DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a ramekin showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The side of the ramekin not shown is a mirror image of the side illustrated.



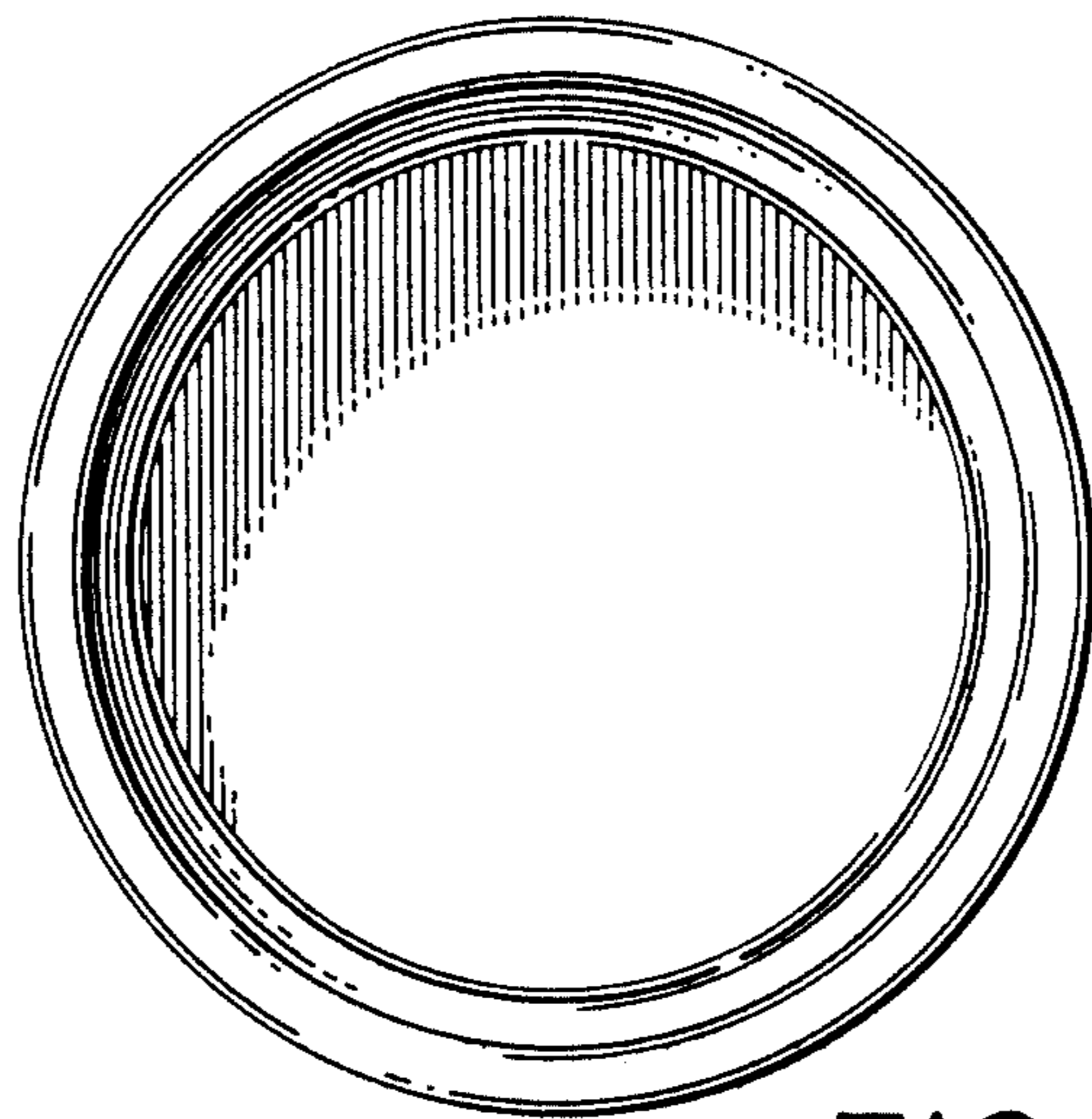

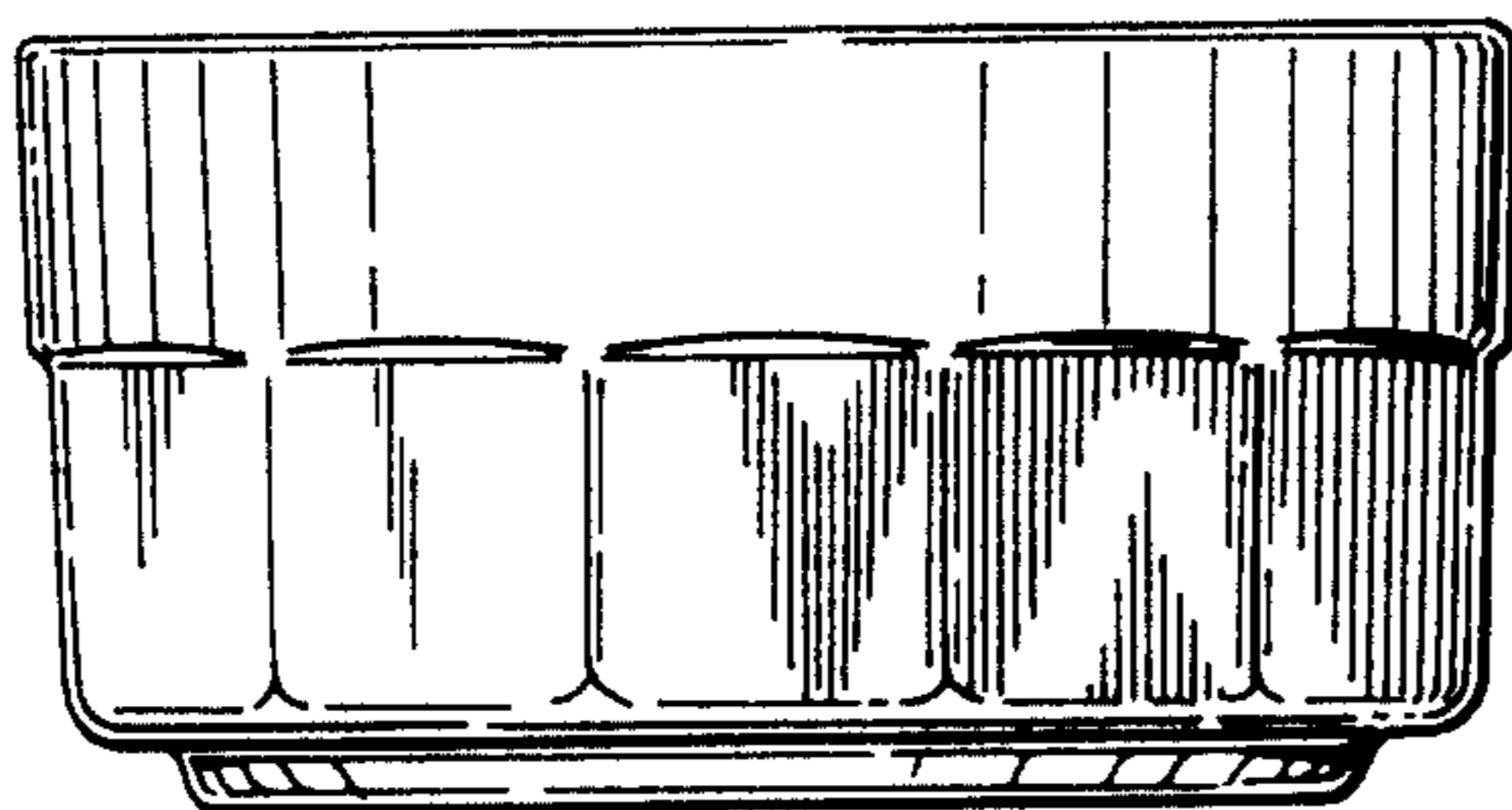

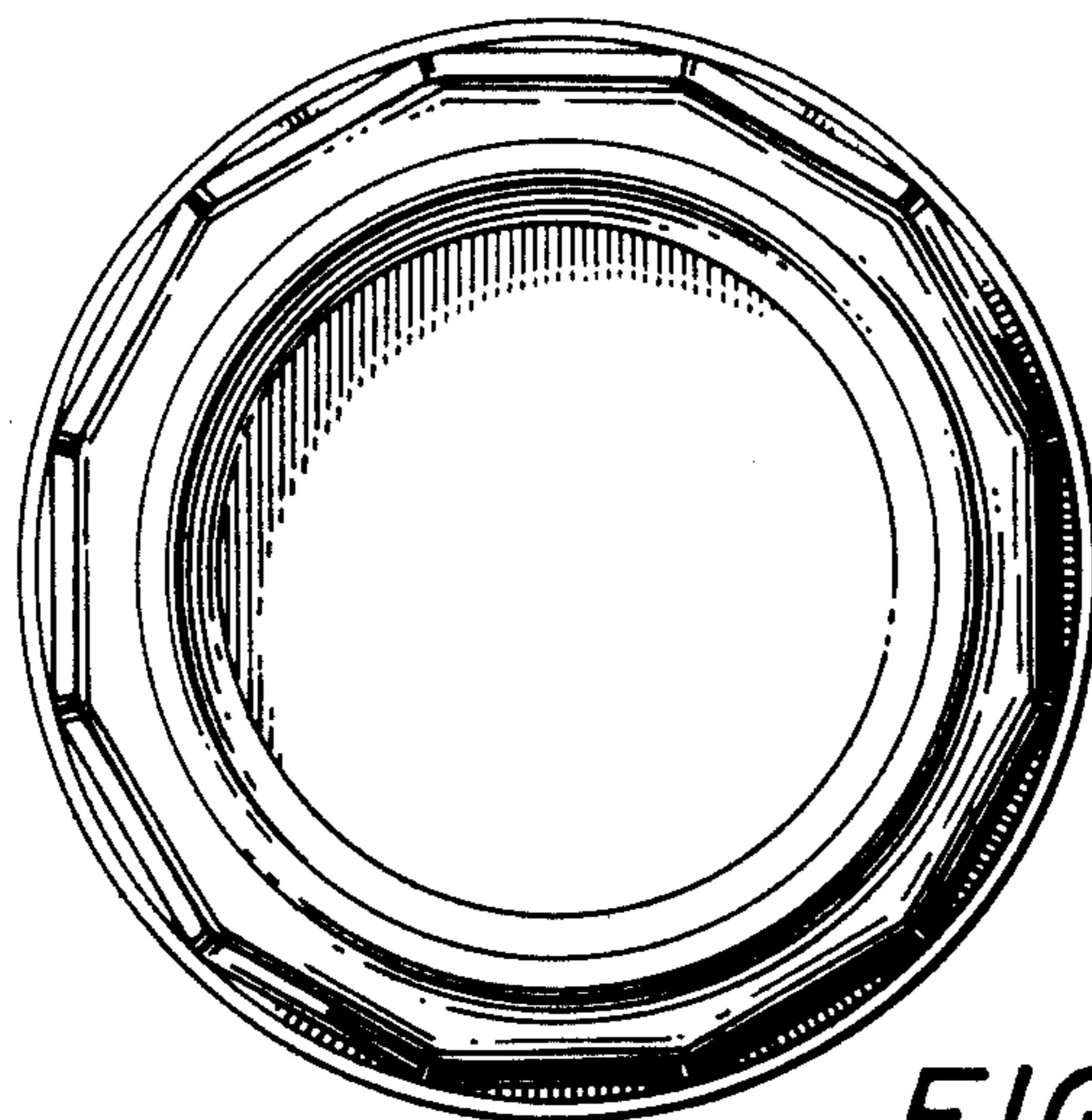
