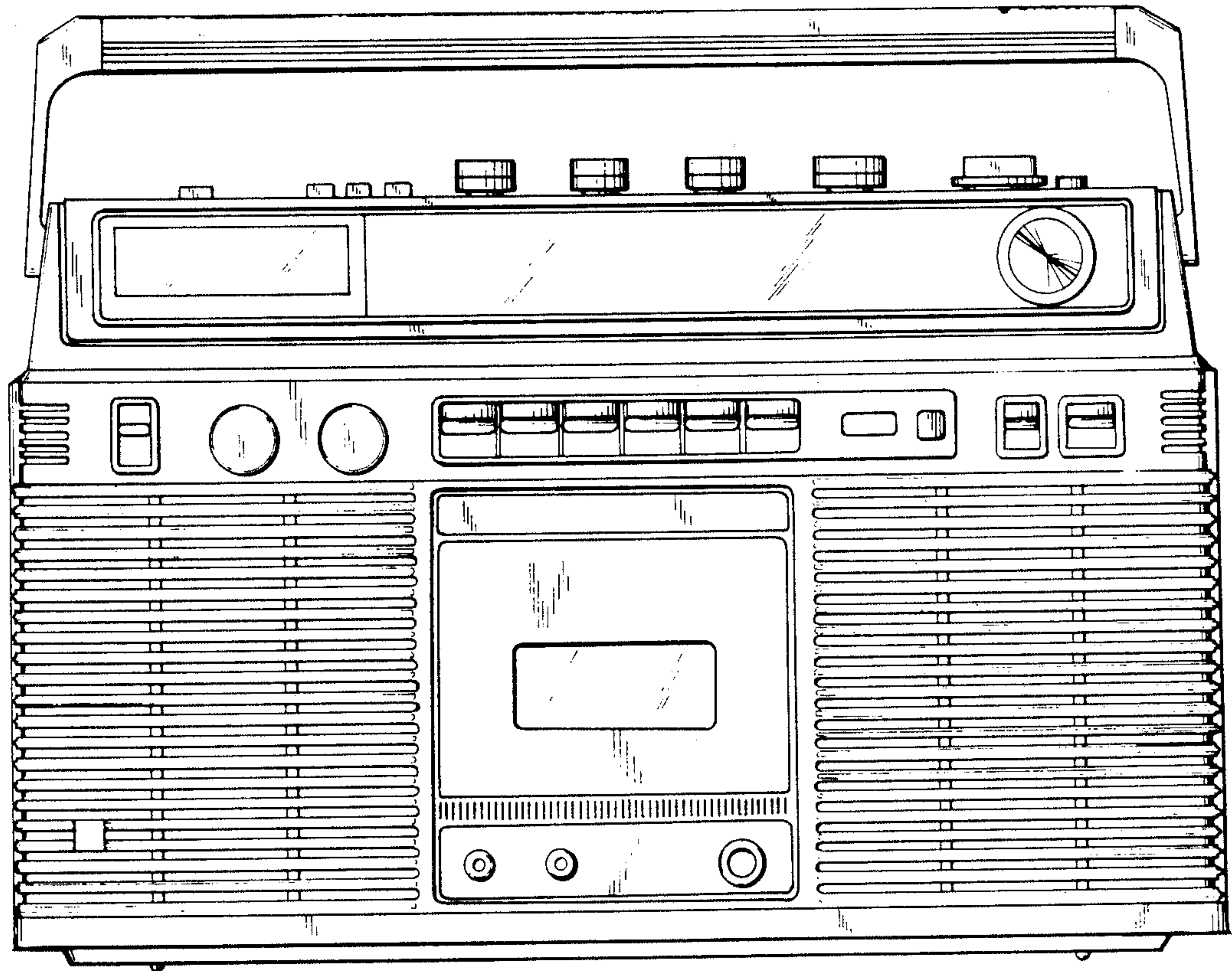

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined cassette re-
corder and player and radio, substantially as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined cassette
recorder and player and radio showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view with the carrying handle
turned rearwardly;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view with the carrying
handle in the position of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.



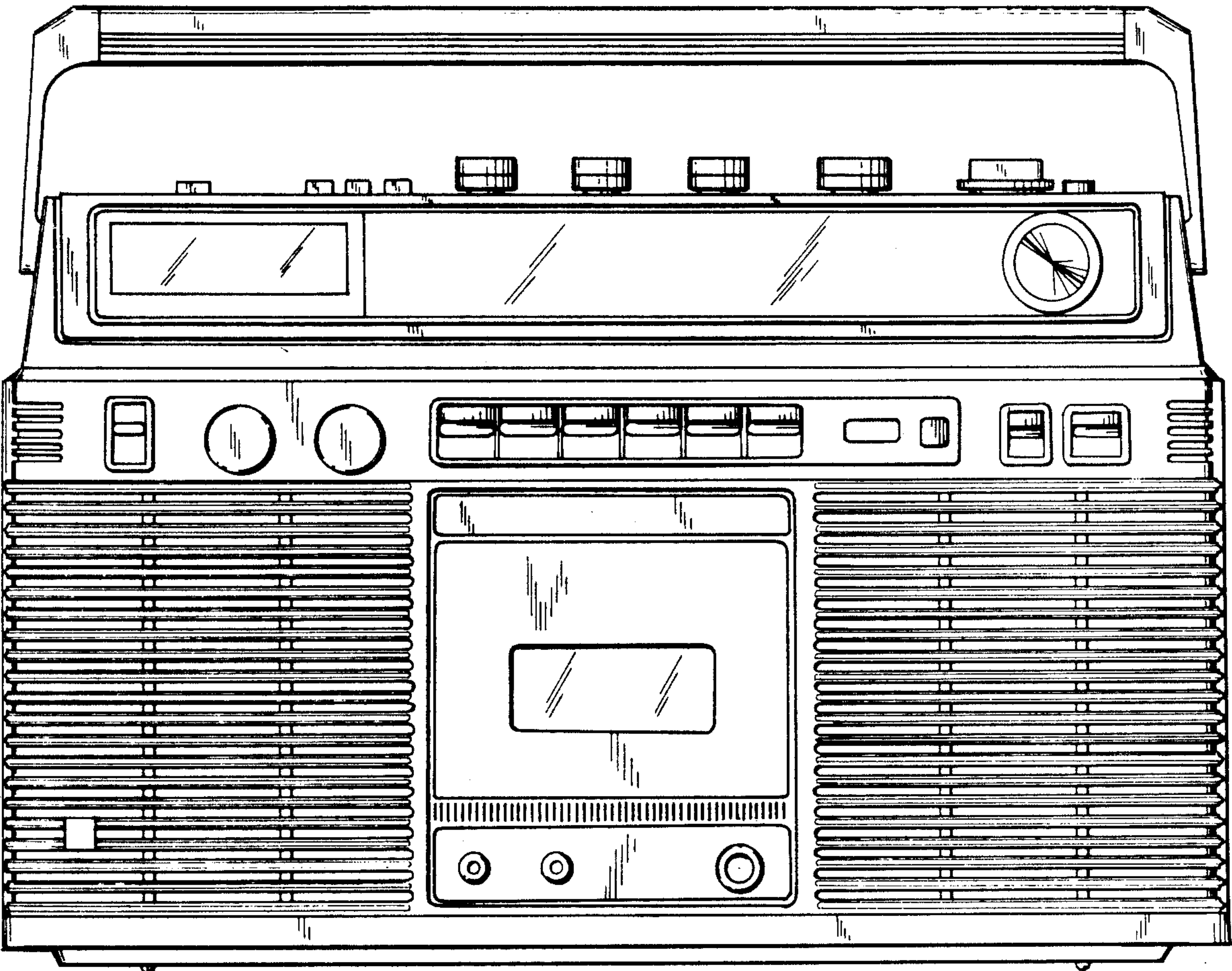

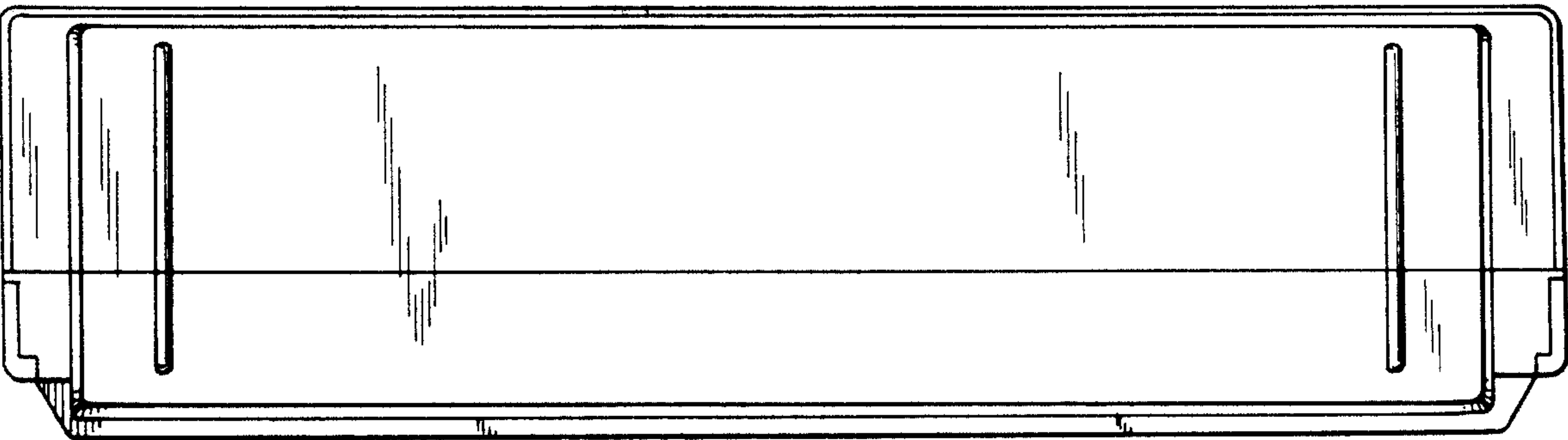

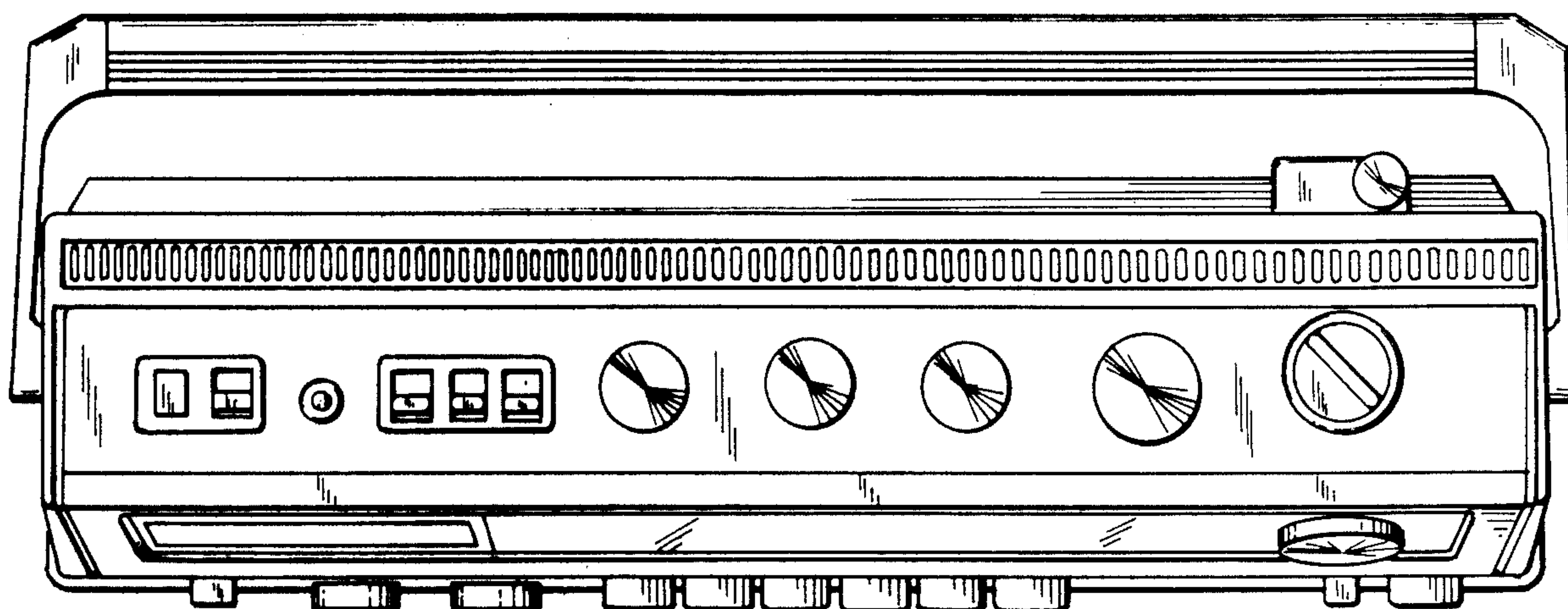

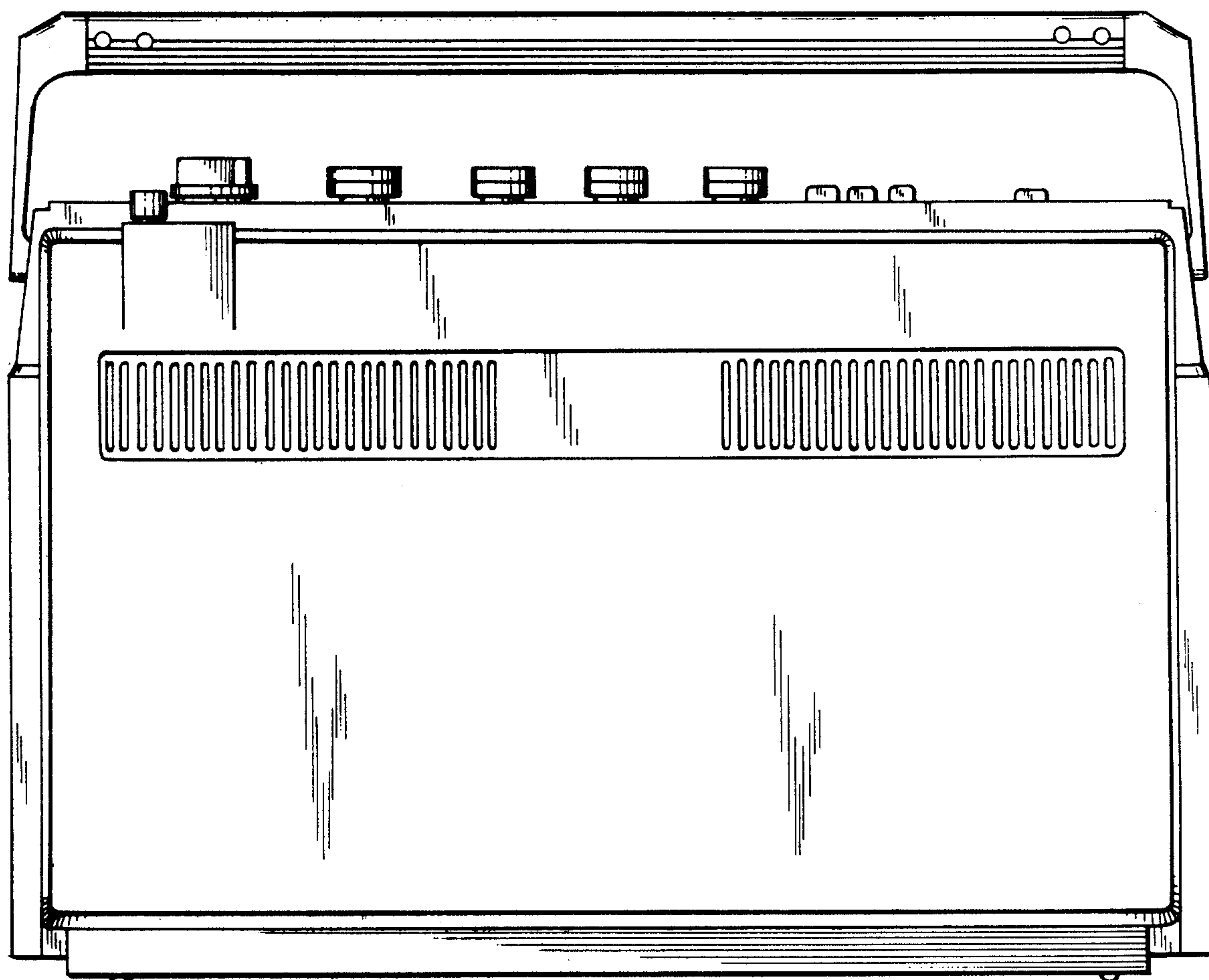

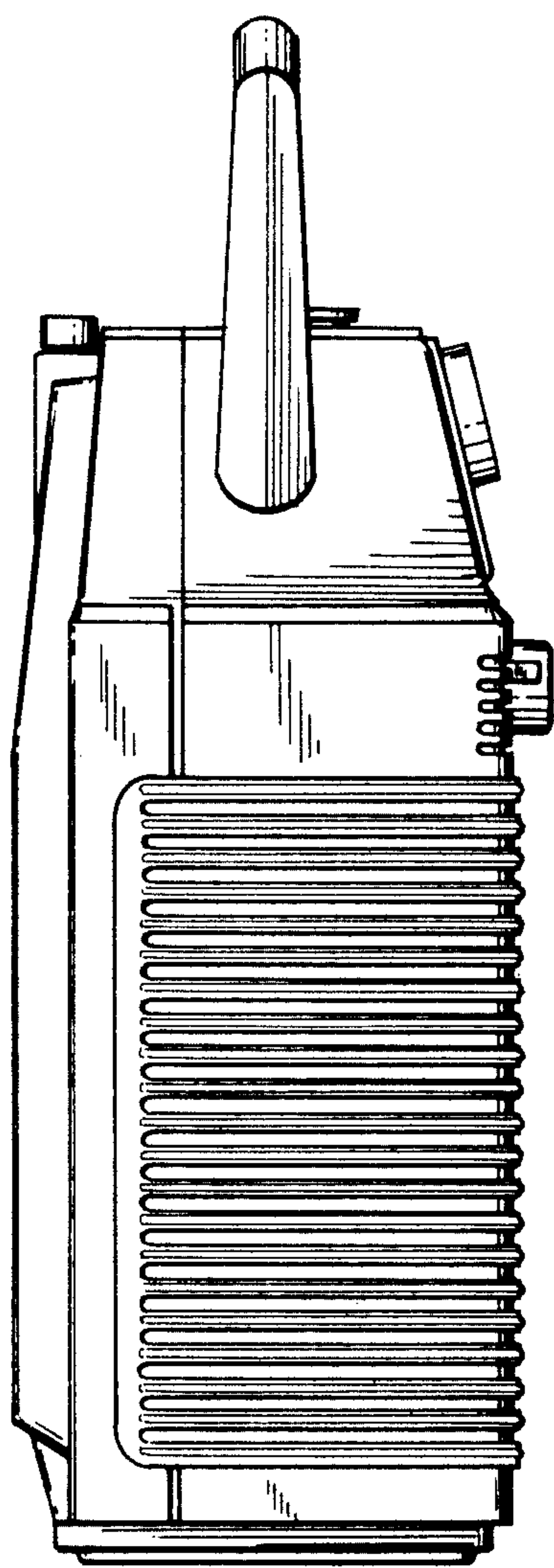

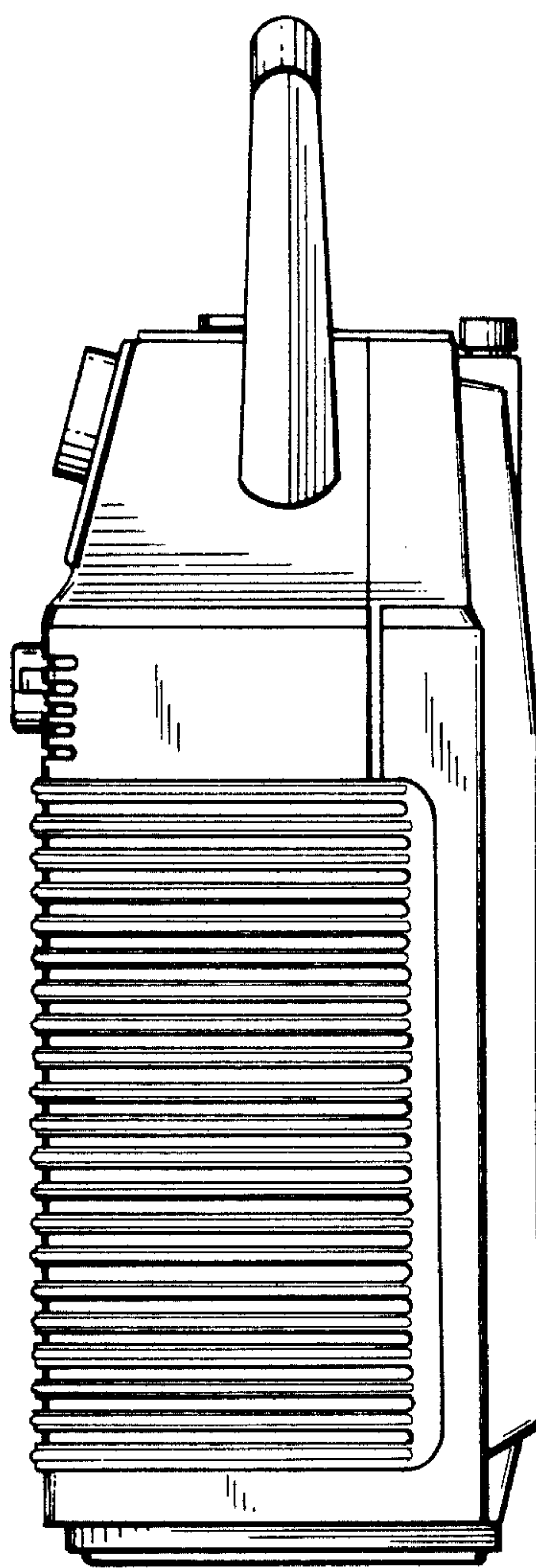
