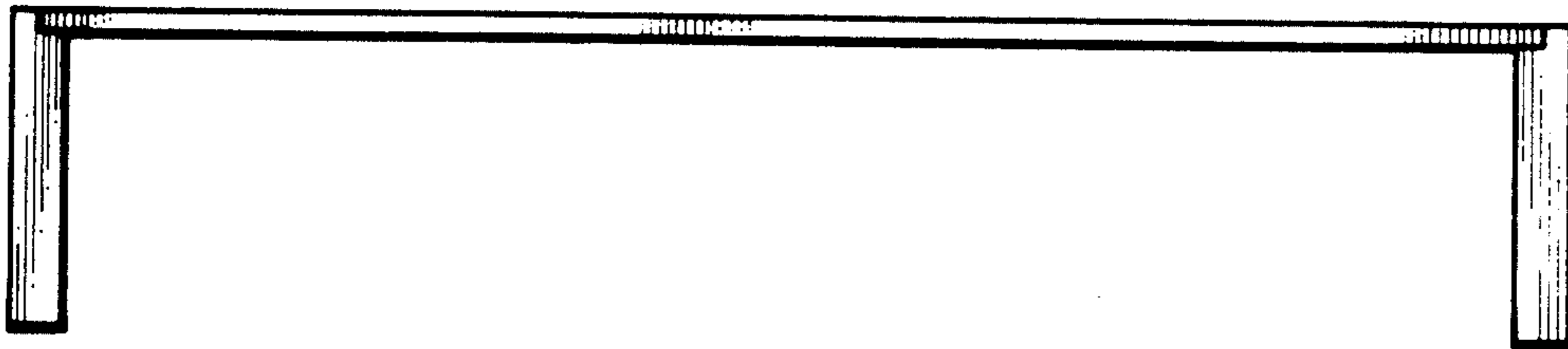
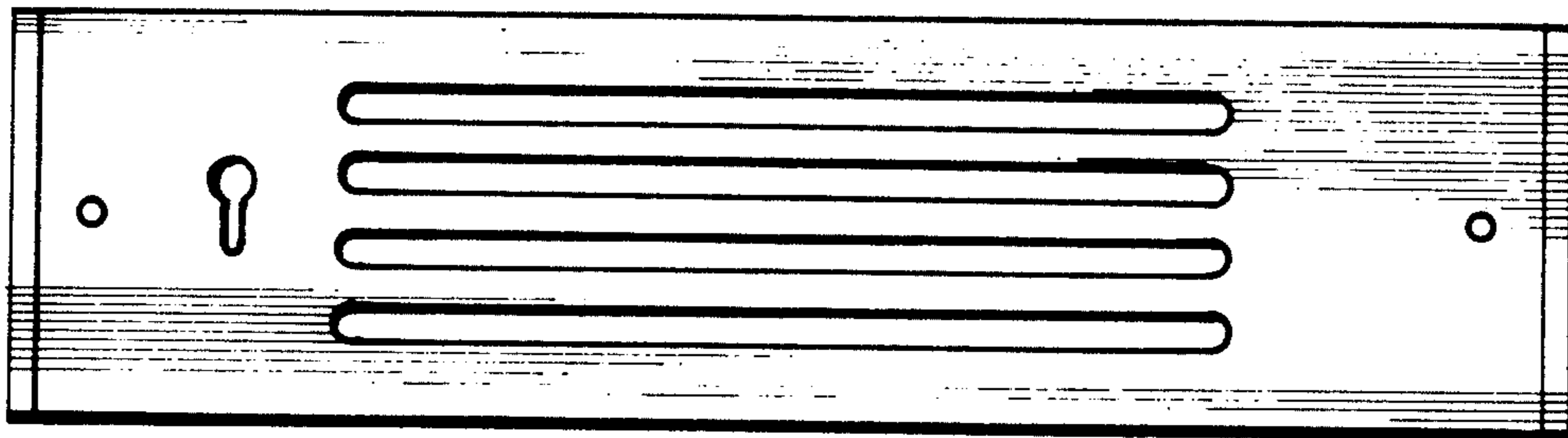
FIG. 1 is a top or plan view of the pipette holder or similar article showing our new design.

The undisclosed rear view is identical to the front view and the sides are conventionally plane and unadorned.



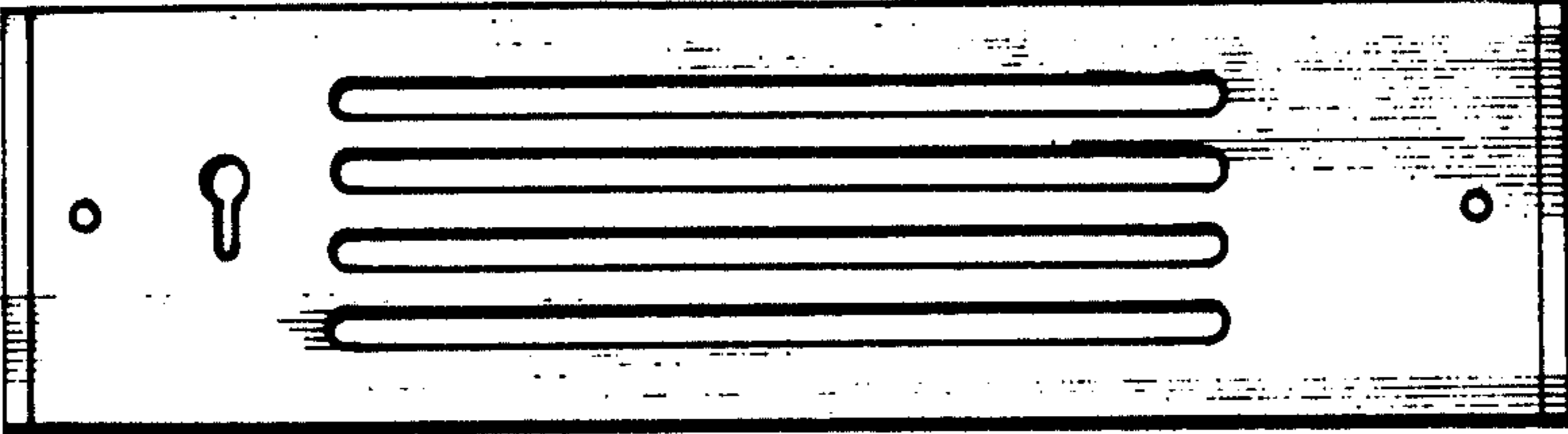

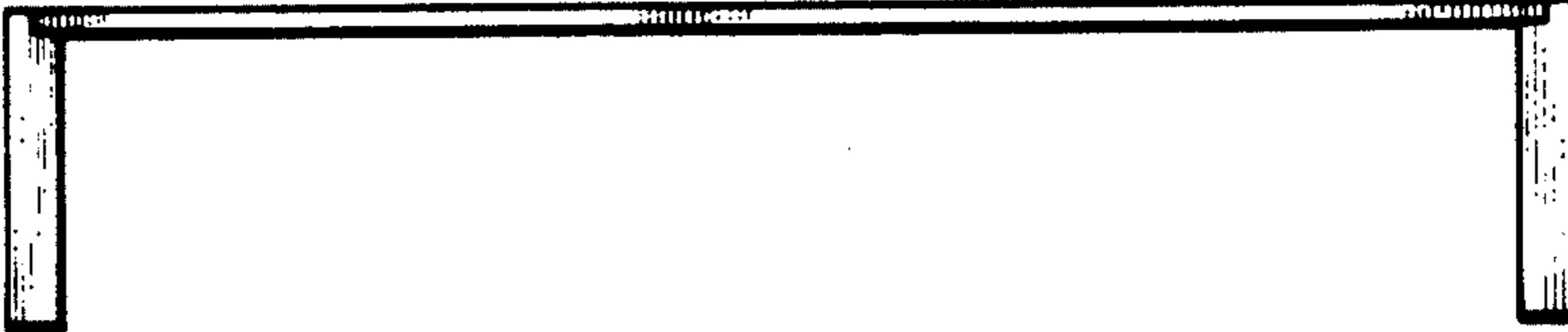
