FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a box showing our new design in a partially open position;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view in a closed position;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view showing the side opposite that seen in FIG. 4;
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 8 is a sectional view taken on the line 8—8 of FIG. 2; and
FIG. 9 is a sectional view taken on the line 9—9 of FIG. 5.
