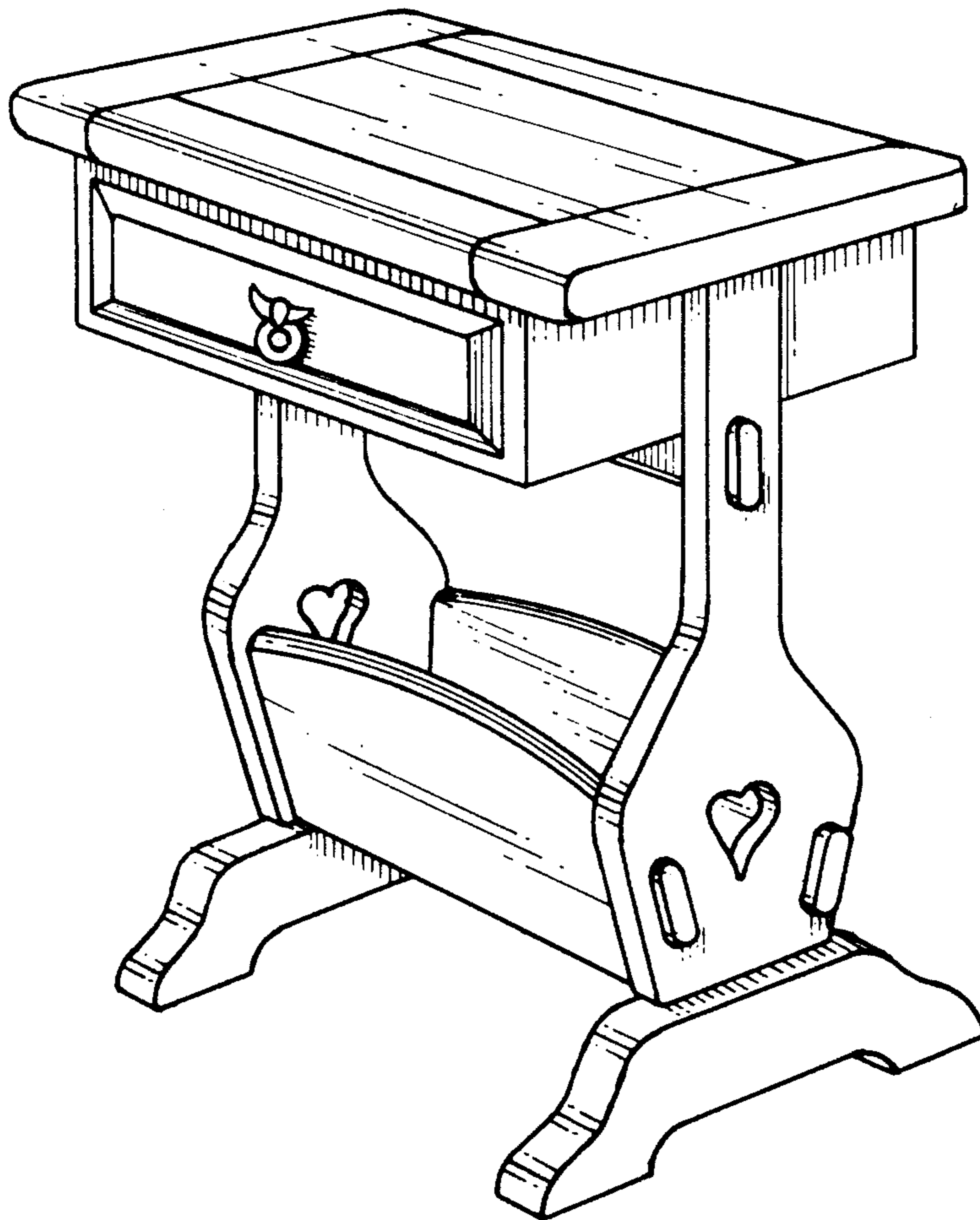
CLAIM
