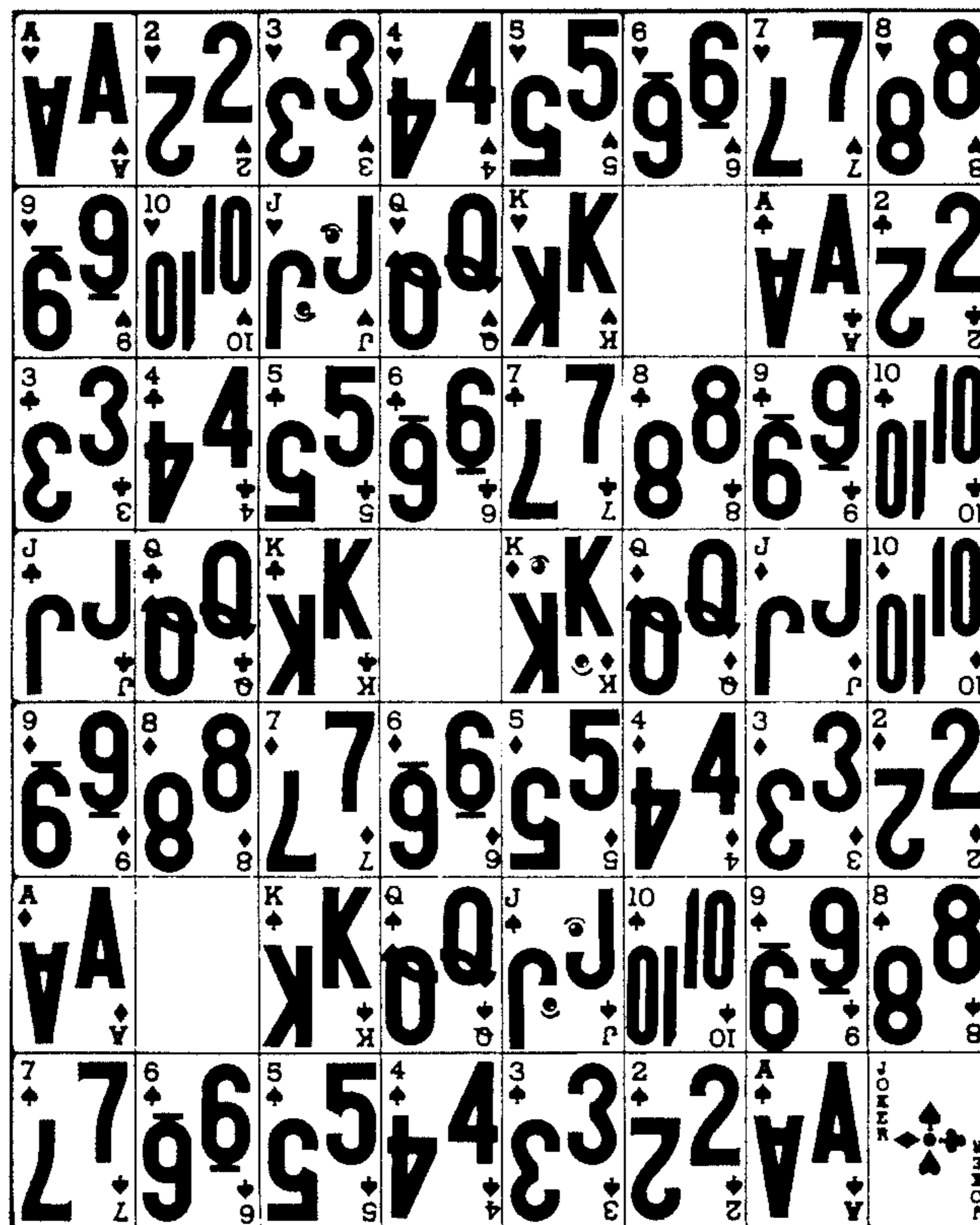
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a face plan view of a deck of playing cards showing our new design; and FIG. 2 is a back plan view on an enlarged scale of one of the cards of the deck, the back plan view of each of the cards being similar.

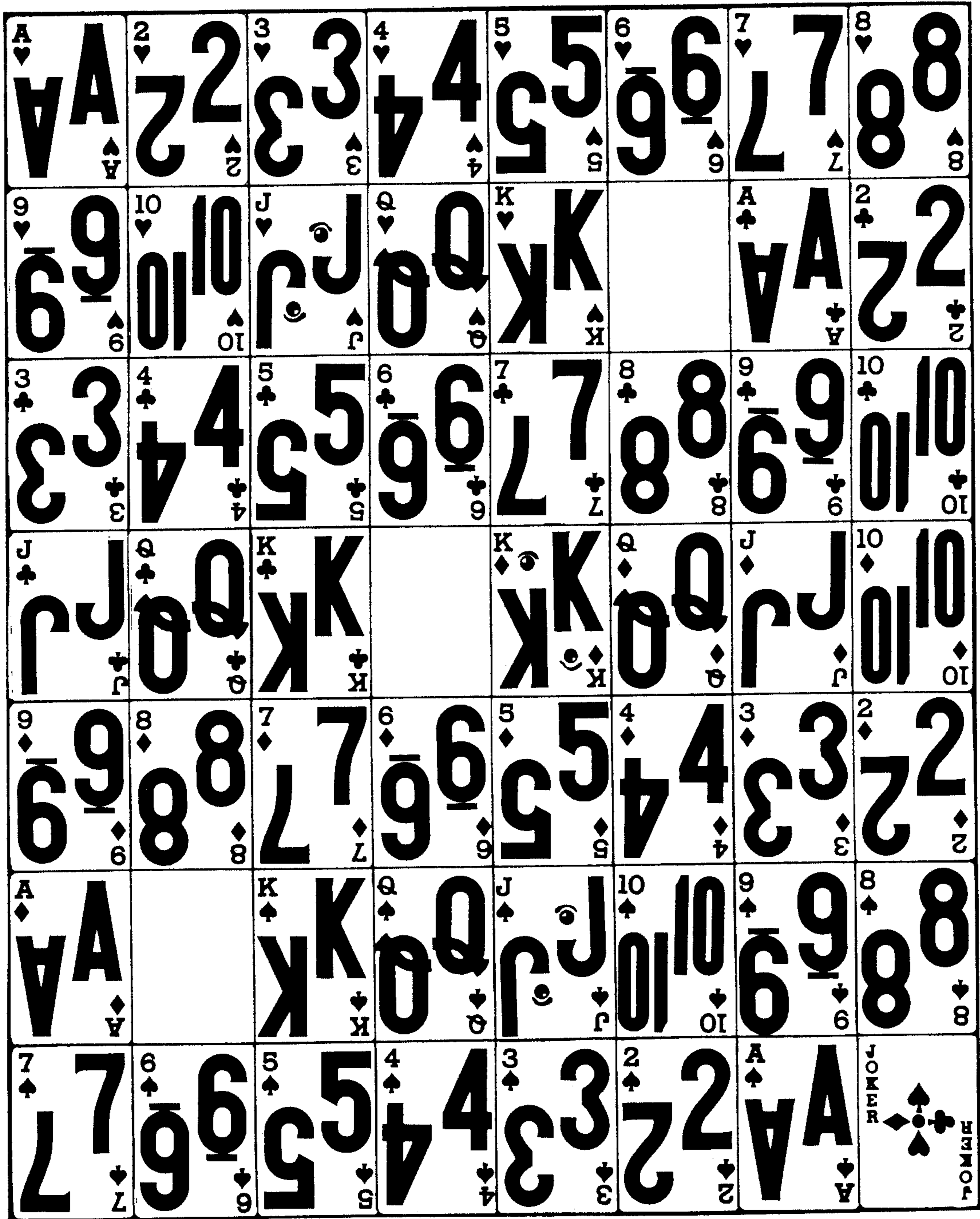

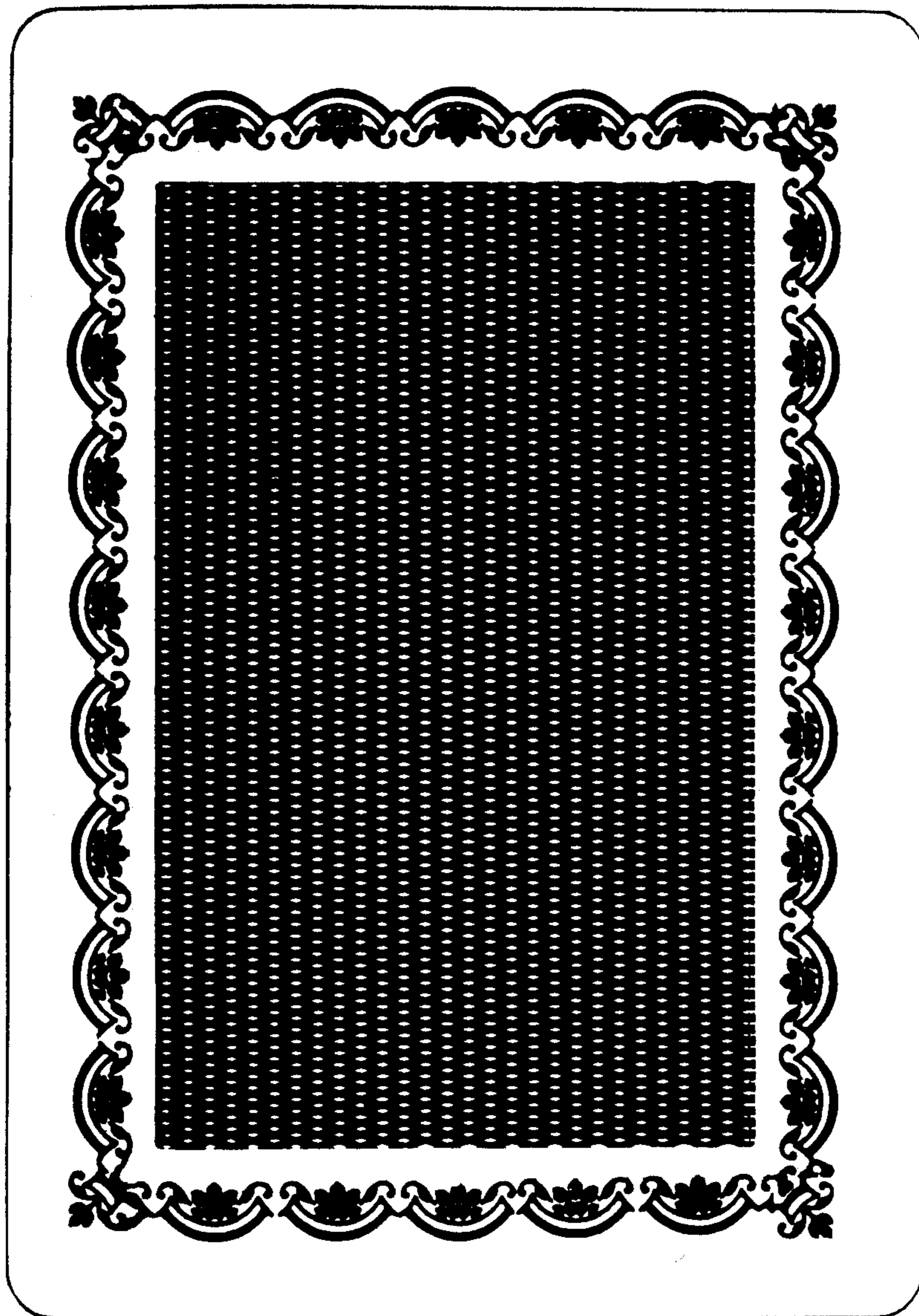
