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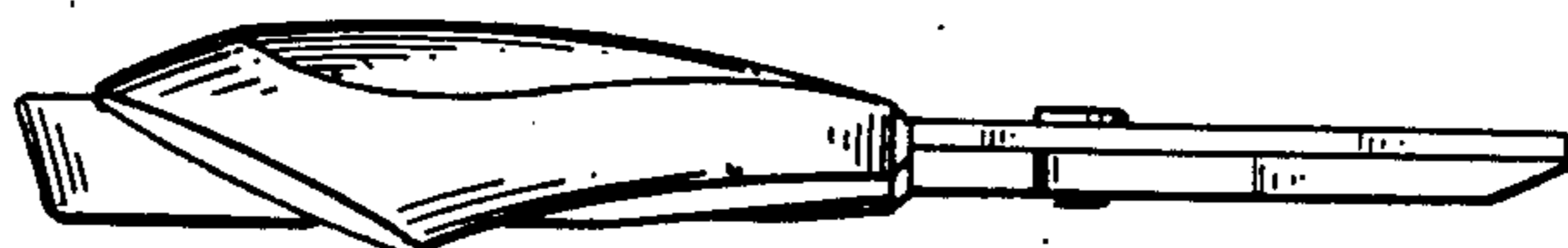
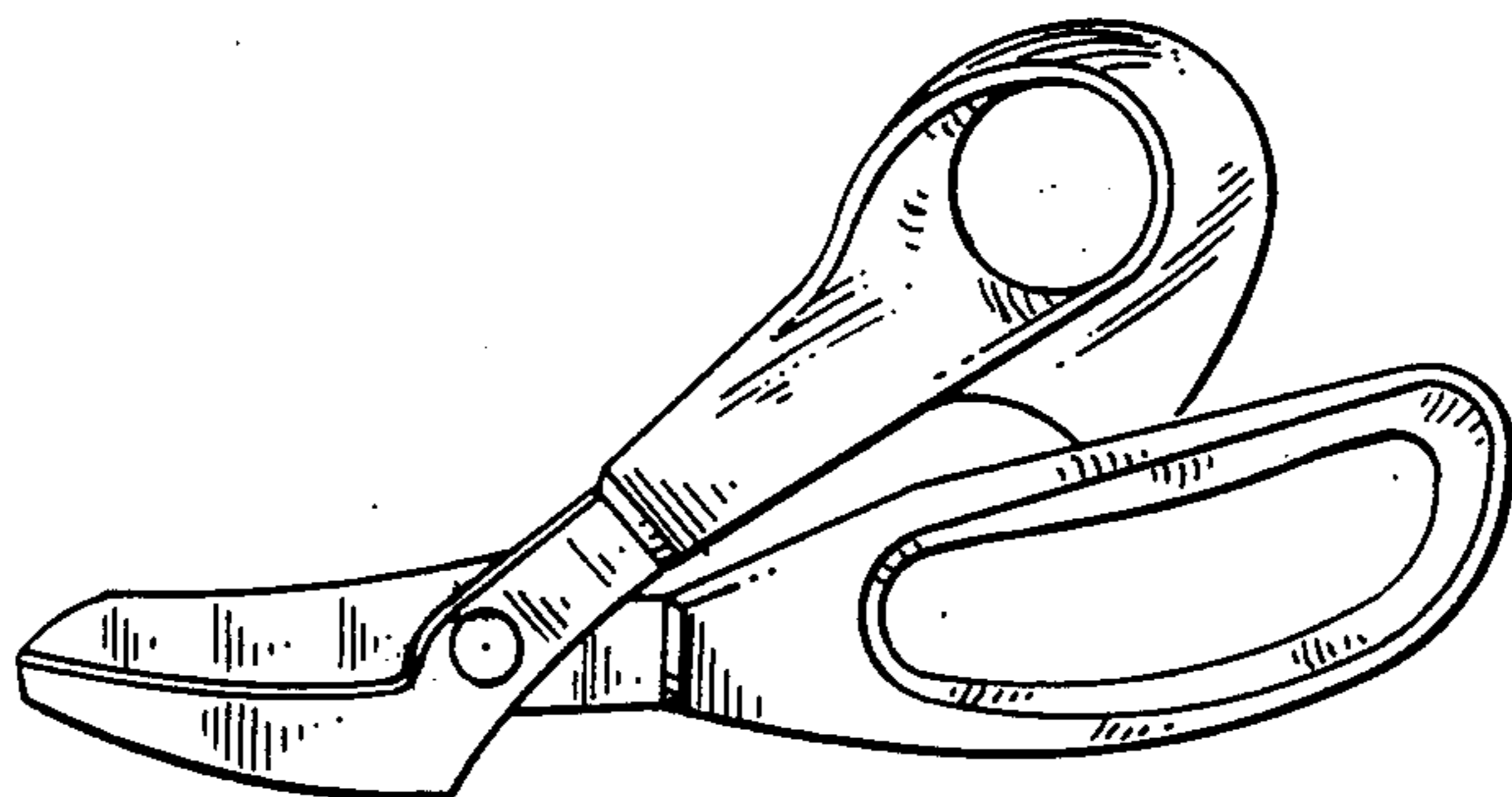

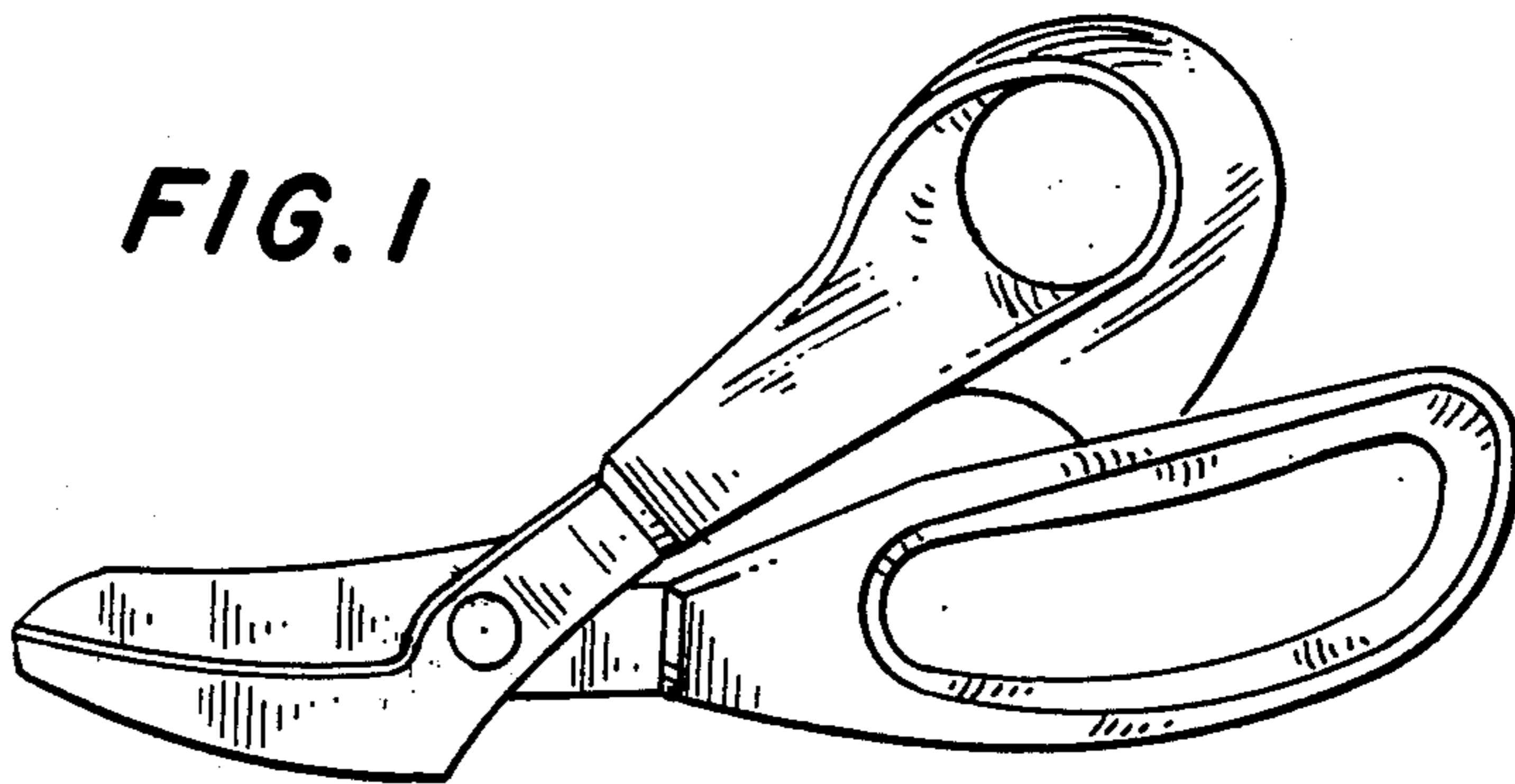
The ornamental design for pruning-shears, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

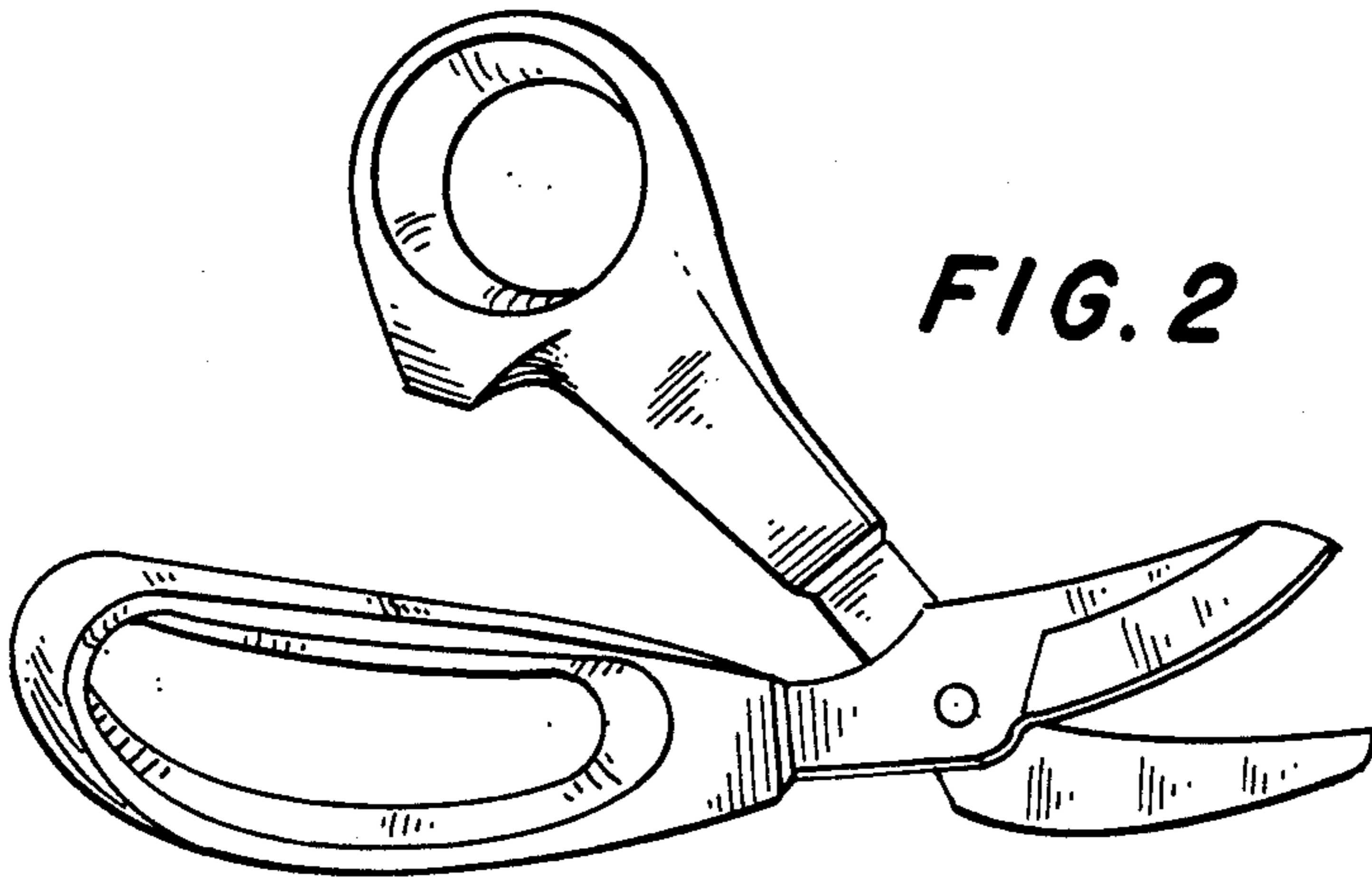
FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a pruning-shears in a closed position showing our new design;

FIG. 6 is an end elevation of the left side of FIG. 1.



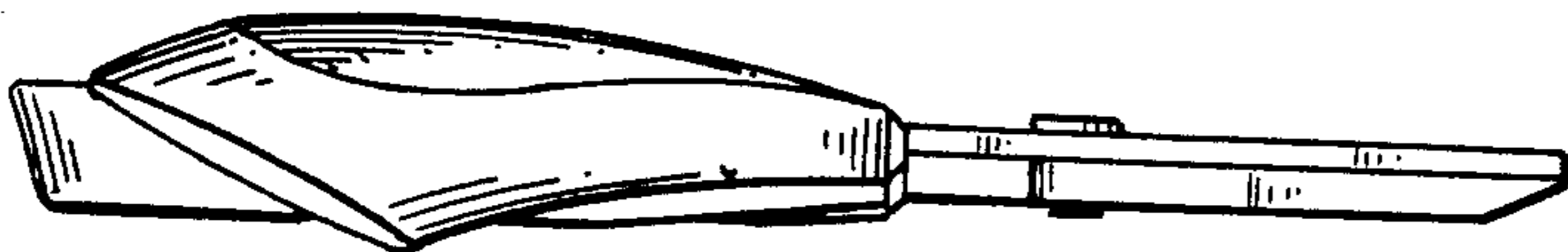

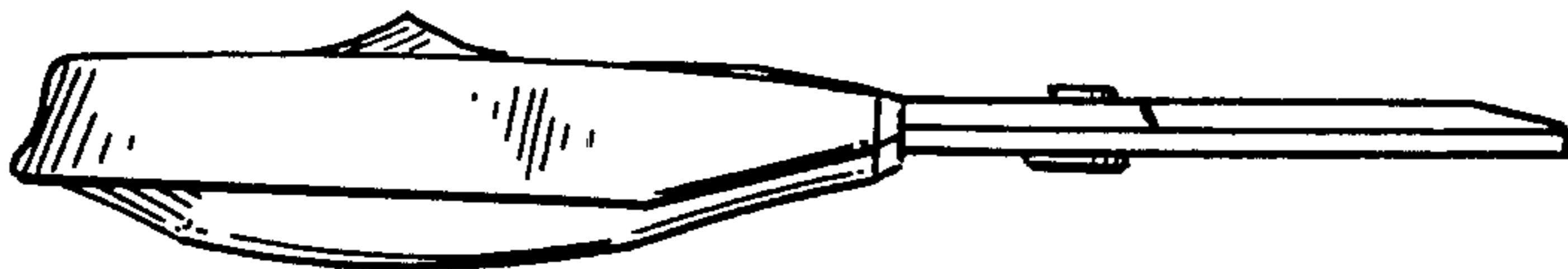
