FIG. 6 is a rear end elevational view thereof.

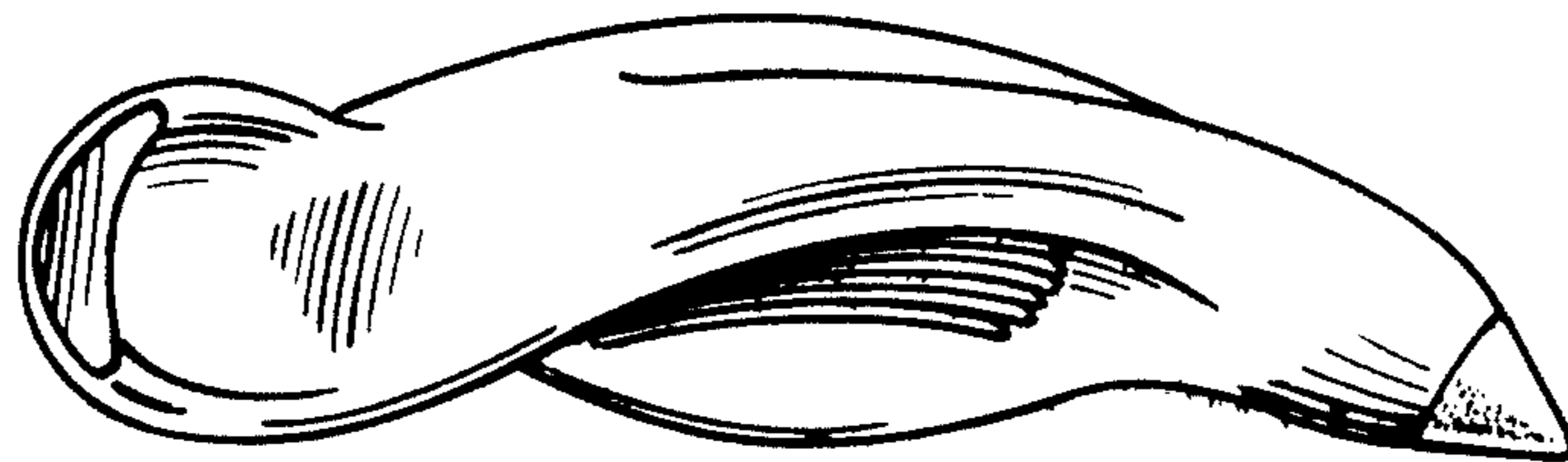
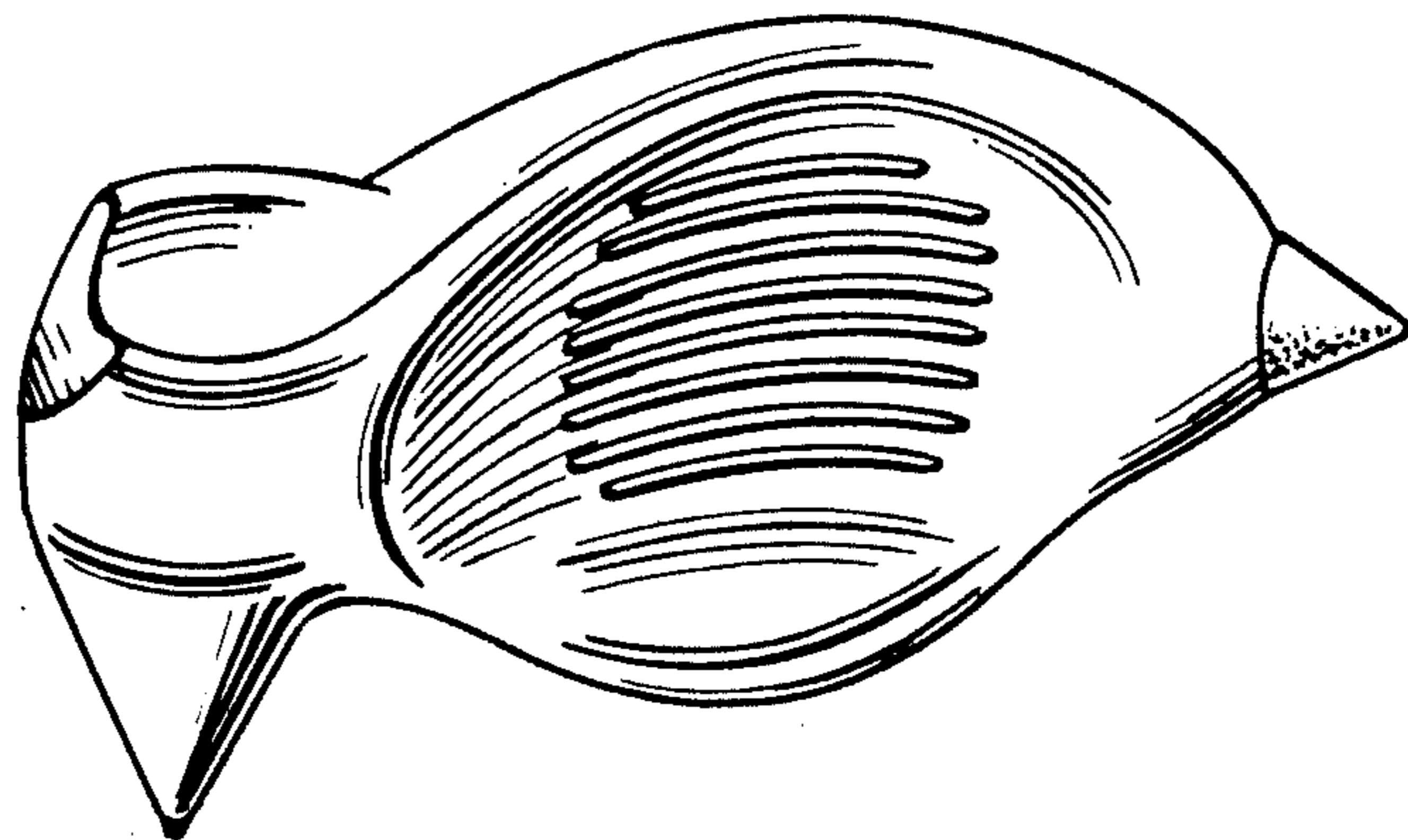

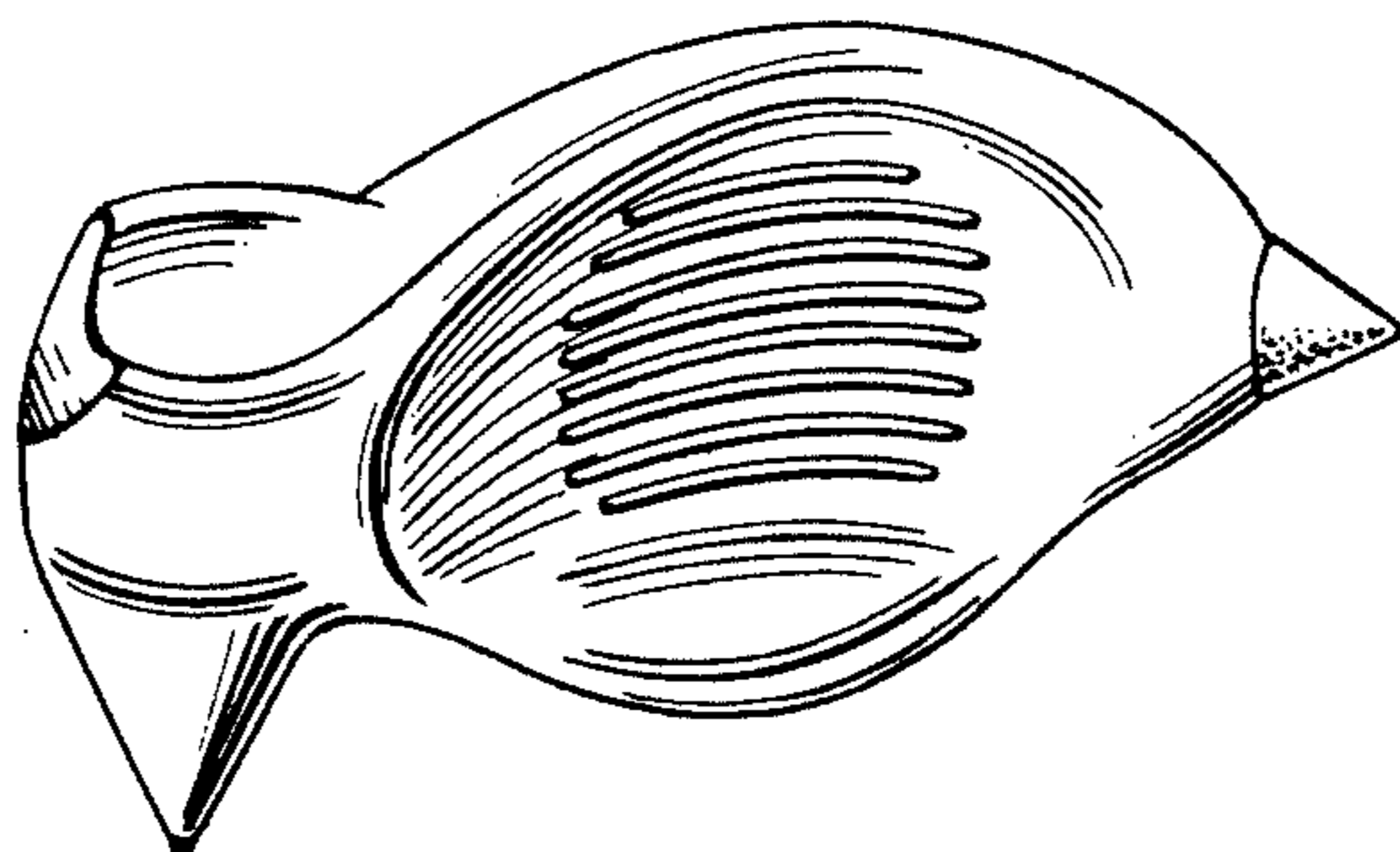

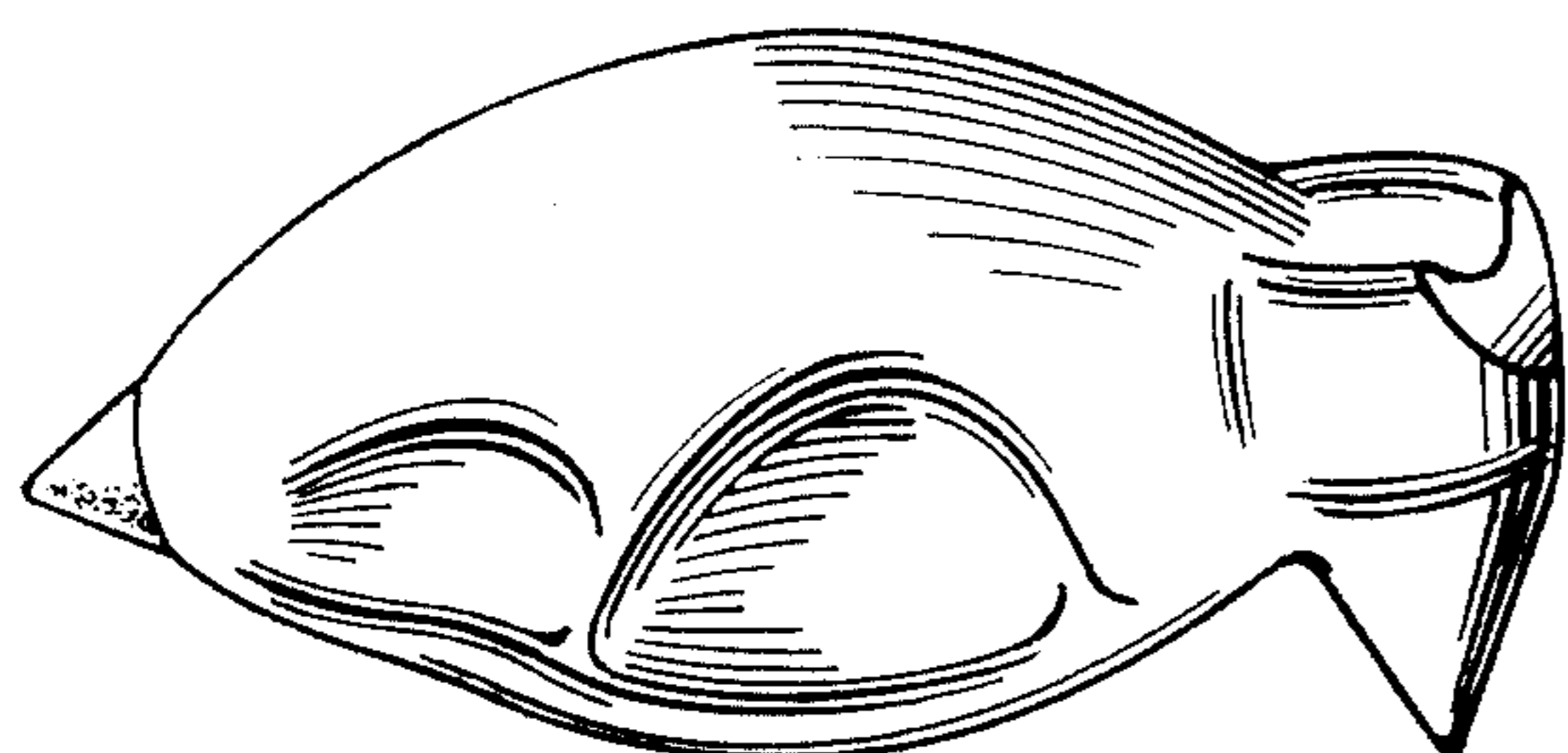

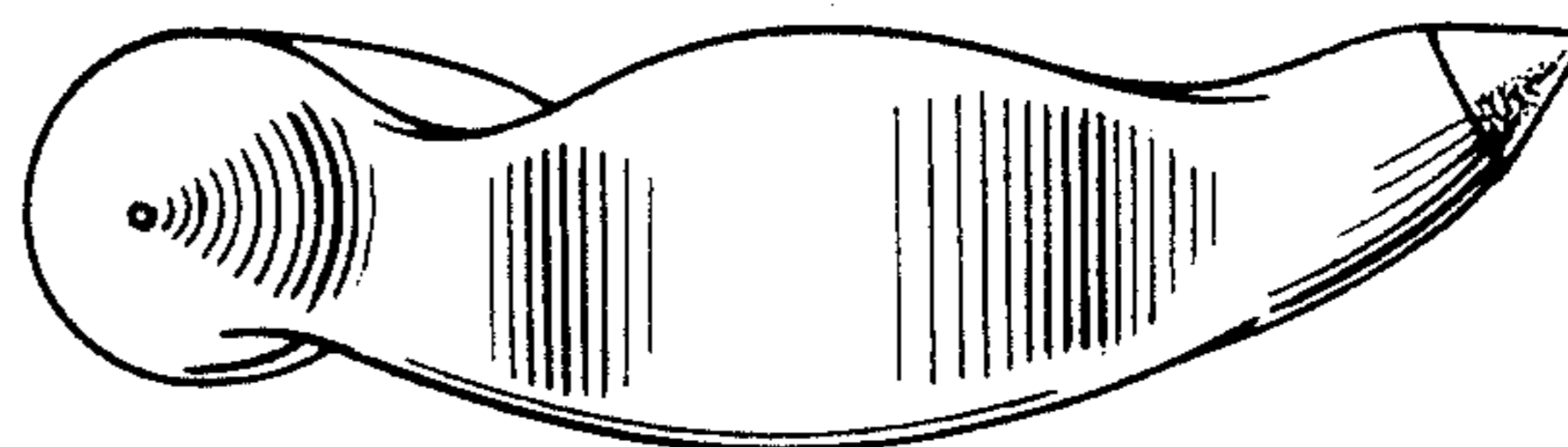

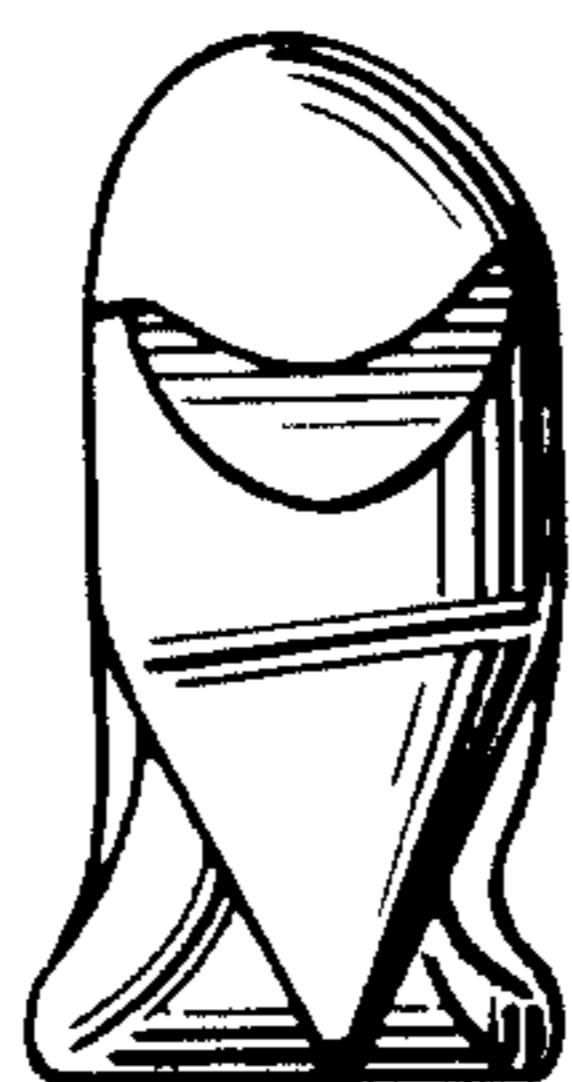
