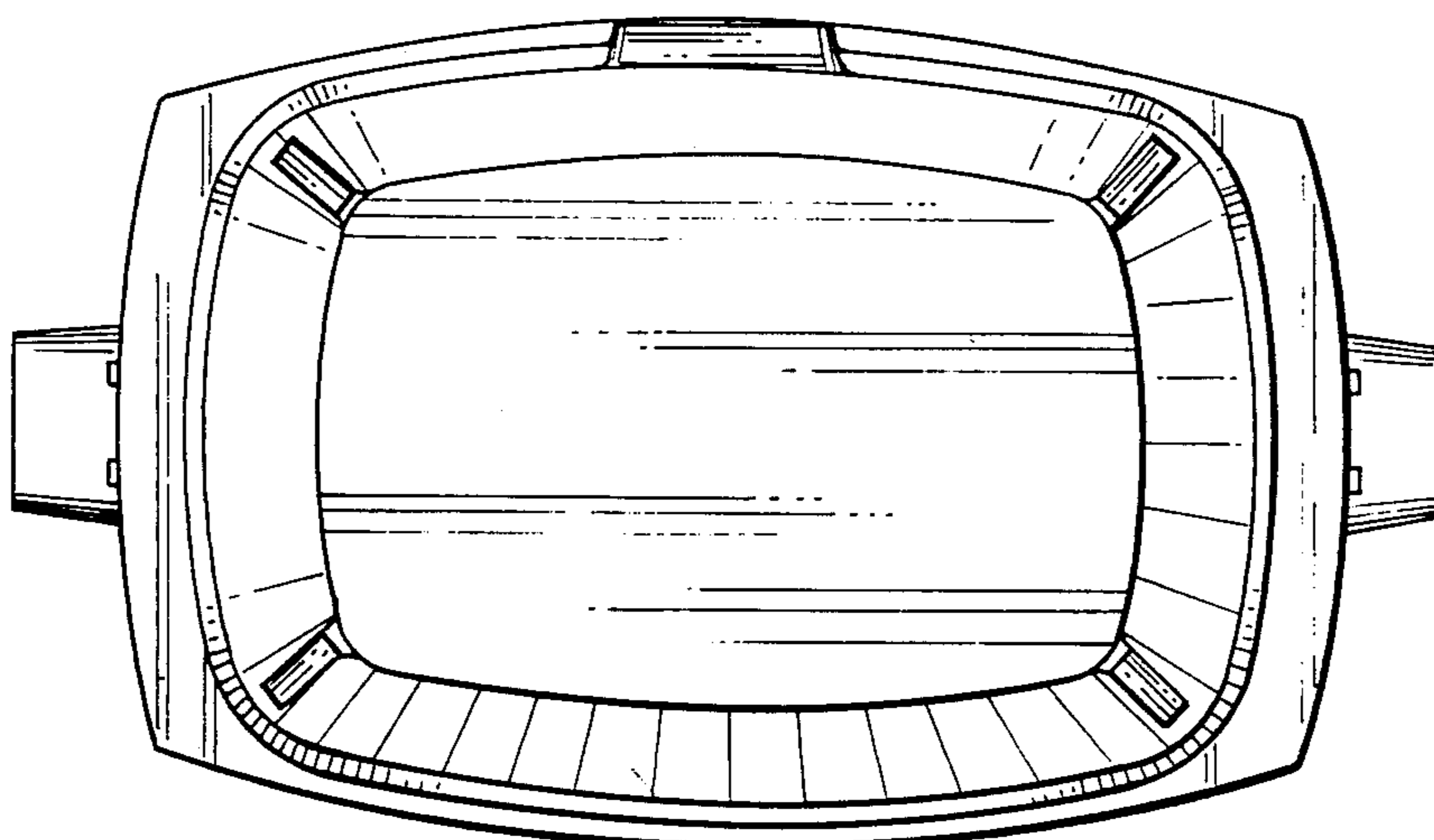
