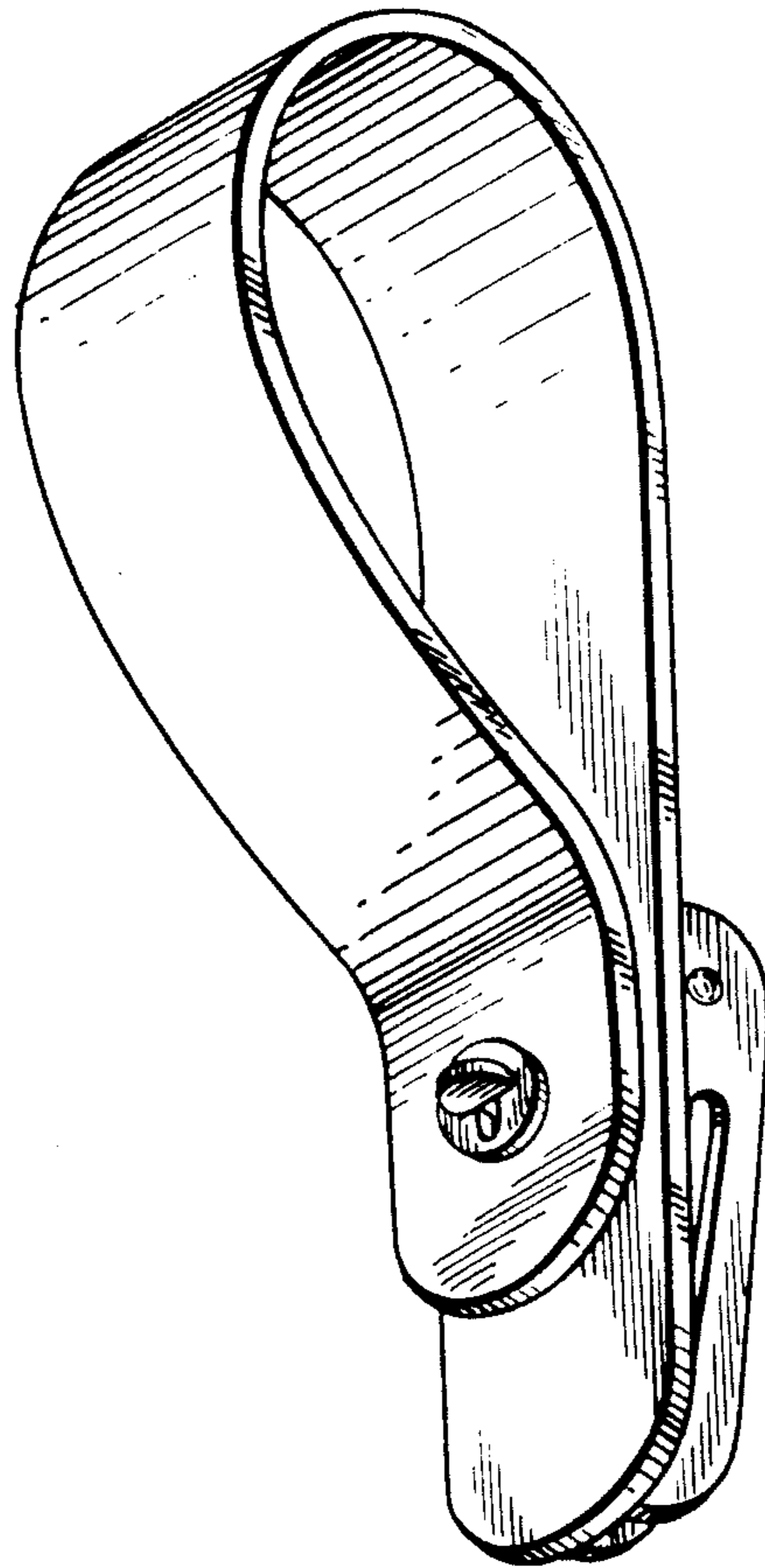
DESCRIPTION

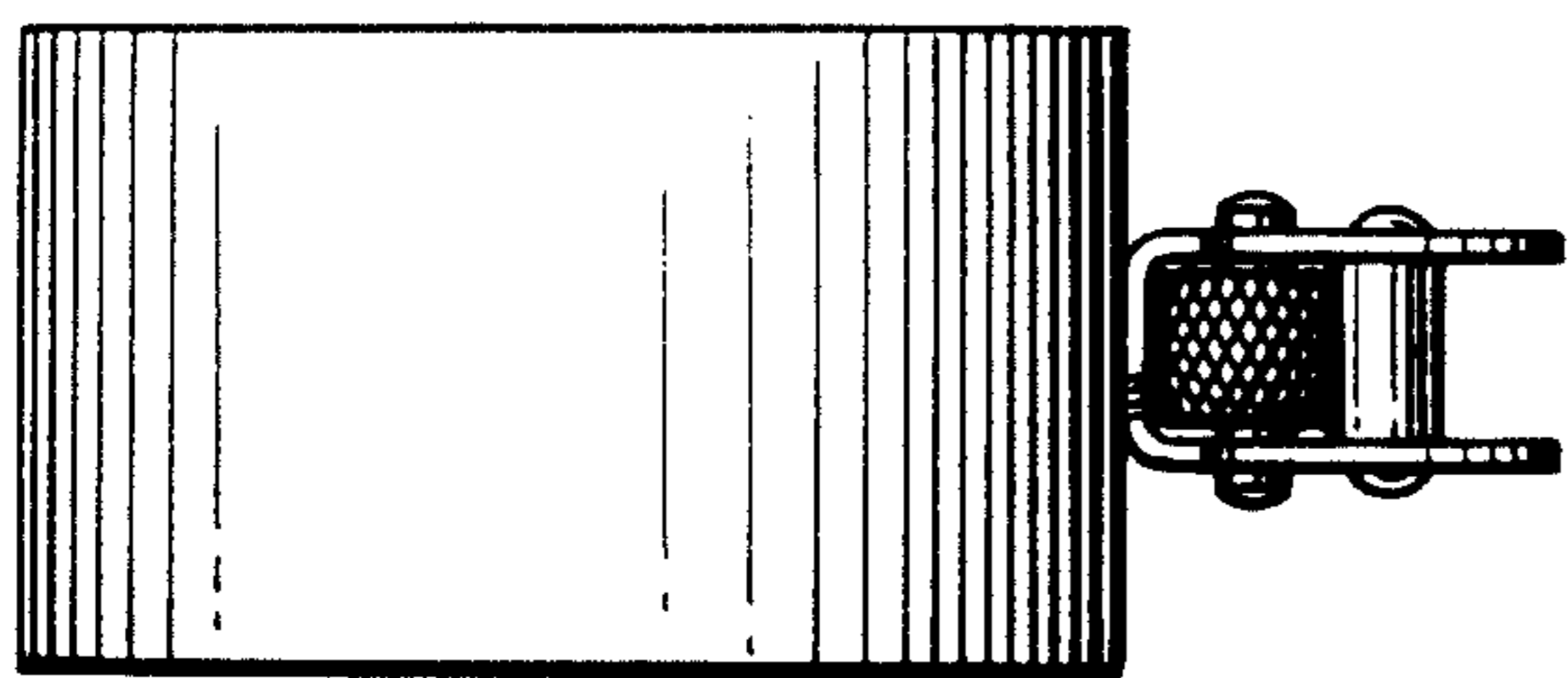

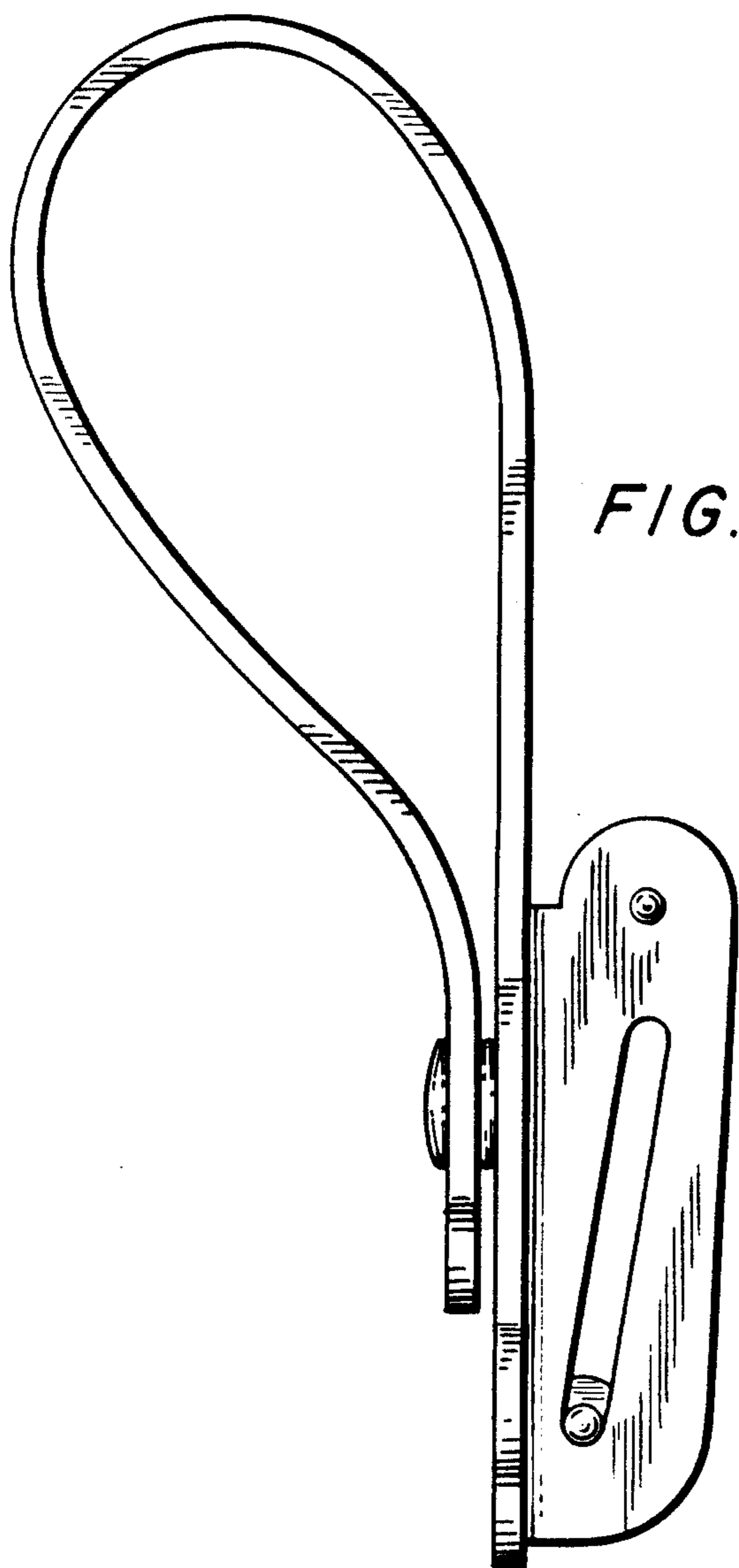

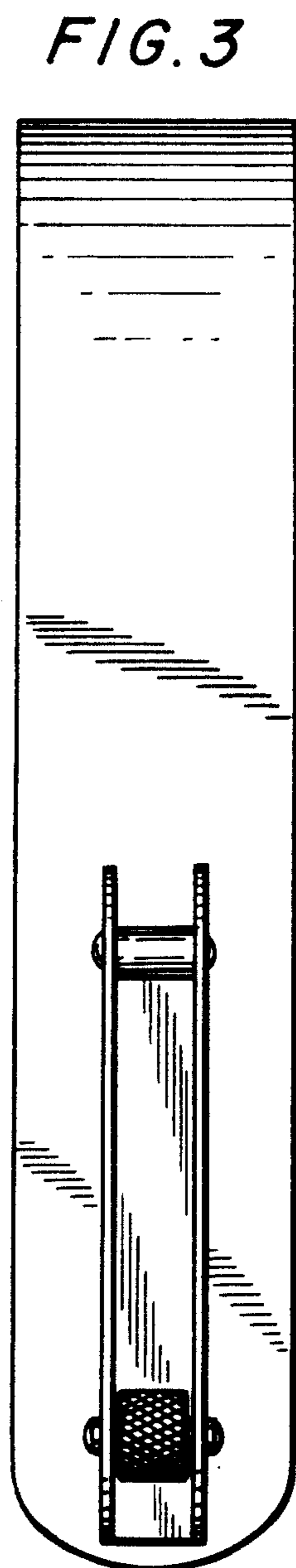

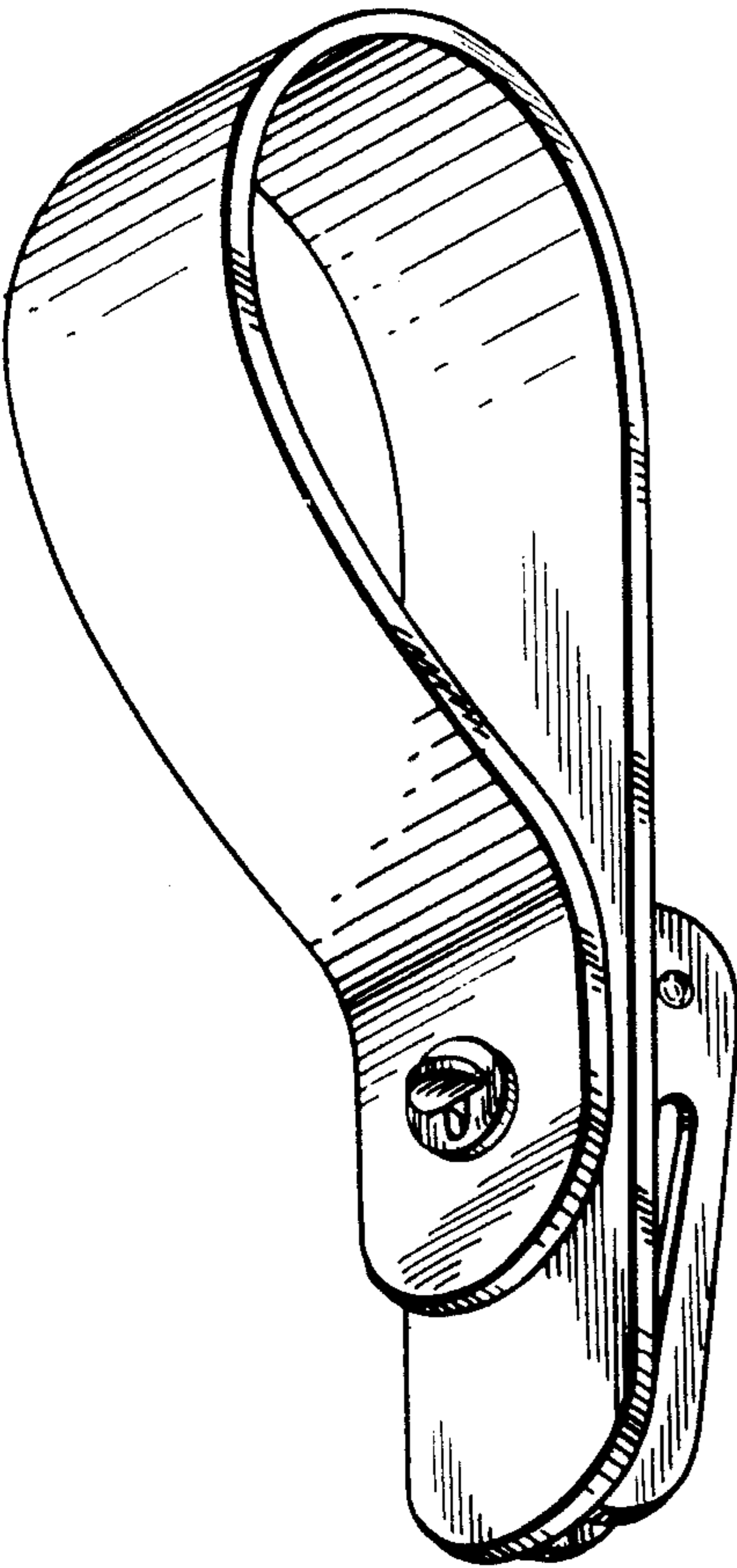

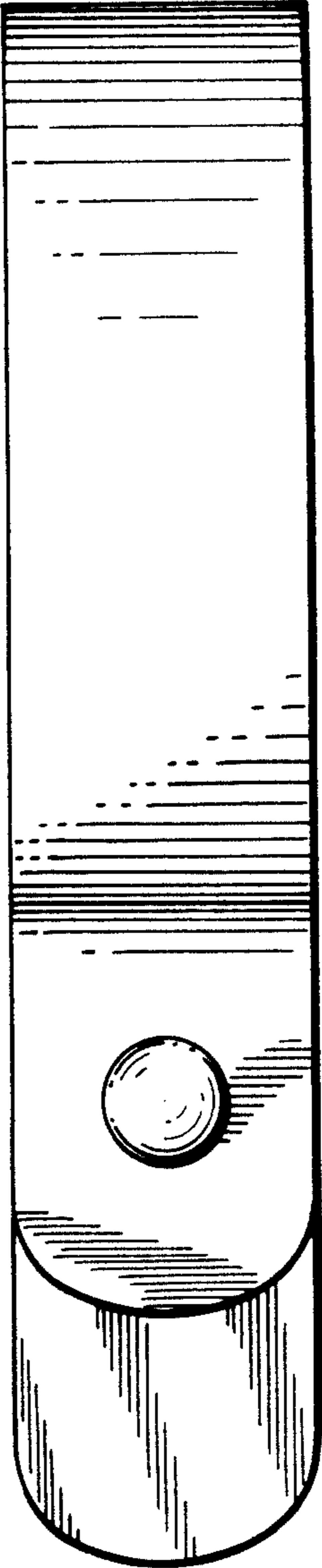
