FIG. 6 is a front end elevational view thereof.

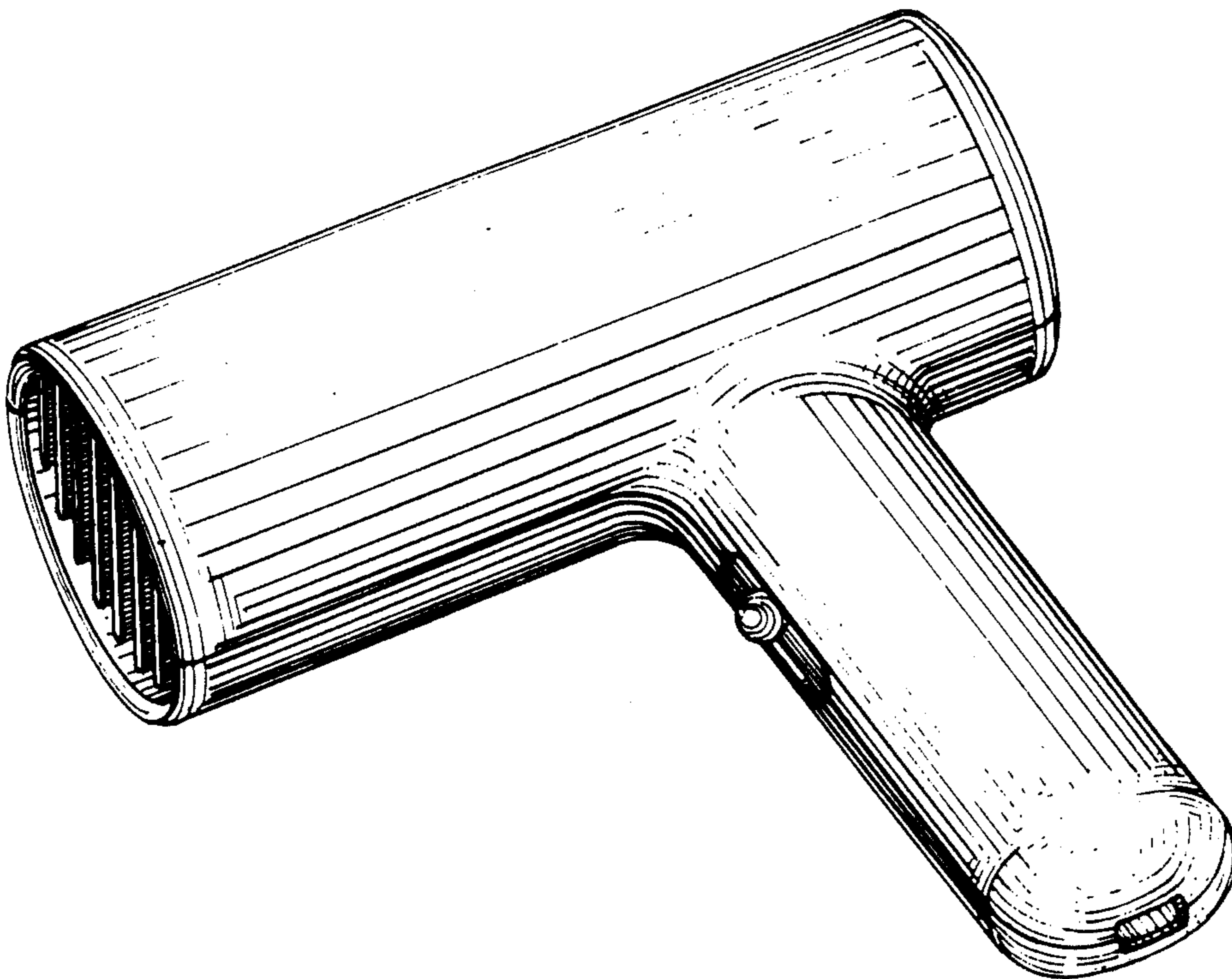

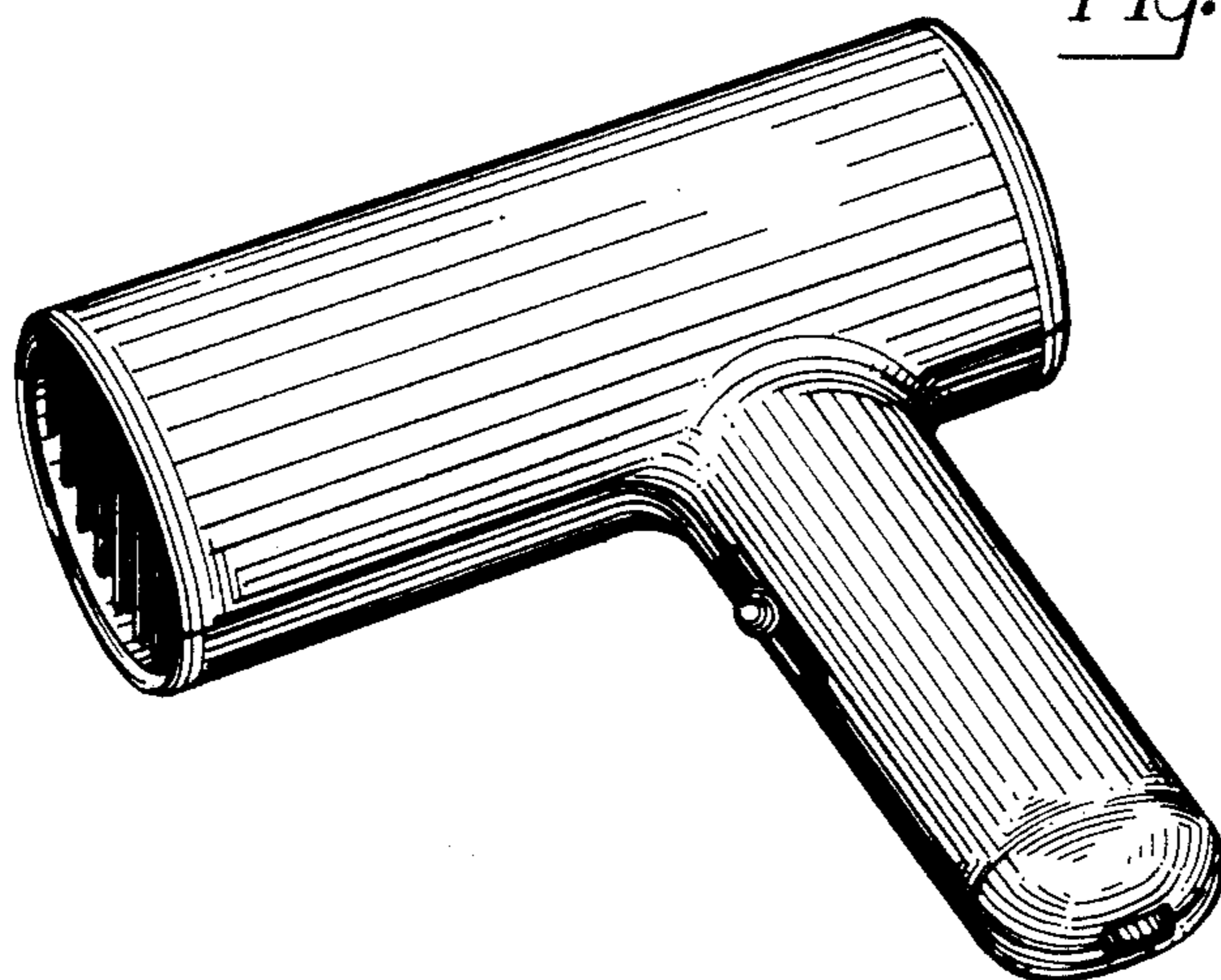
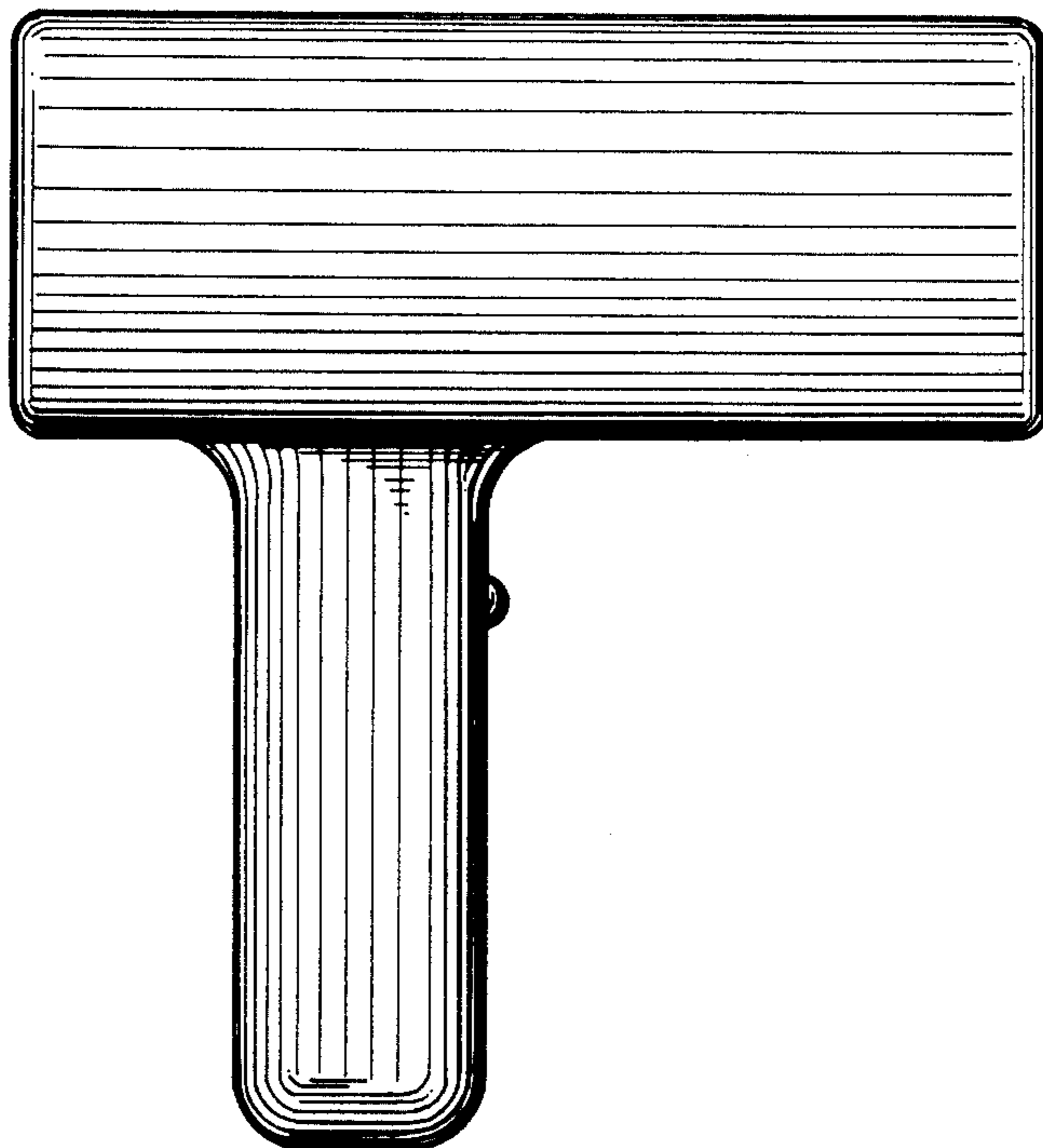

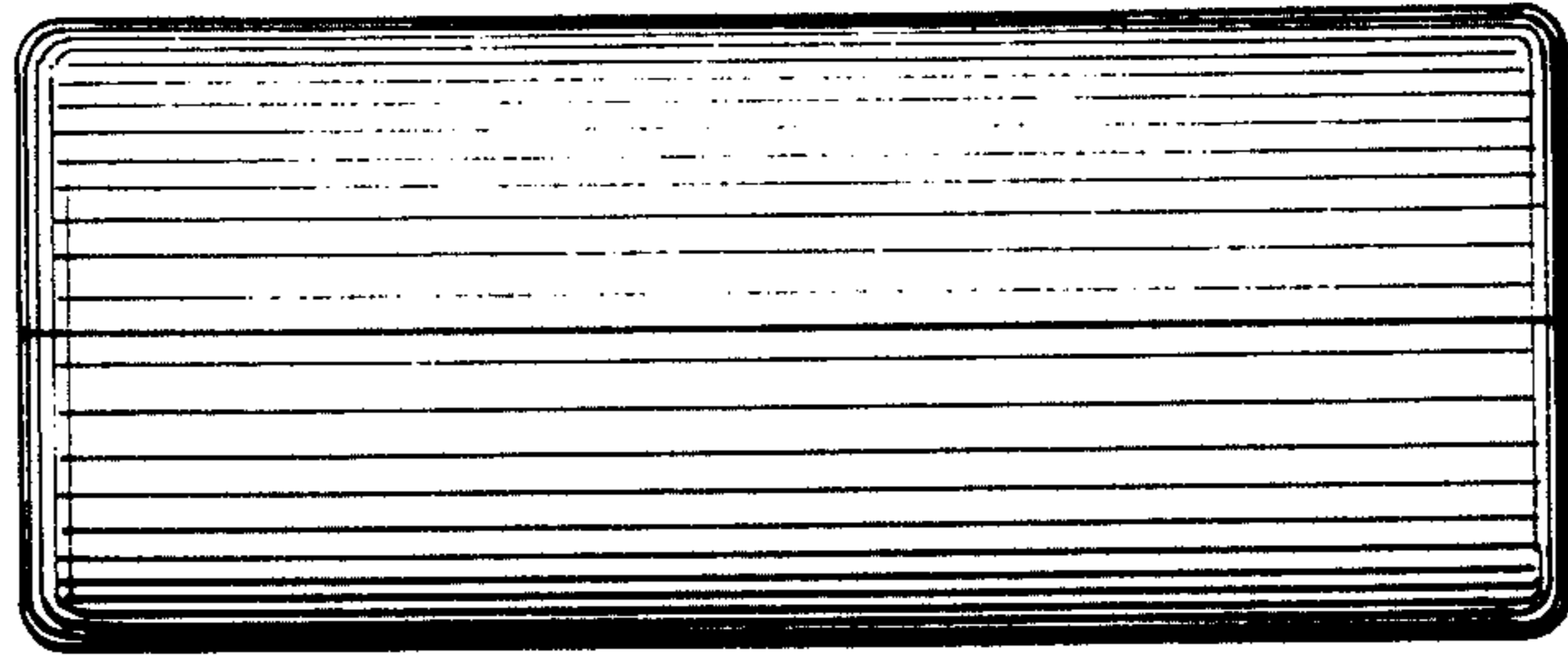

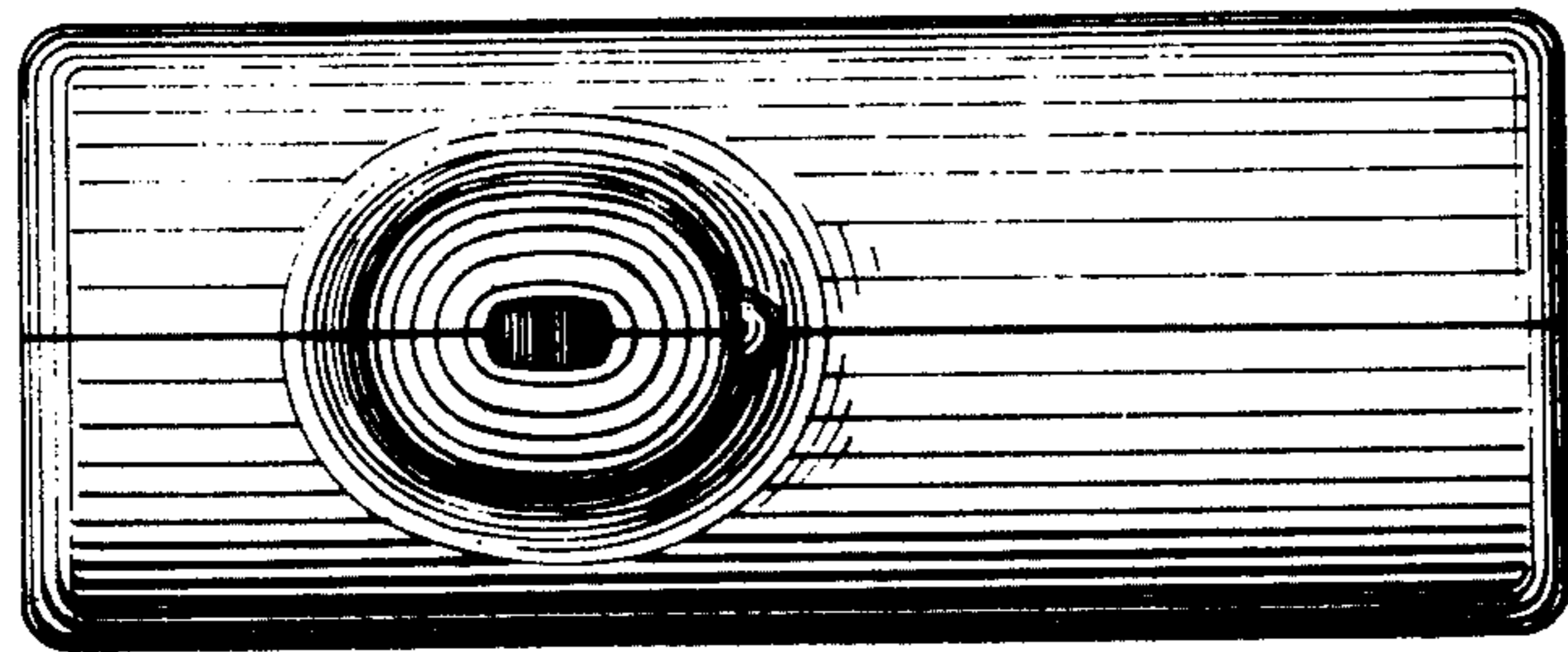

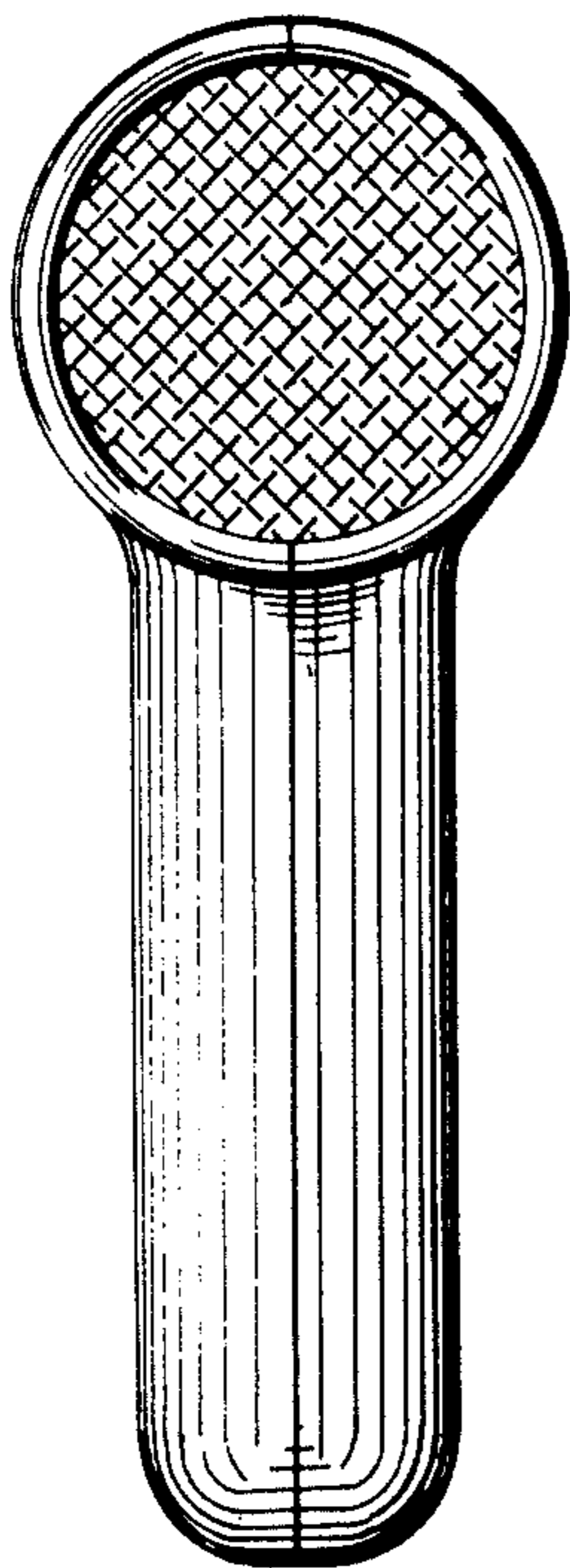

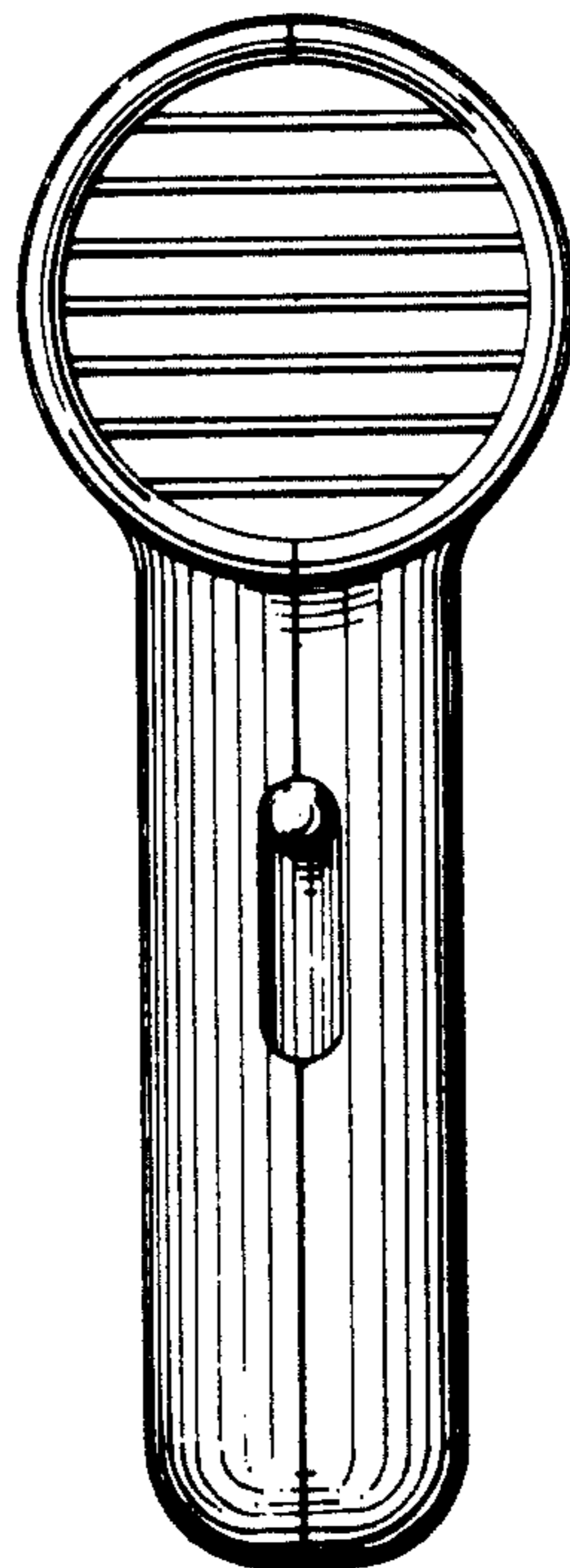
