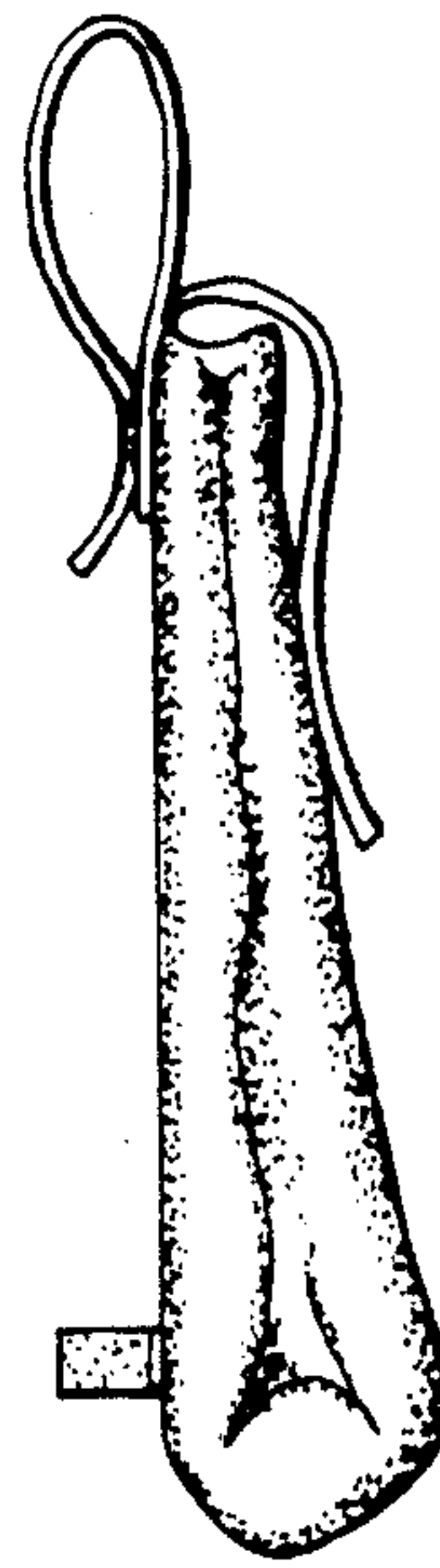
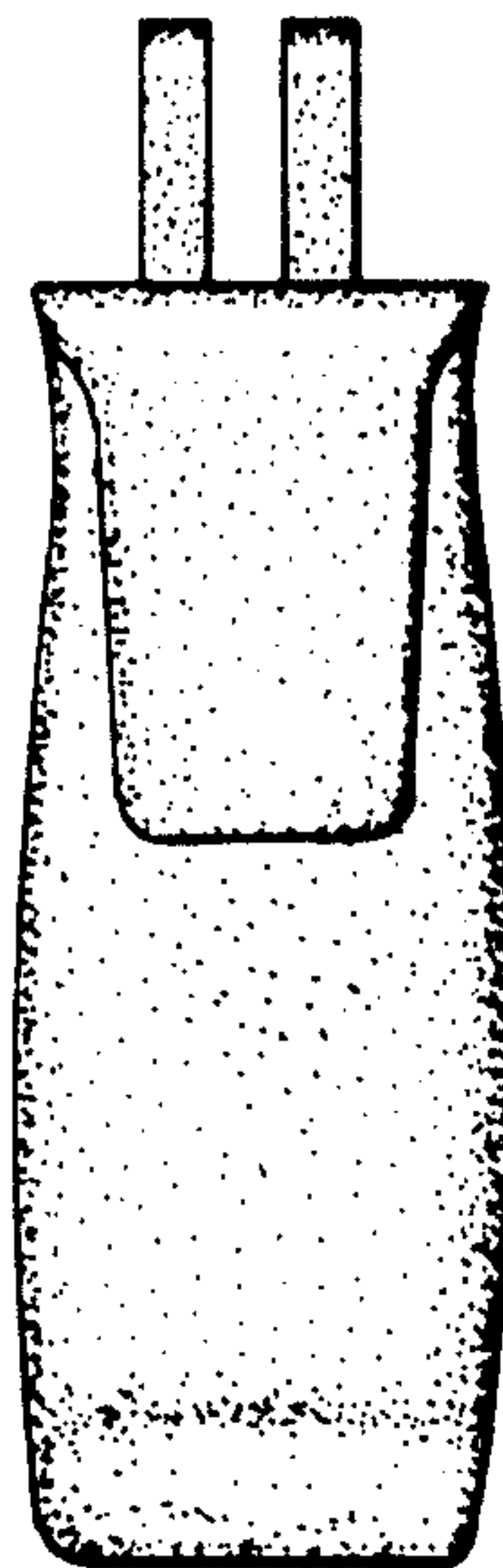

CLAIM

The ornamental design for article carrying bag for attachment to a crutch, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an article carrying bag for attachment to a crutch showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the opposite side being substantially a mirror image thereof.



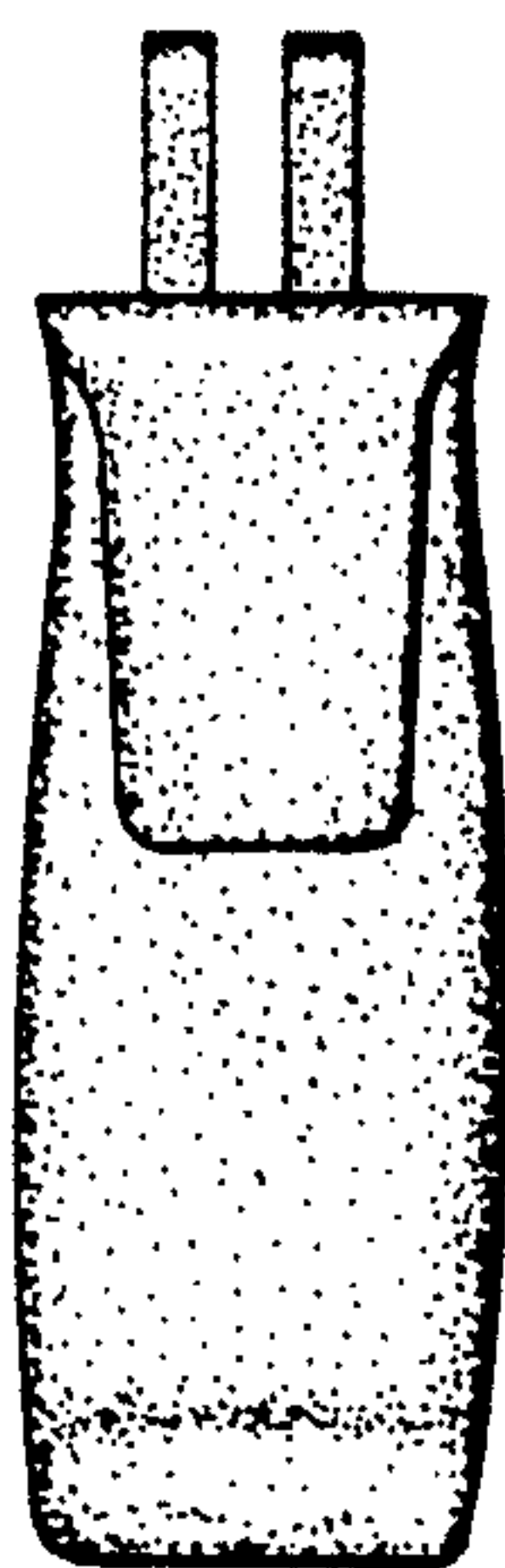

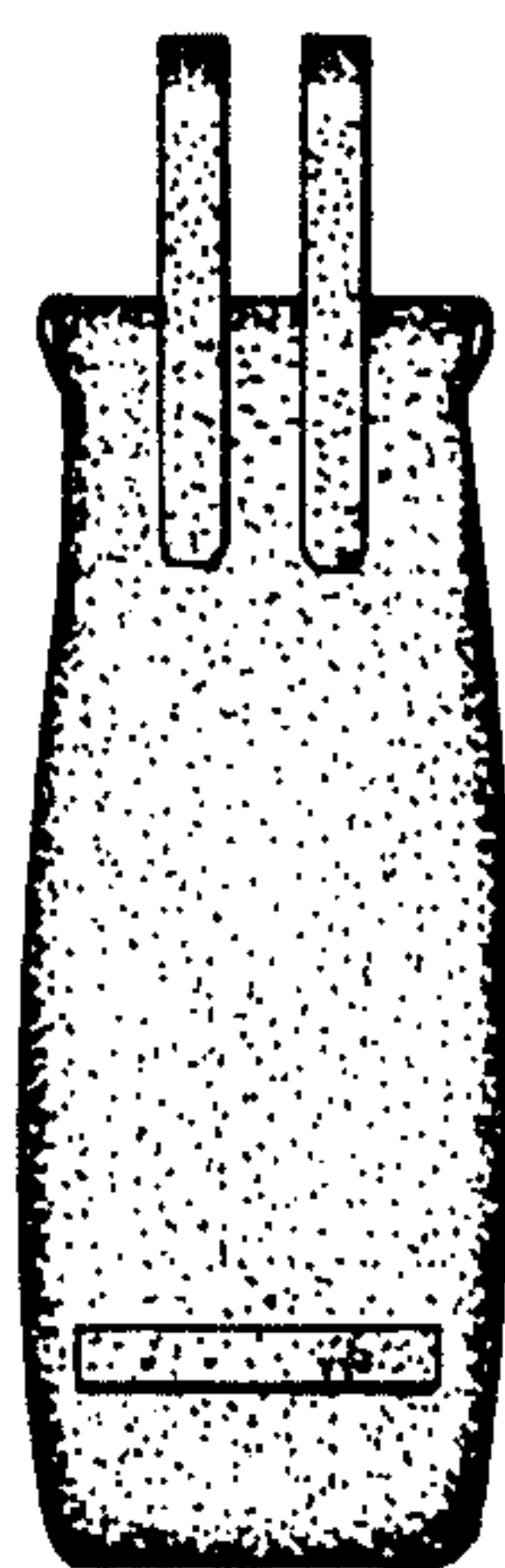

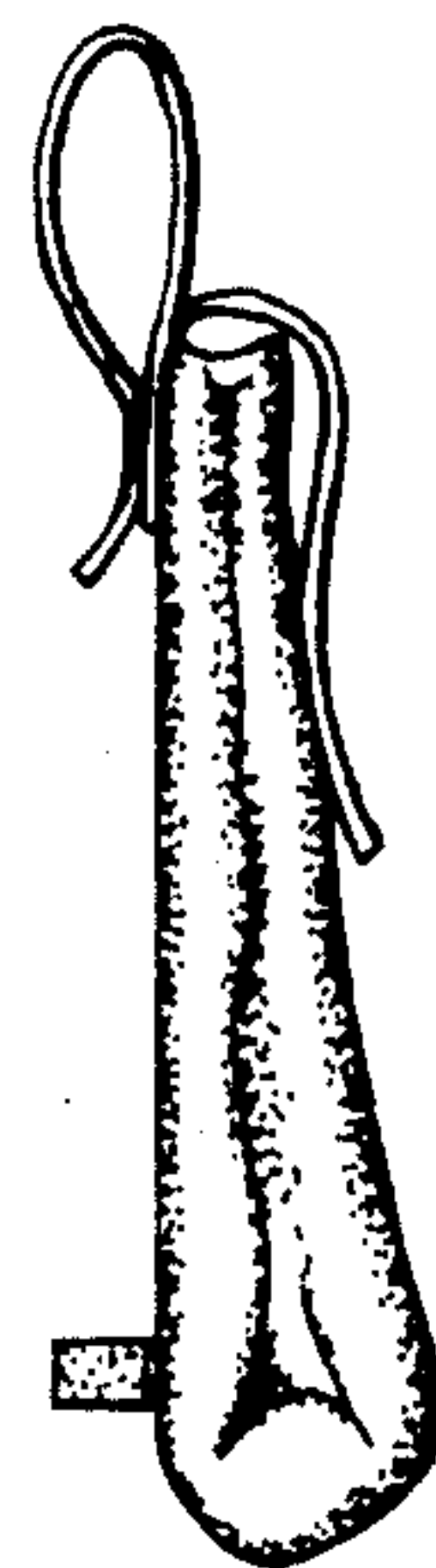
