DESCRIPTION

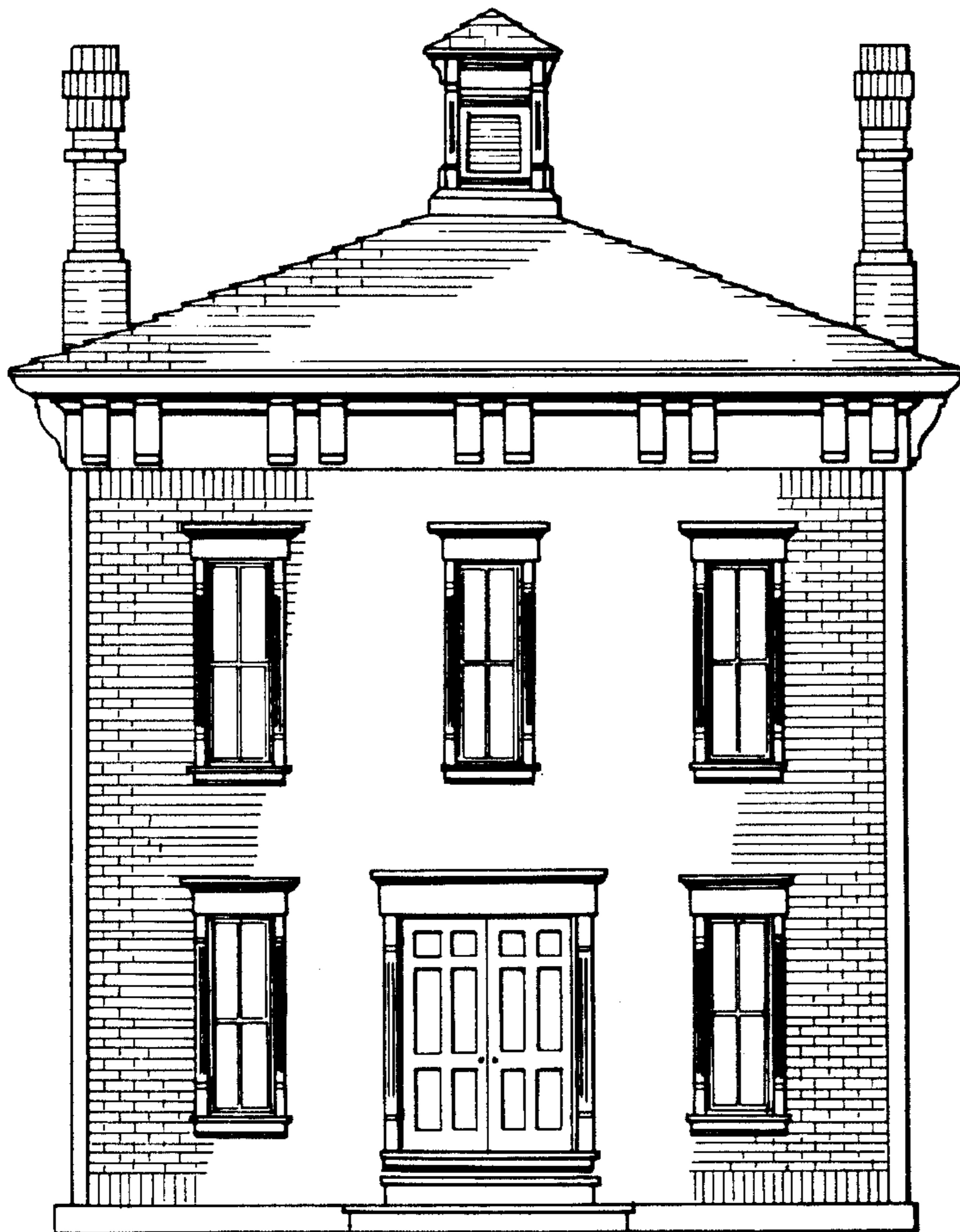
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a doll house showing my new design;

The surface textures partially indicated on the wall, roof and chimney members represent an overall pattern on those surfaces.



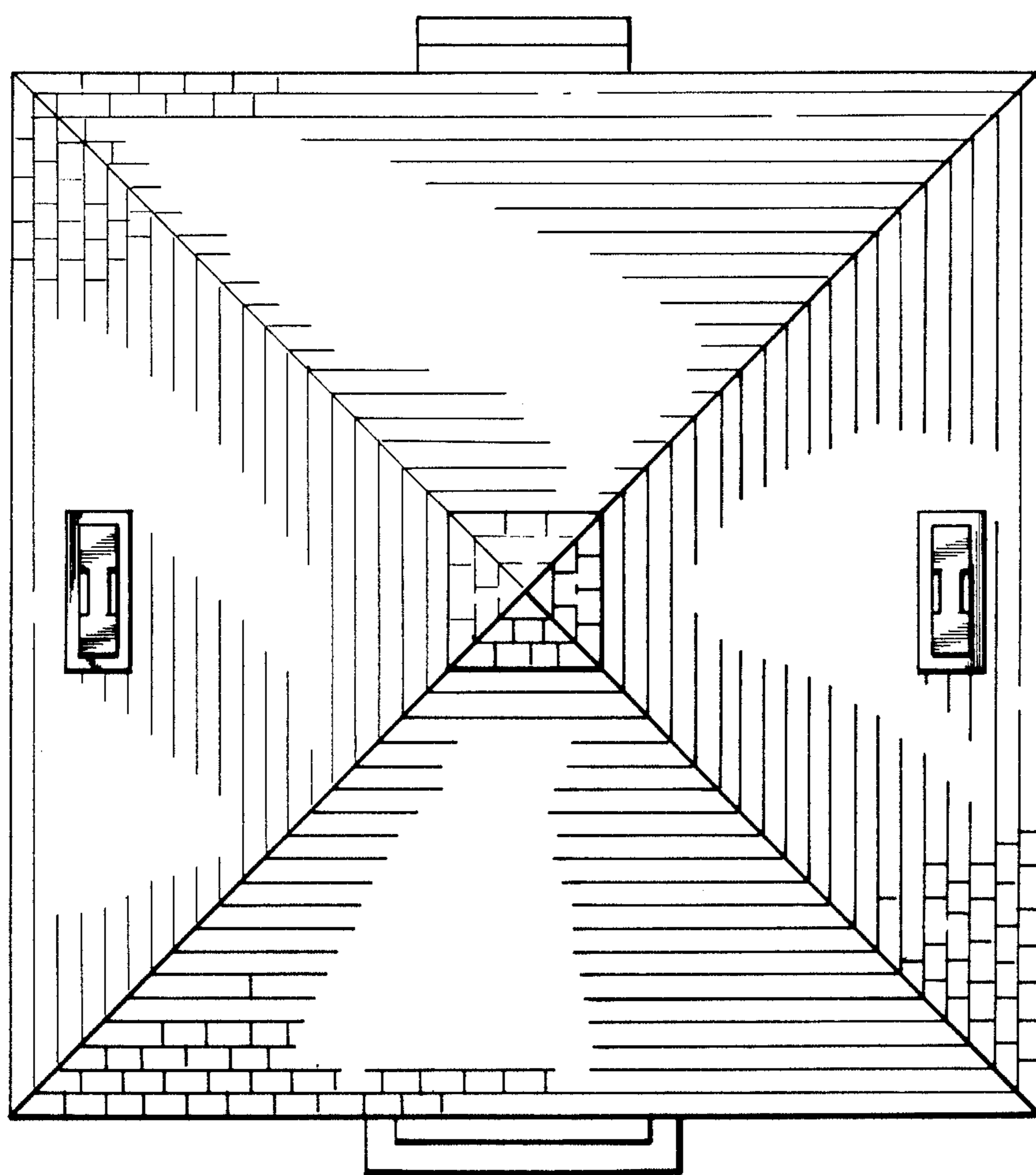

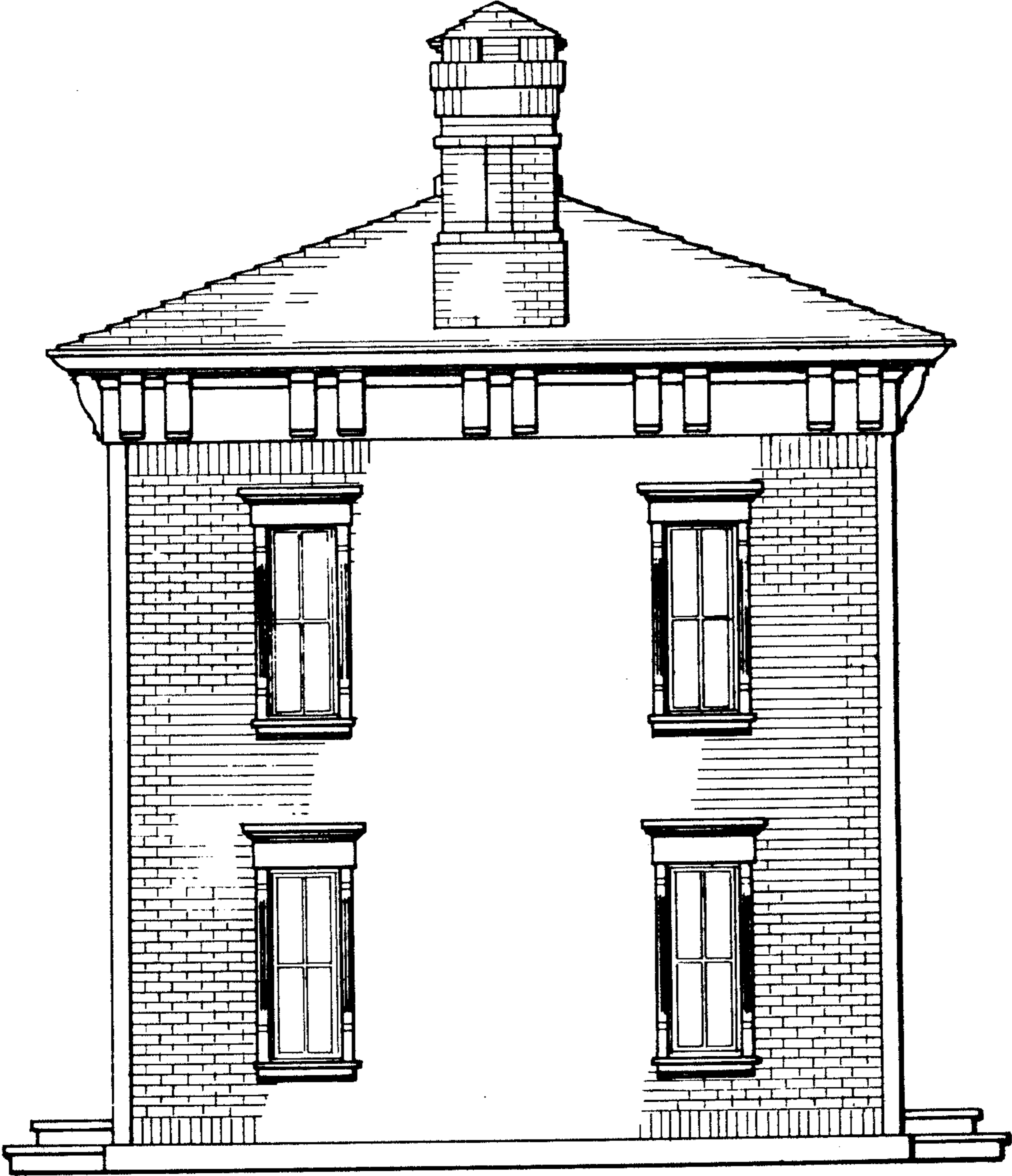

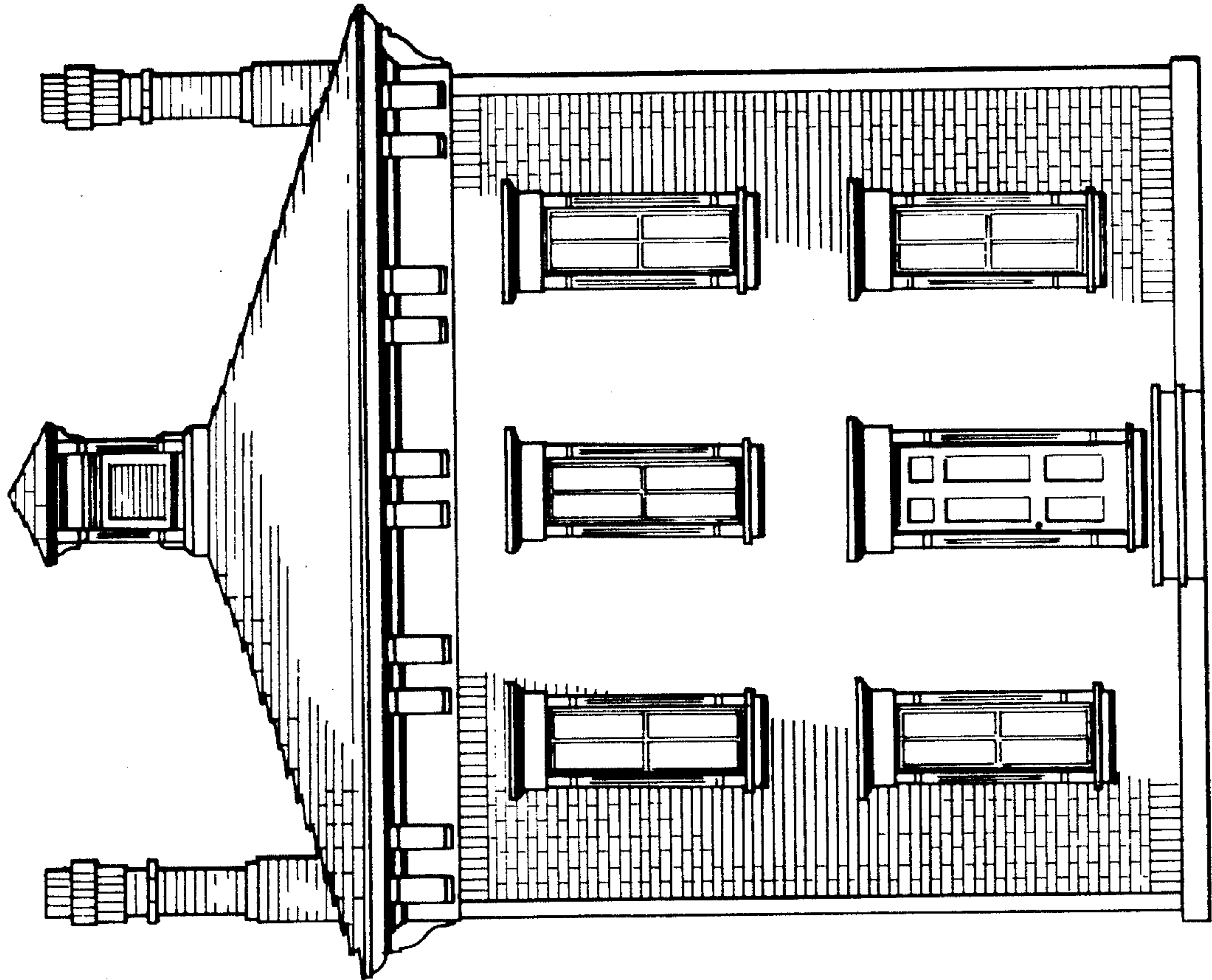

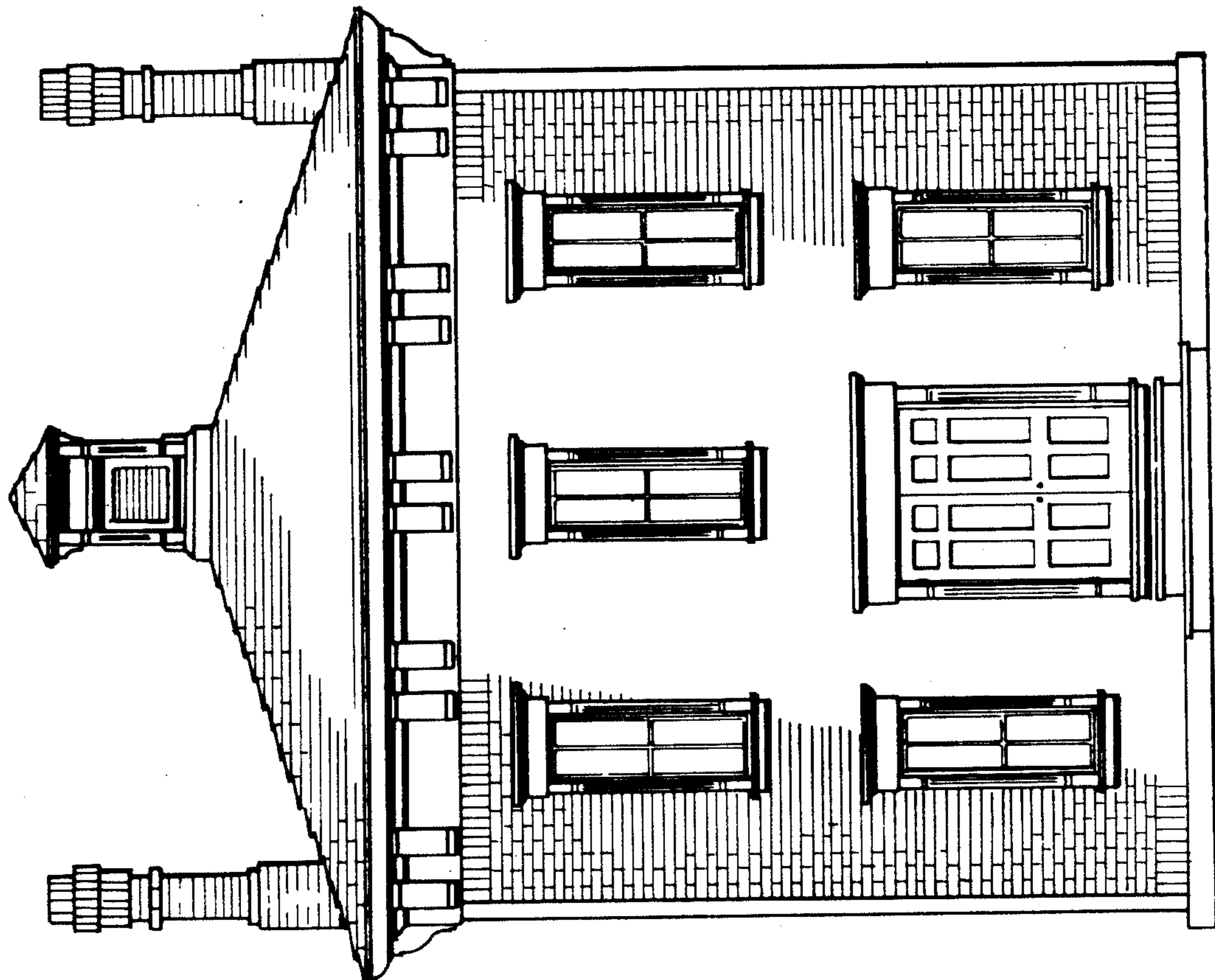
