DESCRIPTION

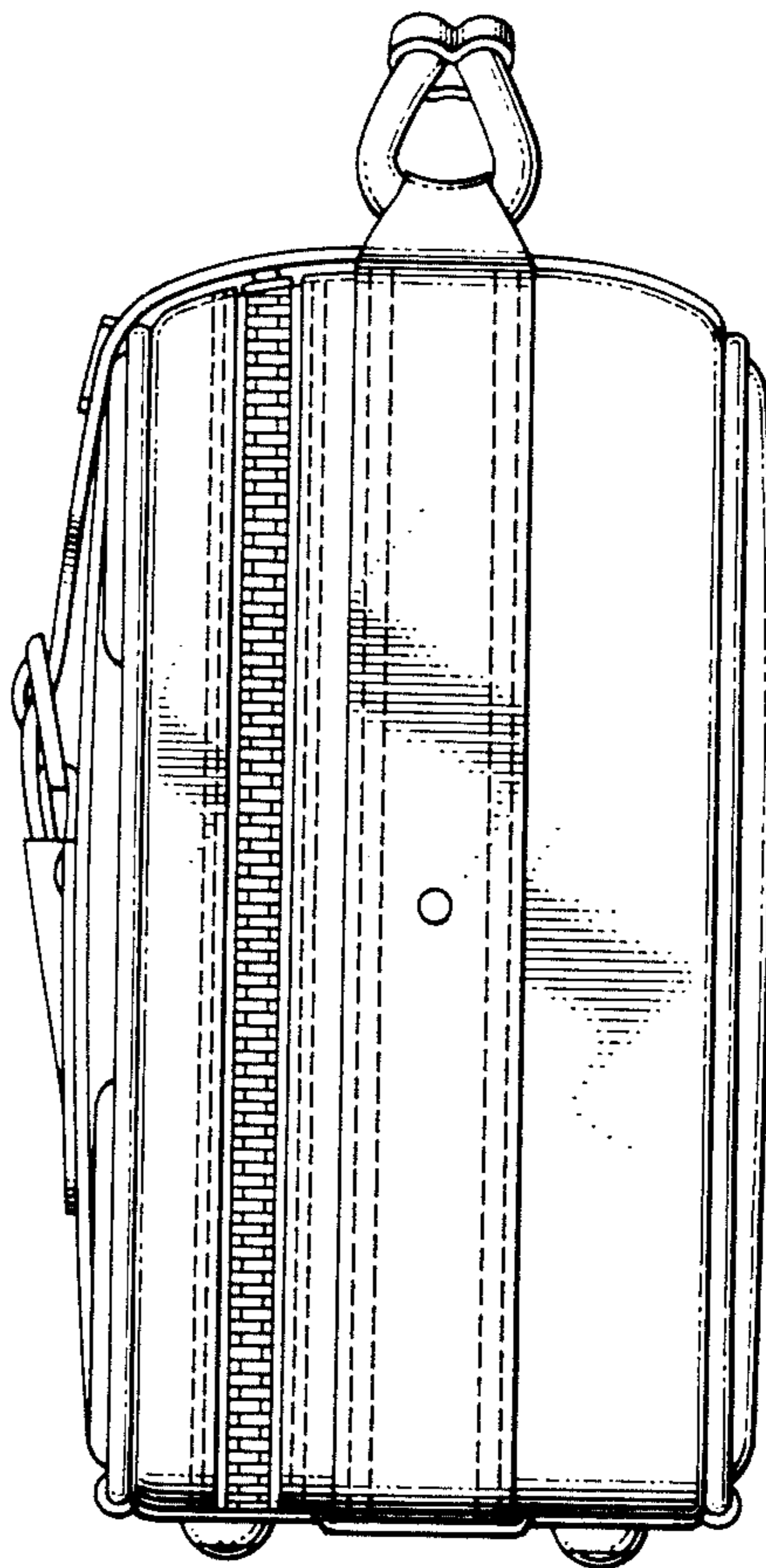
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a luggage case showing my new design;

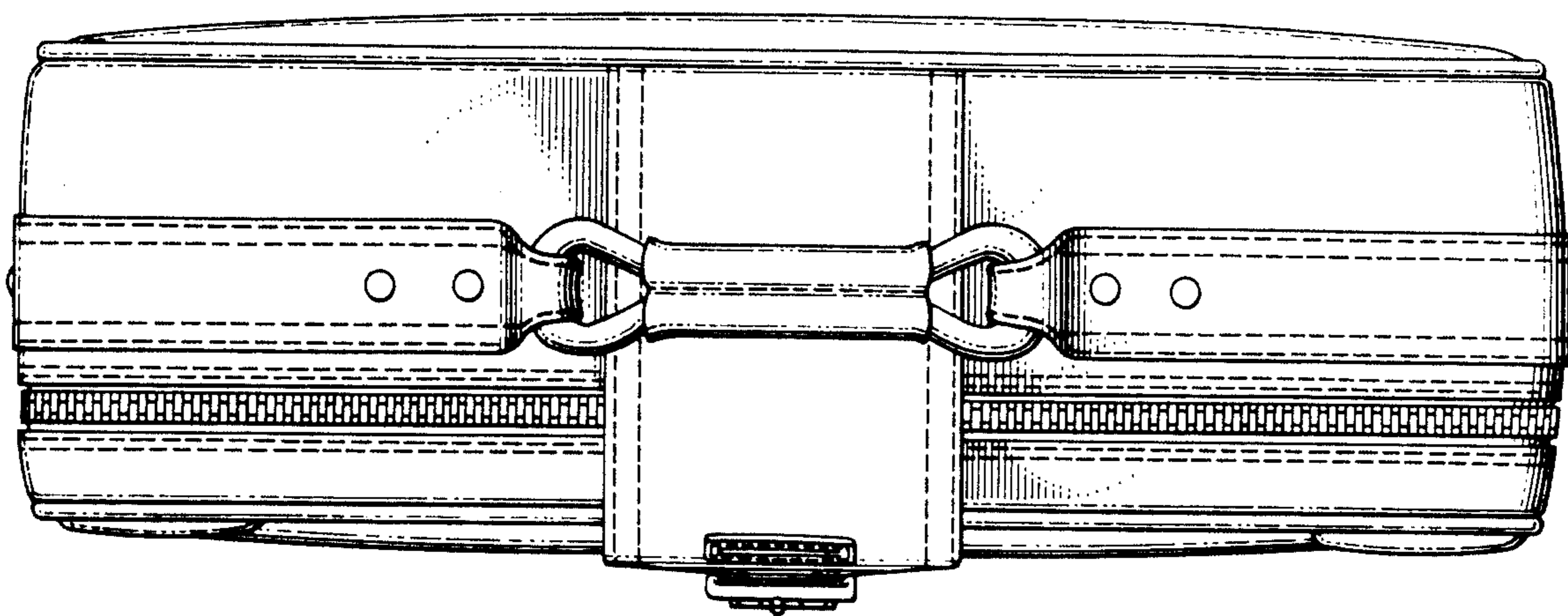

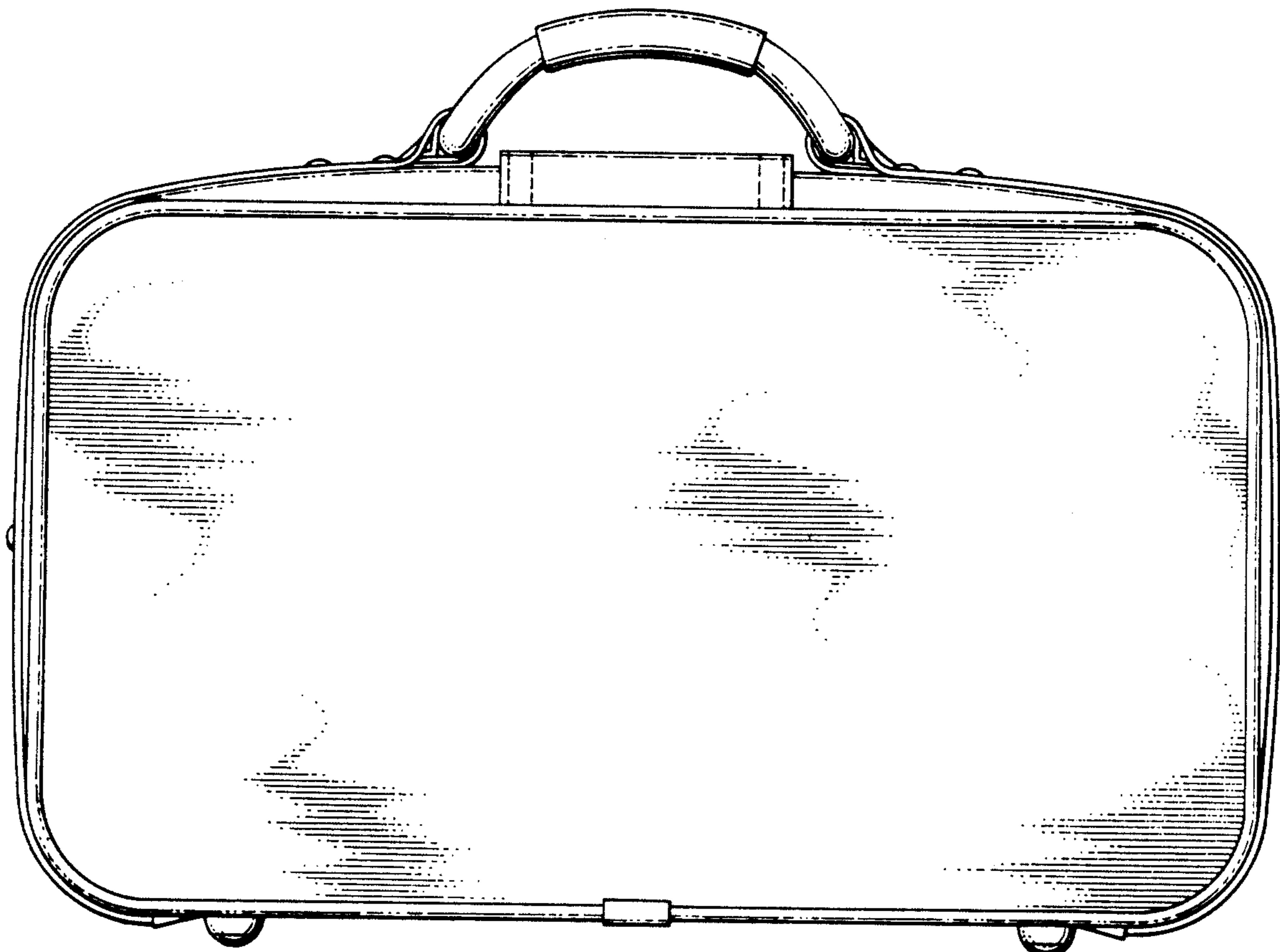

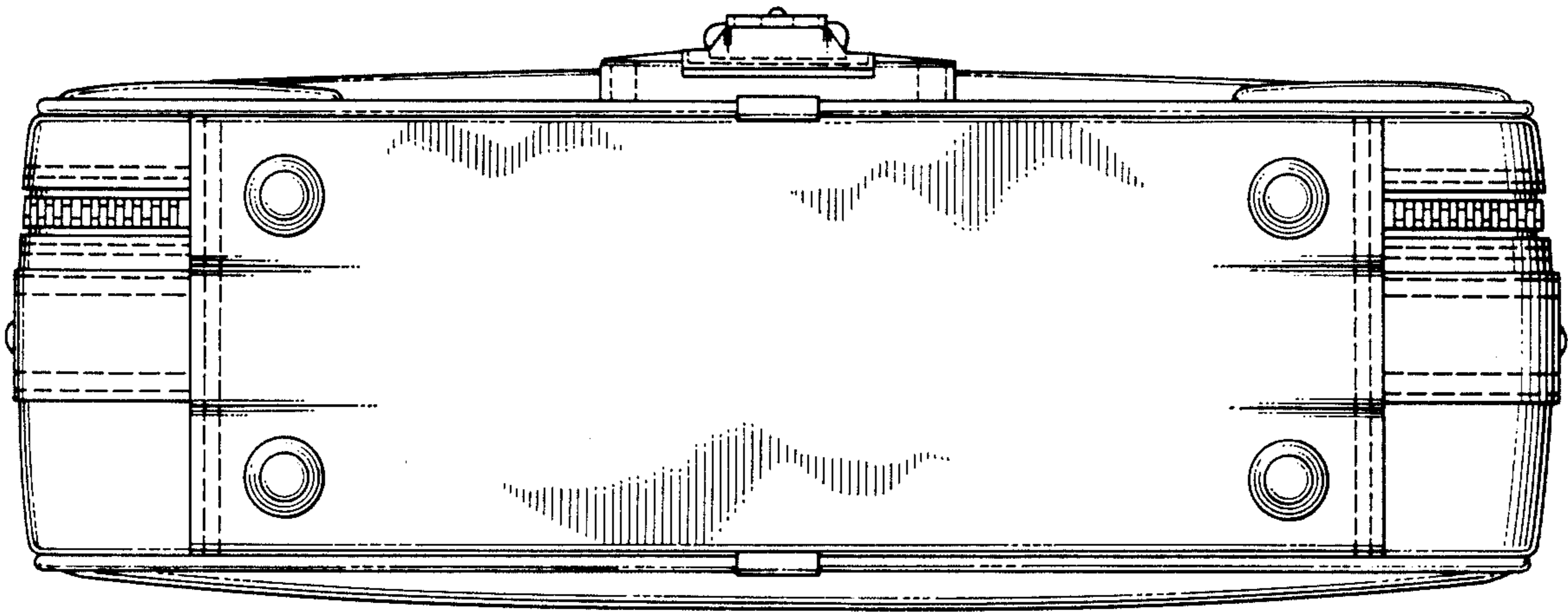
