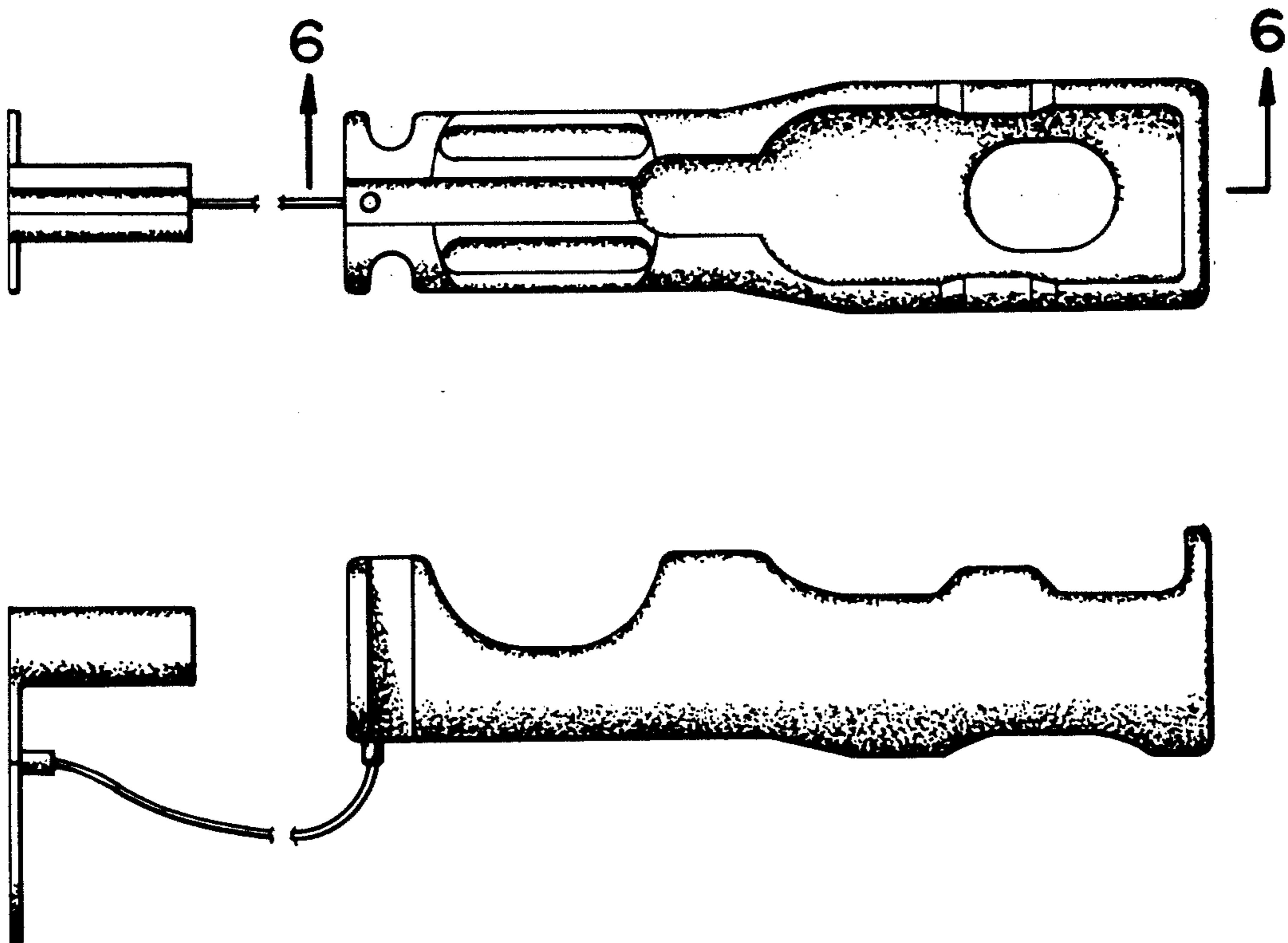

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a vial holder and unit gauge for hypodermic syringes, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a vial holder and unit gauge for hypodermic syringes showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 4 is a one end view; FIG. 5 is the other end view; and FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 1.



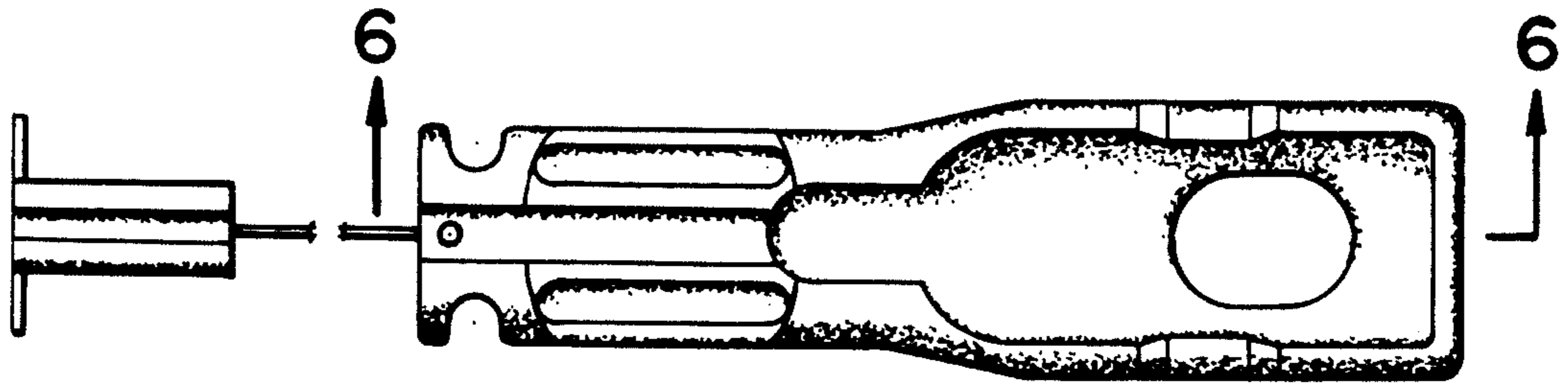

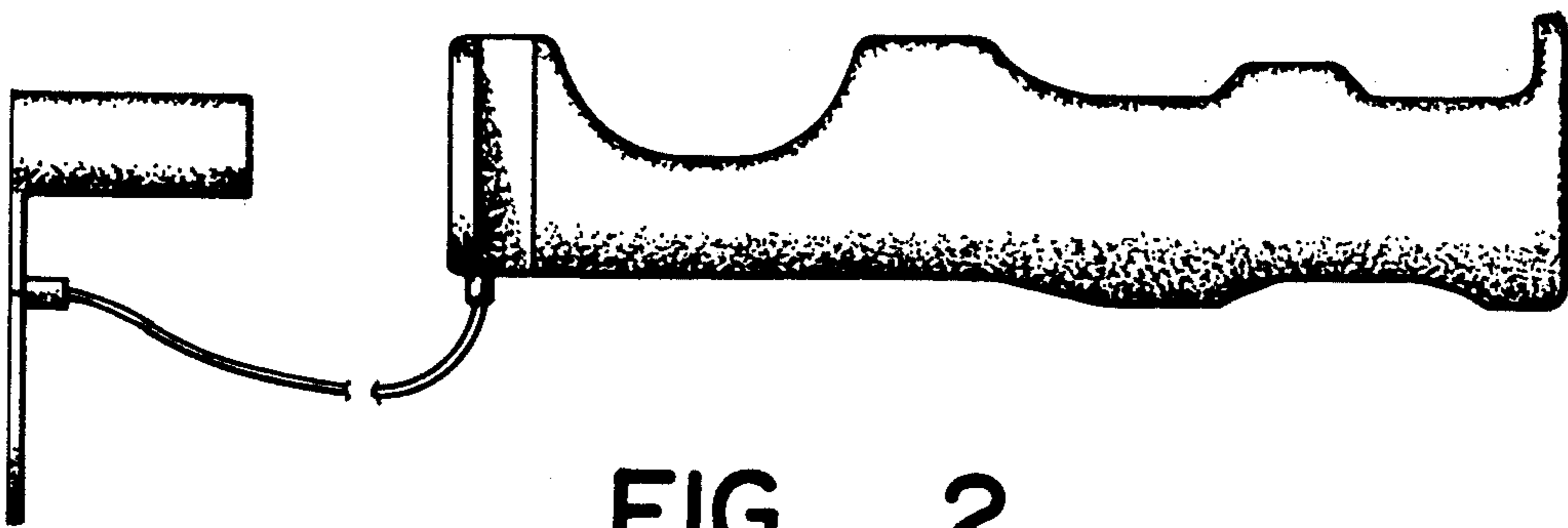

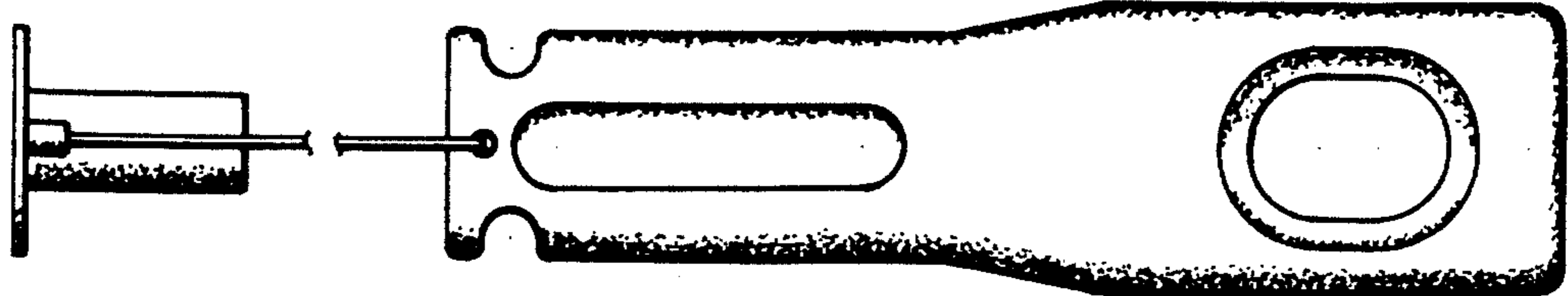

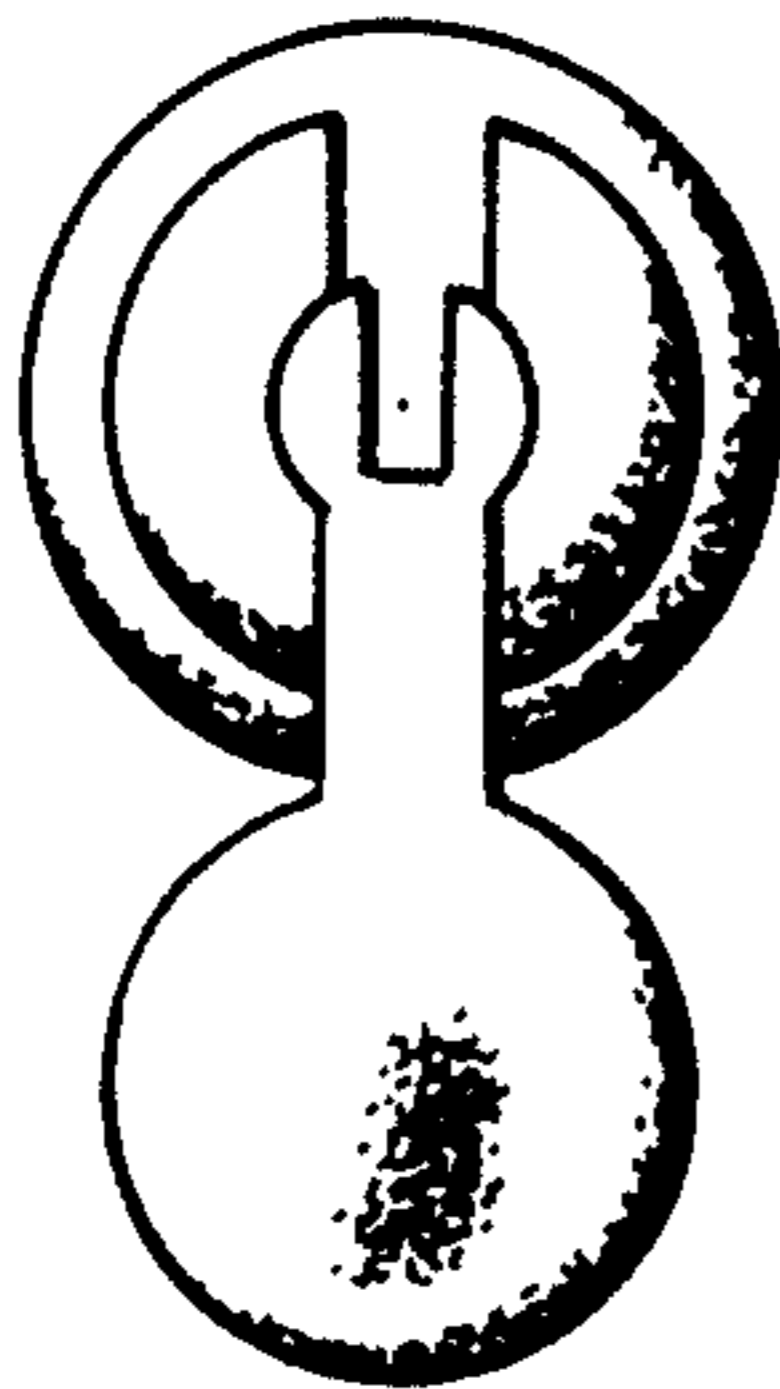

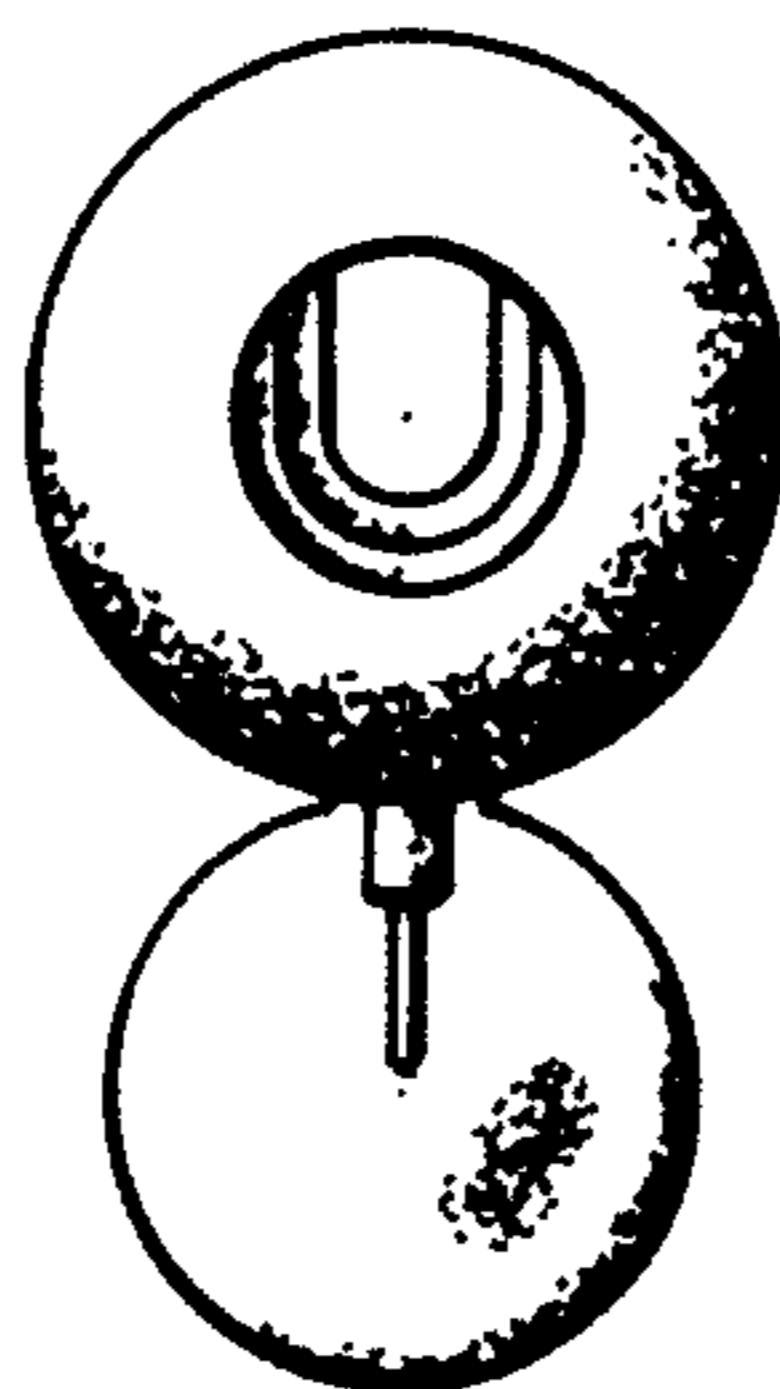
