The ornamental design for a hydrotherapeutic apparatus, as shown and described.

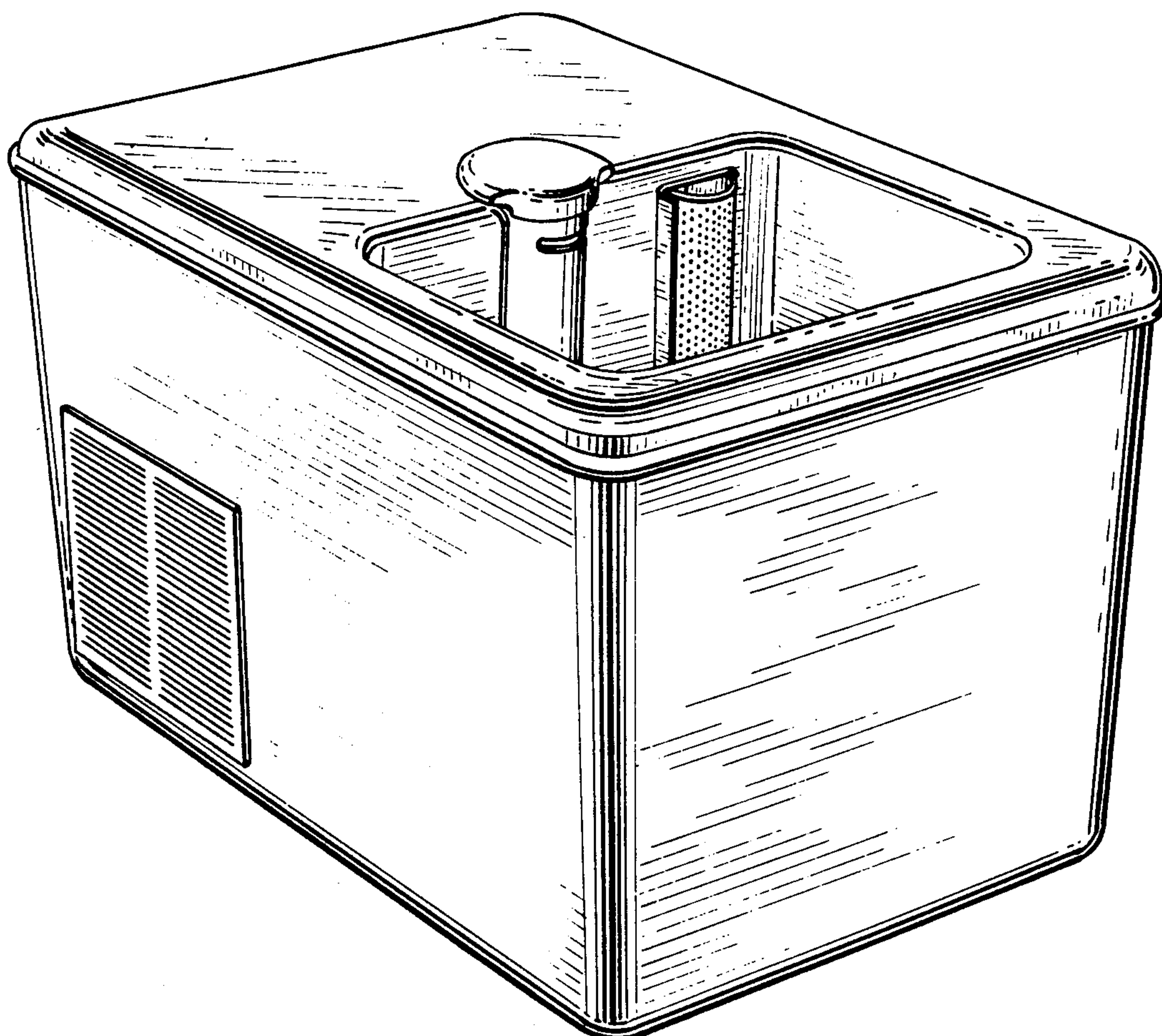
DESCRIPTION

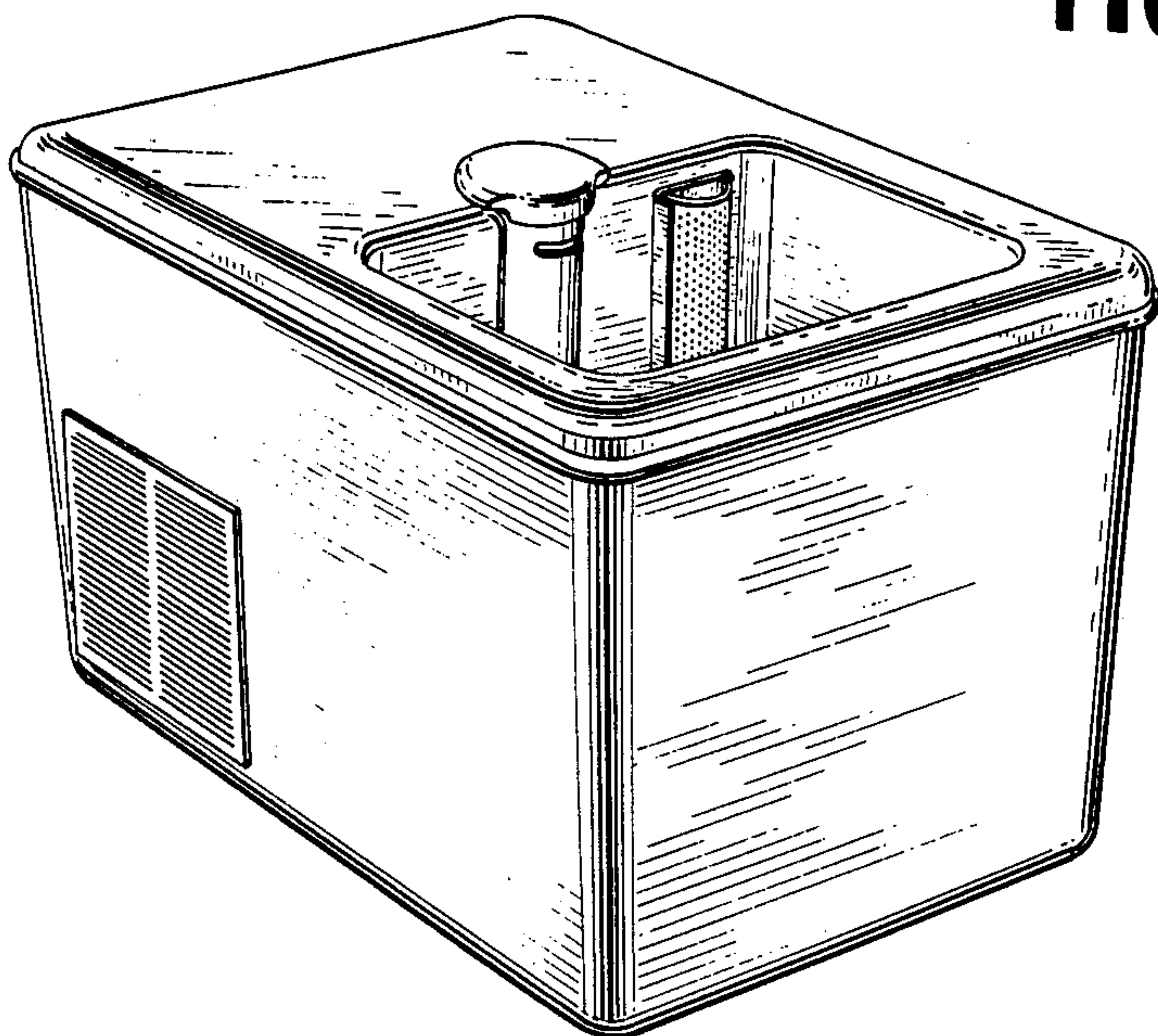

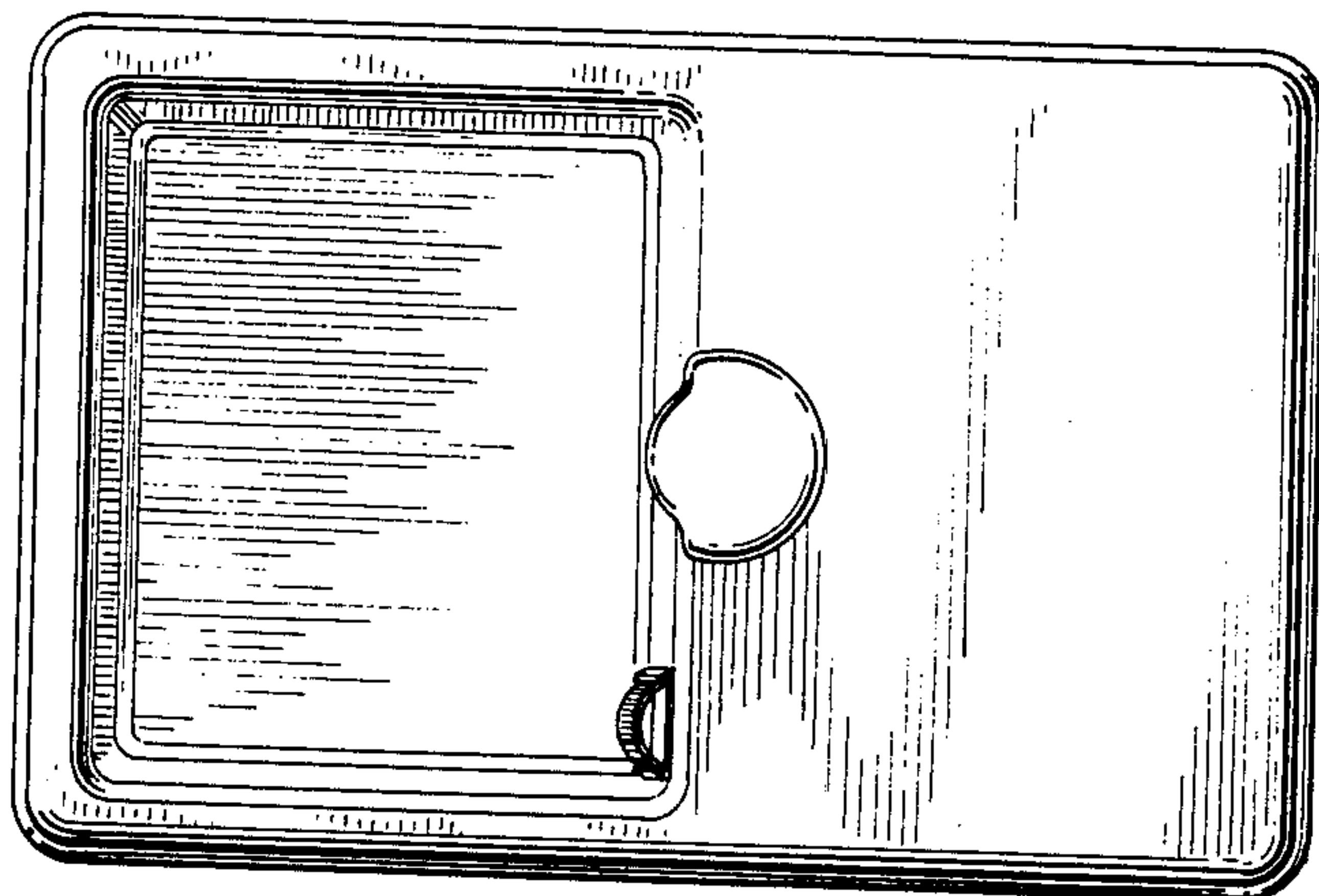
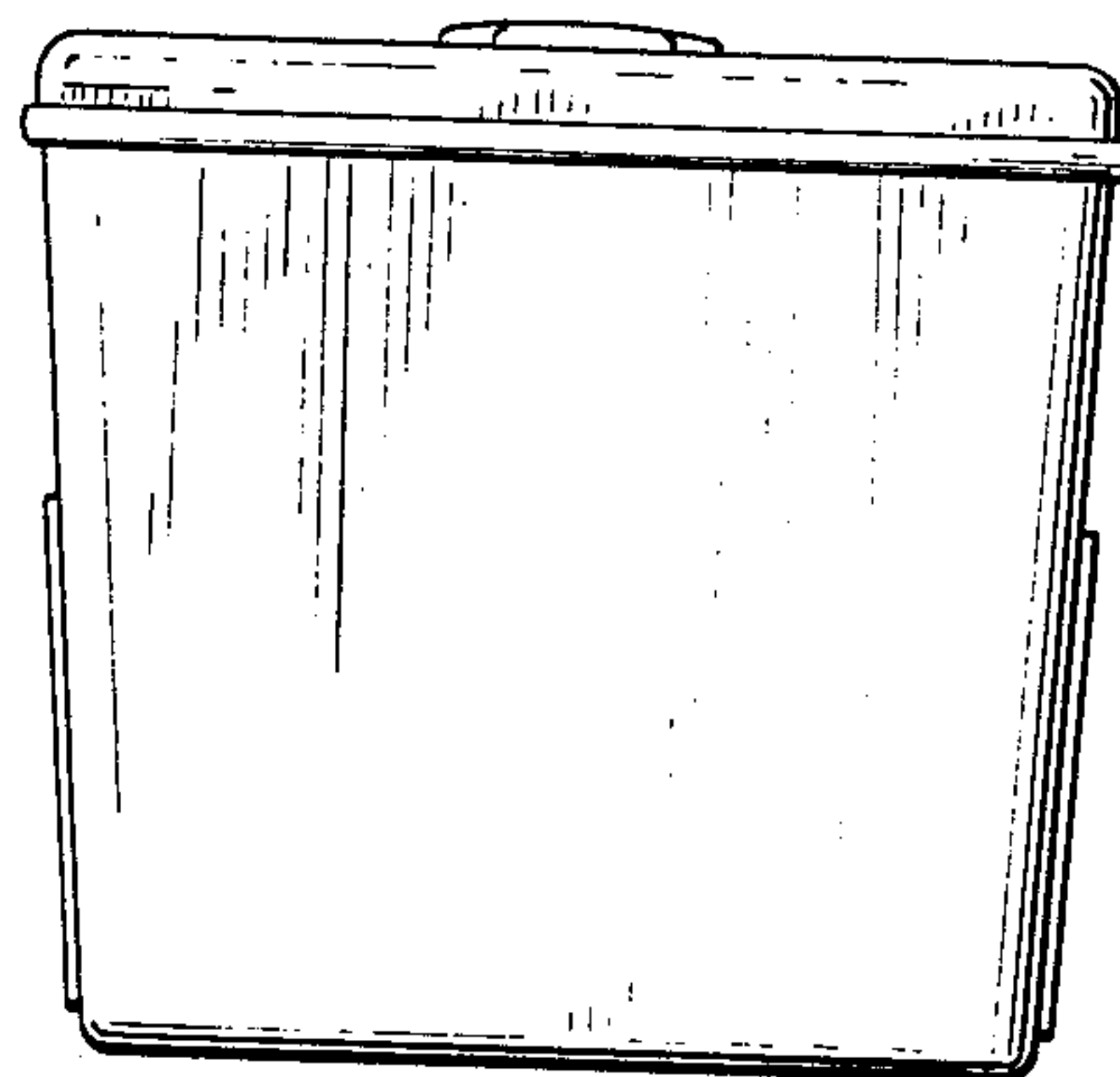

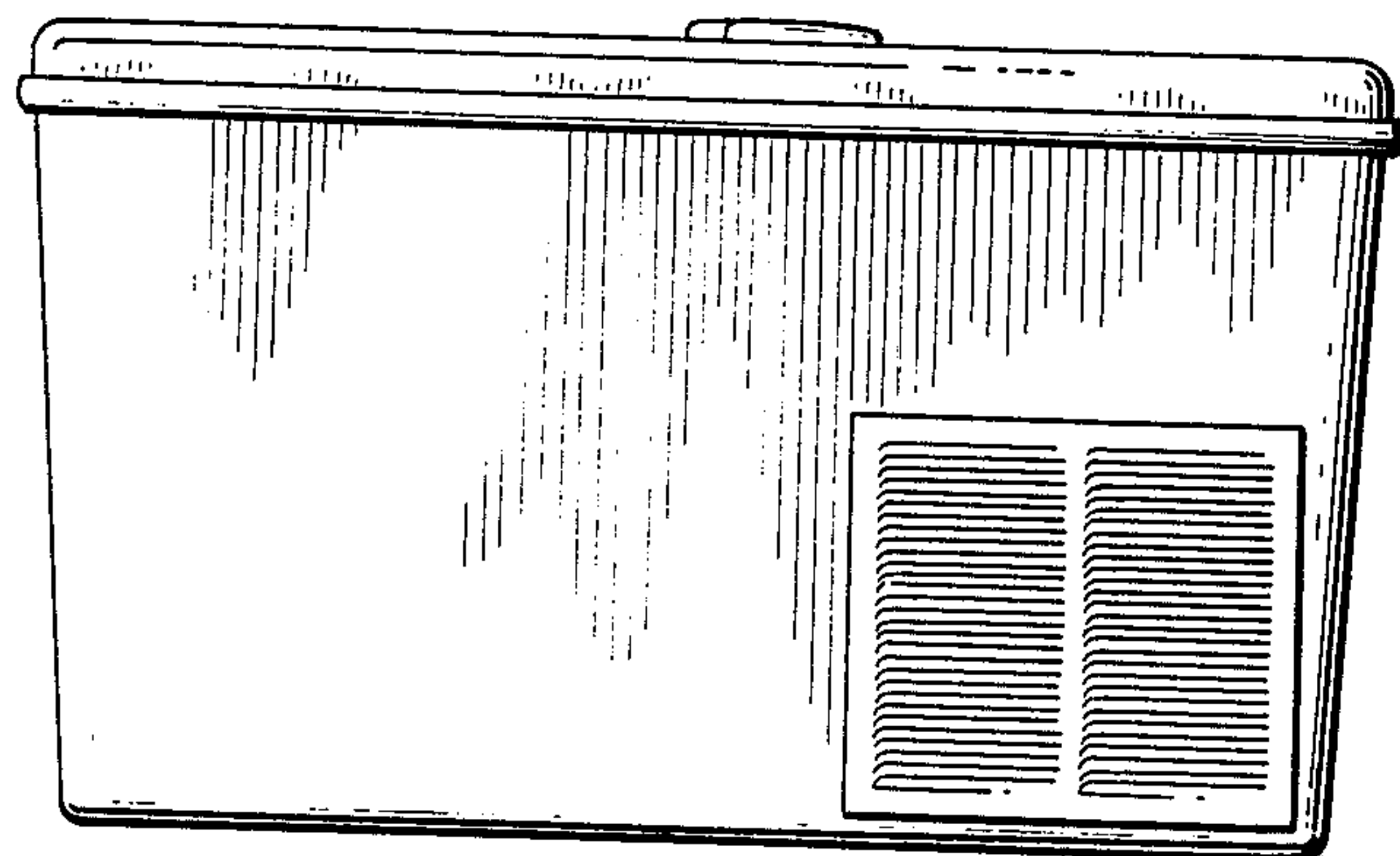
