DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a mirror frame showing our new design, the side opposite being substantially flat, plain and unornamented;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

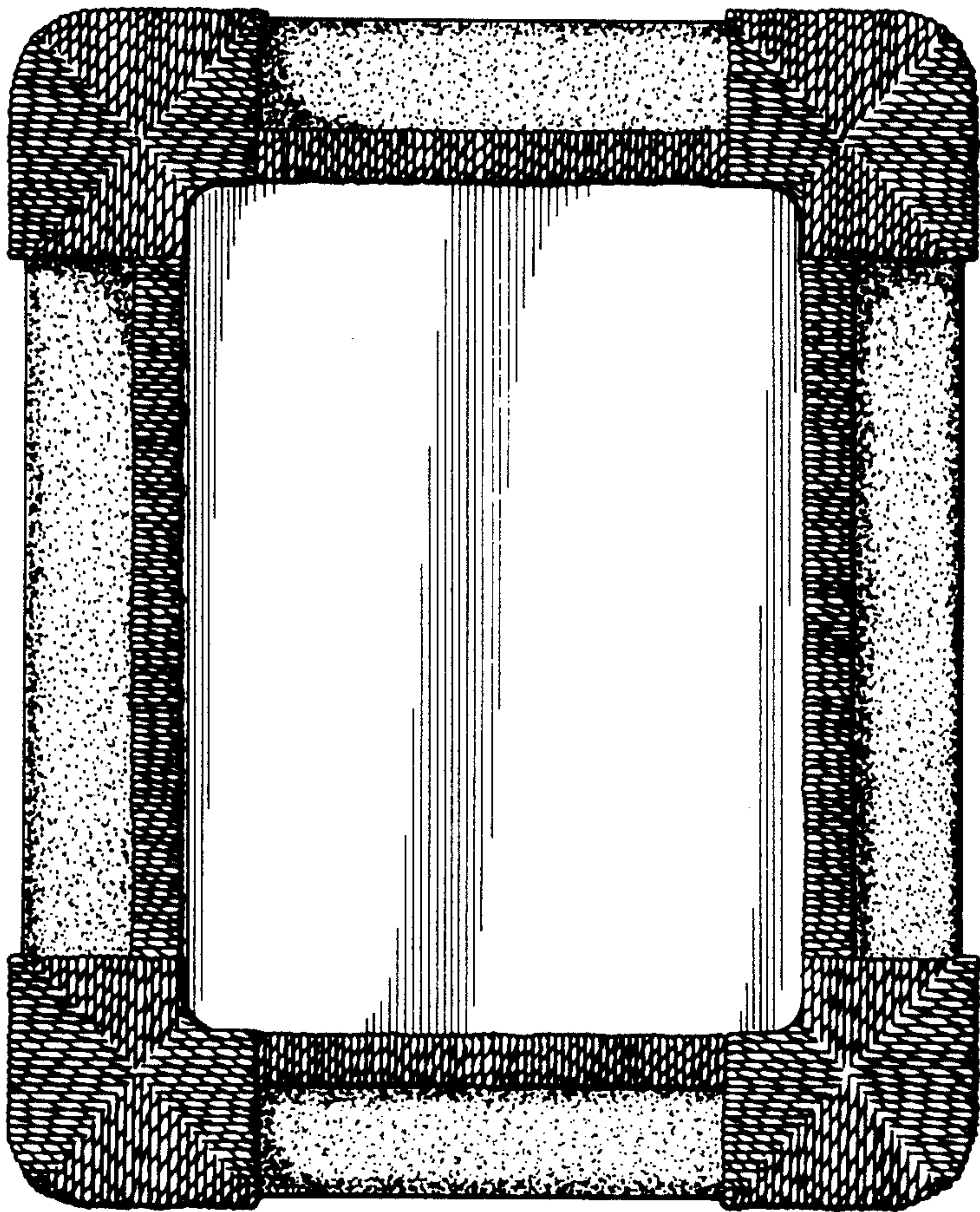

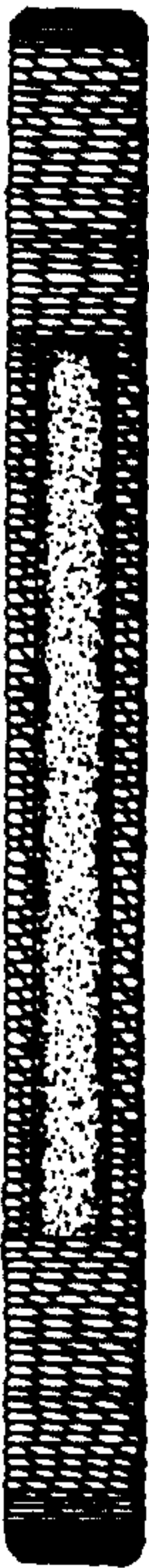

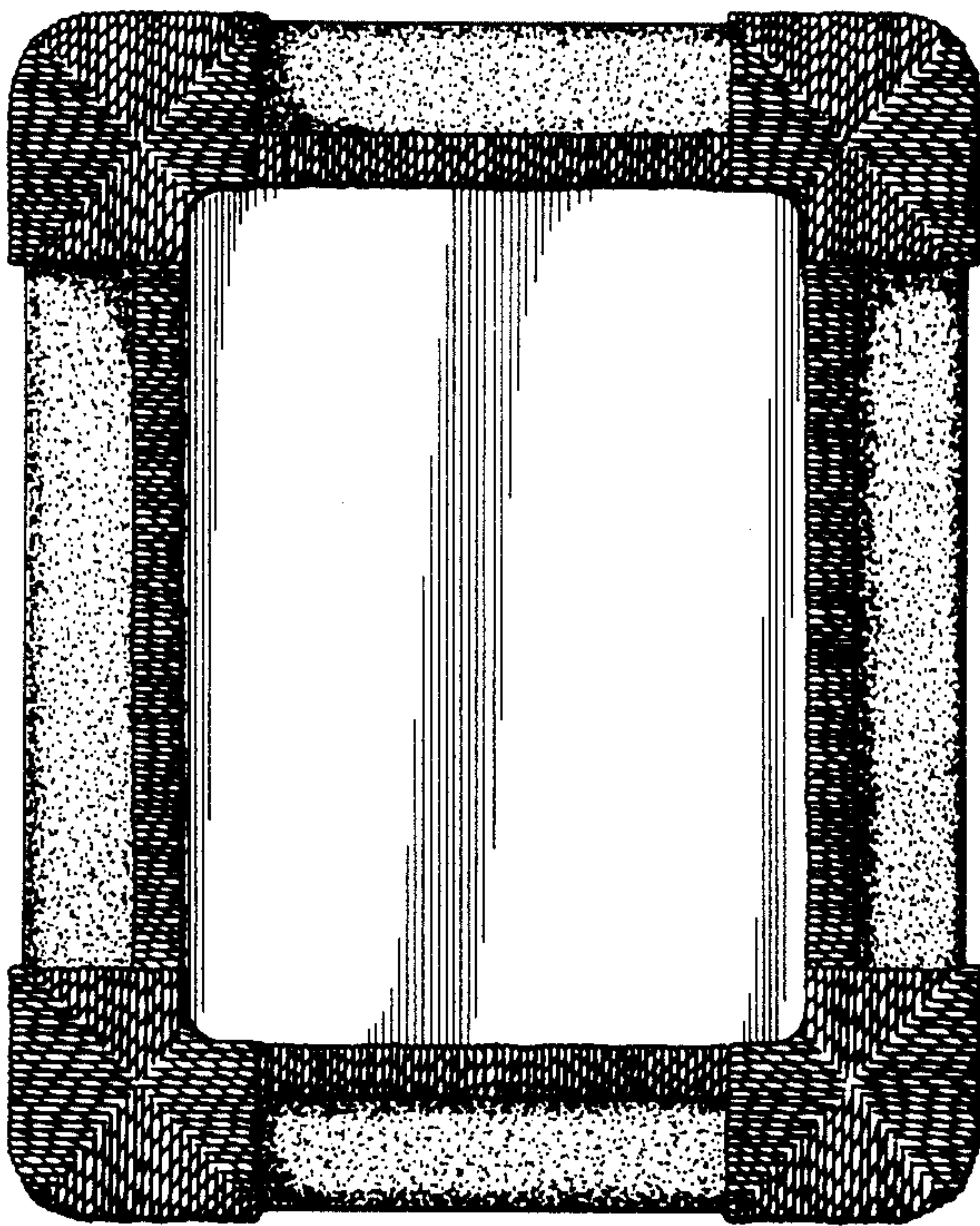

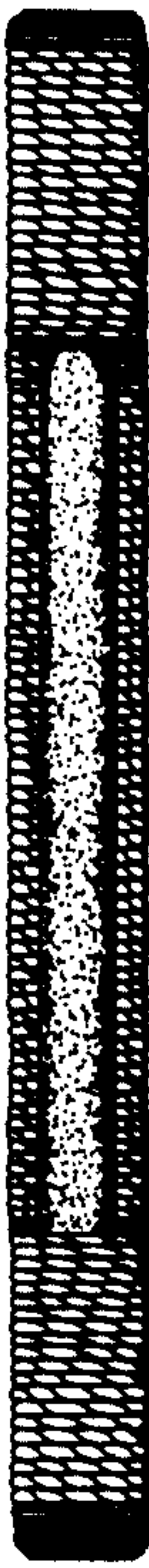
