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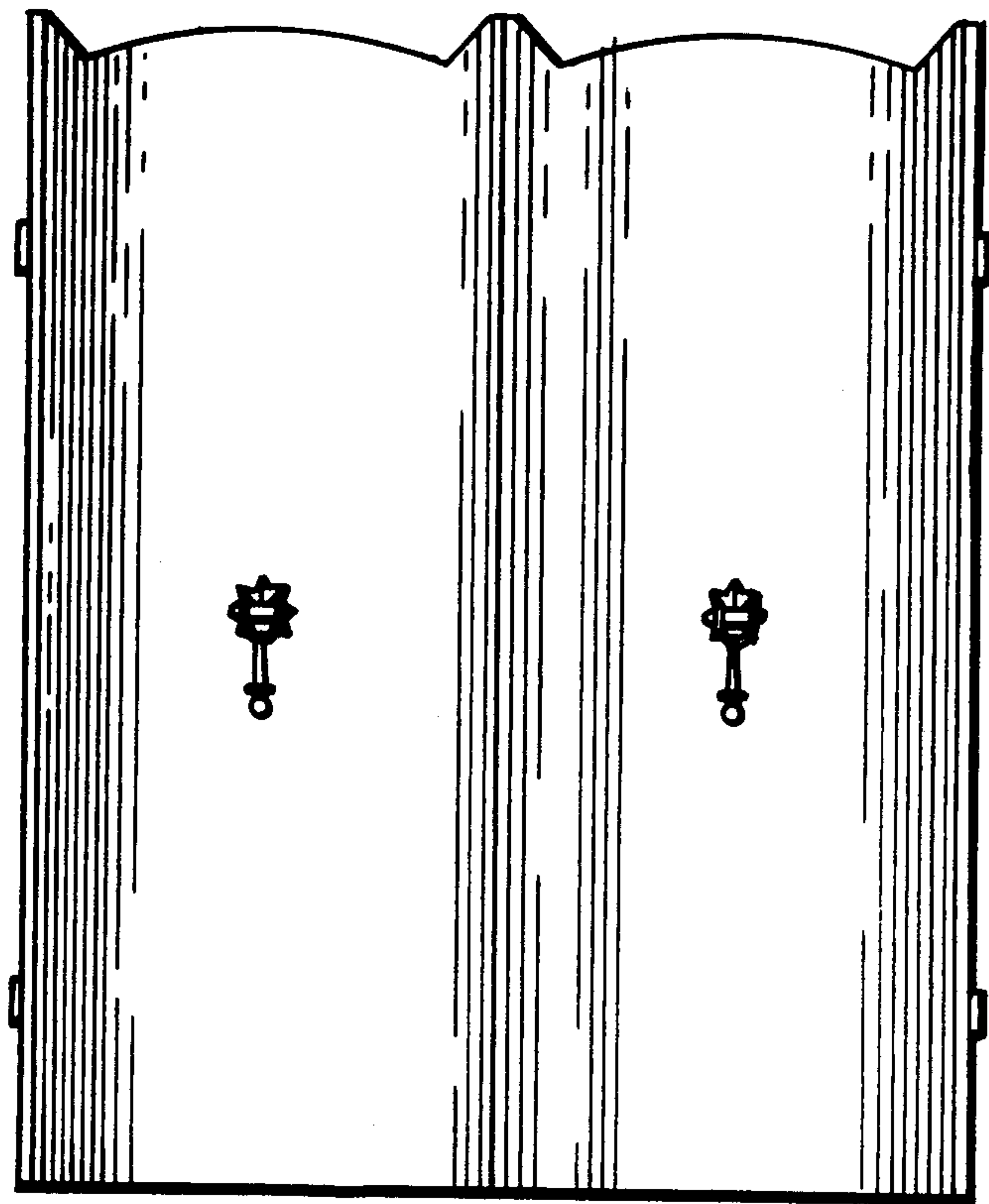

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a jewelry cabinet showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a side view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a front view of the cabinet with the doors in open position.
The back of the jewelry cabinet is conventionally flat and unornamented.



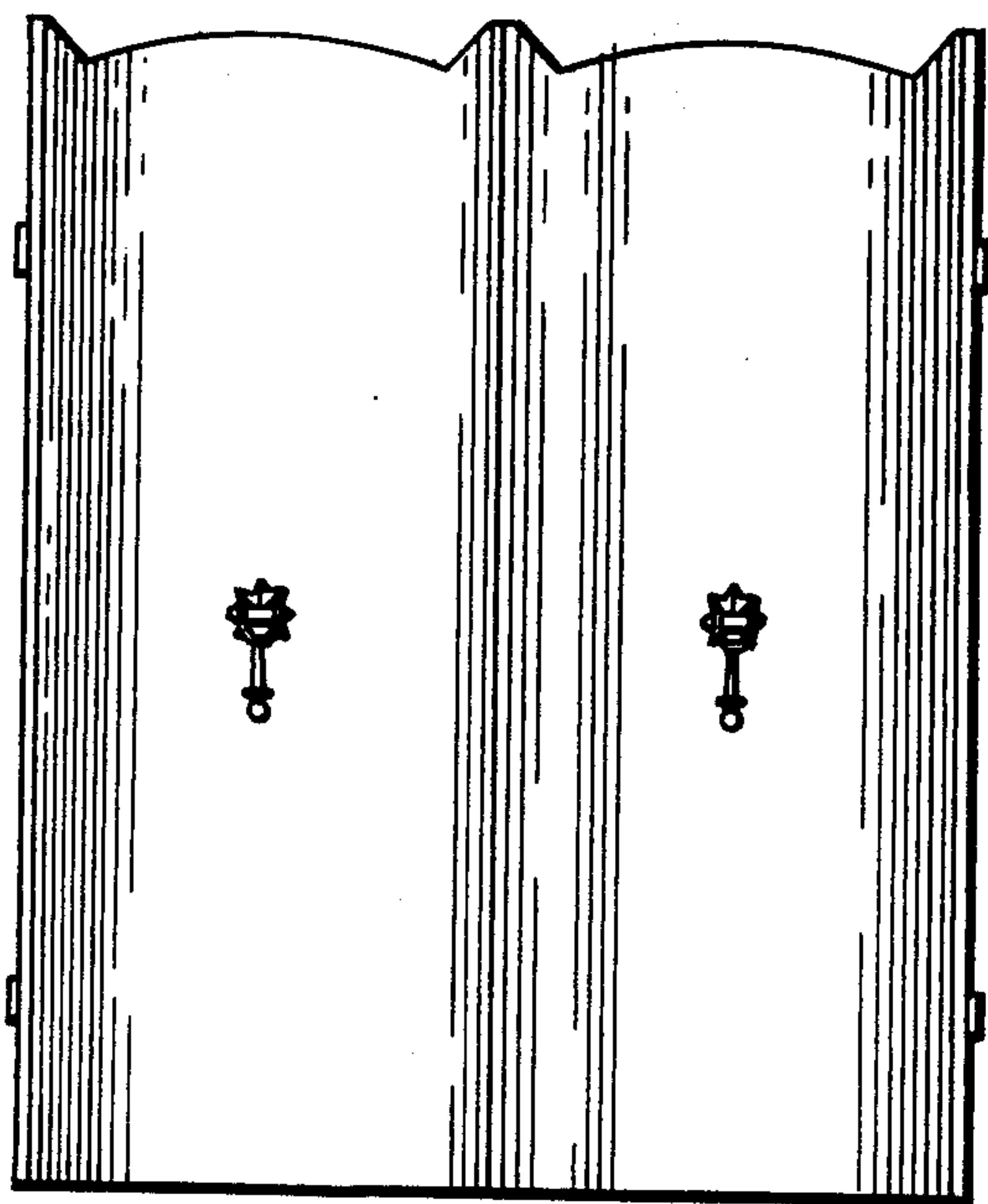

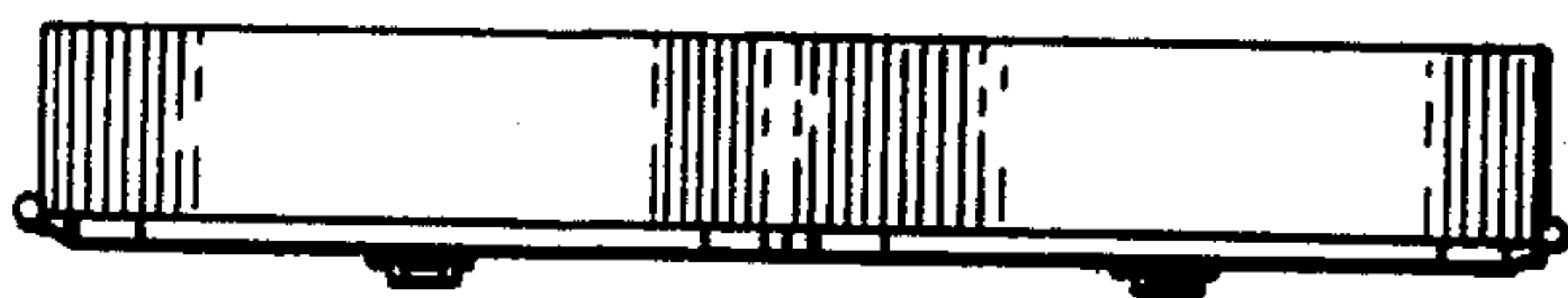

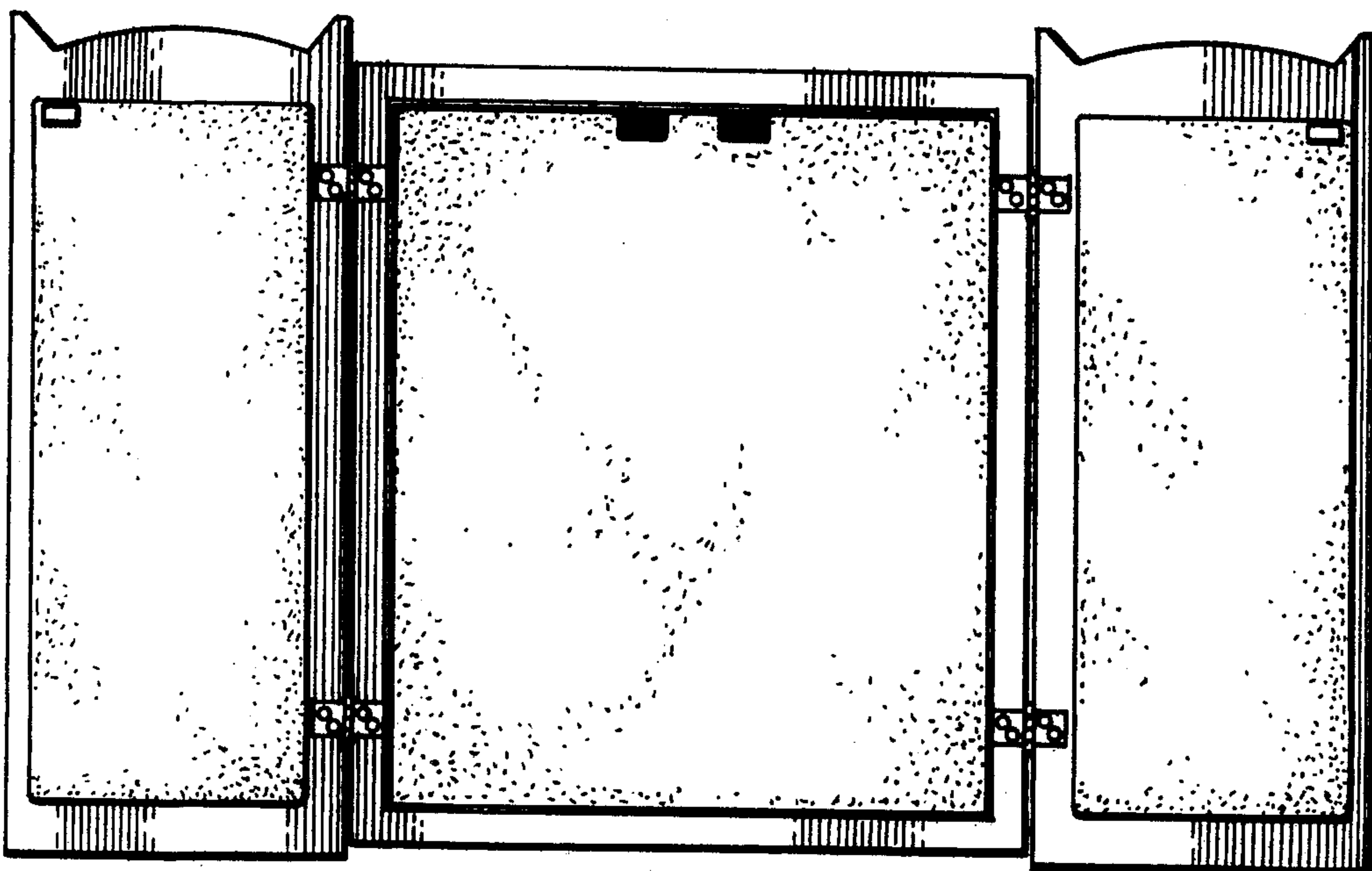
