[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a low console tape deck player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a low console tape deck player embodying our new design.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the low console tape deck player shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the low console tape deck player shown in FIG. 1 taken from the side opposite the view in FIG. 2.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the low console tape deck player shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the low console tape deck player shown in FIG. 1.

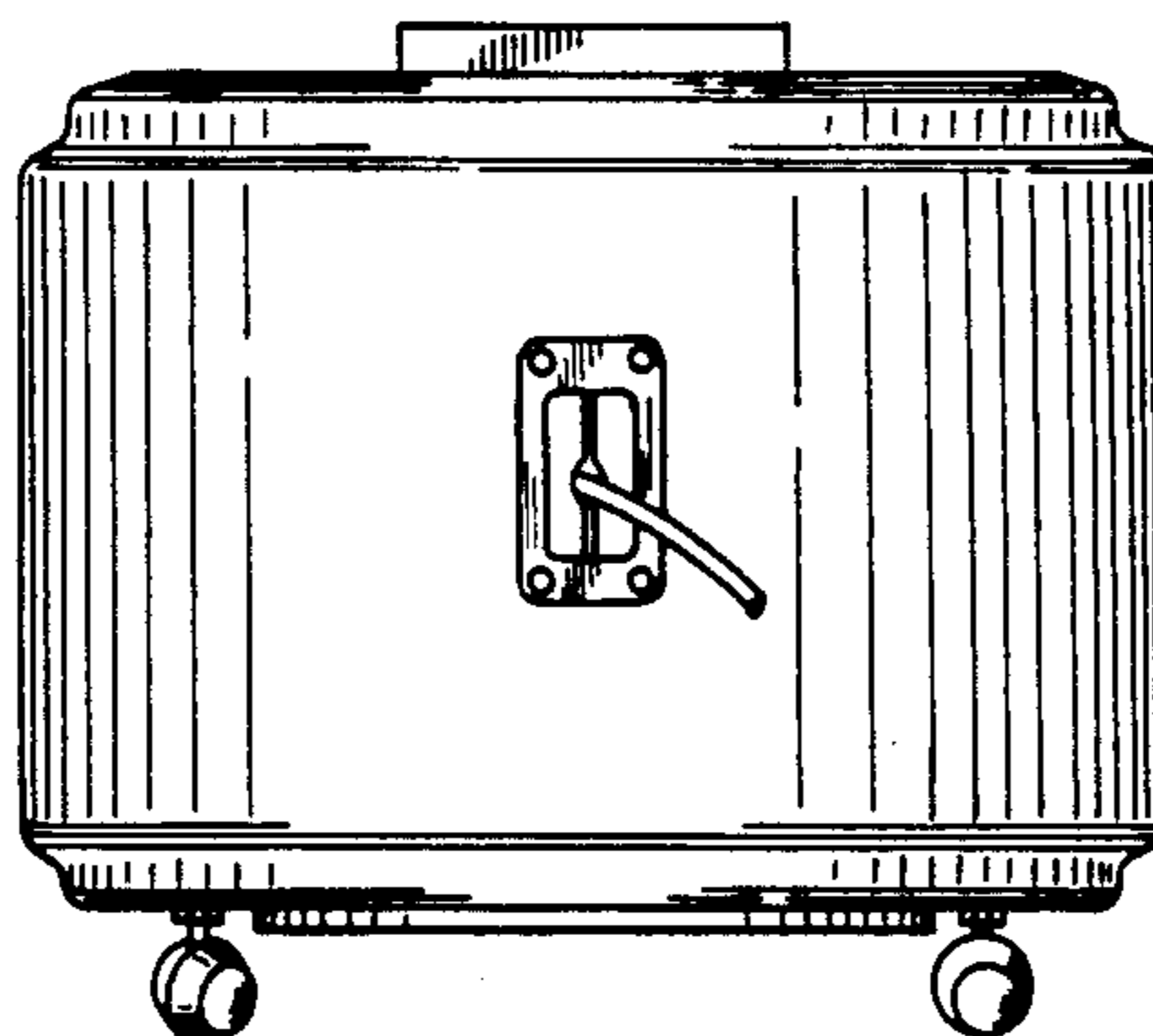
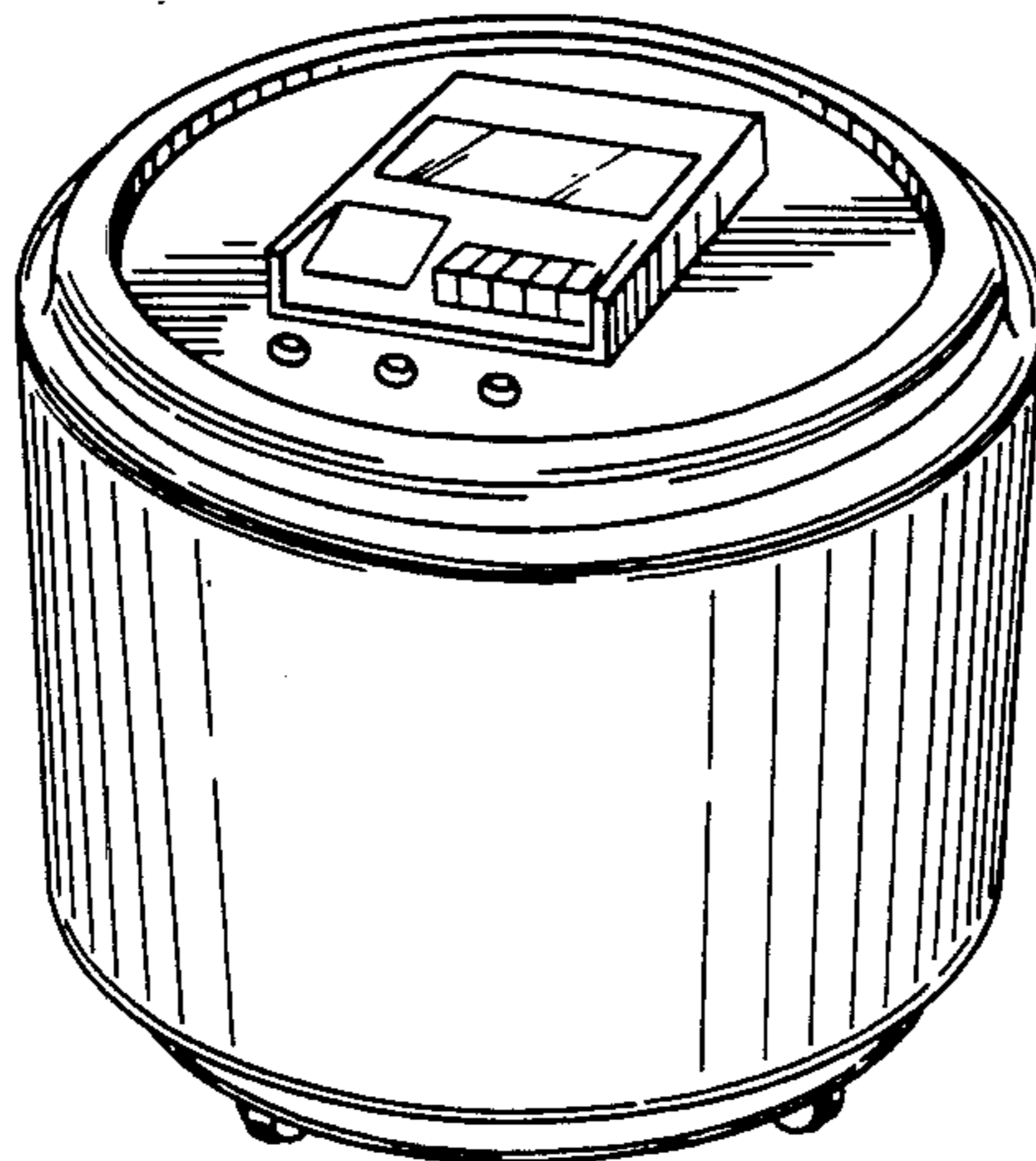

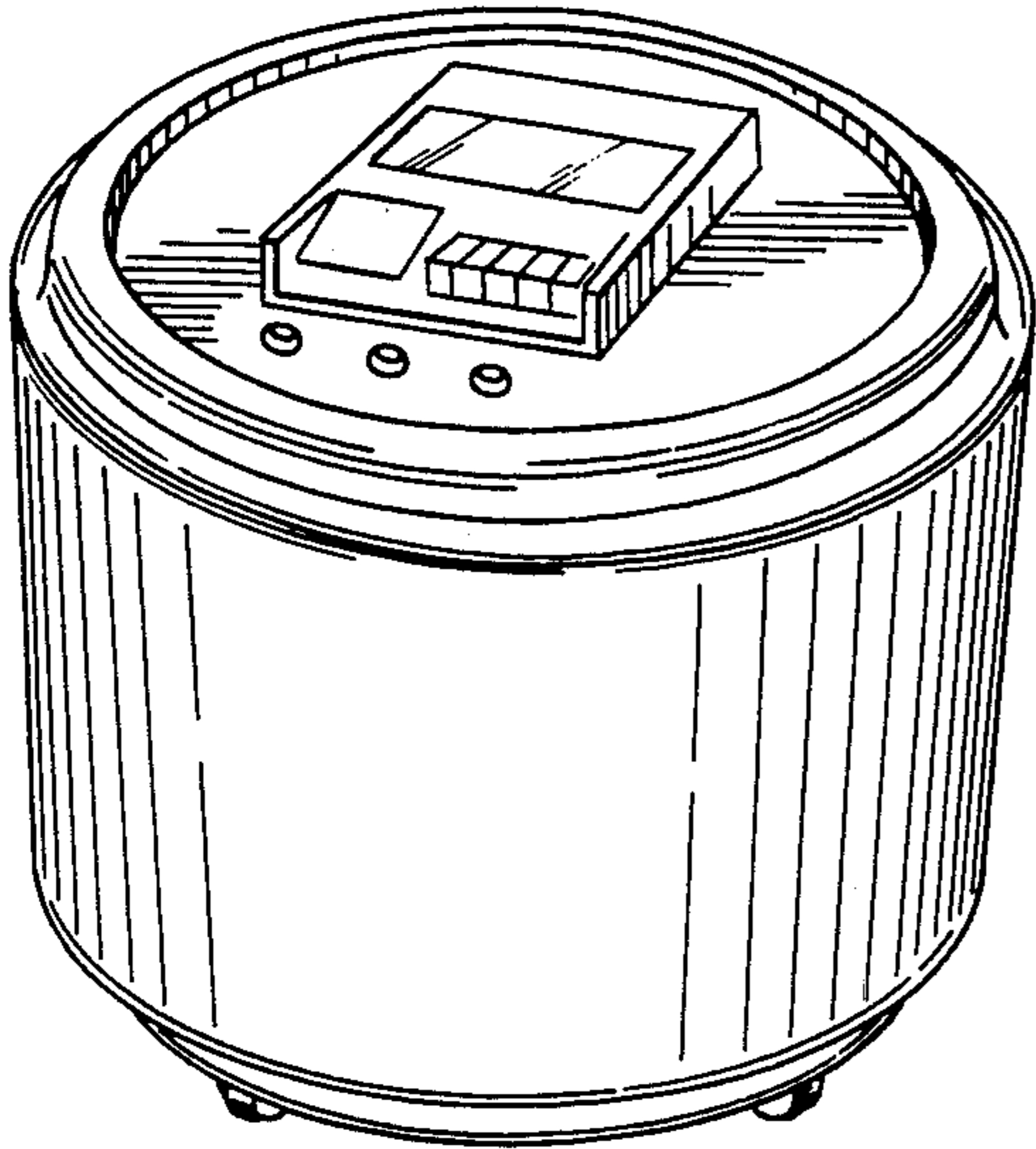

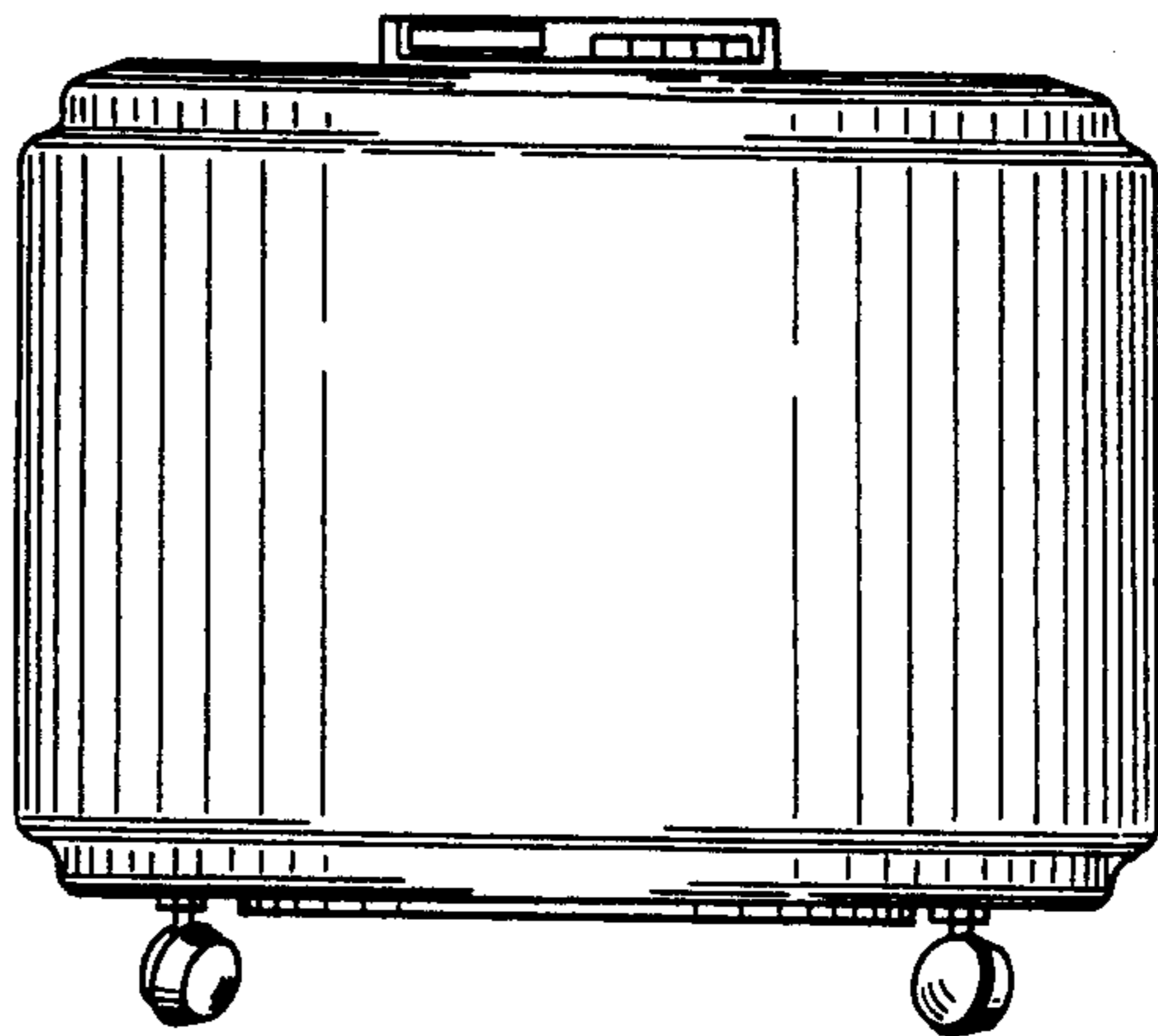

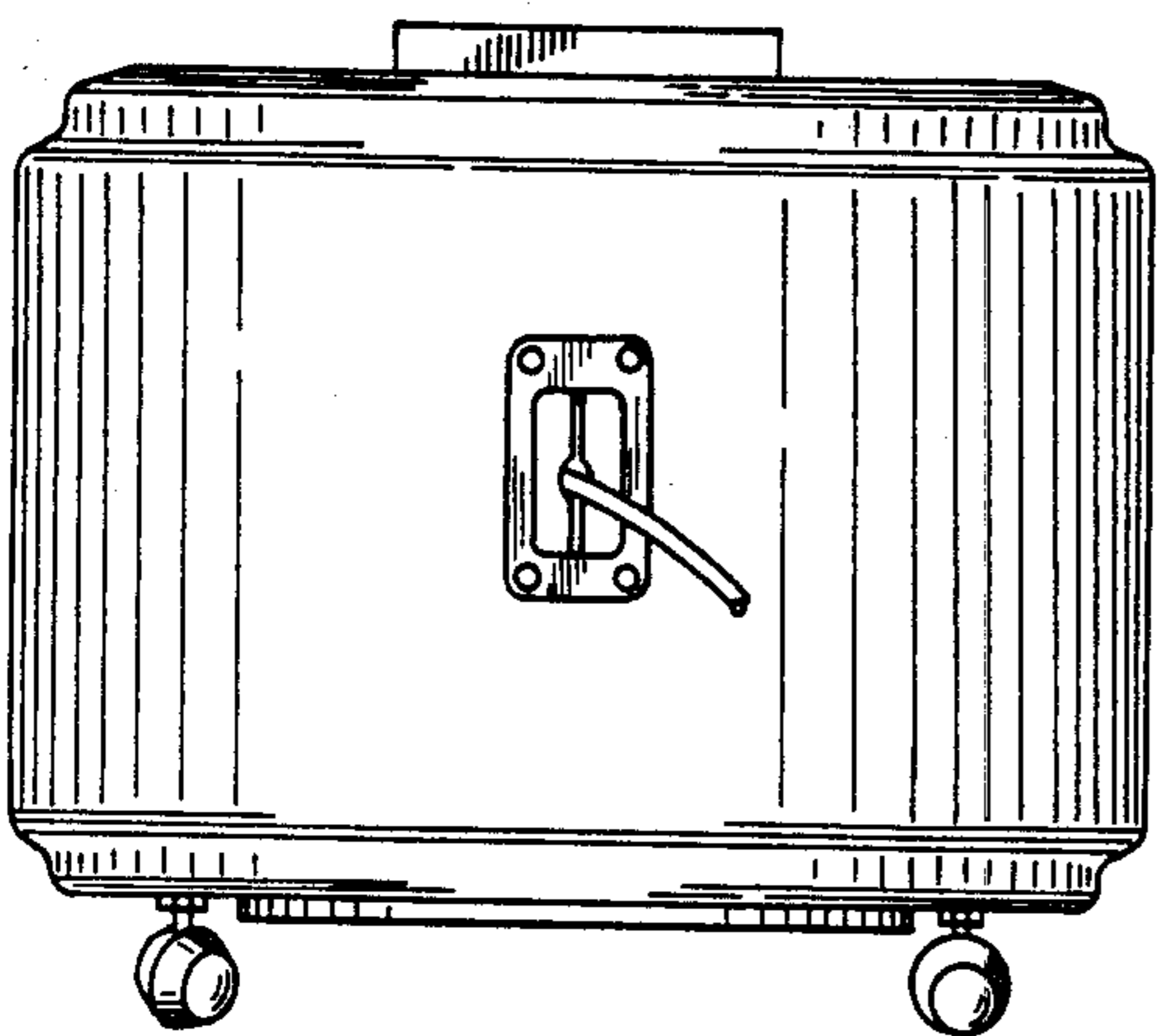

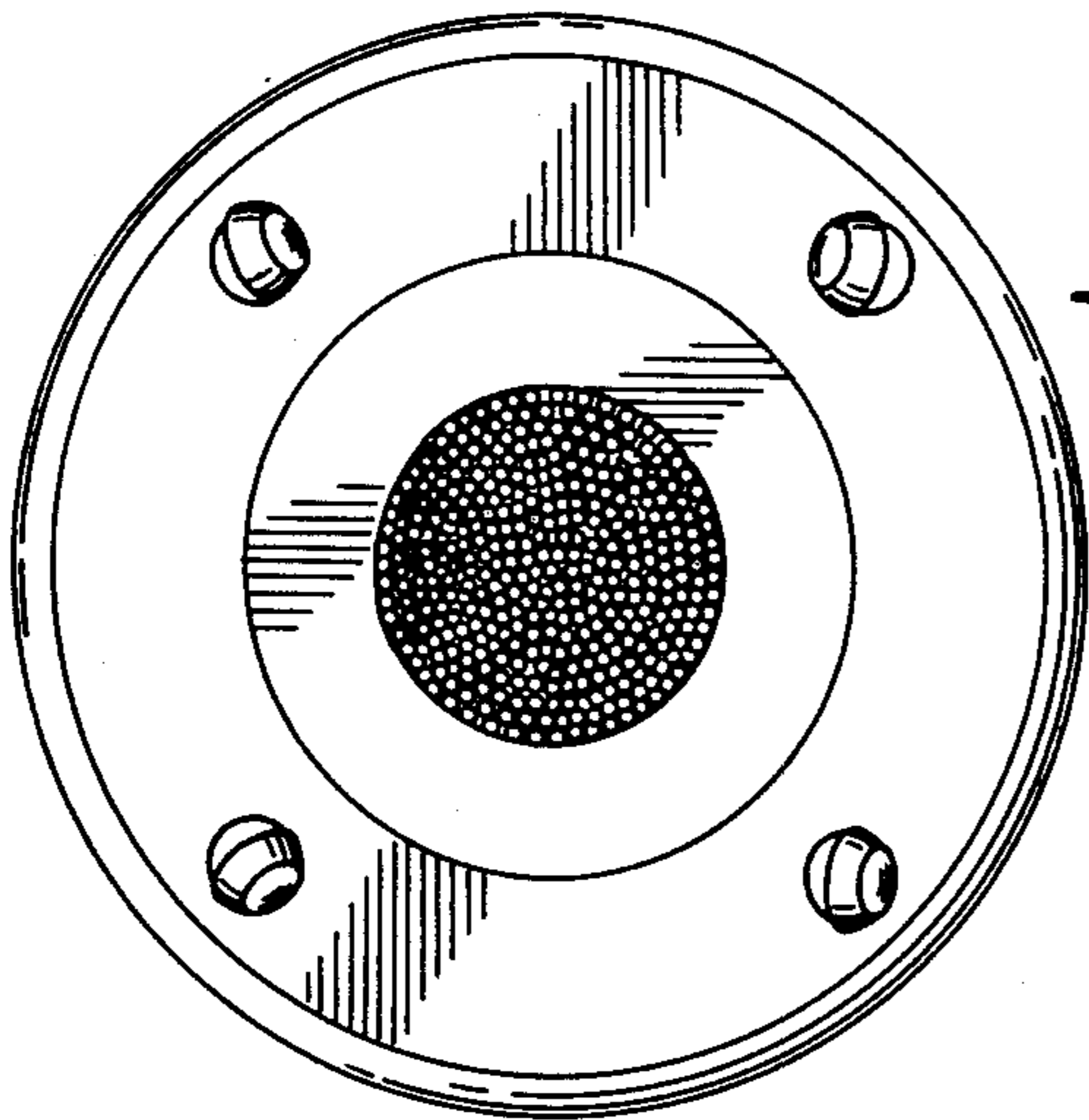
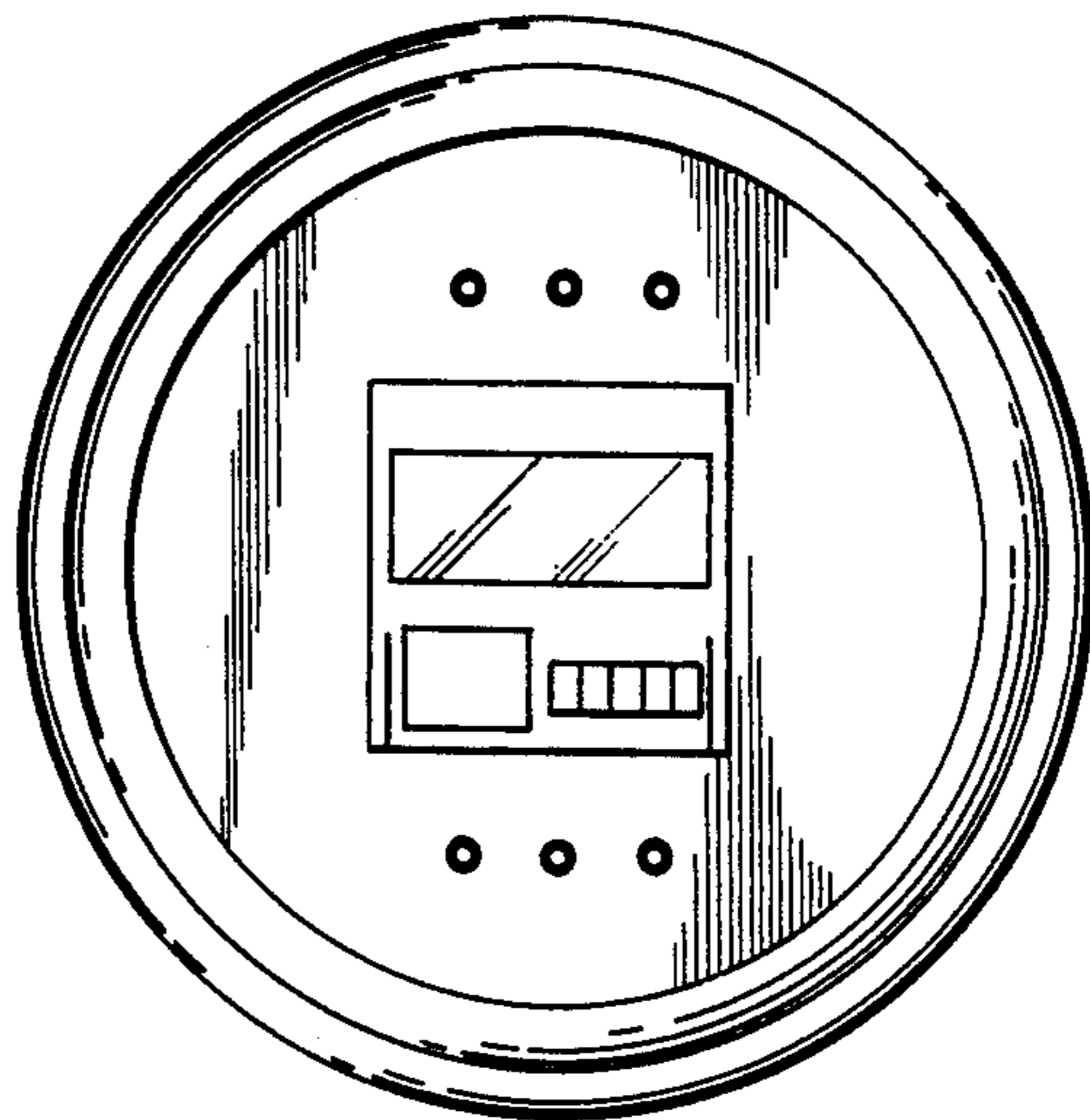
