The ornamental design of a back massager attachment,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a back massager
attachment showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a back massager
attachment;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view, the other side eleva-
tional view being identical thereto;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

only.










