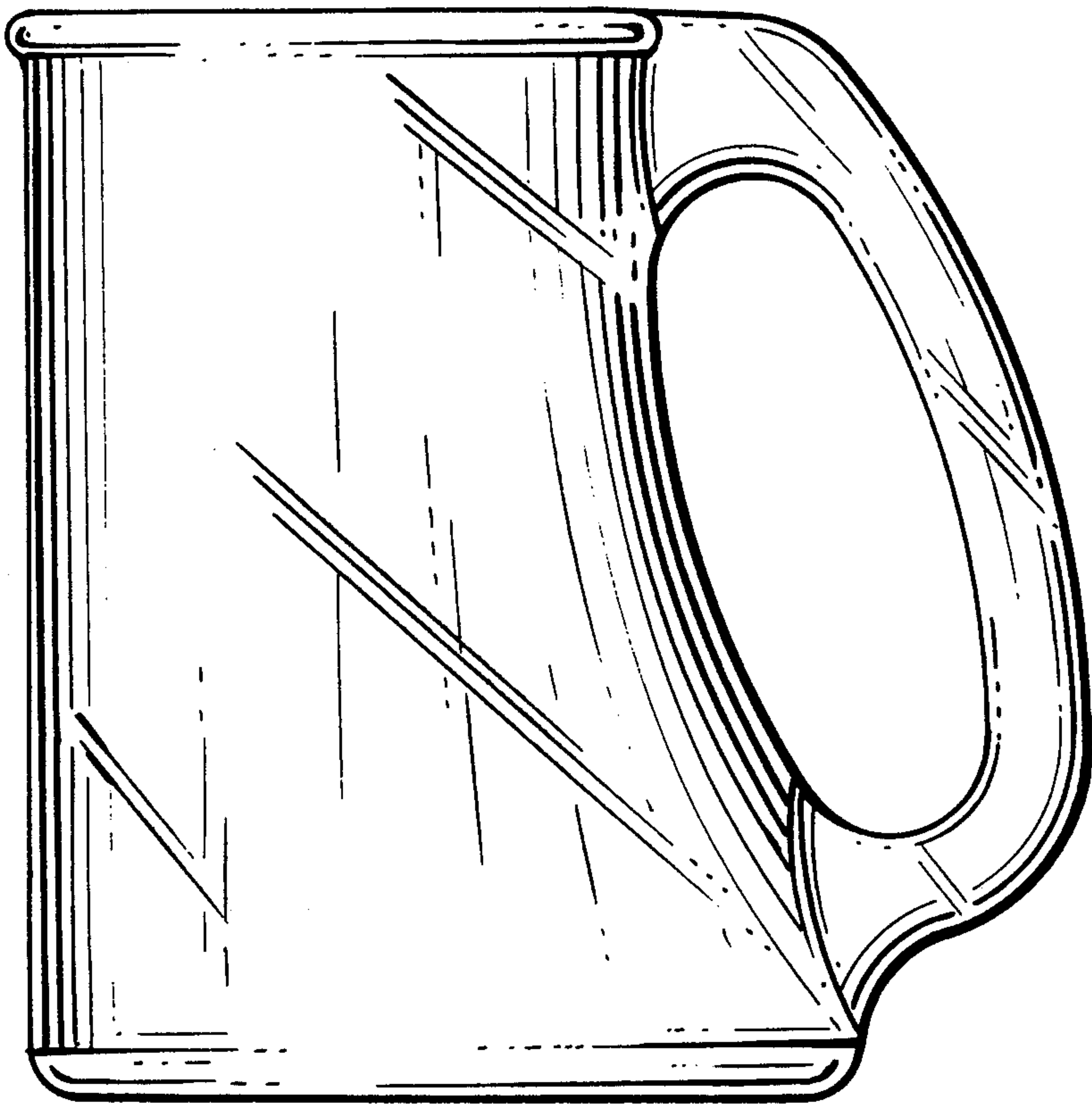

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a glass mug, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.



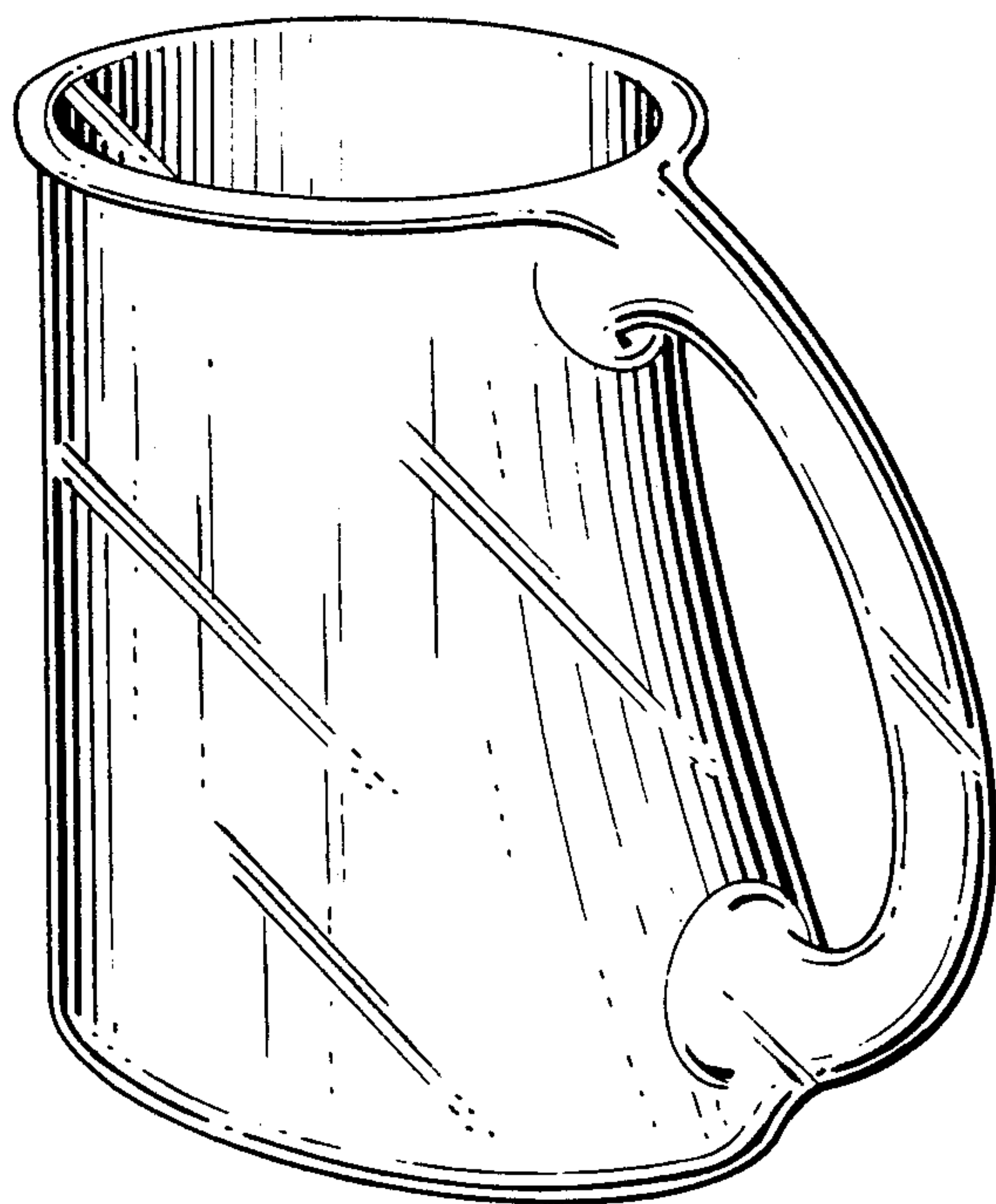

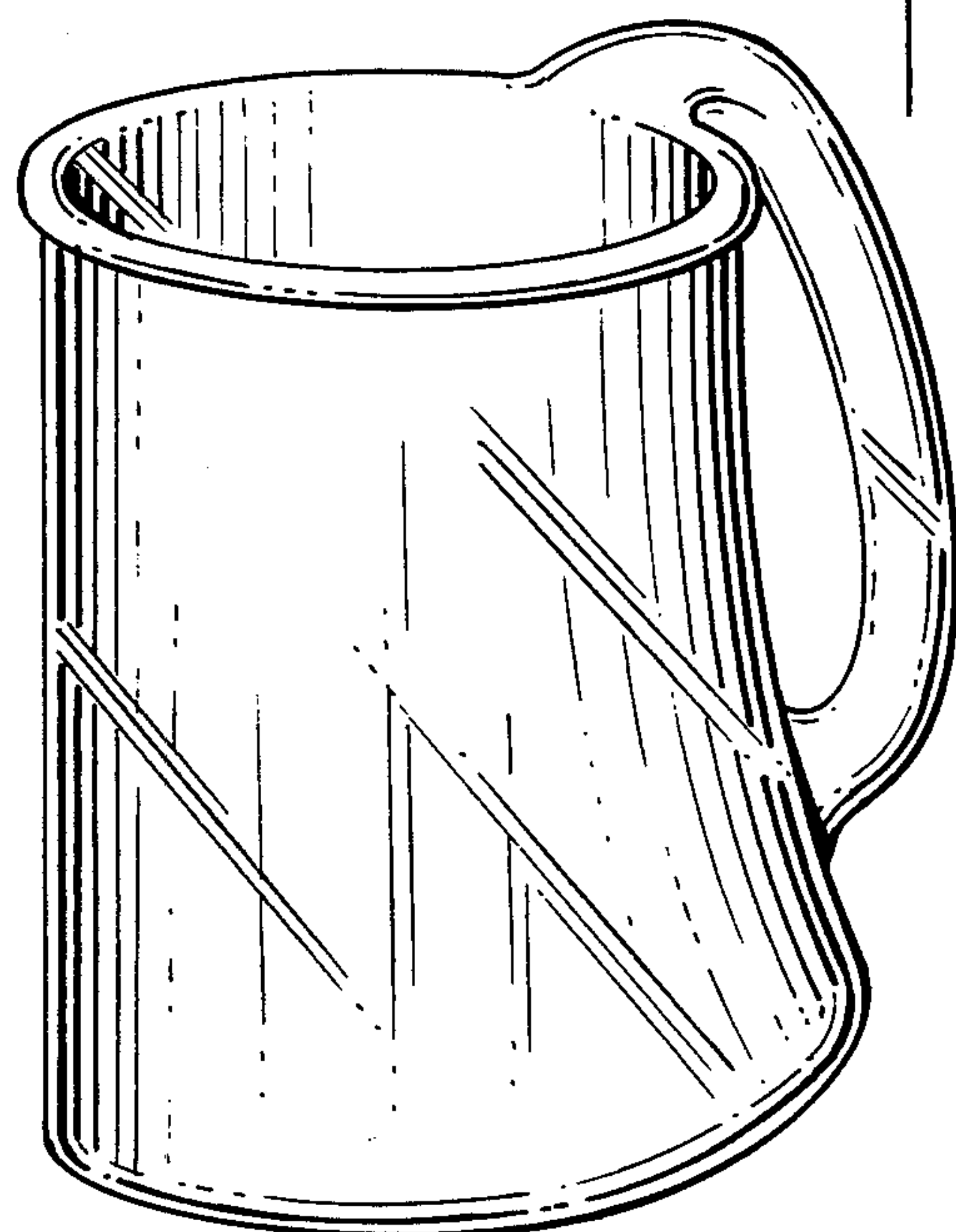

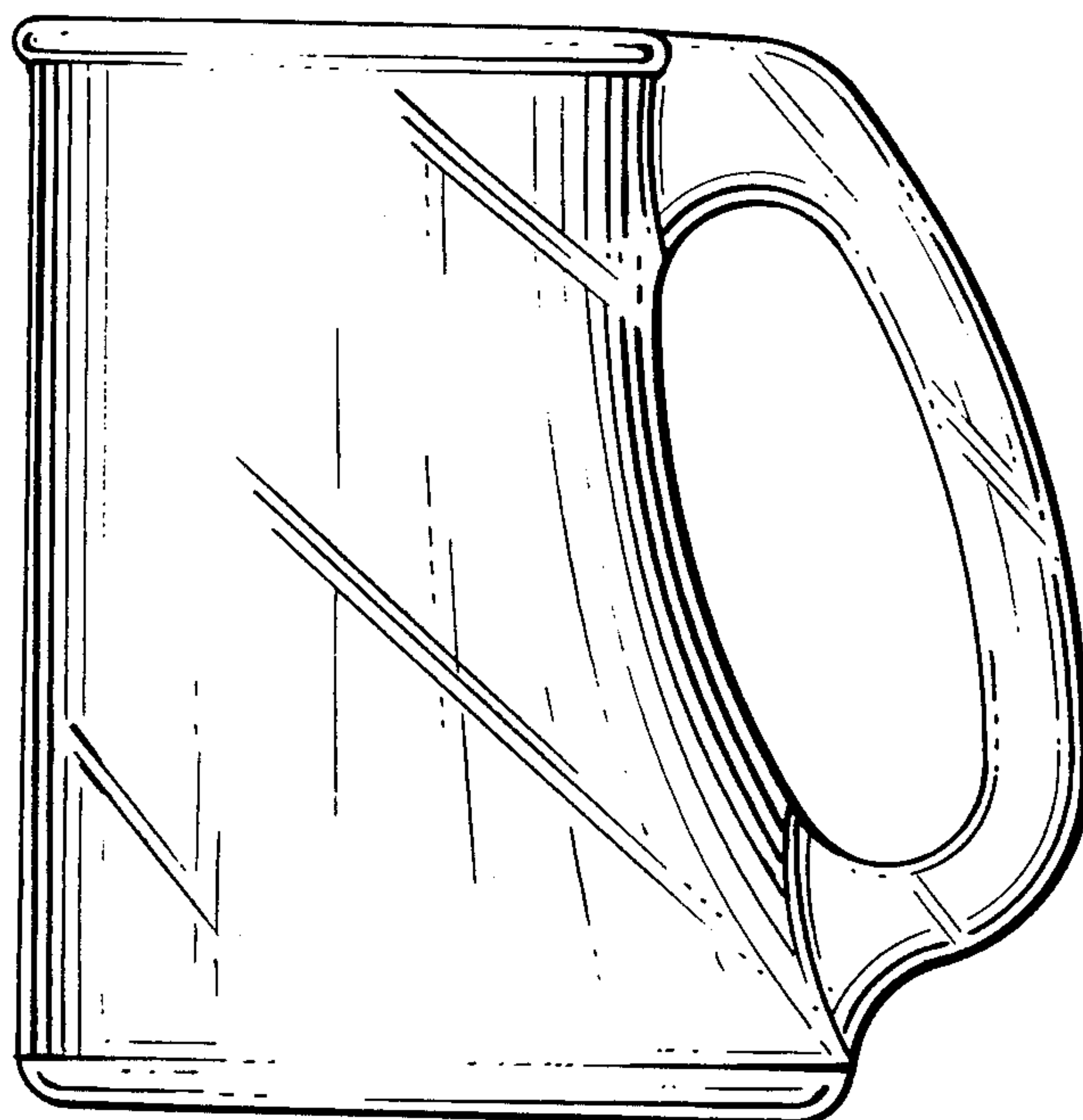

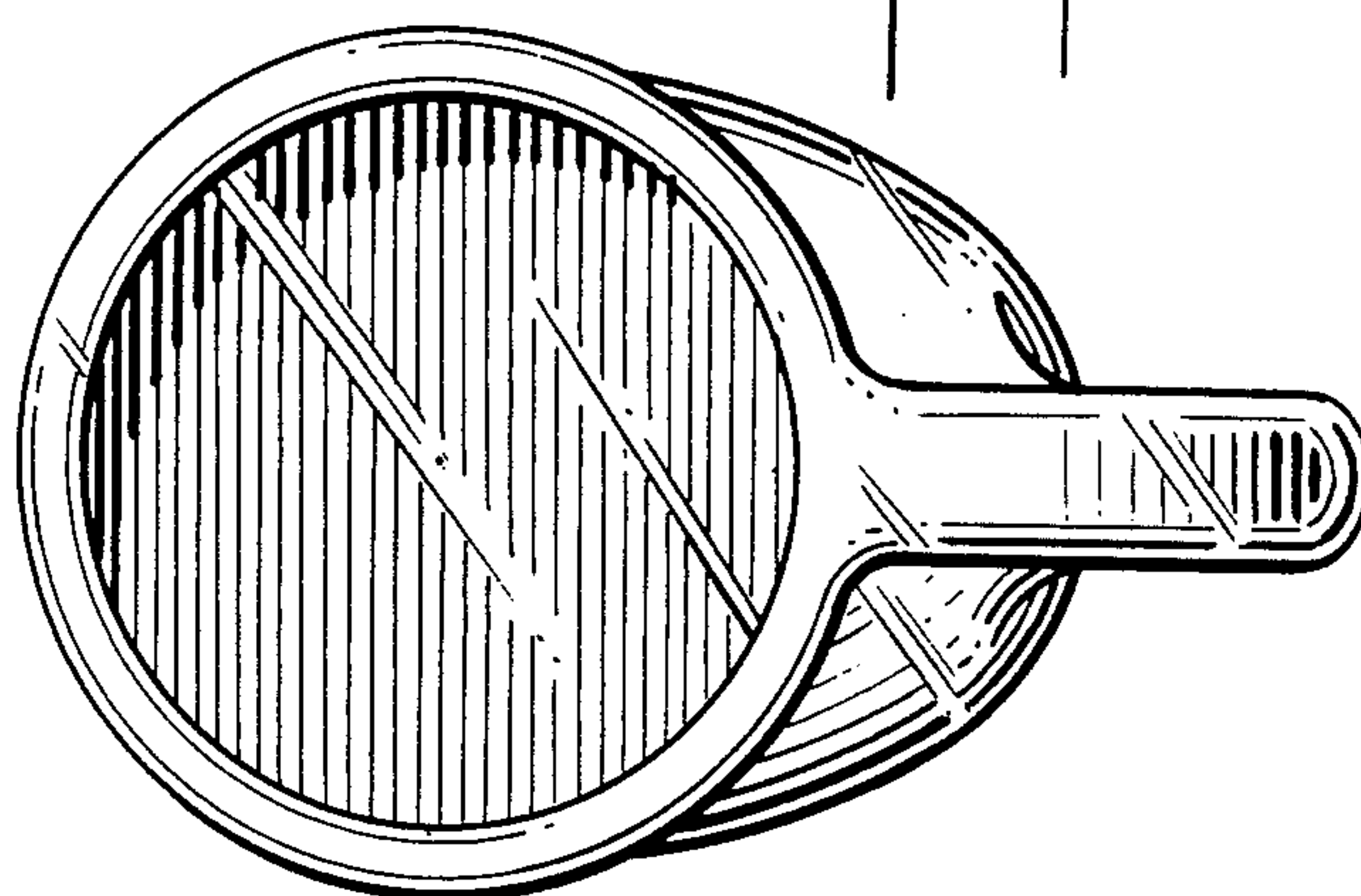

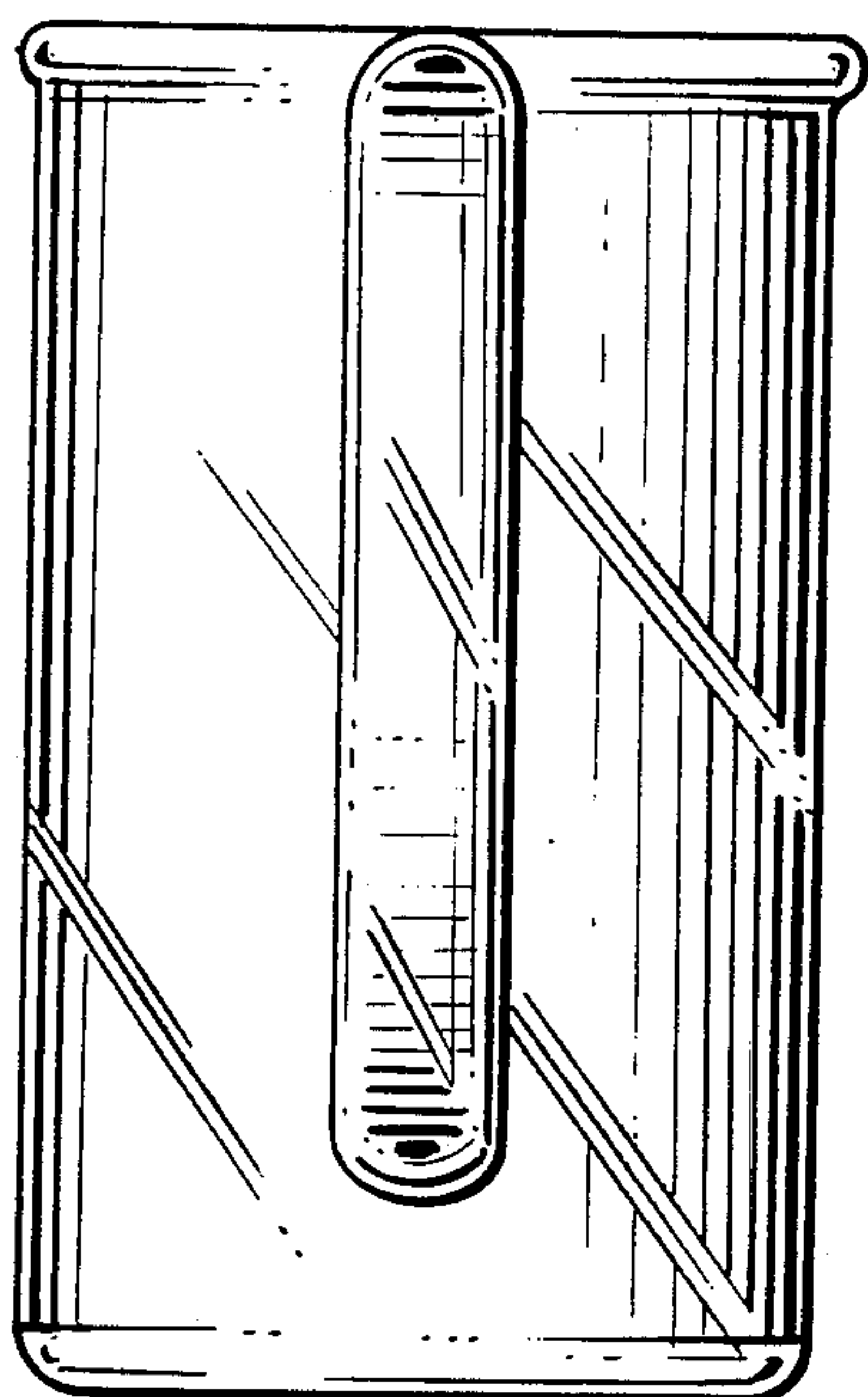

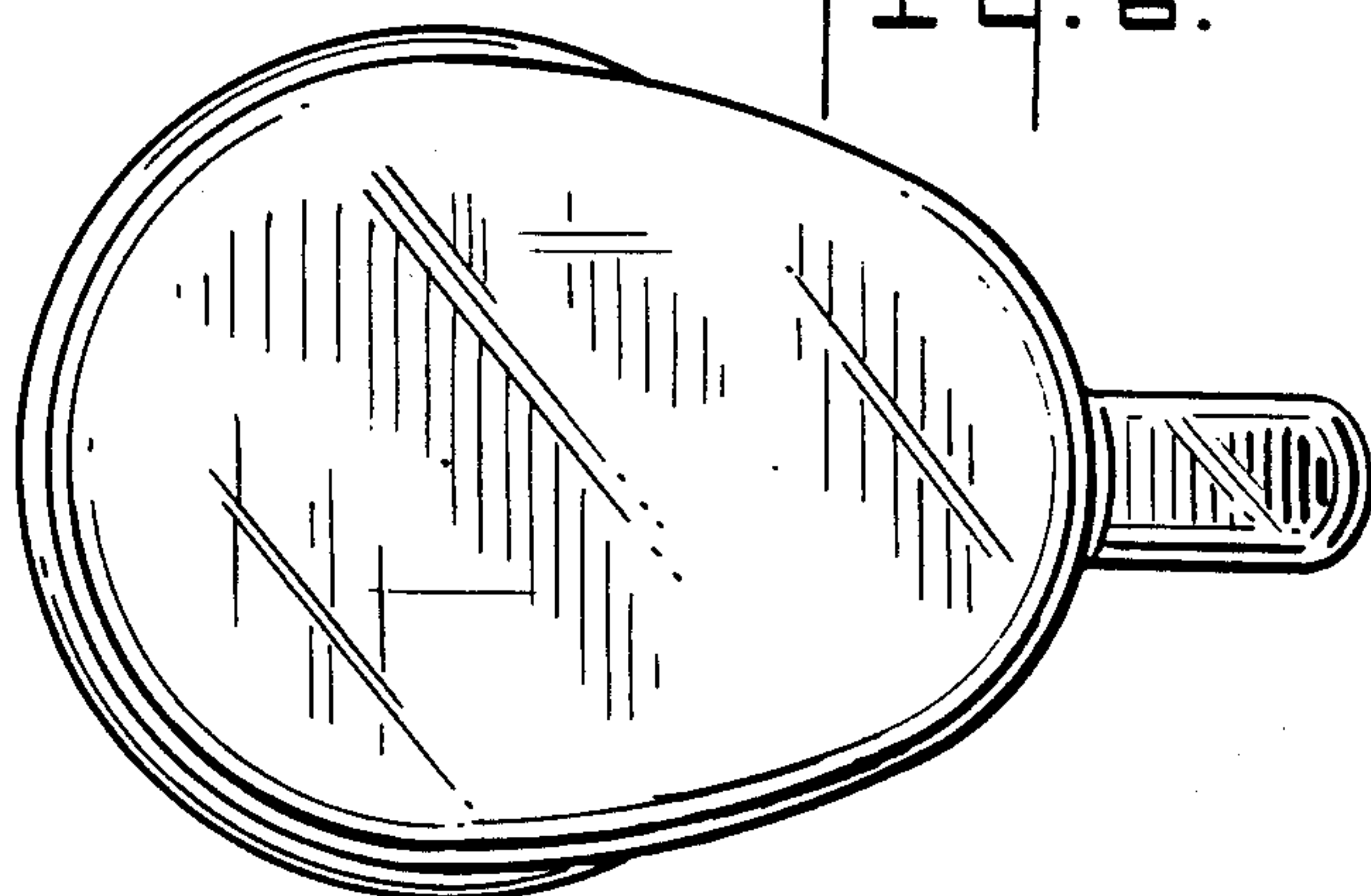
