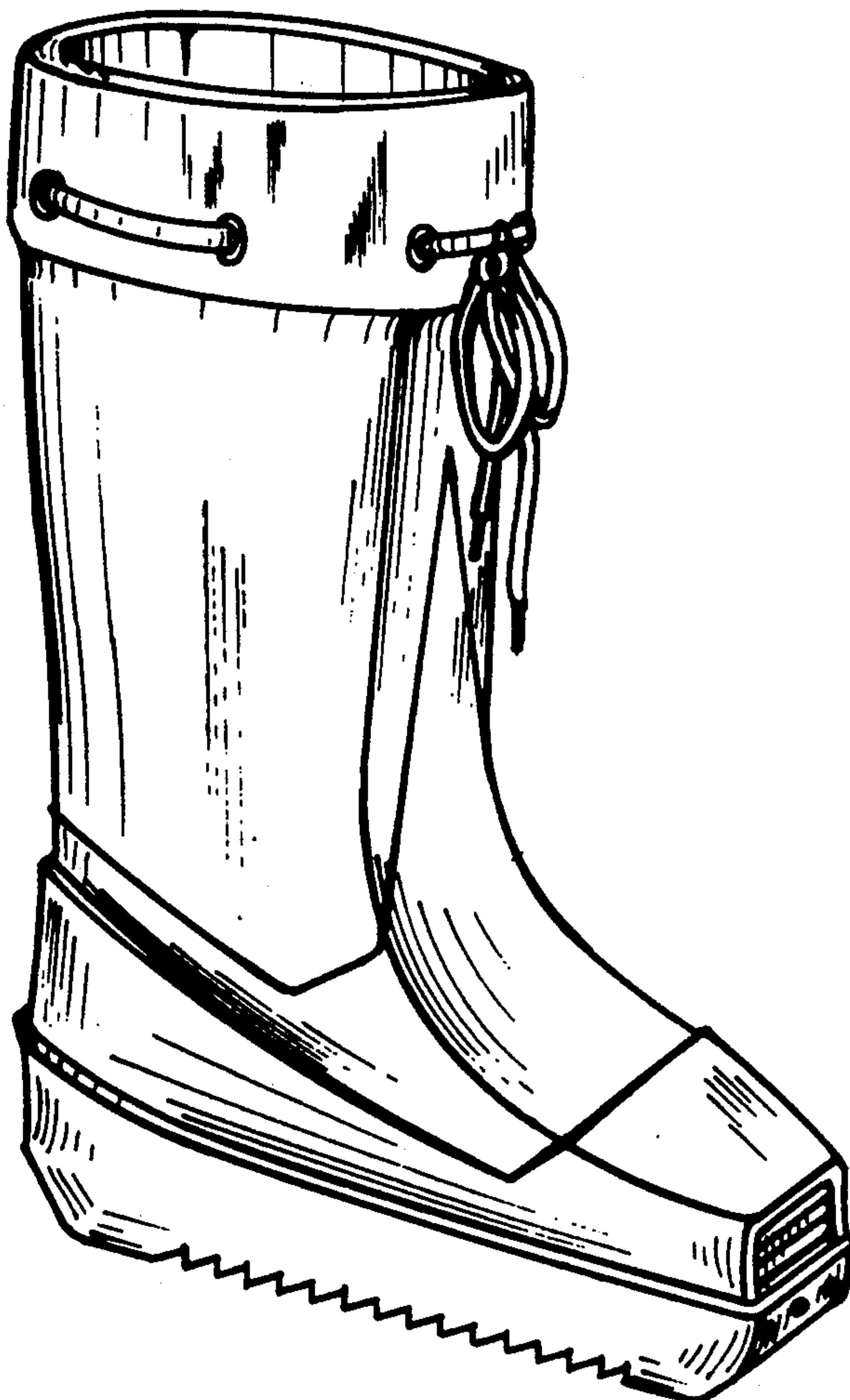

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an after ski boot showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the other side being a mirror image; and
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.



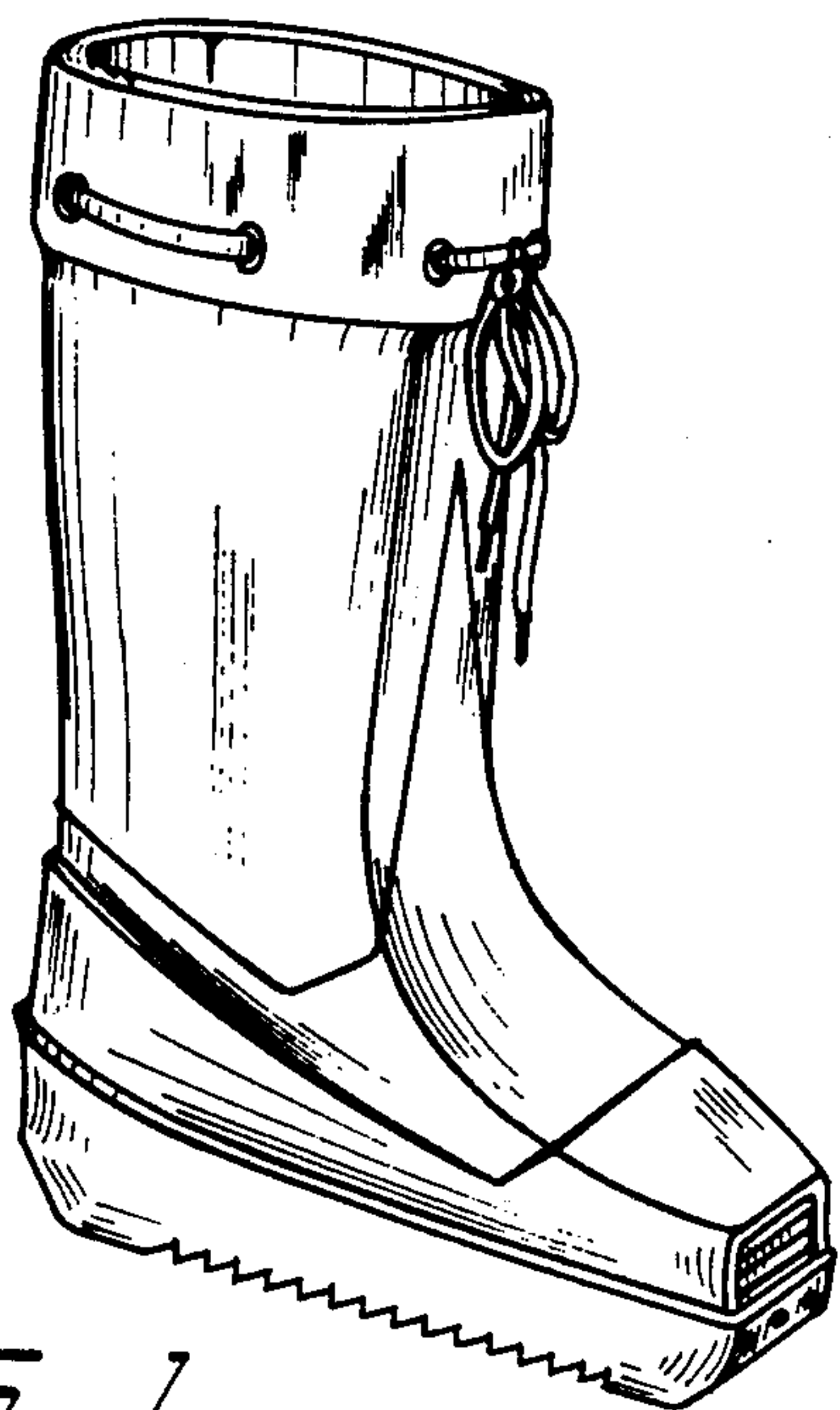

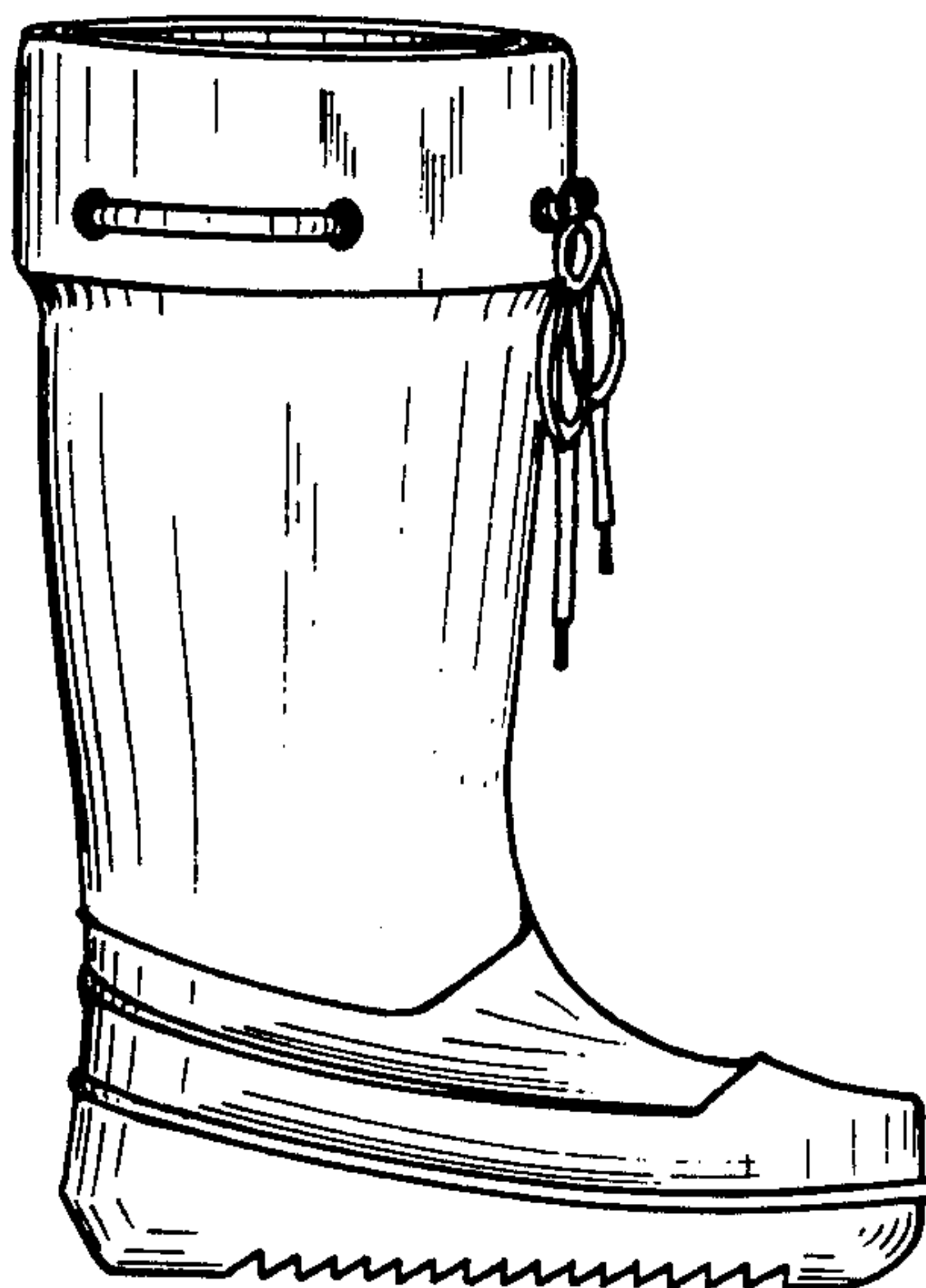

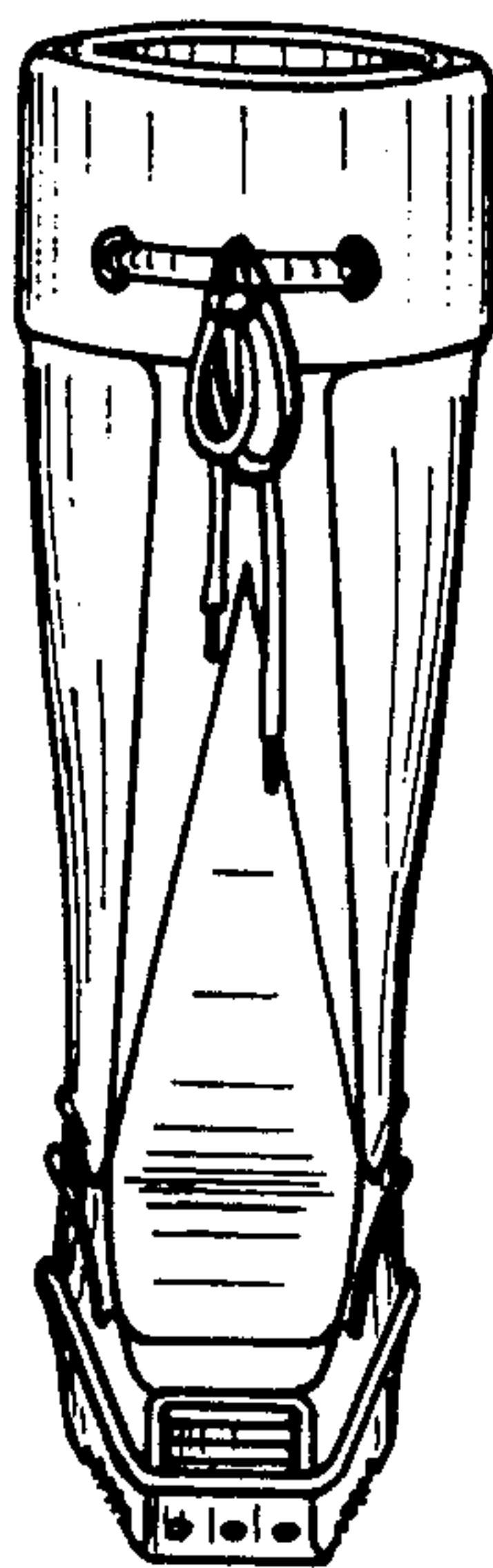
