[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bagpipe practice chanter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded front elevational view of a bagpipe practice chanter showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the upper section of the chanter shown in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the lower section of the chanter shown in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the assembled chanter;  
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the lower section of the chanter;  
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the chanter in assembled condition;  
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 10 is a side elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view thereof.
