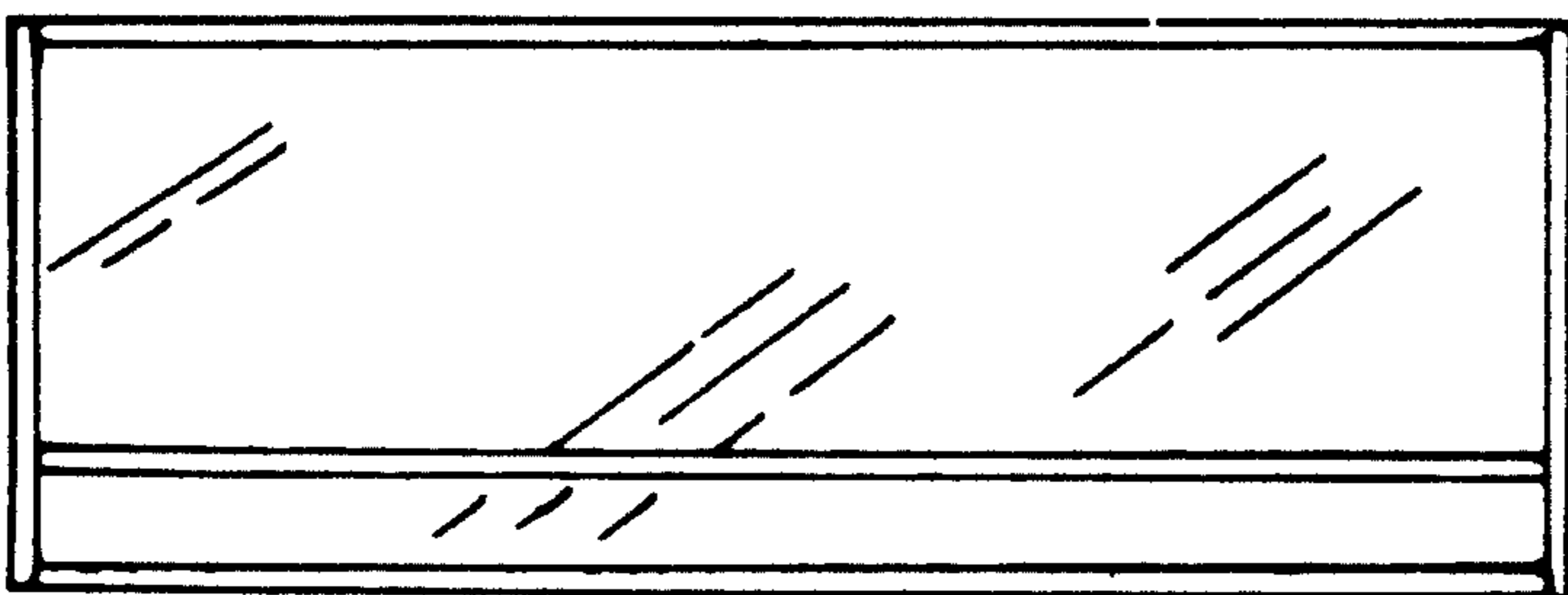

The ornamental design for a shopping bag holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a shopping bag holder showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view; and
FIG. 6 is a perspective view.
The side elevational views are mirror images of each other.



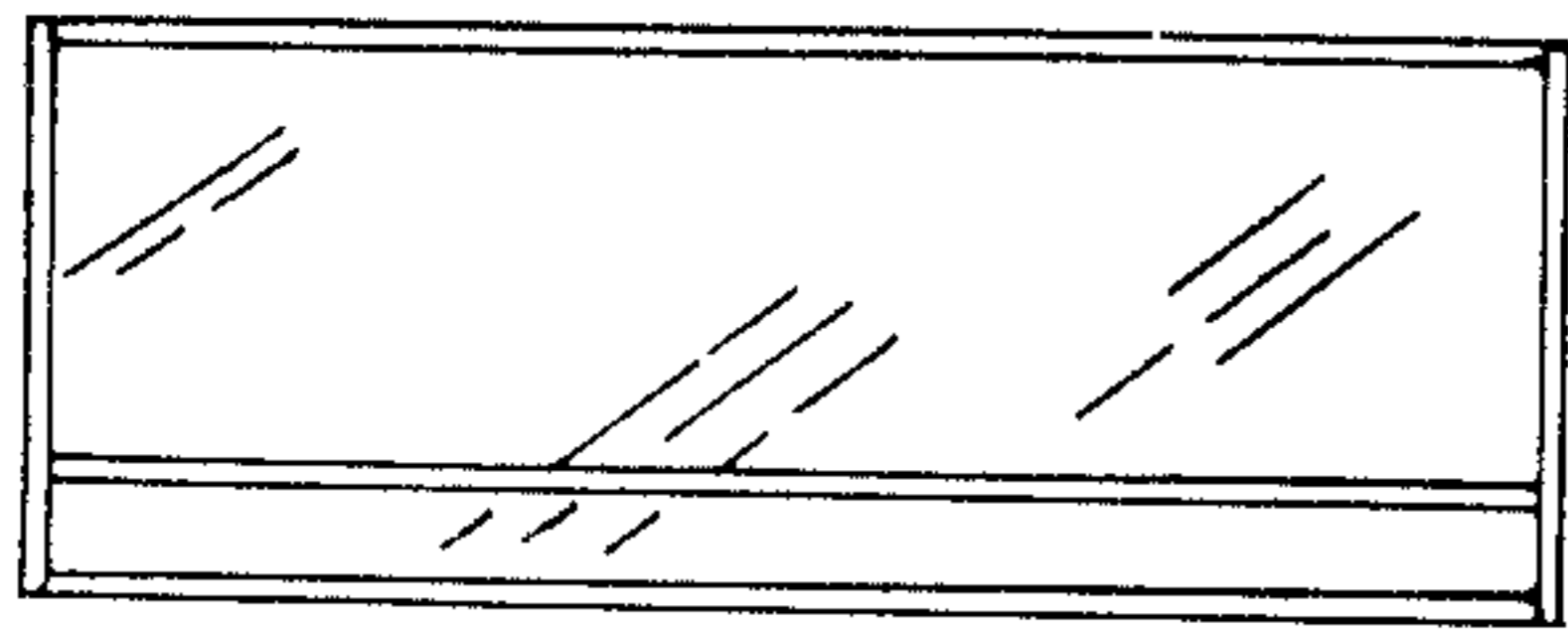

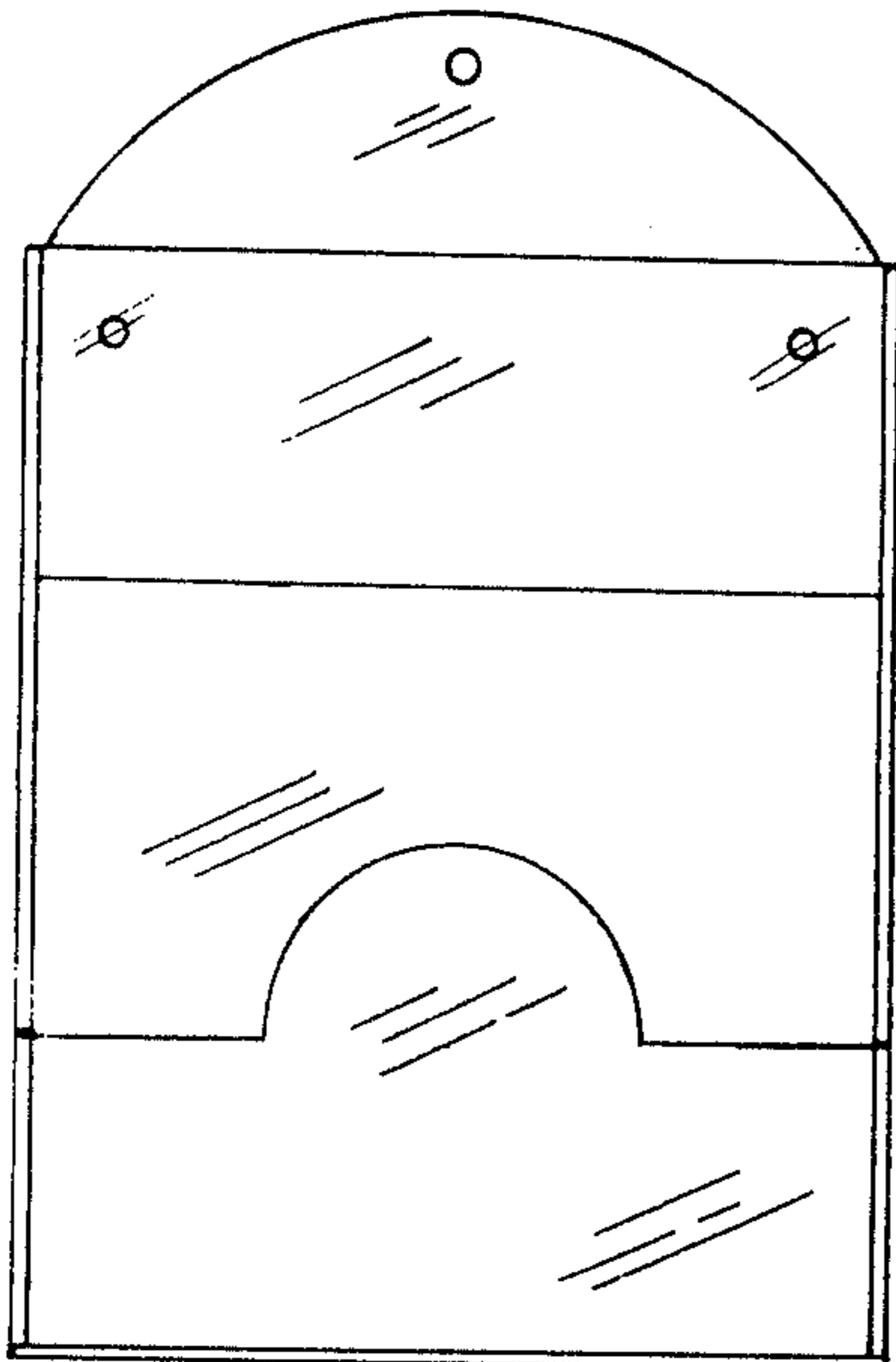

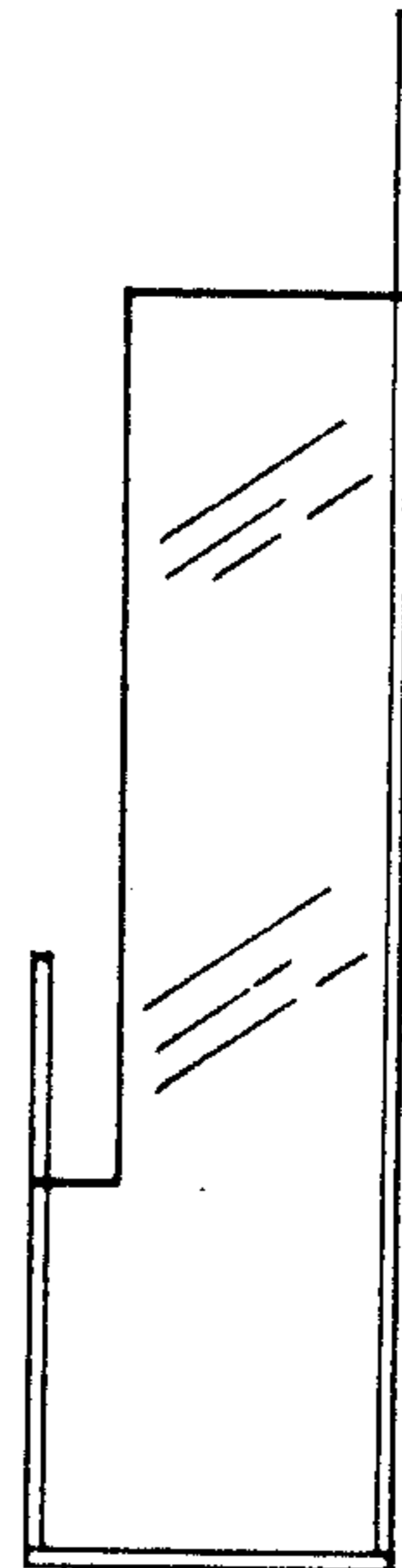

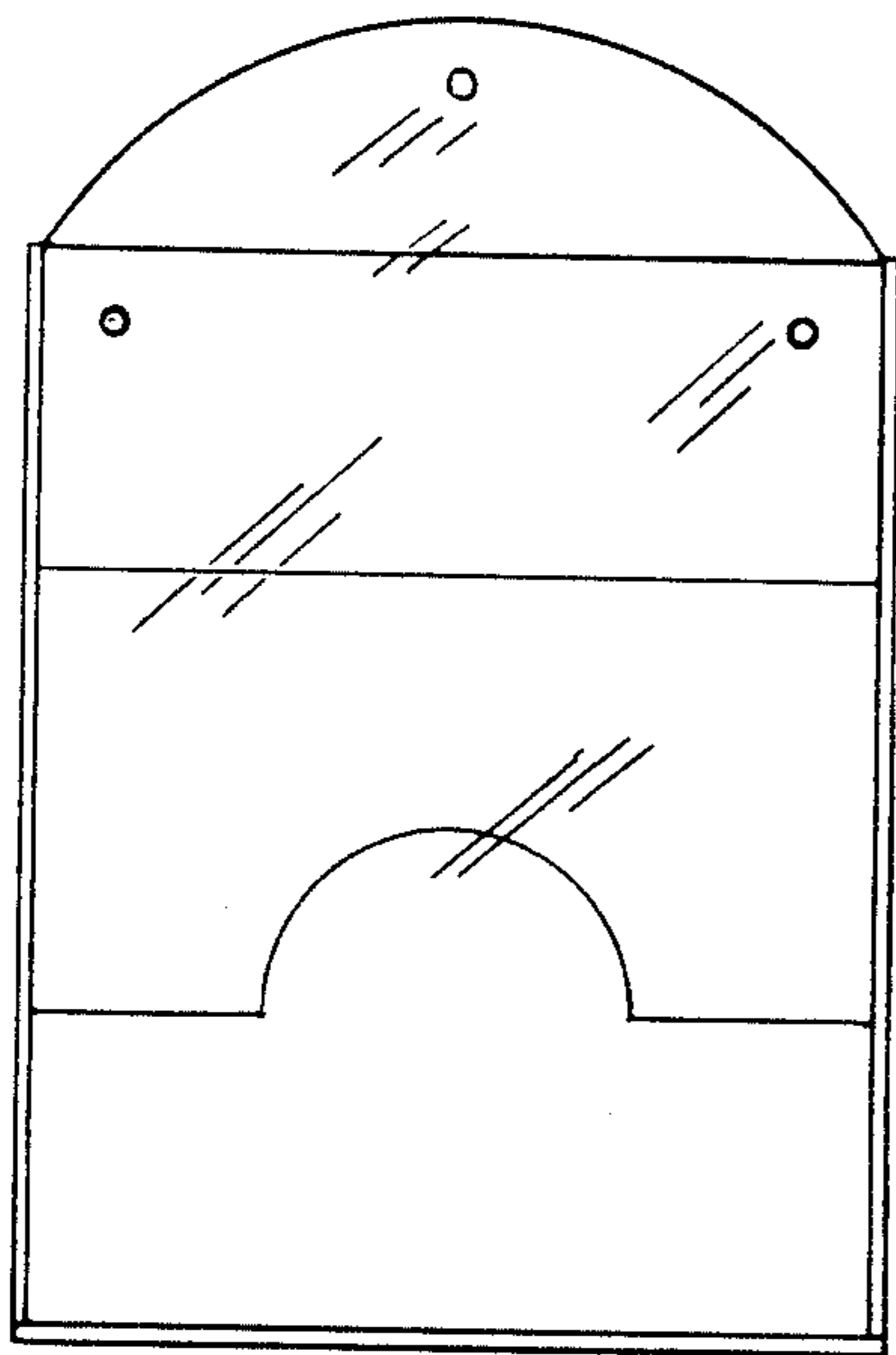

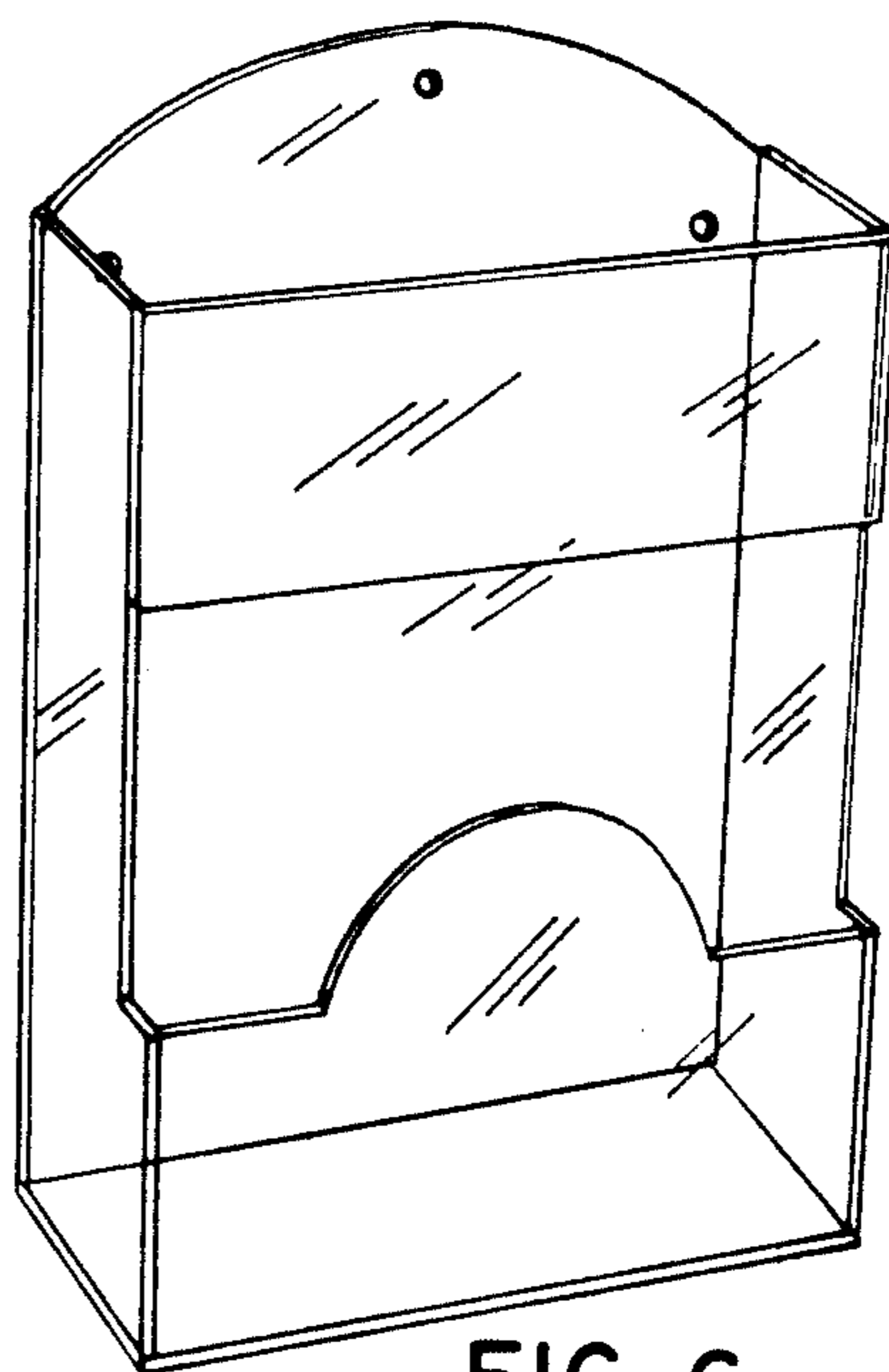

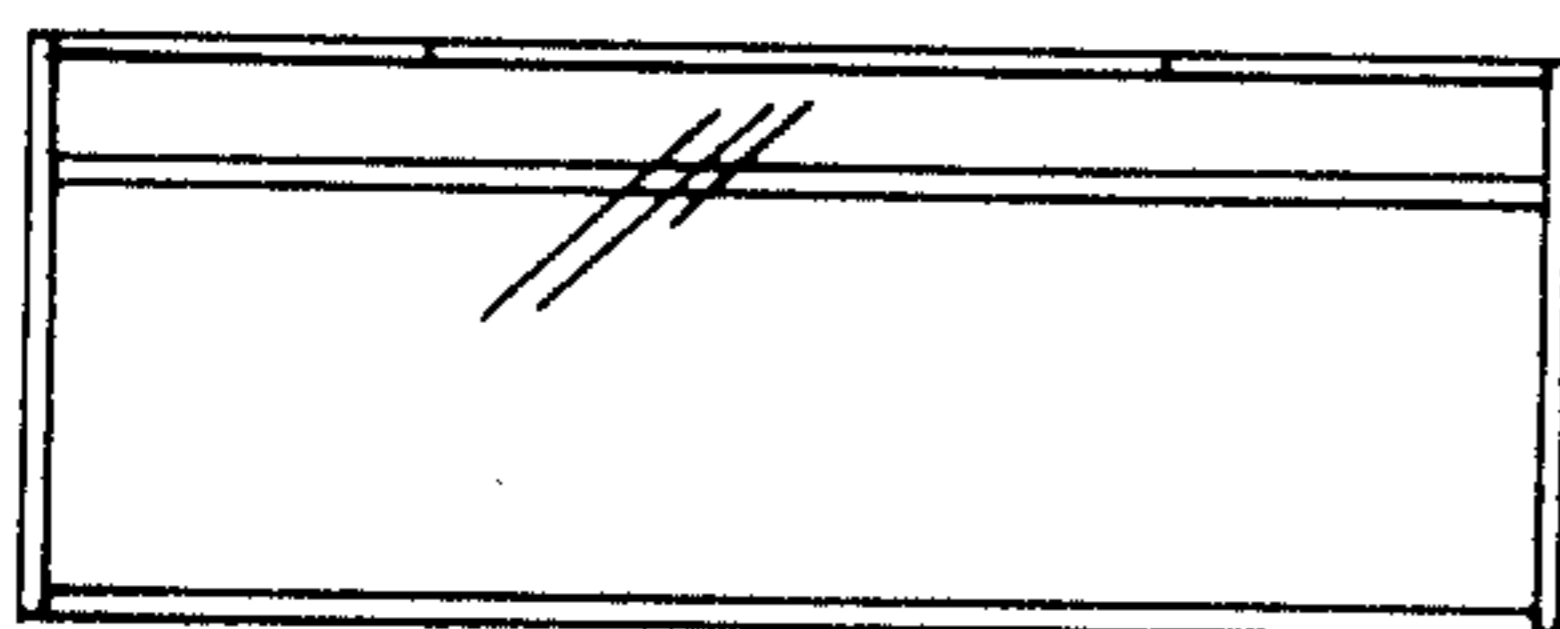
