DESCRIPTION

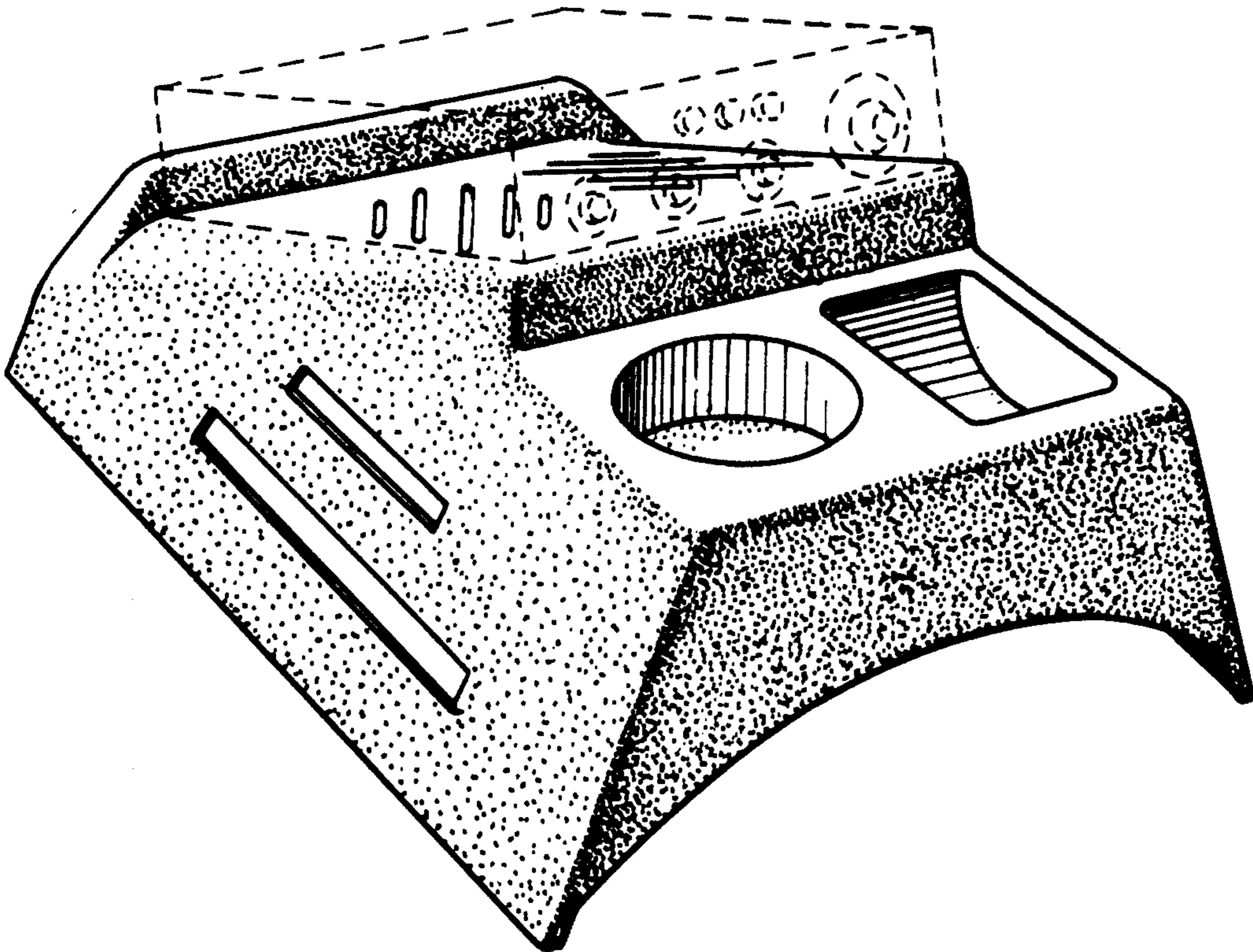
FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a universal mount for a citizen band radio and tape player showing my new design;

The broken lines in the drawing are for illustrative purposes only.



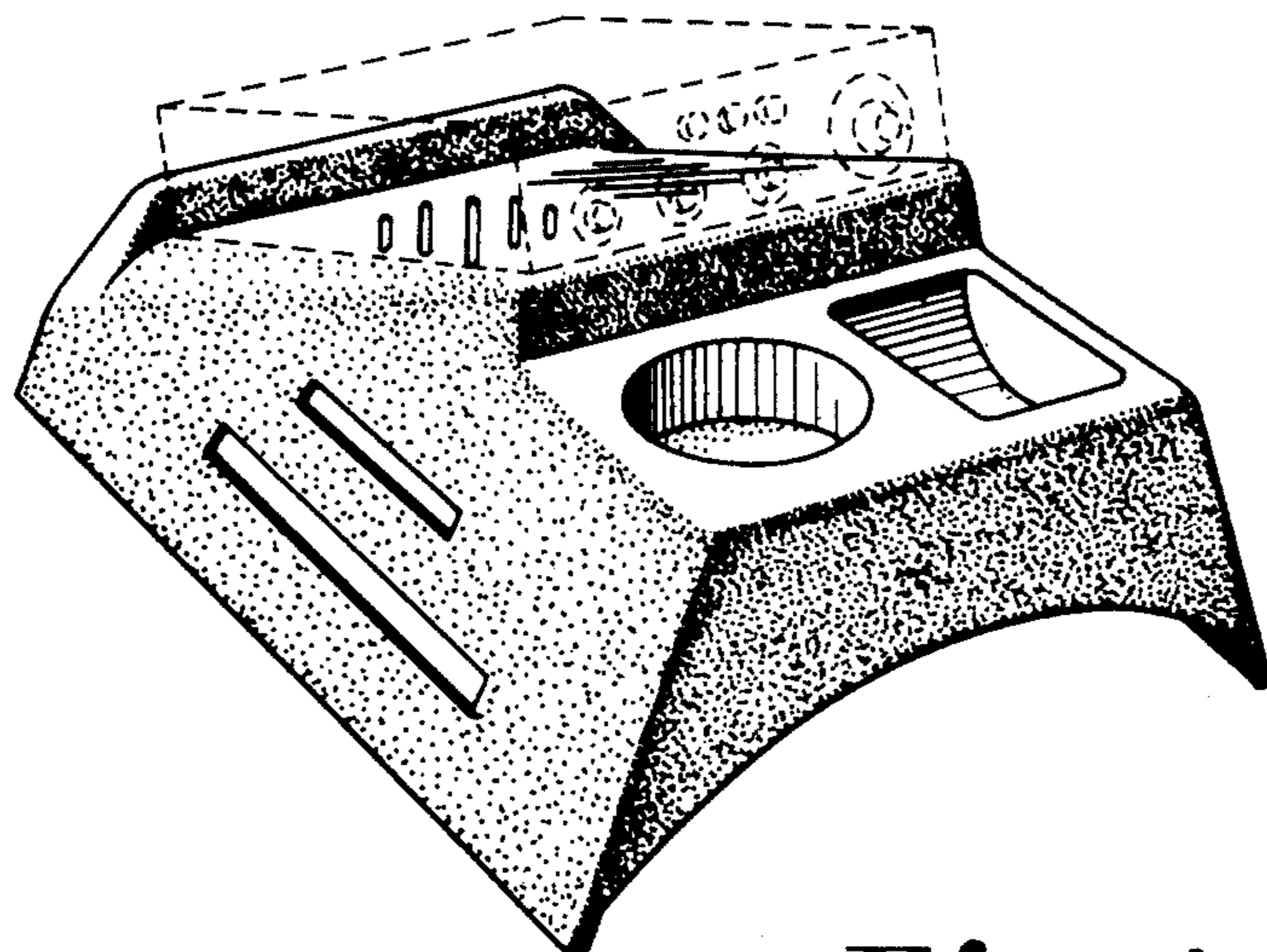

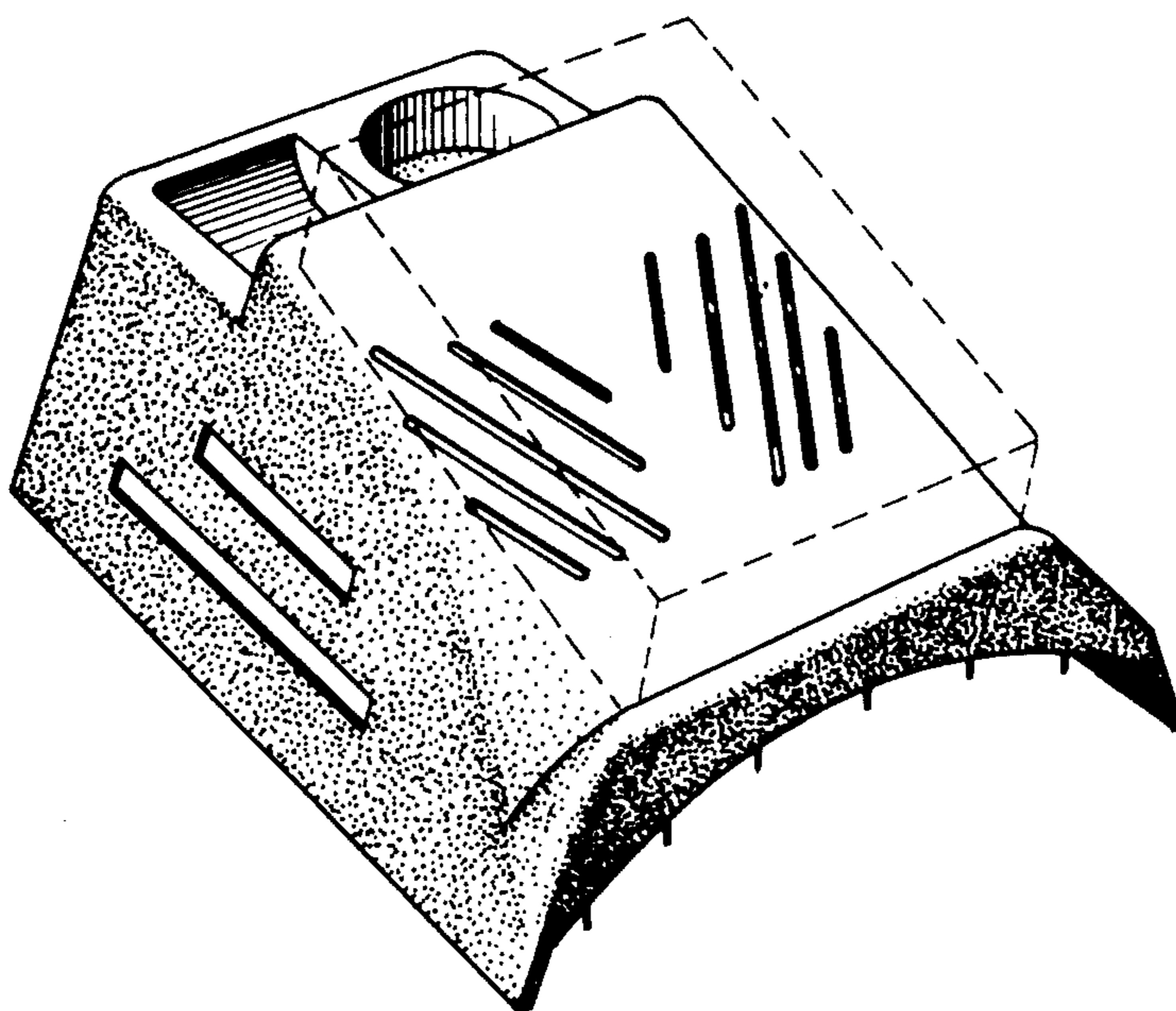

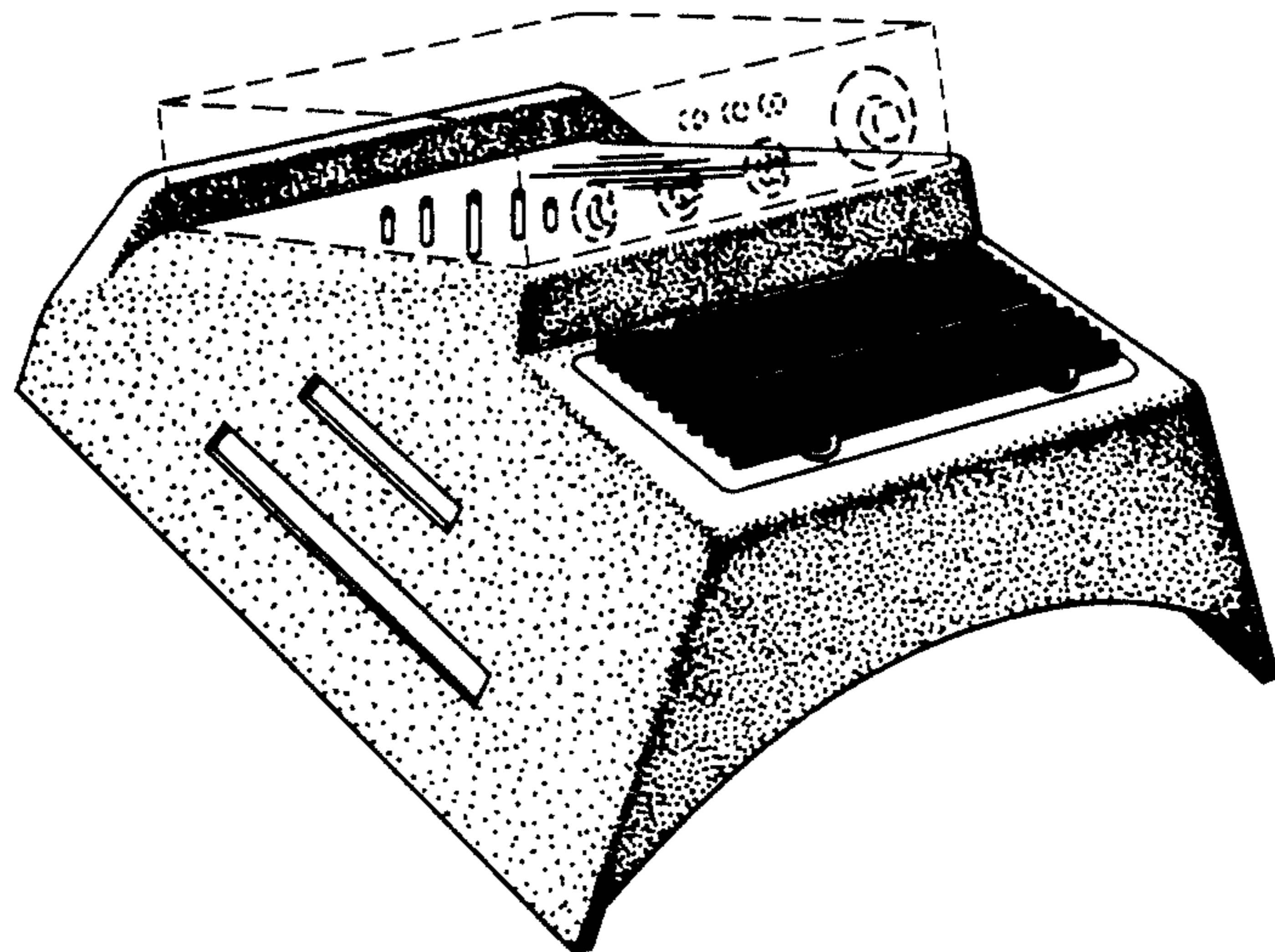

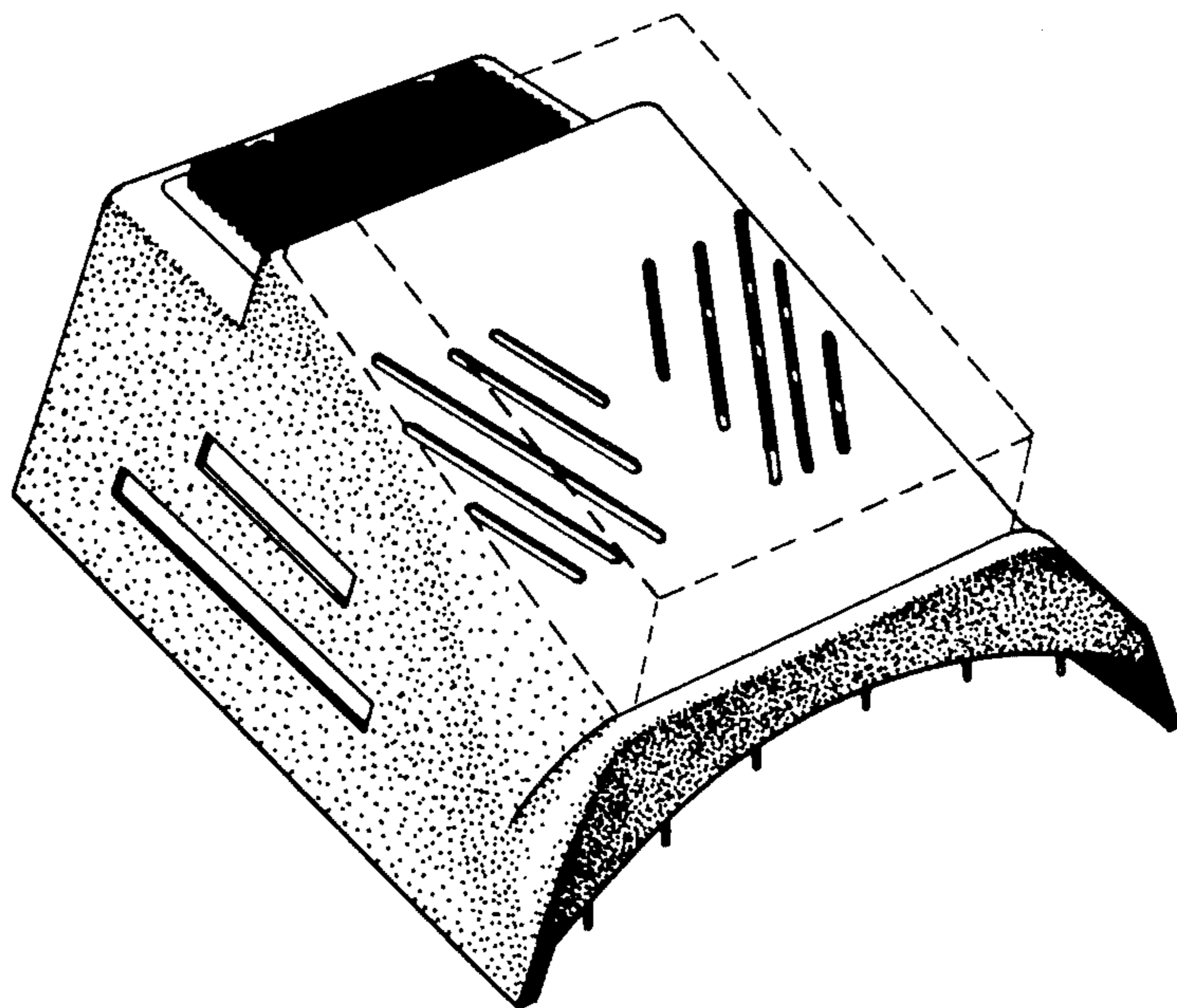
