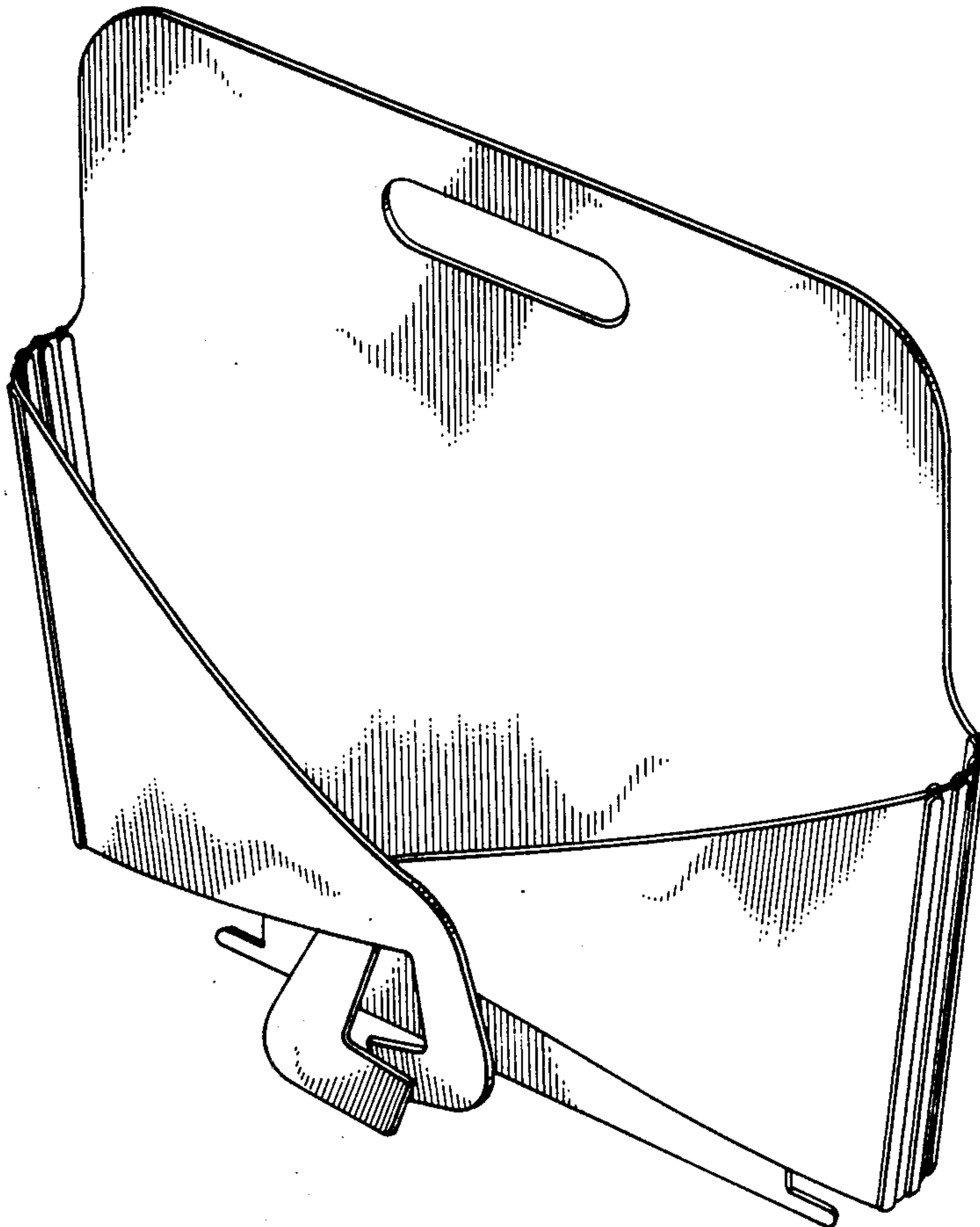
[57] CLAIM

The rear of the seat not shown is plain and unornamented.



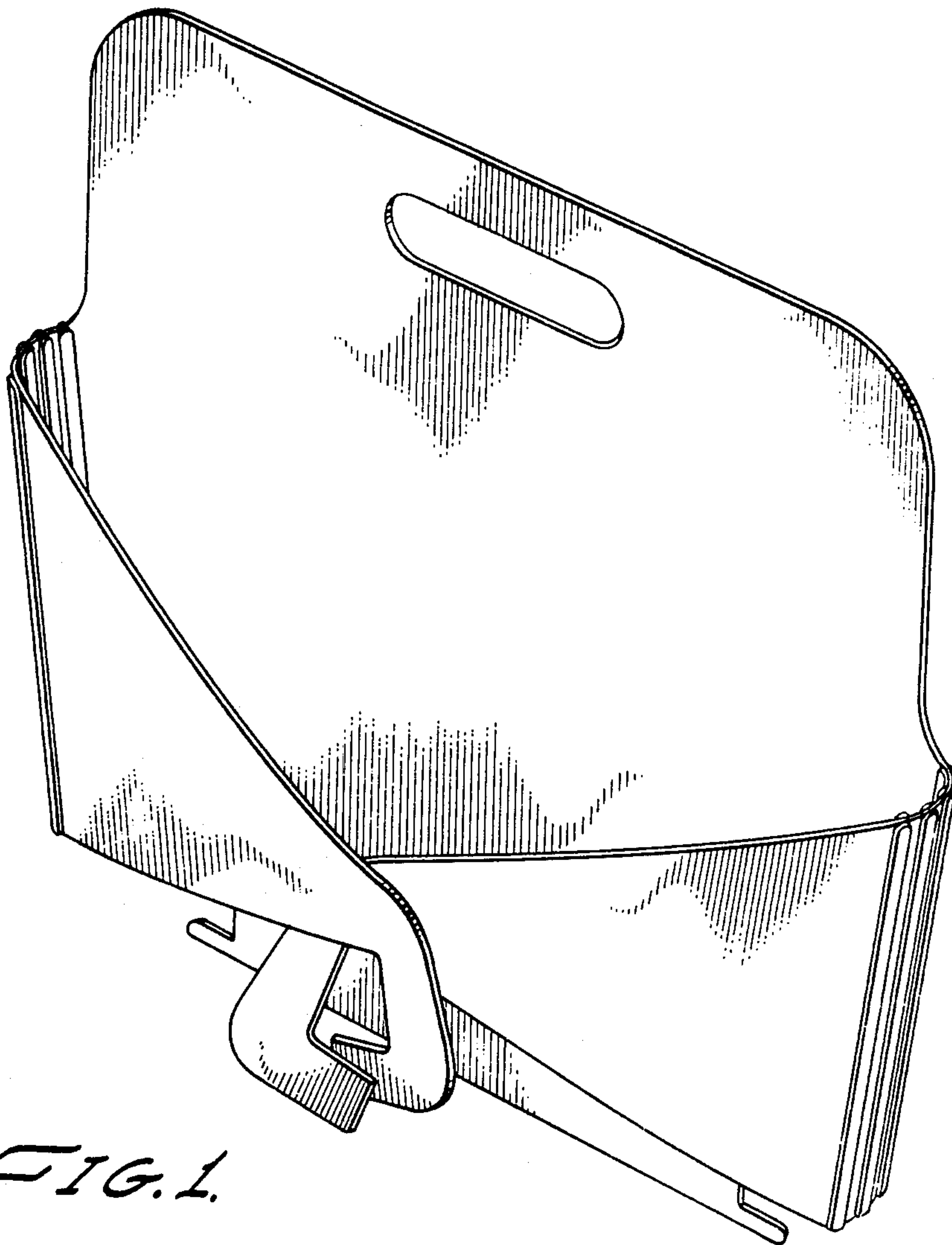

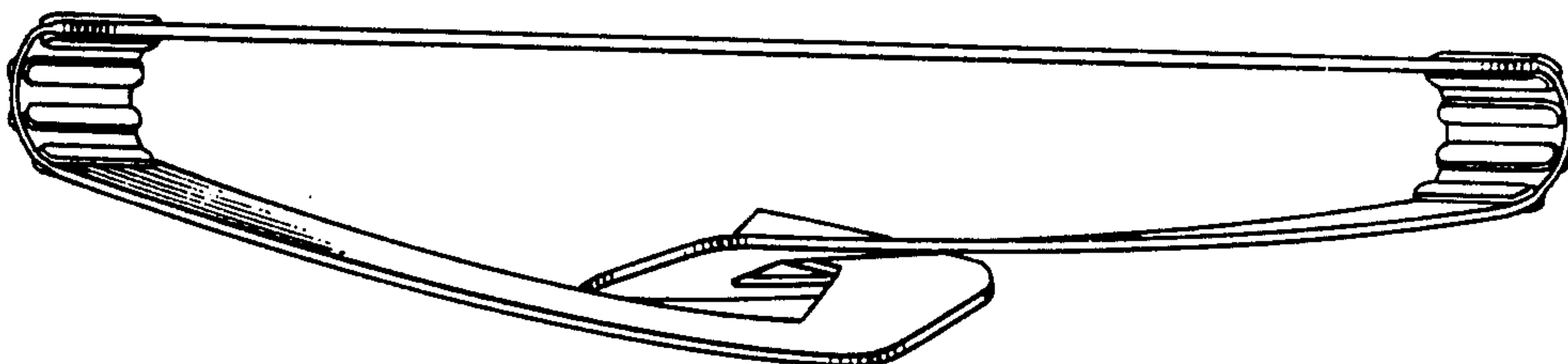
