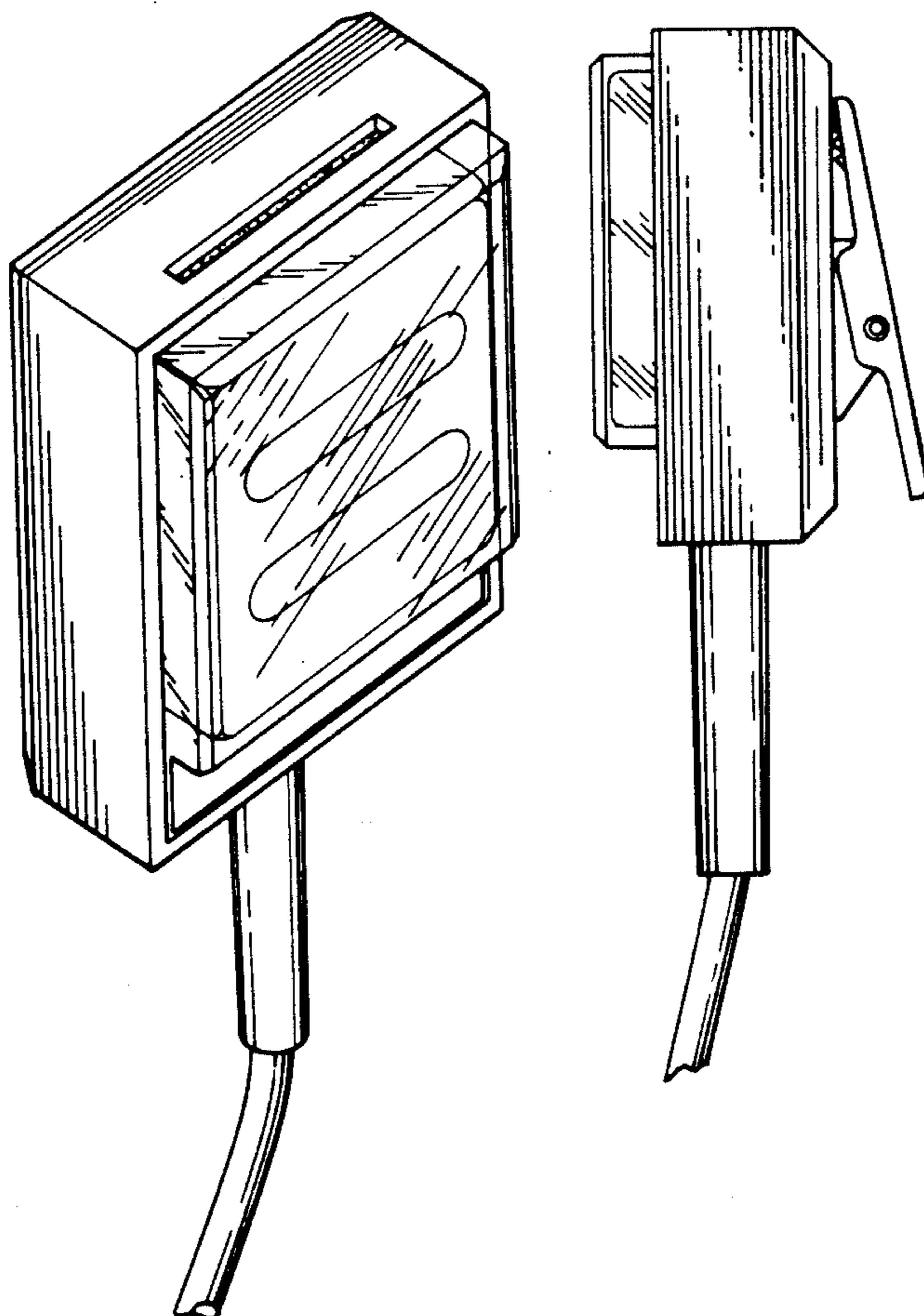

The ornamental design for a lapel speaker or similar article, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front top perspective view of a lapel speaker or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an elevation as seen from the right of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



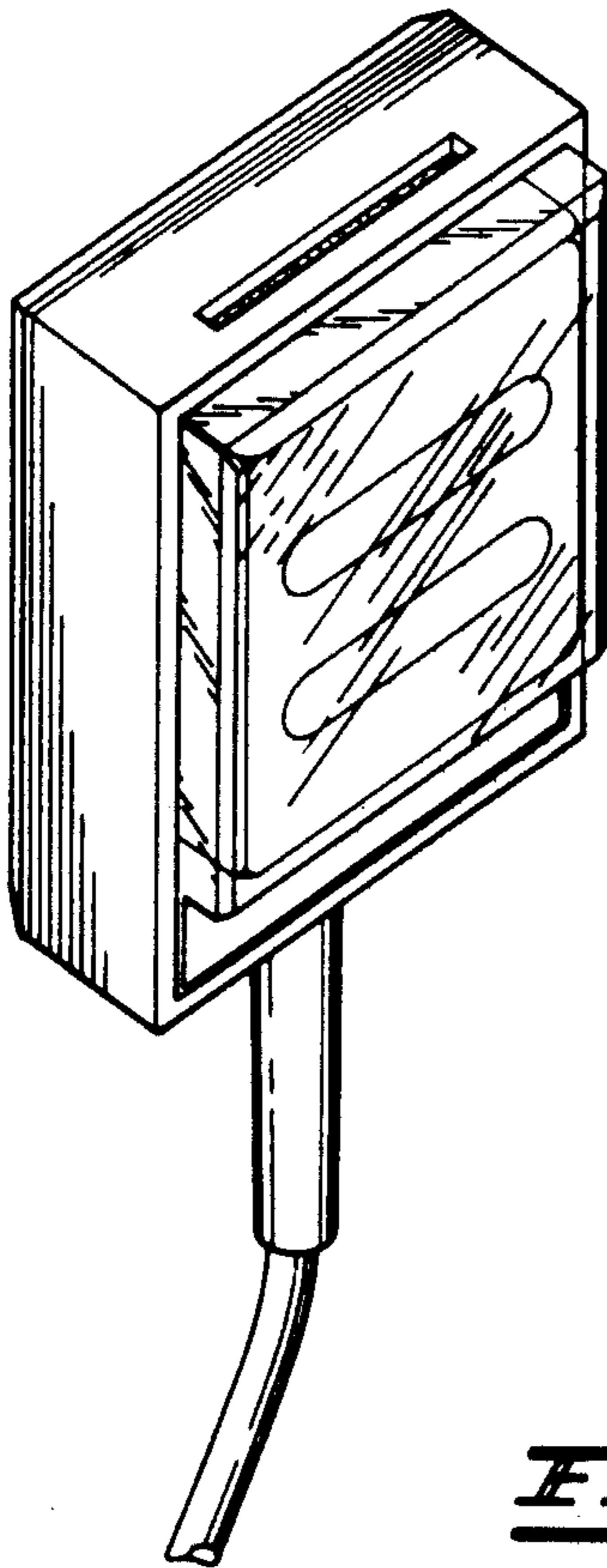

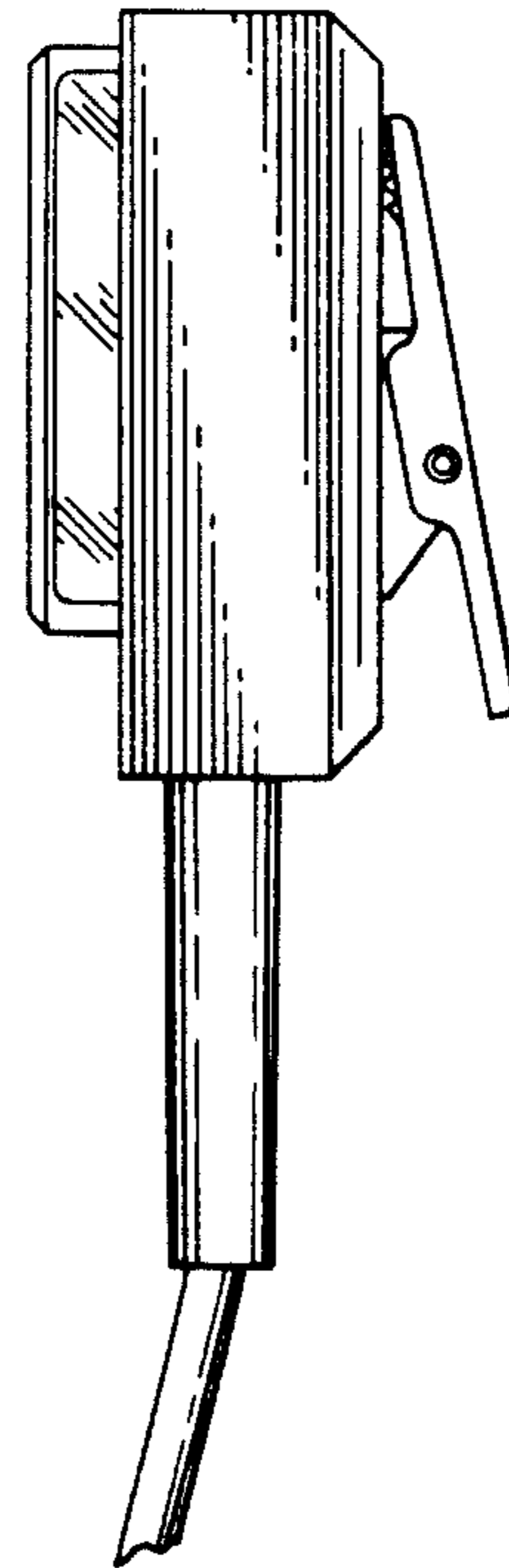

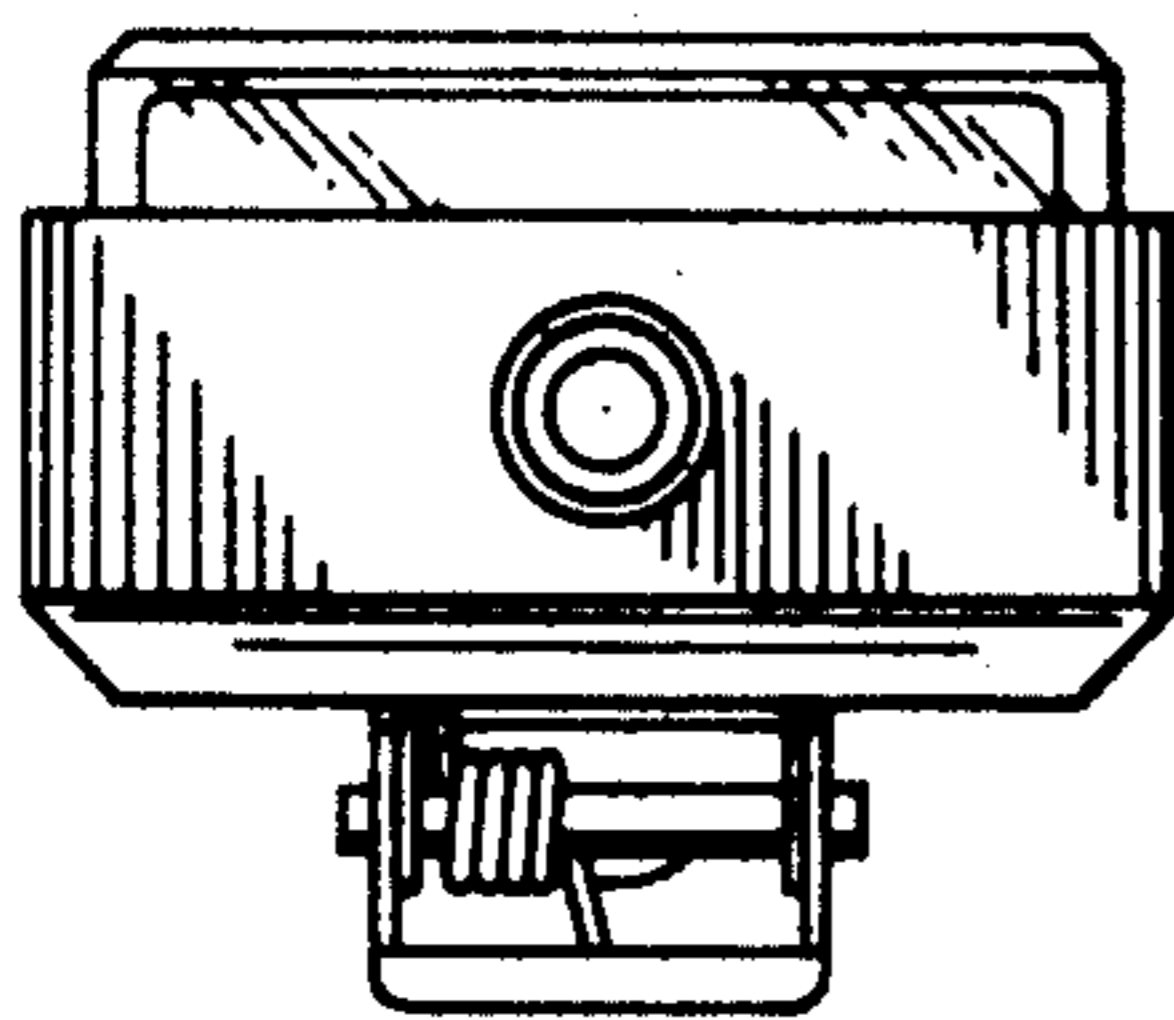

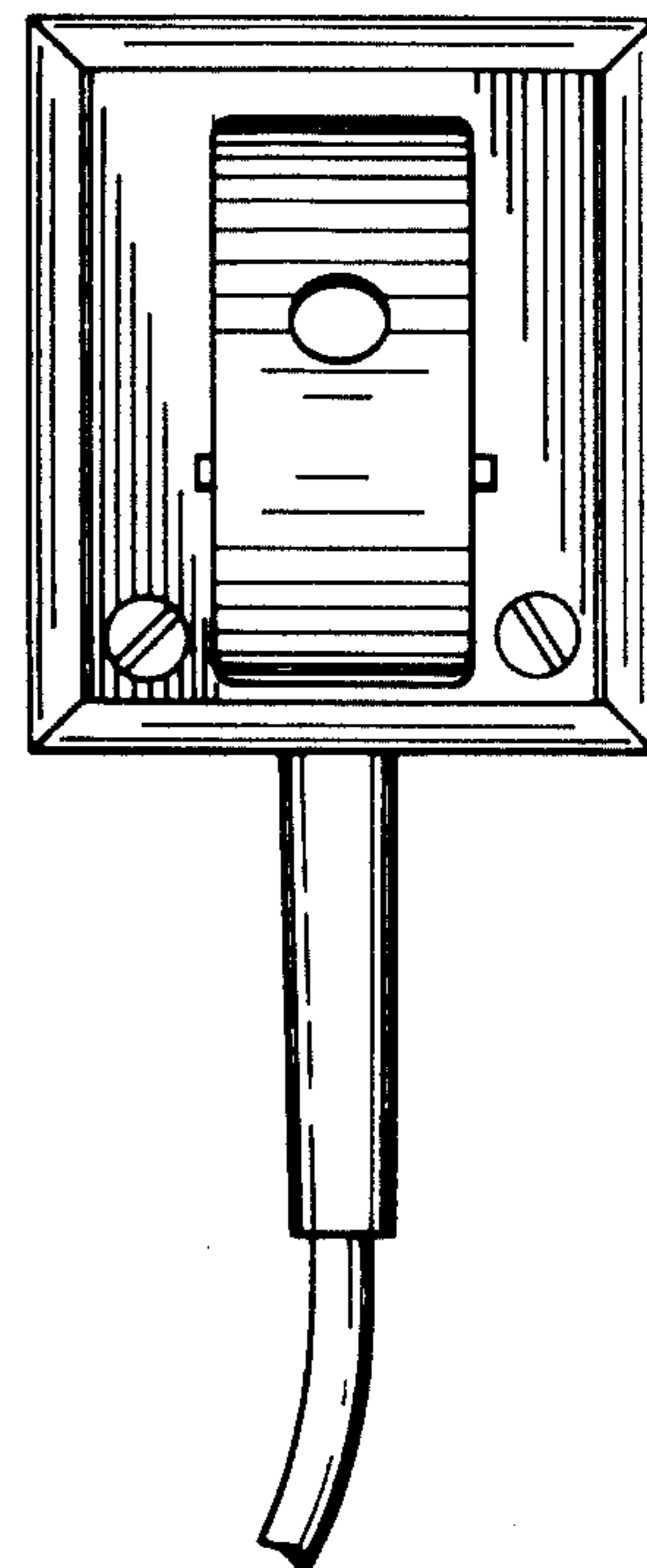
