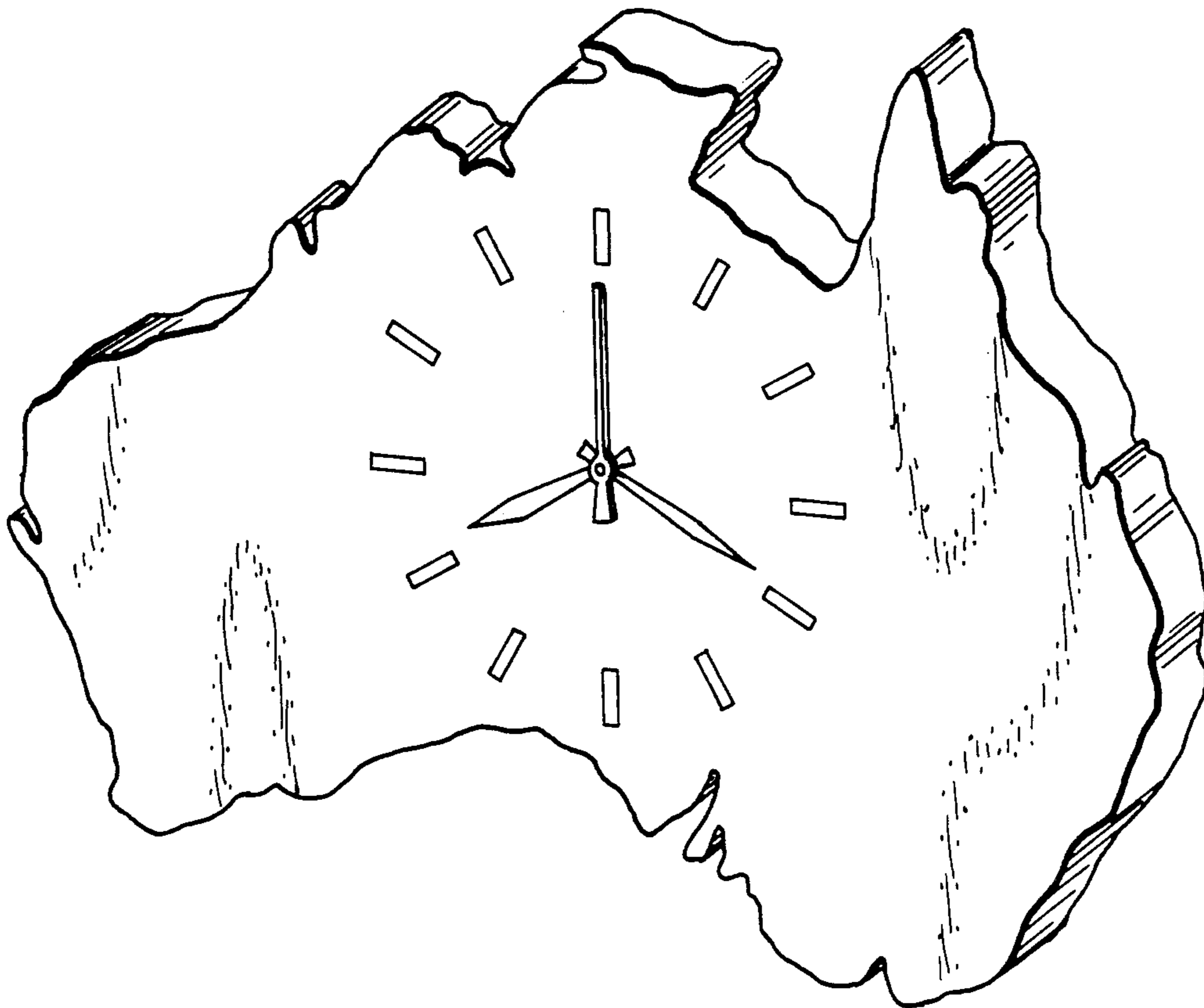

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear, not shown, being plain and conventional.



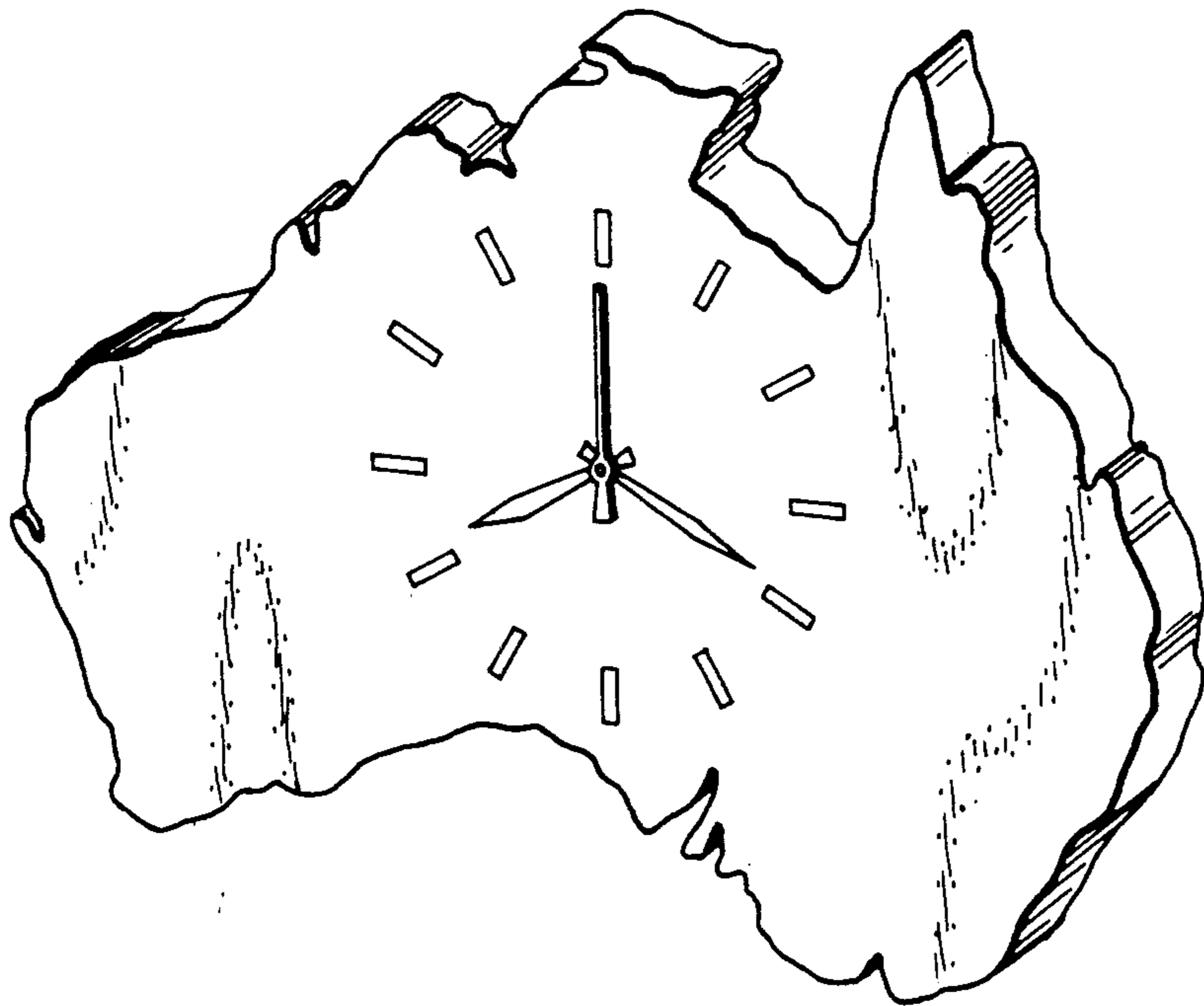

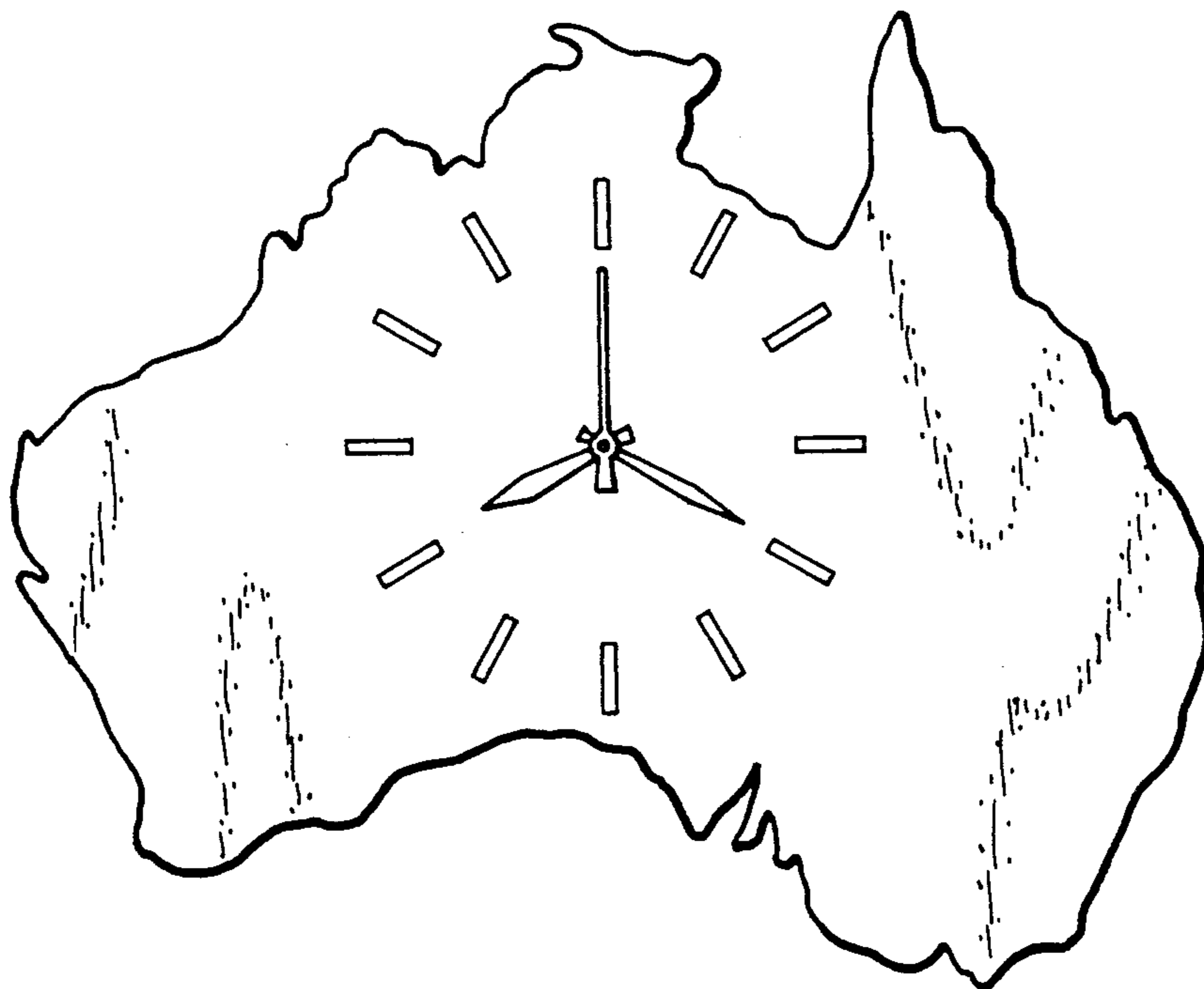
